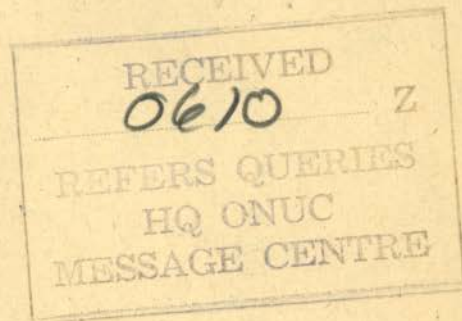

1). Signals concerned moves of MSF Kindu but no indication you had signalled Kindu separately. On other hand MSF does not use our cipher. Therefore we had to repeat in clear avoiding mention your reference number and altering text so not break cipher. For future how should we relay cipher machine ?

2). Bukavu's only reliable radio link Kindu is via Leo. Signals to us for relay to Kindu must from Bukavu to Leo for transmission Kindu. Therefore quicker if you signal Kindu simultaneously with Bukavu where message is for both stations. Cipher signals might go in Malayan from Leo to Kindi to get over lack of cipher in Kindu.

3). In view moves ordered in your OPS 609, what arrangements made for refugees in MSF area Kivu as set out in paras A and B of our BUKA 45 of 4 April.
