

GENDARMERIE WAS IMMEDIATELY INFORMED OF THE ROBBERY BY ICRC CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR BUT ATTEMPTS TO CORDON OFF THE SECTOR AND APPREHEND THE CRIMINALS FAILED. RPA/GENDARMERIE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.

REPORT ON FORCED EVICTION OF RWANDANS

1. It has come to our attention that Rwandans are being forcefully evicted from their homes along the Rusizi River (GR 7422). Cyimbogo Commune has been targeted as part of this plan. Two incidents have been reported:

- a. On Thursday, 06 October one man from Mutongo Sector (GR 7520), Kamarebe Cell (at the T-junction) was evicted at gunpoint and given three (3) hours to move; and
- b. On Tuesday, 12 December in Mururu Sector (GR 7521), Buremera Cell (GR 7622), 15 families (50 people) were forcefully evicted at gunpoint by RPA.

2. The occupants of the houses along the Rusizi River are generally given three (3) hours to leave their houses. These people are told to occupy houses further inland, vacated by those who fled to Zaire in 1994. These expulsions by RPA are essentially South of Rusizi II along the border area upto approximately one kilometer inland from the Rusizi River.

3. The exact extent of the implementation of this policy is unknown but it has been going on since early October 95. The intent appears to create a buffer zone to better contain and deter further infiltrations. This episode is well known by locals of Cyimbogo commune and those living along the Rusizi River.

4. What is not certain at this time is the extent of the buffer zone being created along the Rusizi River. It would be logical that this policy be implemented down to the Rwanda-Burundi border (GR 9397), although no evidence of such enforcement is evident. Further south along the Rusizi River, the areas are not patrolled from the ground, although air reconnaissance have been conducted along the border areas of Rwanda-Zaire and Rwanda-Burundi. In future, landings will be required to verify the above information.

THE ALLEGED REASON FOR HIS ARREST IS THE RELEASE OF INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED FOR GENOCIDE WHO HAVE NOW FLED TO ZAIRE. HIS PRESENT WHEREABOUTS ARE UNKNOWN. HUMAN RIGHTS DELEGATION IN CYANGUGU IS AWARE OF HIS ARREST.

- (3) OTHERS. ON THU, 14 DEC AT 1930 HRS THE ICRC OFFICE IN CYANGUGU WAS ROBBED BY THREE INDIVIDUALS WHO ENTERED THE PREMISES FROM THE REAR OF THE COMPOUND. ALL PERSONNEL WERE IN THE DINING-ROOM WITH THE CURTAINS DRAWN. THEY WERE TOLD TO LIE ON THE FLOOR. \$4,500.00 US AND RF4,700,000.00 WERE STOLEN AS WELL AS PERSONAL BELONGINGS (WATCHES, JEWELLERY...) OF THOSE WHO WERE IN THE DINING-ROOM. THE GUARDS EMPLOYED BY ICRC WERE AT THE FRONT OF THE PREMISES NEAR THE MAIN GATE AND WERE NOT PATROLLING THE PERIMETER AT THIS TIME. TWO OF THE MEN LOOKED LIKE PROFESSIONAL CRIMINALS, ONE ARMED WITH A KALASHNIKOV AND THE OTHER WITH A PISTOL. THE THIRD MEN WAS HEAVILY MASKED AND WAS MINIMIZING HIS MOVEMENTS VOLUNTARILY, AS IF HE DID NOT WANT TO

BE RECOGNIZED. THE THIRD MAN (MASKED) IDENTIFIED THE ICRC ADMINISTRATOR WHO ACCOMPANIED THE ROBBERS TO OPEN THE VAULT LOCATED IN HIS OFFICE. THE ADMINISTRATOR WAS TIED UP AND LEFT IN HIS OFFICE. THE LARGE AMOUNT OF MONEY WAS TO PAY THE EMPLOYEES OF ICRC CYANGUGU AT THE END OF THE MONTH. THE THREE BANDITS MADE A CLEAN GET AWAY AND HAVE DISAPPEARED WITHOUT TRACE. SOME INDIVIDUALS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED BUT NO MONEY OR PROPERTY HAS BEEN RECOVERED. LOCAL RPA COMMANDER AND GENDARMERIE COMMANDER VISITED ICRC EARLY FRIDAY MORNING. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES OR INJURED PERSONNEL DURING THIS INCIDENT.

ASSESSMENT. THE PROBABILITIES THAT THIS WAS AN INSIDE JOB ARE VERY HIGH. THE BANDITS KNEW THE PREMISES AND WHERE TO GO. FROM THE ICRC POINT OF VIEW, ONE OF THEIR EMPLOYEES OR EX-EMPLOYEE WAS INVOLVED BUT ALL WERE AT WORK ON FRI, 15 DEC. SECURITY MUST BE INCREASED BY RPA AT THE LOCATION OF ALL NGOs AND UN AGENCIES, AS THEY NOW HAVE ASSUMED THIS RESPONSIBILITY. THIS INCIDENT MAY WELL BE REPEATED AT OTHER OFFICES AND RESIDENCES AT THE SAME PERIOD NEXT MONTH. SENTRIES MUST BE POSTED AT NIGHT TO COVER THE MAIN ENTRANCES AND PATROL THE PERIMETER OF OFFICES AND RESIDENCES. SECURITY OF THE MOST LIKELY TARGETS MUST BE ENSURED.
