With regard to the 48 new charges enclosed with your letters, I have to draw your attention to the fact that the present ruling of Committee I, as taken on 22nd May, 1947, (see Committee I Minutes No. 100), requires that all charges submitted must contain supporting evidence in the form of two or more extracts from the testimony of witnesses. X In accordance with the Commission's Committee's decision, therefore, and on instructions of its Chairman, I very much regret that I am obliged to return to you the enclosed 48 charges in order that they may be revised by your National Office.

With regard to the submission of the revised charges when completed, I have to point out that in accordance with the decision of the Commission taken on 29th October, 1947, the last date for accepting charges from the National Offices will be 28th February, 1948. In the circumstances, therefore, the Committee would very much appreciate if all charges which the Luxembourg National Office proposes to submit could be transmitted as soon as practicable before that date.

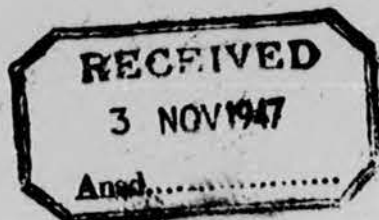

It is therefore considered that it would be useful if Judge Hammes, Chief Officer of the Luxembourg National Office, could be present at the next meeting of Committee I, when the Luxembourg cases will be dealt with.
