



The UNAMIR Finance Section can process MILOBS final payments very quickly. But it can do so only if complete information is provided from the military personnel office. The following explanations are provided as a cooperative way for your office to help us speed the processing of military transactions.

(1) Requests for final payments must include attendance information up to the date of departure. This information must include an accounting of the accrued leave that is payable at the time of repatriation in order for the final payment to be processed. If complete attendance information is not available, then the final payment will be mailed to the MILOBS.

(2) Before you process a request to the Finance Section for an advance for newly-arriving MILOBS, please verify that those MILOBS have not already received an advance from a previous UN mission.

(3) Pursuant to UN auditor's instruction to simplify the processing of MSA payments, MSA will now be calculated on the "location method." That is, in the first month an estimated MSA amount will be calculated and paid at the rate applicable for the location shown for each recipient on the mid-month location report as if each recipient spent the entire month at that location. Then in the second month, adjustments will be made when the first month's actual attendance report is received.

For example, the October MSA payroll paid on 31 October will be calculated as if each recipient spent the entire month at the location shown on the mid-October Location Report. Then in November, the actual attendance report for October will be examined and MSA adjustments will be processed where the October flat-rate was more or less than the daily rates actually payable. These adjustments for October will show on the 30 November MSA statement and payment.

(4) Each month, there are cut-off dates for the processing of MSA payroll. For October, the cut-off dates will be:

7 October	Full month's attendance report for September is due
17 October	Mid-month location report is due
17 October	After this date, new arrivals will receive an advance only, and must wait until the end of November to receive any further MSA payment

(5) MILOBS wanting final payment must present a UNAMIR check-out sheet that has been signed by all other sections and officers. The Finance Section is the last to sign, and keeps the check-out sheet. The next time you reprint the check-out sheet, please add a block for the individual's home mailing address in case the individual is owed more money after he has departed.

1. CURRENT DESIGNATION OF STAFF VERSUS UNMO STATUS AMONG HQ UNAMIR OFFICERS IS A CAUSE OF FRICTION WITHIN MY HQ.
2. IN ORDER TO RETAIN THE MOST EFFICIENT AND PERFORMING OFFICERS REGARDLESS OF THEIR STATUS, OFFICERS WERE ASSIGNED CRITICAL POSITIONS IN THE FORCE HQ. AS A RESULT OF THE RAPID EXPANSION OF THE UNAMIR FORCE AND THE COMMENSURATE REQUIREMENT FOR EXPERIENCED STAFF OFFICERS WITH EXPERIENCE IN UNAMIR, MY HEADQUARTERS NOW CONSISTS OF A MIX OF OFFICERS ON STAFF AND UNMO STATUS. THE DISPARITY IN BENEFITS WHILE WORKING IN THE SAME CONDITIONS AND LIVING UNDER SIMILAR ARRANGEMENTS FOR RATIONS AND ACCOMMODATIONS IS CAUSING SOME DISCONTENT. I STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT THE REMAINING 23 (BUT THIS MAY RISE SLIGHTLY) STAFF OFFICERS' STATUS BE AMENDED TO REFLECT "STAFF OFFICER" STATUS AS OUTLINED IN THE ATTACHED BRIEF.
3. CURRENT HQ UNAMIR LIVING CONDITIONS ARE DIRTY, WITHOUT RUNNING WATER, FURNITURE, APPLIANCES OR AMENITIES. FOOD CONTINUES TO CONSIST OF HARD RATIONS. THIS IS THE CASE FOR ALL PERSONNEL (INCLUDING CIVILIANS, STAFF OFFICERS AND THOSE FORCE HEADQUARTER STAFF ANNOTATED AS MILITARY OBSERVERS) BUT THE STAFF OFFICERS ARE OBLIGED TO TOLERATE THIS WITHOUT THE BENEFITS OF MSA THAT THE OTHERS RECEIVE. IT SEEMS NEITHER FAIR NOR LOGICAL THAT OFFICERS WORKING AND LIVING SIDE BY SIDE UNDER IDENTICAL CONDITIONS RECEIVE SUCH VARYING DEGREES OF FINANCIAL COMPENSATION ESPECIALLY IN SUCH POOR CONDITIONS.

EXPERIENCE IN OTHER MISSIONS SUCH AS UNAVEM AND UNIMUZ HAS SHOWN THAT THE PRACTICE OF A SINGLE (MILITARY OBSERVER) STATUS IS NOT WITHOUT PRECEDENT AND COULD OFFER CONSIDERABLE BENEFITS IF ADOPTED IN RWANDA. HOWEVER, ONGOING CONTRACTUAL NEGOTIATIONS FOR ACCOMMODATION AND OVERALL FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS MAY PRECLUDE THIS APPROACH IN UNAMIR. THE PROVISION OF ACCOMMODATION FOR STAFF OFFICERS AT THE "BELGIAN" VILLAGE IS AN ADEQUATE ARRANGEMENT FOR THEM AND THEREFORE SHOULD RESULT IN 50% MSA FOR RATIONS, WATER AND INCIDENTALS.
5. IN SUMMARY, THE CURRENT MIX OF STATUS AMONG OFFICERS ON MY STAFF IS CAUSING DISCONTENT. LIVING AND WORKING CONDITIONS ARE CHALLENGING ENOUGH WITHOUT MAINTAINING AN ARTIFICIAL, NON-EXISTENT DISTINCTION AMONG STAFF OFFICERS WORKING SIDE BY SIDE. I STRONGLY RECOMMEND AND REQUEST THAT ALL STAFF OFFICERS OF HQ UNAMIR BE DESIGNATED AS "STAFF OFFICERS" WITH AN ENTITLEMENT OF 50% MSA FOR RATIONS AND INCIDENTALS. YOUR URGENT CONSIDERATION AND SUPPORT IS SOUGHT.

A. Force HQ, DFC/COS's office ltr no. 1000.7(DFC)/A/1 dated 10 Sep 94.

1. The above referred ltr has rightly emphasised the need for preventive measures against malaria to be taken by all troops. However this HQ feels that the preventive measures are necessary not only for the troops but also for the UNMOs who face the same risks. And the best preventive measure is to regularly take anti malarial tablets. However for a long time these tablets are not being supplied to the UNMOs nor are these tablets available in the local market wherefrom the UNMOs can purchase them.

2. As such it is requested that anti malarial preventive medicine be procured on immediate basis and be supplied to all persons serving with UNAMIR.

SUBJECT: Assault & Battery


On September 11, 1994 at about 1605 hrs two Nigerian U.N. troops came downstairs to the Brown & Root office yelling "Who was at the processing counter earlier". I asked "What was the problem" and the officer (Nigerian) stated again "Who was at the counter". I informed him "Not to be yelling at me". And he stated "You don't give me any shit you fuck, I'll fuck you up". I then told him to leave. He then came closer to me and with his hands pushed back against a wall. He then stated "He was a African fucking office and I was not shit, shut the fuck up". Then the other Nigerian soldier came over and with his hands started pushing me backwards and attempted to take away my radio as I tried to contact security. The first Nigerian officer told the other Nigerian soldier to "Come on and leave". As they were leaving my office they continued cursing at me and my employees. They left the terminal and entered a U.N. land cruiser bumper # UNAMIR 1041.

I then was finally able to get hold of the Air Ops Officer and he also witnessed their departure.

Both Nigerian personnel were in uniform and smelled of alcohol and acted intoxicated at the time.






