SUBJECT : OPTION FOR MOVING DPS IN BIRAMBO TO GITARAMA AND KIGALI VIA GISENYI	

1. YOUR FAX DATED 210958Z OCT 94 INDICATED THAT YOU HAVE A PLANNED MOVEMENT OF DPS FROM GISENYI TO KIBUYE SCHEDULED FOR 26 OCT TO 29 OCT.
2. SECTOR 4B HAS REPORTED THAT THEY HAVE ABOUT 400 DPS PRESENTLY IN BIRAMBO CAMP WHO WISH TO MOVE TO GITARAMA AND KIGALI. THIS WILL EMPTY THE CAMP.
3. IN VIEW OF THE DIFFICULTY IOM AND UNHCR VEHICLES WILL HAVE NEGOTIATING THE ROAD GITARAMA - KIBUYE HAC FEELS SECTOR 4B REQUEST TO MOVE BIRAMBO DPS CAN BE INCORPORATED WITH SECTOR 5 OPERATION.
4. PROPOSED PLAN WOULD INVOLVE FRAFBAT TRANSPORTING DPS TO KIBUYE FROM BIRAMBO CAMP AND ONWARD TRANSPORT WOULD BE EFFECTED BY SECTOR 5 TRANSPORT USED TO BRING DPS GISENYI TO KIBUYE. BIRAMBO DPS WOULD THEN MOVE TO GITARAMA - KIGALI USING NORMAL OP HOMEWARD/IOM CONVOY OPS. ACCORDING TO SCHEDULE THIS OPERATION COULD DONE 28 OR 29 OCT.
5. IT IS REQUESTED THAT HAC REPS SECTORS 5 AND 4B LIAISE TO DETERMINE FEASABILITY OF PLAN AND ADVISE HAC KIGALI OF FINAL DECISION OR ANY FORESEEN DIFFICULTIES.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL.

(1) THE SOUS PREFET OF BIRAMBO ADDRESSED A MEETING OF DPs AND EMPHASIZED RPA ULTIMATUM THAT THEY MUST VACATE THE CAMP BEFORE 29 OCT 94.

(2) THE BOURGEMESTRE OF BUGARAMA ARRESTED SOME WEEKS AGO HAS NOW BEEN RELEASED BUT NOT TO RESUME DUTY.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA CONTINUED ROUTINE DAY AND NIGHT FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS IN MAJOR TOWNS AND VILLAGES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. THEY ALSO MOUNTED SNAP ROAD BLOCKS ON MAJOR ACCESS ROADS AND CONDUCTED INTENSIVE SEARCH ON VEHS AND PASSENGERS.

(2) RPA CARRIED OUT RELIEF IN PLACE AND REDUCED STR OF TROOPS AT REMERA (415916) TO PLATOON MINUS.

(3) RPA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE ARRESTED ONE MR KANEZA JEAN BAPTISTE ON 23 OCT 94 AT KIBUYE AND TAKEN TO GITARAMA ON 24 OCT 94.

(4) RPA TROOPS AT NYAGATARE AREA WERE REPORTED TO HAVE HARASSED ADRA STAFF FOR FOOD DURING FOOD DISTRIBUTION AT MUVUMBA (2747) ON AN UNSPECIFIED DATE LAST WEEK. THE INCIDENT WAS REPORTED TO RPA LOCAL COMMANDER WHO PROMISED TO TAKE ACTION.

(5) LOCALS OF NYABUYONE (517512) REPORTED THAT BANDITS SUSPECTED TO BE INTERAHAMWE ATTACKED A HOME AT THE VILLAGE WITH A GRENADE. THE GRENADE HIT A WALL AND EXPLODED AND THE BANDITS FLED LEAVING BEHIND 1 GRENADE WHICH WAS TAKEN BY RPA SOLDIERS.

(6) ON 24 OCT, HIGH RANKING OFFICERS OF RPA ADDRESSED THE PEOPLE OF GIKUNDAHURA (9309) AND EXPLAINED REASON FOR CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATIONS IN THAT AREA. 5 RPA SOLDIERS WERE CANNED IN FRONT OF THE CROWD FOR MISCONDUCT DURING THE OPERATION.

(7) AT ABOUT MIDNIGHT 24/25 OCT, BANDITS SHOT AND KILLED ONE MR MONTAKASI AND HIS WIFE AT RUVUNGURA (8713). THE MAN, A SHOP OWNER AT BUGARAMA WAS ORDERED TO SURRENDER CASH BUT HE REFUSED. THE SAME GROUP OF BANDITS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE ROBBED ANOTHER PERSON OF CASH AND PROPERTY IN THE SAME TOWN. LOCALS REPORTED THEY SAW 4 BANDITS IN MILITARY ATTIRE ON 7 OCT 94. ROBBERY BY BANDITS IN MILITARY UNIFORM WAS ALSO REPORTED AT RWIHENE (8715) NEAR RUVUNGURA. ONE BANDIT WAS IDENTIFIED AS A LOCAL OF THE VILLAGE.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. PLANNING, COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOB SECTORS ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT DURING THE PERIOD. ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO UNREO AND NGOs.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOB TEAMS PATROLLED BYUMBA, NGARAMA, NYAGATARE AND KAGITUMBA AREAS.

(3) MILOBS MONITORED GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDERS AND REPORTED NORMAL TRAFFIC WITH AN ABOUT 50 RETURNEES FROM UGANDA ENTERING RWANDA DAILY.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED AND MONITORED ACTIVITIES ALONG THE RWANDA-TANZANIA BORDER AND REPORTED INFLOW OF RETURNEES AT RUSUMO BORDER DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) MILOBS LIAISED WITH UNREO AND DISCUSSED THE HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN THE SECTOR.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS, BORDER MONITORING AND INVESTIGATIONS WITHIN THE SECTOR.

(3) MILOBS ESCORTED HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM TO SAVE (7419) TO INVESTIGATE MASSACRE ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN DONE BY FORMER RGF.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS AND CARRIED OUT MONITORING DUTIES AT THE BORDERS IN AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY AND REPORTED LOW VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC IN AND OUT OF RWANDA.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN THE KIBUYE-BIRAMBO AREA AND TO ASSESS THE SITUATION IN THE DPs CAMPS AFTER THE RPA ULTIMATUM.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD EXCEPT FOR RAMPANT BANDITRY IN CERTAIN PARTS OF THE SECTOR.



(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE SECTOR.

(3) SECTOR MILOBS ESCORTED A CONVOY OF BROWN AND ROOTS TRUCKS TO KIBUYE DURING THE PERIOD.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED GISENYI AND BORDER POSTS, NYUNDO (248117), RUHENGIRI, CYANIKA (7153), KINIGI (5440), BISOKE (449393) AND KARISOKE (428360).

(3) SECTOR MILOBS ESCORTED MSF TEAM TO KAREBA HEALTH POST (417253).

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI AND ITS SUBURBS REMAINED CALM. RPA CONTINUED THEIR ROUTINE FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS AND MOUNTED SNAP ROAD BLOCKS IN THE CAPITAL ESPECIALLY AT NIGHT.

(2) SECTOR MILOBS ESCORTED UNCHR TRUCKS WITH A TOTAL OF 44 DPs FROM KIGALI TO NYAMATA AND BYUMBA. 13 OF THOSE PEOPLE SENT TO BYUMBA WERE RETURNED TO KIGALI SINCE THE AUTHORITIES CLAIMED THEY HAD NO FACILITIES TO RESETTLE THEM THERE.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

(1) EXCEPT ABOUT 400 WHO ARE AWAITING TPT TO GITARAMA AND KIGALI, DPs HAVE LEFT BIRAMBO CAMP IN SECTOR 4B. THIS IS IN LINE WITH RPA DIRECTIVE TO THEM TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES.

(2) TWO UNHCR OFFICIALS AND THE ASSISTANT PREFECT OF GISENYI HELD A MEETING WITH THE ASSISTANT PREFECT OF KIBUYE TO COORDINATE THE RESETTLEMENT OF RETURNEES AND DPs IN KIBUYE PREFECTURE.

(3) 150 DPs WERE TRANSPORTED TO RWAMATAMU (1615), GISHITA (2161) AND MUBUGA (2463) ALL IN SECTOR 4B, BY UNHCR FROM CYANAGUGU.

(4) 159 DPs ARE IN BUGARAMA AWAITING EVACUATION.


