

Monsieur Le Gallais referred to a conversation which he had had recently with Mr. Grew in which he had recommended that Luxembourg be represented on the Executive Committee of the Conference.

Monsieur Le Gallais said that Mr. Bech, his Foreign Minister, is really the dean of foreign ministers, having held this position for twenty years. He went on to refer to Mr. Bech's familiarity with the activities of the League and his frequent appearances before the League. He said he thought that Mr. Bech would be most useful to the other countries if he could serve on the Executive Committee. He assured me that Mr. Bech is not aware of the proposal which Monsieur Le Gallais has made.

Monsieur Le Gallais said that at one recent conference in this Country Belgium had been on the Executive Committee and at another one The Netherlands had been. He said he thought it might be appropriate this time to include Luxembourg. He went on to say that the usual position for Luxembourg in recent conferences has been on the Nominations Committee. He said that if his proposal as to Mr. Bech were adopted it might be embarrassing

for

for Luxembourg to be on the Nominating Committee. He also implied that Luxembourg is a little tired of being regularly relegated to the Nominations Committee.

I told Monsieur Le Gallais that I would see that his views were presented to my superiors and I reminded him that important matters relating to the arrangement were a matter for consultation among the four sponsors and further that the definitive organization of the Conference is for the Conference itself to decide.
