TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT ON 03 DEC 95, IN CYIBINGO SECTOR OF THE COMMUNE, A MAN NAMED NAMAHUNGA PHELIMON WAS ATTACKED WHILE HE WAS SLEEPING IN THE BUSH. HE SUSTAINED MULTIPLE INJURIES ALL OVER THE BODY AND WAS LEFT FOR DEAD. HE IS NOW ADMITTED IN RUNYINYA COMMUNE CLINIC AND IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE TEAM INFORMED THAT HE COULD IDENTIFY ONE OF THE ATTACKERS AS AN INTERHAMWE.







  - (2) **EM-2.** Team visited NDORA (8112) commune and reported the situation to be calm. Team was challenged by RPA soldier at checkpoint (GR 755108). Details of this incidents are being followed. Assist bourguemaster stated that new returnees needed food, cooking pots, seeds and hoes. They are also facing shortage of housing.



(3) EM-3. Team patrolled Muganza (8407) commune and informed that the new bourguemaster named MR. NZABINTARE EUGENE has taken the charge of the commune. The commune is facing two major problem. These are as follows:

- (a) Rehabilitation of the commune office.
- (b) For 4 water point there is one pump that need repairs. It is requested that Engr technician may be send to repair the pump.

(4) EM-4. Team visited Nyaruhengeri (7607) commune and Kanyaru-haute border post. At Nyaruhengeri team visited the clinic being run by LVIA. The staff has started receiving their pay. In addition LVIA is also paying at the rate of 8450 RF for qualified nurses and 5200 RF for unqualified nurses.

(5) CIVPOL. Team visited Mbazi (7117) commune and reported the situation to be calm.

#### 4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

- a. At Nyabisindu CRS was found distributing beans as seeds and hoes to 3558 families. They are likely to distribute similar number of families in the 1st week of Nov 95. This is going to happen after a break of 3 month.
- b. At Nyaruhengeri distribution of seeds and agricultural materials by CRS was carried out for 4000 people.
- c. At Kigembe ICRC distributed foods (beans, soya, cooking oil and soap) to Kivulu sector.

(3) EM-3. Team patrolled HUYE (GR 6714) commune and reported the situation to be calm. Team could not gathered information due to shortage of interpreter in the sector. presently sector is running with two interpreter.

(4) EM-4. Team visited Gishamvu (GR 6505) assisted inspector of school to transfer school material like books, pens, pencils and other stationary from butare to the commune

(5) CIVPOL. Team visited Kibayi (GR 8497) and reported the situation to be calm. Cooperation between the RPA and locals were observed satisfactory. No report of illegal arrests and detentions, torture and violation of Human rights were received.
