121630 HRS. ONE MALE DIED ON ARRIVAL AND ONE CHILD IS IN A VERY
SERIOUS CONDITION. A NGO REPORTED THAT THERE WAS AN ATTACK IN
SECTOR 5B WHICH RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF TWO RPA OFFICERS AND A
SOLDIER. IT IS REPORTED THAT ABOUT 25 PEOPLE WERE KILLED. NO
FURTHER DETAILS WERE GIVEN.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

a. SECTOR HQ: CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING THE ACTIVITIES

OF THE TEAMS.THE DCOS OPS WAS BRIEFED BY THE SECTOR COMD DURING HIS FAMILIARIZATION TOUR TO THE SECTOR.RPA BATTALION COMD ACCOMPANIED BY COMD GENDARMERIE AND DIR GENDARMERIE TRAINING SCHOOL ALSO ATTENDED THE BRIEFING.THE RPA BN COMD COMMENTED ON THE GOOD WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH THE MILOBS.

b. TEAMS:

(1) TEAM: PATROLLED CYABINGO AND NYARUTOVU COMMUNES. SITUATION IN THE AREA IS CALM.

CYABINGO COMMUNE: REF OUR SITREP FOR PERIOD 151700 TO 161700 AUG 95, THE BOURGEMESTRE, MR WILLYBROLD NIZEYIMANA, WHO WAS IMPRISONED HAVING BEEN SUSPECTED OF KILLING THE PREVIOUS BOURGEMESTRE WAS RELEASED ABOUT TWO WEEKS AGO. HE WAS RELEASED AFTER A VISIT TO THE PRISON BY HR. ABOUT 100 RETURNEES WHO WERE REPATRIATED FROM ZAIRE URGENTLY REQUIRE FOOD. THERE IS AN INSPECTOR POLICE JUDICIARY (IPJ) WHO PRESIDES OVER MINOR CASES. RADIO UNAMIR IS NOT HEARD, TIMINGS AND FREQUENCY WERE GIVEN TO THE AUTHORITIES.

NYARUTOVU COMMUNE: 157 PEOPLE WHO WERE REPATRIATED FROM ZAIRE ARE IN NEED OF FOOD. THE COMMUNE USES TWO ROOMS FOR DETENTION. 5 PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED, 2 SUSPECTED FOR GENOCIDE AND 3 FOR ILLEGAL RELIGION CALLED ABAKUSI. THE ROOMS HAVE NO VENTILATION. HR WILL BE ADVISED. AN IPJ IS LOCATED AT THE COMMUNE. HE PRESIDES OVER MINOR CASES. THEY REQUEST FOR A MOTORCYCLE AND STATIONARY.

(2) TEAM: PATROLLED NYAKINAMA AND KIGOMBE COMMUNES. SITUATION IN THE AREA REPORTED TO BE CALM.

NYAKINAMA COMMUNE: THERE IS ONE ROOM USED AS A PRISON. IT HAS ONE PERSON ONLY. RADIO UNAMIR IS NOT HEARD IN THIS COMMUNE. TIMINGS AND FREQUENCY WERE GIVEN TO THE COMMUNE. THERE IS AN IPJ WHO HANDLES MINOR CASES TOGETHER WITH THE BOURGEMESTRE. THE COUNSELLOR OF MUKO SECTOR, MR FLORIEN HATEGEKIMANA, WAS APPOINTED ACTING BOURGEMESTRE SINCE THE BOURGEMESTRE IS ILL (REF OUR SITREP OF 031700 TO 041700)

KIGOMBE COMMUNE: ONE CELL IS USED AS A PRISON CURRENTLY WITH 5 PERSONS ACCUSED OF MINOR CASES. THERE IS A MAIN PRISON WHICH IS CURRENTLY HOLDING ABOUT 2000 PEOPLE. NORMAL HOLDING CAPACITY IS 600 PEOPLE. RADIO UNAMIR IS NOT HEARD IN THE COMMUNE.

NYAMUTERA COMMUNE:IN THE COMMUNE 2 ROOMS ARE BEING USED AS CELLS.THIS CAN HOLD ABOUT 20 PERSONS.THERE IS 1 X IPJ WHO HANDLES MINOR CASES SUCH AS FAMILY DISPUTES.SERIOUS CASES LIKE GENOCIDE AND ARMED ROBBERY ARE ALWAYS REFERRED TO RUHENGERI FOR TRIAL.ADDITIONALLY ARE 10 COMMUNE POLICE ASSISTING THE IPJ.UNAMIR RADIO HAS BEEN HEARD TO BE FUNCTIONING IN KIGALI BUT NOT NYAMUTERA COMMUNE.HOWEVER,THE FREQUENCIES AND TIMINGS HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO THE STAFF.ONE MAJOR PROBLEM FACING THE COMMUNE IS THE REHABILITATION OF 2 WATER RESERVOIRS AT NYARUTEMBA(5722) AND TUBUNGU (5918) SECTORS.THE ASSISTANT BURGMASTER REQUESTED FOR IMMEDIATE HELP.HUM OFFR WILL LOOK INTO THE ISSUE.

NDUSU COMMUNE:2 ROOMS ARE BEING USED AS CELLS.THE HOLDING CAPACITY IS ABOUT 20 PERSONS.PRESENTLY,THERE ARE 13 SUSPECTS IN THE CELLS.2 SUSPECTS ARE UNDER INVESTIGATION FOR GENOCIDE WHILST THE REST ARE HELD FOR MINOR CASES.ONE IPJ HANDLES MINOR CASES.SERIOUS CASES ARE REFERRED TO RUHENGERI.THERE ARE 5 COMMUNE POLICE HELPING THE IPJ.THEY

HAVE NOT HEARD ABOUT THE FUNCTIONING OF RADIO UNAMIR. THE RADIO TIMINGS AND FREQUENCIES HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO THEM. THE ASSISTANT BURGMASTER REQUESTED FOR SEEDS AND FARMING IMPLEMENTS FOR RETURNEES.

(3) OTHERS: BN SECOND IN COMD OF RPA INFORMED TODAY AT 1200 HRS THAT ON 04 SEP 95 AT NIGHT THERE HAD BEEN TWO INCIDENTS OF FIRING AND ROBBERY IN KINIGI COMMUNE. MILOBS AND CIVPOL WENT TO INVESTIGATE THE INCIDENTS, DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

ON 04 SEP 95 AT MID NIGHT 3 PERSONS WITH ARMS AND ONE IN CIVIL DRESS WENT TO ONE OF THE HOUSE OF KANYAMIHETO (5139) SECOTR, FIRED 3 ROUNDS AND BY FORCE TOOK 15 COWS. AFTER FEW MINITS OF THEFT, RPA PATROL NEARBY TRIED TO FOLLOW THIS ARMED MEN BUT MANAGED TO RECOVER ONLY 2 COWS. THERE WAS NO EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN RPA AND ARMED MEN AND NO ONE WAS ARRESTED.

SECOND INCIDENTS TOOK PLACE ON THE SAME NIGHT IN SECTOR MUSANZE (5338) AT 0030 HRS. SOME ONE THREW GRENADES ON THE RPA PATROL AND THERE WERE EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN RPA AND THOSE WHO THREW GRENADES. THERE WERE NO CASUALTY ON BOTH THE SIDE AND NO ONE WAS ARRESTED.

IT HAPPENED YESTERDAY AT 1750 HRS WHEN MAJOR JAMES (M 11930) WENT TO PICK UP DUTY OFFR FROM HIS HOUSE. IT SEEMS THAT THOSE BOYS WERE PLAYING WITH STONS AND SUDDENLY ONE STONE STRIKE THE BACK DOOR GLASS. AFTER THAT ALL THE BOYS LEFT THE AREA.

B. WAY STATION. THERE IS NO WAY STATION IN THE SEC AND ACCORDING TO UNHCR ABOVE TRANSIT CAMP IS USED FOR ALL PURPOSE.

C BORDER CROSSING. ONLY ONE OFFICIAL BORDER CROSSING BETWEEN UGANDA/RWANDA AT CYANIKA GR 710520. BUT IT IS REPORTED THAT 5 RETURNEES HAVE COME FROM ZAIRE THROUGH VOLCANO FOREST IN KINIGI COMMUNE '5440' ON 18 AUG 95. THEREAFTER ON INVESTIGATION IT WAS LEARNT FROM THE LOCALS OF KINIGI COMMUNE

A.GENERAL: SITUATION REMAINED GENERALLY CALM.

B.BORDERS: NORMAL BORDER TRAFFIC BETWEEN UGANDA/RWANDA BORDER AT CYANIKA BORDER POST.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

B. MILITARY:

(1) RPA: REF OUR SITREP COVERING PERIOD 041700 TO 051700 SEP 95. MILOBS AND HR TEAM JOINTLY INVESTIGATED THE MATTER IN NYAMUGALI COMMUNE. BUT COMMUNAL STAFFS ARE NOT AWARE OF THE INCIDENTS. TEAM ALSO VISITED NEIGHBORING CLINICS BUT DID NOT FIND ANY PATIENT WITH BULLET INJURY. HENCE FAILED TO COLLECT ANY INFORMATION ON THE ISSUE. BUT RPA BN COMD VISITED OUR OFFICE TODAY AT 1200 HRS AND HE RECONFIRMED THAT HE WAS NOT A CIVILIAN BUT A RPA SOLDIER WHO WAS SHOT BY ANOTHER RPA. REASON BEING, THEY CAUGHT SOME SMUGGLERS AND ONE OF THE RPA WANTED TO RELEASE THEM WHEN ANOTHER RPA DID NOT AGREE. ON THIS ISSUE SOLDIERS STARTED QUARRELING AND ONE RPA SOLDIER FIRED A ROUND TO ANOTHER RPA WHO WANTED TO MAKE THEM FREE. BN COMD FURTHER INFORMED THAT LOCAL

RPA COMD HAS BEEN REPLACED BY ANOTHER AND THE MATTER IS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

(2) FRGF: REF OUR SITREP COVERING PERIOD 041700 TO 051700 SEP 95. THE INCIDENT WAS RECONFIRMED BY RPA BN COMD DURING HIS VISIT TO OUR OFFICE TODAY AT 1200 HRS. ACCORDING TO BN COMD, RPA OF NYAMUTERA COMMUNE ARRESTED ONE PERSON AS SUSPECTED INTERHAWME. AT THAT TIME ANOTHER CIVILIAN THREW A GRENADE TOWARDS THE CIVILIAN AND RPA. AS A RESULT, CIVILIAN WAS WOUNDED SERIOUSLY AND ONE RPA SOLDIER ALSO RECEIVED FEW SPLINTERS BUT NOT SERIOUSLY INJURED. BOTH OF THEM ARE UNDER GOING TREATMENT IN RPA HOSPITAL.

ON BEING INFORMED BY BOURGMESTER OF NKULI COMMUNE THAT ONE COLONEL (BANGAMWABO STANISLAS) OF FRGF HAS ARRIVED IN THE COMMUNE ON 29 AUG 95 FROM ZAIRE BY HIS OWN VEHICLE, TEAM WENT TO VISIT HIM WITH ASSISTANT BOURGMESTER IN SECTOR RYINYO '4920'. THE COLONEL INFORMED THE TEAM THAT AS SERVING COLONEL, HE LEFT THE COUNTRY LAST YEAR DURING WAR AND NOW RETURNED VOLUNTARILY WITH HIS OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS. HE COMPLAINED THAT 2 GENDERMARE TOOK HIS DAIHATSU PICK UP FROM HIS PRESENT RESIDENCE ON LAST FRIDAY. 


