Excellency,

I would like to thank your Government for the valuable insights provided as part of the Stocktaking Exercise of the 'Delivering as One' pilot. I would like also like to congratulate your Government for advancing the resolutions contained in the Triennial Comprehensive Policy Review (TCPR) 2004/7 on coherence and effectiveness of the work of the United Nations. The different reports of governments and United Nations Country Teams from the eight countries, as well as the reports from the Headquarters of some participating UN agencies, have been synthesized into a summary document by the United Nations Development Group members in consultation with the countries. I have the pleasure of sharing it with you, together with an Executive Summary of the key points emerging from the ongoing process.

The stocktaking reports clearly indicate that the first year of 'Delivering as One' has led to:

- increased government ownership of the programme;
- government's improved coordination system and alignment of United Nations with national development priorities;
- increased participation of United Nations agencies, including from specialized and non-resident agencies, opening the cooperation of the UN to cover new areas particularly in the productive sectors and the environment;
- more empowered Resident Coordinator and the increased clarity in accountability of Resident Coordinators and United Nations Country Team as well as the division of labor among agencies;
- more joint programming, which includes joint thinking, joint planning and working together when it makes sense programmatically.

These gains have been amply recognized by different intergovernmental fora, including the UNIDO organized meeting in Vienna 4-5 March and the recent GA discussion on 'Delivering as One' held on 28 March 2008. The general conclusion is that while the eight 'Delivering as One' pilots are still ongoing, there are already some positive demonstrations of results called for by the TCPR and these should be mainstreamed into our ongoing programming process. We also need to learn from the experiences in several "self-starters" non-pilot countries, which are also generating ways of working better together.

In 2008, we are looking to the pilots to build on the gains made last year, focusing on implementation and delivering results truly important to the government and partners, and at the same time showing tangible results in addressing transaction costs.

I have requested UNDGO to support a process of documenting the experiences and lessons to share with all countries, particularly with the UNDAF rollout countries for 2008 and the self-starter countries.

Equally important, however, to advance this reform faster is the need to address, on an urgent basis, both the harmonization and simplification of business practices among the United Nations Development Group members and the finalization of the emerging agreements on 'empowered Resident Coordinators' together with the mutual accountability framework with 'empowered UNCT'.

I reiterate my gratitude to all of you for all your valuable work and I look forward to further advances in 'Delivering as One' this year.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
