Dear Monsieur Gros,

In the charges which you gave me yesterday by France against German War Criminals, a mistake has been made as to the first entry which the National Office is asked to make in the Form, after indicating the country which brings the charge and the country whose war criminals are accused. I refer to the heading:

"CHARGE No."

The purpose of this heading was to enable the National Office to insert the registered number under which it had filed the case in its own records, so that the War Crimes Commission and its Secretariat, if it had to call the National Office's attention to a particular case, would be able to quote the registered number under which the National Office had filed the case.

If you have at present any system of filing your cases under Serial Numbers, I should be very glad to send the completed forms which I have received back to you for the insertion of these serial numbers at the place in the file to which I have referred.

SUB-COMMITTEE ON FACTS AND EVIDENCE

Note by the Secretary General on the first batch of cases
transmitted by the French National Committee

The Cases are:

- A. French charges against German War Criminals filed under
Nos. 1 / Fr / G / 1 to 15 / Fr / G / 15 inclusive.
- B. One French charge against an Italian War Criminal filed under
No. 16 / Fr / It / 1.

OBSERVATIONS

1. As regards the particular cases:-

In 7 cases the name of the accused is given, namely, the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 8th, 9th French /German cases and the French /Italian case.

In 4 cases the person charged is identified by his rank or office, namely, the first, 9th, 10th, 15th French/German cases.

In 5 cases no indication of the identity of the accused is given, namely, in the French/German cases, the 2nd, 7th, 11th, 12th, 14th.

In nearly all the cases no indication whatever is given as to the kind of evidence on which the charges are based.

In case 2/Fr/G/2 there is said to have been a woman witness, and in case 15/Fr/G/15 four witnesses are named, and their rank and units given. In case 8/Fr/G/8 the name of a witness is given and he is said to be at present in London.

In case 10/Fr/G/10 the names of victims are mentioned, and this is also done in case 11/Fr/G/11 and case 12/Fr/G/12. The name of the victim is also given in the French/Italian case number 16/Fr/It/1.

As regards the war crimes which are charged, the following appear to be doubtful:- In 1/Fr/G/1 the General in command of the City of Strasbourg and the local Gestapo are charged with crimes No. 1 - Murder and massacres and systematic terrorism, and crime No. 7 - Deportation of civilians. What the

General is said to have done is to have had six young men shot for facilitating the escape of prisoners, and to have deported their families to Germany and broken them up. It seems doubtful whether these cases come within the crimes mentioned.

2. In general:-

- 1) The French National Committee has not complied with the Commission's request that if witnesses could not be named or their identity otherwise indicated without danger to them or persons connected with them, their existence only should be indicated and the witnesses be described by numbers under which they would be registered by the National Office and the nature of the evidence which they would give should be shown. The sections on the form entitled "Particulars of Alleged Crime" and "Notes on the Case" have also been left blank. A question therefore arises as to the adequacy of the presentation of the cases.
- 2) The French National Office has misunderstood the meaning of the heading on the form "Charge No. ...", which, as shown in the footnote is intended to be filled in with the "serial number under which the case is registered in the files of the National Office of the accusing State". Instead of giving this number it has inserted the numbers under which the war crimes charged in the case are described in the List of War Crimes, although this information also appears lower down on the form. It is very important that the National Offices should register their cases by numbers and put the relevant number on each form used to transmit a case. If this is not done there will be no convenient method of identifying the cases filed by the Secretariat with cases filed in the National Offices, and vice versa, particularly as in so many instances the person charged will be anonymous.
- 3) It seems clear that the National Offices should have been requested to state the unit and rank, or the official position of all persons mentioned in connection with cases, in the language of the country to which these persons belong, wherever this is possible. A great difficulty will obviously arise if the National Offices translate these indications of identity into what they regard as the nearest equivalent in French or English, and they have to be translated back into their original language when the list of war criminals is compiled.

Londres, le 21 Mars 1944.

Le document présenté par le ~~Sous~~-Comité I à la Commission d'Enquête sur la préparation et la présentation des dossiers a été l'objet, de ma part, des plus fortes réserves, à la séance du mardi 7 mars. Ayant ensuite assisté à une séance du ~~sous~~-comité I le mercredi 15 mars j'ai renouvelé mes observations et certaines ont été prises en note par Monsieur le Président du ~~Sous~~-Comité I.

Je tiens à résumer la position prise à l'égard du premier rapport du Sous-Comité I.

1./ En fait, après cinq mois d'existence soixante dossiers à peine ont été remis, la plupart incomplets et classés à la liste C. donc sans utilité actuelle. Il y a là une disproportion effrayante avec la réalité, les atrocités allemandes en Europe.

Rien ne permet de croire que les gouvernements pourront jamais augmenter le nombre des dossiers, dans le cadre des exigences du Sous-Comité I pour les raisons qui seront exposées plus loin. Au moment de l'armistice où les gouvernements demanderont notre liste l'échec sera évident.

2./ Le ~~Sous~~-Comité I pose aux Gouvernements les questions d'un juge d'instruction et se transforme ainsi en juge supranational, ce qu'aucun texte ne lui permet de faire. Ainsi le ~~Sous~~-Comité insiste sur la preuve par témoins d'un acte imputé à un Chef de la Gestapo alors que pour certaines législations le seul fait d'être membre de la Gestapo opérant en territoire opprimé ^{constitue} est le crime. Le ~~Sous~~-Comité refuse donc de mettre sur la liste des criminels un homme qui pour le juge national est un accusé de droit.

Aussi bien, par cette position de juge prise par le ~~Sous~~-Comité I aucun dossier intéressant les grands responsables ne pourra être retenu car il n'y a pas de témoignage sur les crimes commis par les chefs sous forme d'ordres généraux ou décrets.

3./ En ce qui concerne les crimes commis contre les prisonniers de guerre le ~~Sous~~-Comité a constaté que les coupables étaient toujours inconnus et ne seraient connus que si l'Etat major allemand livrait ses ordres d'opération. Ici encore, par conséquent, la liste reste vide.

4./ La conclusion de ces observations est qu'une liste ne correspond pas à la réalité des faits. L'idée d'une liste de criminels de guerre pouvait être intéressante en 1918 où la criminalité était restée dans les limites d'une responsabilité individuelle. En 1944 lorsque des centaines de milliers d'individus ont mis à mort ou terrorisé des millions d'autres individus la criminalité a pris un caractère collectif avec lequel une liste n'a plus de rapport.

Même si les Gouvernements avaient les preuves des crimes individuels commis ce n'est pas leur total qui crée l'atrocité allemande; l'atrocité consiste dans l'organisation systématique du crime.

Je demande que la Commission examine soigneusement la voie ouverte par le premier rapport du ~~Sub~~-Comité I afin d'être bien sûre qu'elle mène à une solution du problème de la répression.

Je me permets de rappeler que la Commission est saisie, d'autre part, d'un projet d'article à insérer dans l'armistice, prévoyant l'internement obligatoire des membres de la Gestapo et des SS. Le ~~Sub~~-Comité II a bien vu, en effet, que la répression du crime individuel ne serait possible que dans le cadre d'une sécurité générale assurée vis-à-vis de l'organisation du crime.

Je demande que la Commission envisage de faire un rapport provisoire aux Gouvernements sur cette question au plus tôt.

Le public croit à la confection actuelle des listes, les gouvernements, peut-être, sont imbus de la même confiance. Le désappointement serait trop grand, au moment de la libération de l'Europe, pour les peuples opprimés, de constater que la Commission n'a pas rempli leurs espoirs. Il est encore temps de dire que la méthode suggérée par les gouvernements n'est pas satisfaisante; qu'une liste ne peut pas être dressée actuellement.

On peut ^{enfin} douter qu'une liste, telle que la veut le ~~Sub~~-Comité I, puisse jamais être dressée, car les Allemands ont exterminé trop de témoins de leurs crimes, anéanti trop de preuves. Mais, sans préjuger de l'avenir la Commission peut chercher à remplir ses obligations par d'autres voies. Je crois qu'il est temps, à la fois de le dire aux gouvernements des Nations Unies, et de la faire./



I find this paper very convenient. It will enable us to send you five carbon copies, instead of four, in addition to the original charge.


I thank you very much for the trouble you took in finding the paper. Please, will you tell the Secretary-General that I would be grateful if he could supply us with the necessary amount.

I enclose some information that will interest you.

It seems from what is said about the "Germania" Division that there may be need of amending your charge about the Oradour massacre. The first information that we received was that the units concerned were the 1st and 3rd companies of the S.S. Panzer Grenadier Regiment No. 4 called "Der Fuhrer" and belonging to the "Reich" Division. One of the paras. (No. 4) in the enclosed papers speaks of "the 3rd Company" without mentioning a Division and gives the name of the guilty officer as Kahn.

Would you consider these points and see if you think the charge should be amended or supplemented.

On sait que fonctionne actuellement à Londres, et depuis 1942, une commission d'enquêtes des Nations unies sur les crimes de guerre, le "War Crimes Commission". Dans le but d'aider le travail de cette commission d'enquêtes des Nations unies sur les crimes de guerre, le jugement des criminels allemands qui ont perpétré tant de forfaits dans notre pays, un service dépendant du ministère de la Justice a été créé en France. Il s'est installé 22, place Vendôme et s'intitule "Service des crimes de guerre ennemis".

Son rôle est de centraliser tous les renseignements. Puis, après une vérification minutieuse et sur place des faits rapportés de transmettre les dossiers à la "War Crimes Commission".

On juge de l'importance de ce service et de l'ampleur des enquêtes qu'il va falloir mener à travers le pays.

Mais là ne se borne pas l'activité de ce service. Il est malheureusement trop vrai que bien souvent nos alliés, et notamment le peuple américain, se refusent à croire les récits des atrocités qui leur sont rapportées. Il a donc été décidé qu'une exposition serait prochainement organisée, et que des brochures de propagande seraient éditées dans toutes les langues de façon à donner la preuve indiscutable que l'humanité civilisée n'a pas le droit d'oublier comme on l'a trop fait en 1918, ni de faciliter la fuite des coupables devant le châtimement.

La commission française s'efforcera surtout de déterminer les responsables des massacres ou atrocités; on ne frappera les exécutants que s'ils ont encore ajouté à l'horreur des choses qui leur étaient commandées. La commission s'efforcera aussi de définir clairement ce que l'on doit appeler crime de guerre. C'est une chose délicate, mais les meurtres de femmes, d'enfants, les incendies d'hôpitaux, d'églises, de villages, les tortures infligées avant la mort, aussi bien en France qu'en Allemagne, ne sauraient être considérés comme des actes de guerre: ce sont des crimes contre la morale humaine et qui méritent un châtimement exemplaire.

La commission considère aussi comme "crimes de guerre", le pillage systématique de la nation française et mettra tout en oeuvre pour découvrir les preuves, très difficiles à déceler, de cette entreprise de ruine et de mort.

Tous les Français sont invités à coopérer avec le Service des crimes de guerre ennemis et à faire savoir, soit au siège central, 22, place Vendôme, soit dans les annexes qui seront créées dans tous les départements, les faits qu'ils peuvent connaître ou dont ils ont été témoins.

La justice militaire demeure seule chargée, conformément à l'ordonnance du 28 août 1944, de ces poursuites et compléments d'informations ou instructions.

Art. 10.- Le directeur du service de recherche des crimes de guerre et, dans leurs circonscriptions, les délégués des services régionaux pourront, pour l'accomplissement de leur mission, demander le concours de toute administration ou services compétents.

Art. 11.- Un arrêté signé du ministre de la justice et, éventuellement, de tout autre ministre intéressé fixera le siège des comités régionaux, leurs circonscriptions, la composition des comités et les autres questions intéressant le fonctionnement du service.

Art. 12.- Il est pourvu aux emplois prévus aux articles ci-dessus par des détachements de personnel civil ou militaire des autres administrations ou par recrutement direct. Le personnel recruté est engagé à titre temporaire et peut être congédié à tout moment, sous réserve d'un préavis d'un mois.

Dans la limite des crédits ouverts à cet effet, il sera recruté du personnel auxiliaire sur la base des salaires régionaux.

Art. 1er.- Le service de recherche des criminels de guerre ennemis comprend une direction centrale, des services régionaux en France, un organe de recherches en pays étrangers, et des officiers de liaison près des grandes unités alliées.

Art. 2.- La direction centrale comprend le personnel suivant, dont la rémunération est fixée par le ministre de la justice dans la limite des maxima mensuels ci-après:

Un directeur: limite maxima, 15.000.fr,
Deux chargés de mission faisant fonction de sous-directeurs: limite maxima: 10.500.fr;
Cinq chargés de mission première catégorie: limite maxima: 9.000.fr; moyenne : 8.000.fr;
Huit chargés de mission deuxième catégorie: limite maxima: 7.000.fr; moyenne: 5.500.fr;

Les émoluments fixés au présent article sont exclusifs de toute rémunération accessoire à l'exception des allocations prévues au code de la famille.

Art. 3.- Chaque service régional comprend un délégué régional et, suivant les besoins, un délégué adjoint.

Le délégué régional est assisté d'un comité régional, composé de personnalités désignées par le ministre et comprenant au moins un représentant des mouvements de résistance ou un officier ayant appartenu aux F.F.I.

Ce comité conseille le délégué régional et par tous les moyens apporte son concours au bon fonctionnement du service.

Les fonctions de membre du comité sont gratuites. Toutefois les membres du comité ont droit au remboursement de leurs frais ~~de~~ justifiés.

La rémunération des délégués régionaux est fixée par le ministre de la justice dans la limite des maxima mensuels ci-après, ces émoluments étant exclusifs de toute rémunération accessoire, à l'exception des allocations prévues au code de la famille:

Art. 4.- Un arrêté interministériel, signé des ministres de la justice, de la guerre, des affaires étrangères, et, éventuellement, de tout autre ministre intéressé, réglera le fonctionnement et la composition de l'organe de recherche en pays étrangers.

Art. 5.- Le directeur du service de recherche des crimes de guerre est chargé de rechercher et contrôler tous les faits constituant un crime de guerre commis par l'ennemi, d'en faire connaître les coupables et d'établir un dossier d'enquête sur chaque cas.

Art. 6.- Le directeur du service de recherche des crimes de guerre ennemis peut faire personnellement ou requérir tous officiers de police judiciaire de faire tous les actes nécessaires à l'effet de rechercher et constater les infractions, d'en rassembler les preuves et d'en découvrir les auteurs.

Il peut déléguer les pouvoirs qui lui sont attribués.

Art. 7.- Les services régionaux sont placés sous l'autorité de la direction centrale qu'ils représentent.

Dans la région ~~qu'il~~ qui leur est assignée, ils ont pour mission de contribuer à la recherche des crimes de guerre, à la constatation de faits, à la constitution des dossiers, à la préservation des preuves de la criminalité ennemie, et d'aider en tous points la direction centrale dans l'accomplissement de sa tâche, selon ses directives.

Ils transmettent à la direction centrale toute plainte, dénonciation ou renseignement par eux recueillis.

Art. 8.- Les dossiers constitués par le service des crimes de guerre ennemis seront soumis périodiquement à une commission d'enquête intérieure composée du président de la commission interministérielle de crimes de guerre, du directeur de la justice militaire et du directeur du service de recherche des crimes de guerre. My dear Colleague,

With reference to this morning's meeting of Committee I, I feel that it would be most useful if the French National Office could supply this Commission with further information about the identity of some of the accused, who have been listed as "unknown".

It seems, for instance, as France has been liberated for some time, that the names of accused of prominent rank such as commanders of troops of occupation, or commanders of operational troops, or heads of the Gestapo could now be ascertained without too much difficulty.

You will appreciate that SHAEF will have a heavy task in identifying all these unknown persons, and that their arrest will be speeded up if we can complete their identification.

In making this request I recognise the force of your remarks concerning the use by Gestapo men of assumed names, but Committee I was of opinion that even such a name could have value as a clue.

According to the Interrogation Report which was attached
to the charge by the British National Office, Leya and Pohl
are also suspect of having committed crimes against French
nationals. This part of the depositions is in the following
terms:

"Atrocities at partisan Camp

"O/Lt. LEYA (C.C. of Trupp 648) and O/Feldw. POHL
"(LEYA'S 2 i/o) conducted the interrogation of partisans
"in HUELGOAT in BRITTANY, (early July) where they had a
"special cage for them. Partisans were beaten until they
"fainted and then ducked into a large water barrel.
"LEYA had a very large barrel brought to the cage
"specially and partisans who would not talk were put into
"the barrel head down until they nearly drowned. PW. has
"seen LEYA and POHL beat partisans personally."

I am directed by Committee I to draw your attention to
these facts.

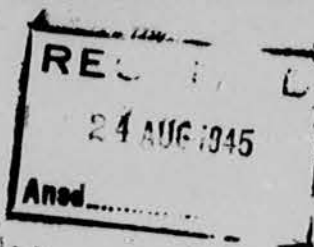



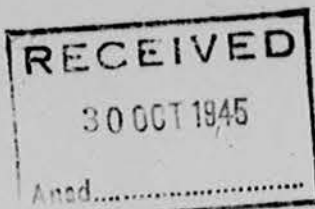
