- 9:45 am H.E. the President, escorted by the Chief of Protocol, will proceed to the Office of the President of the General Assembly for a meeting with him.
- 10:00 am H.E. the President will proceed to the Trusteeship Council Chamber to assist at a meeting.
- 11:55 am H.E. the President, escorted by Protocol, will proceed by special elevator to the 38th Floor. The Secretary-General will receive the President at the elevator.

Salute by the Honour Guard.

H.E. the President, accompanied by the Secretary-General and escorted by the Chief of Protocol, will proceed to the conference room of the Secretary-General.

Visual media will record the visit (**flag shot**).

- 12:00 pm H.E. the President will confer with the Secretary-General in the conference room.
