UNIC LUANDA

For the Secretary-General's
trip to Angola

The draft agreement on the establishment of UNIC Luanda was presented in January 1983 to Ambassador de Figueiredo, Permanent Representative of Angola to the United Nations. Several contacts were made with the Angolan Mission since then to obtain their comments on the draft agreement and on likely views regarding the candidate for the post of the Director.

Ambassador de Figueiredo has promised to assist in obtaining a response from the Government of Angola to the draft agreement, but we have not received the Government's reply so far.

Regarding the post of the Director, some members of the Angolan Foreign Ministry had proposed UNHCR Representative in Maputo, Mr. Diarra Boubacar (a citizen of Mali) whose wife works at the Foreign Ministry. Mr. Boubacar was interviewed by Mr. Joe Sills during the Secretary-General's previous visit to Angola in January 1983. The view expressed by ERD/DPI was that the candidate had no media experience and his link with the United Nations has been limited to one country in Africa.

Another candidate is Mr. Paulo Rodrigues Nascimento (Brazil), who is fluent in Portuguese and has worked for several years as a Writer/Producer in the Radio Service of DPI. He is well-known to Angolan officials, particularly to Ambassador de Figueiredo, because of his extensive radio coverage of events in Angola and Mozambique. We are awaiting the return of Ambassador de Figueiredo to finalize the discussions on both the agreement and on the candidate for the Director.

SECRETARY-GENERAL'S STATEMENT TO PRESS IN LUANDA

(Received from the Spokesman for the Secretary-General.)

LUANDA, 26 August -- Secretary-General Javier Perez de Cuellar made the following statement to the press here today:

I am most grateful to President dos Santos and the Government of the Peoples Republic of Angola for this warm welcome and very kind hospitality.

As you know, I was here in Luanda in January of this year. This time my primary purpose was to consult with the President of the South West Africa People's Organization (SWAPO), Sam Nujoma, as a party to the cease-fire under Security Council resolution 532.

I shall go from here to Geneva and shall submit my report to the Security Council on 31 August.

I had a useful meeting with Mr. Nujoma, during which he reiterated to me SWAPO's readiness to sign a cease-fire with South Africa and to co-operate with the Secretary-General and with United Nations Transition Assistance Group (UNTAG) on the implementation of resolution 435.

My visit to the area has greatly reinforced my conviction of the urgent necessity to secure the objective of an independent, peaceful, prosperous and united Namibia through the speediest possible implementation of the United Nations plan.

I have greatly welcomed this opportunity to exchange views once again with President dos Santos on the situation in the southern part of Africa. We had, in particular, a chance to discuss the co-operation of Angola with organizations within the United Nations system.

I also appreciated the moving and impressive gathering at the airport this morning.

Peace in southern Africa is a major priority of the United Nations. I will do all in my power to further this objective.

SECRETARY-GENERAL ARRIVES IN LUANDA

(Received from the Spokesman for the Secretary-General.)

LUANDA, 26 August -- Secretary-General Javier Perez de Cuellar arrived in Luanda today at 1 p.m. local time on the last leg of the mission he has undertaken to southern Africa in order to speed up the implementation of Security Council resolution 435 on the question of Namibia, and in the context of the mandate entrusted to him by the Security Council in its resolution 532.

The Secretary-General was met at the Fourth of February International Airport by President Jose Eduardo dos Santos and Interior Minister Alexandre Rodrigues.

The welcoming ceremony was attended by the Dean and the Vice-Dean of the diplomatic corps in Angola, as well as thousands of Angolans who later lined the Secretary-General's route from the airport to the capital.

On the tarmac, the Secretary-General viewed a number of folk-dancing presentations and reviewed groups of Angolan pioneers as well as Portuguese in exile in Angola.

Addressing a mass meeting outside the airport, at which several thousand persons were present, the Secretary-General answered President dos Santos' welcoming address with a statement in Portuguese in which he reaffirmed his commitment to the independence of Namibia.

"My struggle for peace continues, victory is certain," he said.

The Secretary-General then drove to Luanda in the company of President dos Santos.

In the afternoon he met for one hour and 15 minutes with Sam Nujoma, President of the South West Africa People's Organization (SWAPO). The Secretary-General and Mr. Nujoma discussed the implementation of Security Council resolutions 435 and 532, and the Secretary-General briefed Mr. Nujoma on his discussions with the South African Prime Minister and Foreign Minister in Cape Town.

The Secretary-General then met with President dos Santos. Following this meeting, the Secretary-General will be guest at a State dinner given in his honour by the Commissioner of Luanda Province.

Following the dinner, the Secretary-General and his party will leave Luanda by private plane.

Before leaving Luanda, the Secretary-General made a statement to the press (see Press Release SG/SM/3458).




