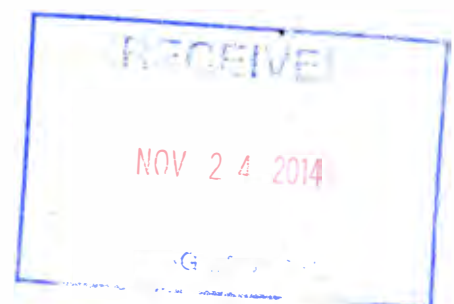
We value the humanitarian ideals underlying the CCW and as such respect your efforts in promoting its wider acceptance.
