1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.
2. REGARDS

1. OVERVIEW. THE RPA MAINTAINS A LARGE PRESENCE SECTOR 4B AND BUTARE. PEOPLE IN NYABITARE (SECTOR 4C) HIDE IN THE FIELDS AT NIGHT IN FEAR OF BANDITS.

2. RPA/GENDARMERIE. IN SECTOR 4B: THE RPA CONTINUE WITH PATROLS AND MANNING CHECKPOINTS AND PRISONS IN THE SECTOR. A LARGE CONCENTRATION OF RPA TROOPS REMAINS IN BUTARE.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 1: THREE ARMED MEN FORCIBLY ENTERED THE RESIDENCE OF THE BROWN AND ROOT COORDINATOR IN BYUMBA GR 0825 AT 0630 HOURS 30 JUN. THEY STOLE A PORTABLE GENERATOR, REFRIGERATOR AND A FREEZER.

B. IN SECTOR 4C: PEOPLE LIVING IN THE AREA OF NYABITARE GR 8911 HIDE IN THEIR FIELDS AT NIGHT TO AVOID BANDITS. THE BANDITS ARE ARMED, USUALLY DRESSED IN UNIFORM AND ESCAPE UNCHALLENGED AFTER LOOTING HOMES. LOCALS COMPLAIN THAT UNAMIR IS SEEN ONLY DURING THE DAY AND THAT THE RPA DOES NOT PROTECT THEM FROM THE BANDITS.

C. IN SECTOR 4B: DURING THE NIGHT OF 29/30 JUN, TWO MEN DRESSED IN CIVILIAN CLOTHING AND ONE DRESSED IN AN RPA UNIFORM ROBBED THE RESIDENCE OF THE PROGRAMME OFFICER FOR WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME IN BUTARE GR 7111. THEY ESCAPED WITH A QUANTITY OF AMERICAN MONEY.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS. NSTR.

5. POLITICAL. NSTR.

6. REGIONAL. IN SECTOR 4C: AT 1145 HOURS 30 JUN, ONE AIRCRAFT WAS HEARD FLYING WEST TO EAST OVER KIRAMBO COMMUNE GR 0344. CLOUDS PREVENTED VISUAL OBSERVATION OF THE AIRCRAFT.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) CONDUCTED PTLS AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) NIBATT PROVIDED TRUCKS TO CONVEY 9.41 TONNES OF FOOD FROM BYUMBA WFP STORE TO EPA SECONDARY SCHOOL NYAGAHANGA.

(3) NIBATT MED STAFF TREATED 112 LOCALS IN AOR.

(4) MILOBS PATROLS TO VARIOUS COMMUNES REPORTED ON HUMANITARIAN ACTIONS OF NGOS. ONE TEAM BROUGHT ELECTROGAZ WORKERS TO BUYOGA GR 0131 COMMUNE TO

INSPECT ELECTRIC POLES AND LINES.

(5) MILOBS REPORTED THAT EIGHT RETURNEES WITH 78 COWS CROSSED FROM UGANDA TO GATSIBO IN BUTARO COMMUNE OF SECTOR 5. THE RPA IN THAT LOCATION GAVE THEM AUTHORITY PASS TO GO TO NYGATARE TROUGH KIVUYE AND MUKARANGE.

(6) MILOBS PTL REPORTED THAT THREE ARMED MEN FORCIBLY ENTERED AND STOLE A PORTABLE GENERATING SET, FREEZER AND REFRIGERATOR FROM THE HOUSE OF MR. JERRY RAY OGDEN, BROWN AND ROOT SECTOR COORDINATOR IN BYUMBA ON 30 JUNE 95 AT 0630 HRS. MPS INFORMED.

SECTOR 2

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) GHANBATT DONATED NINE BALES OF USED CLOTHES TO ORPHANAGE AT RWAMANGANA GR 4884 ON BEHALF OF UNIT. ALSO DONATED SIX BALES OF USED CLOTHES THROUGH ASST BOURGMESTRE OF GASHORA COMMUNE TO RILIMA PRIMARY SCHOOL ON BEHALF OF UNIT.

(3) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT UNHCR DISTRIBUTED RELIEF ITEMS TO LOCALS AT BARE GR 5549 ON 30 JUN 95.

(4) MILOBS PATROLS TO BIRENGA TRANSIT CAMP GR 5959 REPORTED THAT 197 RETURNEES WHO ARRIVED ON 28 JUNE 95 HAVE BEEN SENT TO THEIR COMMUNES. THERE WERE 37 RETURNEES AT NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP. BOTH OF THE CAMPS HAD ENOUGH FOOD AND WATER. TEAM REPORTED THAT THE BROKEN BRIDGE AT GR 3156 HAD NOT BEEN REPAIRED AND THE PEOPLE CROSSED THE RIVER BY CANOE. THE WATER SHORTAGE AT SAKE GR 4354 TRANSIT CAMP WAS REPORTED. PATROL TO NYARUBUYE GR 8459 REPORTED THAT MANY PEOPLE RETURNED TO THAT AREA AND MORE WERE EXPECTED.

(5) GHANBATT MED STAFF TREATED 76 LOCALS IN AOR.

C. SECTOR 3

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) MALAWICOY TRANSPORTED TIMBER AND FIREWOOD FOR NGOMA ORPHANAGE AND FROM GISOVU GR 2652 TO NGOMA GR 2059.

(3) MALAWICOY TRANSPORTED IDPs FROM NYAMISHABA GR 2671 TO RUTSIRO GR 3053 AND GISHYITA GR 1962.

(4) MALICOY TRANSPORTED 1 TONNE OF SCHOOLING MATERIALS FROM GITARAMA TO TARA GR 8883 AND KAYENZI GR 8389 COMMUNES.

(5) MILOBS PATROLS TO KAYENZI COMMUNE GR 8389 REPORTED THAT THERE WERE 346 WIDOWS. THERE IS LACK OF

ALL THE BASIC HUMAN NEEDS. SALVATION ARMY PROVIDED THEM FOOD AND BLANKETS TWO MONTHS AGO. THE SAME NGO COMMENCED THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE HOUSES FOR THE WIDOWS AT A RATE 5 PER SECTOR.

(6) MILOBS REPORTED THAT CIVPOL TEAM WENT TO GITARAMA PRISON TO INVESTIGATE ON A SHOOTING INCIDENT THAT TOOK PLACE ON THE NIGHT OF 28/29 JUNE 95. THE DIRECTOR CLAIMED THE PRISONERS WERE SHOT WHILE ESCAPING.

(7) MILOBS ALONG WITH BOURGMESTRE OF RUTSIRO AND A REPRESENTATIVE OF MINISTRY OF SOCIAL AFFAIRS PATROLLED RUTSIRO COMMUNE AND BWIZA SECTOR GR 3693 AND REPORTED THERE WERE 700 REFUGEES STRANDED AT RUTSIRO COMMUNE CENTRE. THEY WILL BE RESETTLED IN THE AREAS AT GR 3794, GR 3795, GR 3494 AND GR 3495.

(8) MILOBS PATROLLED NGOMA GR 4170 AND MABANZA COMMUNE GR 4071 AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS IN BOTH SECTORS WERE HARASSED AND ARRESTED FREQUENTLY. THE LOCALS SAID THAT 09 PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED IN JUNE 95. THESE PEOPLE WERE ACCUSED IN TAKING PART IN LAST YEAR GENOCIDE. THEY WERE CURRENTLY DETAINED AT MABANZA PRISON.

(9) MILOBS PTL TO MUTUNTU HOSPITAL GR 3653 AND MUSANGO GR 3760 PRIMARY SCHOOL REPORTED THAT THE HOSPITAL WAS RUN BY THE CHARITY SISTERS (FRANCE) AND SPONSORED BY CARITAS. THE SAME ORGANIZATION WAS RUNNING THE DISPENSARY AT MUSANGO TWO TIMES A WEEK. THE SCHOOL HAS NO QUALIFIED TEACHERS AND NO TEACHING MATERIALS.

D. SECTOR 4A

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) ZAMBATT PROVIDED A TEAM OF 34 TROOPS WHO ASSISTED LOCALS OF KIYUMBA GR 5729 TO RECONSTRUCT A CULVERT ON THE ROAD.

(3) ZAMBATT REPORTED THAT ONE LOCAL AGED 45, OF MUBUNGA COMMUNE GR 5202 KAMANA SECTOR WAS MATCHETED BY 03 UNKNOWN LOCALS. SAME WAS TAKEN TO RUNYOMBYI HEALTH CENTRE AND CASE WAS HANDED OVER TO THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES.

(4) MILOBS PATROLS TO KARAMBO REPORTED THAT THERE WAS NO HOSPITAL AND PEOPLE HAD TO GO TO KADUHA OR KIGEME HEALTH FACILITIES. MOSTLY THE POPULATION IS SAID TO BE REMAINING IN ZAIRE OR BURUNDI. THE REGISTRATION OF POPULATION WAS GOING ON IN THAT COMMUNE.

(5) ZAMBATT MED STAFF TREATED 317 LOCALS IN AOR.

E. SECTOR 4B

- (1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.
- (2) MILOB SECTOR COMMANDERS CONFERENCE WAS HELD ON 30 JUNE 95 AT SECTOR HQ.
- (3) SENBATT MED STAFF TREATED 116 LOCALS IN AOR.

F. SECTOR 4C

- (1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SECURITY DUTIES IN AOR.
- (2) ETHIOBATT ESCORTED A UNHCR CONVOY OF 54 IDPS PROCEEDING TO BUTARE FROM NYAGATARE TO KITABI GR 3520.
- (3) ETHIOBATT REPORTED THAT THE PEOPLE AROUND NYABITARE GR 8911 SPEND THE NIGHT OUT OF THEIR RESIDENCES IN FEAR OF THE BANDITS WHO ATTACKED THEM AT NIGHT. THEY SAID THAT RPA DOES NOT PROTECT THEM FROM THE BANDITS. ARMED BANDITS WITH UNIFORM USUALLY COME BY THE NIGHT AND MANAGE TO ESCAPE AFTER LOOTING.
- (4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM. HOWEVER ONE OVERFLIGHT WAS REPORTED IN KIRAMBO COMMUNE ON 30 JUNE 95 AT 1145 HRS. THE AIRCRAFT MOVED FROM WEST TO EAST, BUT WAS NOT VISIBLE BECAUSE OF CLOUDS.
- (5) MILOBS PATROLS REPORTED THAT IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR ONE MAN WAS KILLED BY AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF BANDITS ON SUN 25 JUNE 95 AT 1930 HRS IN NYAHONGA GR 9101. THE BANDITS STOLE HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND OTHER BELONGINGS. AT GISUMA COMMUNE GR 852262 APPROX 400 LOCALS, MOSTLY WOMEN WERE WAITING FOR FOOD AND CLOTHING COLLECTION FROM PAM (NGO). THOSE WOMEN WERE SAID TO BE WIDOWS AND UNMARRIED.
- (6) MILOBS REPORTED THAT IN KAMEMBE NEAR THE STADIUM GR 771251 APPROX 300 MOSTLY WOMEN WHO WERE REGISTERED BY RPA APPEARED TO BE RELEASED PRISONERS OR REFUGEES. PAM WAS TO PROVIDE THEM WITH FOOD AND CLOTHS.
- (7) ETHIOBATT MED STAFF TREATED 18 LOCAL DENTAL PATIENTS IN AOR.

G. SECTOR 5.

- (1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.
- (2) TUNBATT REPORTED THAT 80 SOLDIERS FROM TUNBATTWERE REPATRIATED TO TUNISIA ON 30 JUN 95.
- (3) MILOBS PATROLS REPORTED THAT AT GASAKE GR 4904 THE HEALTH CENTRE IS URGENTLY NEEDED SINCE PEOPLE HAVE TO WALK 5 KM TO KABAYA GR 4907. THE MILOBS WERE ALSO

INFORMED THAT THE CATTLE WHICH HAD BEEN PREVIOUSLY STOLEN BY RPA SOLDIERS HAS BEEN RETURNED TO THE OWNERS. THE RETURNEES FACE A GENERAL PROBLEM OF SHELTER, FOOD AND FARMING IMPLEMENTS IN ALL COMMUNES.

- (1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SECURITY DUTIES IN AOR.
- (2) INDBATT REPORTED THAT 109 IDPs ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP. 20 IDPs DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO THEIR RESPECTIVE HOME COMMUNES. A TOTAL OF 203 IDPs AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.
- (3) INDBATT PROVIDED ESCORTS TO BROWN AND ROOT WATER TANKER FOR NIGHT SHIFT DUTIES.
- (4) PROVIDED EIGHT TRUCKS FOR CONVEYANCE OF RATIONS FOR RPA FROM KIGALI TO RUHengeri.
- (5) MILOBS PATROLS REPORTED THAT THE NAME OF THE LOCAL RPA COMMANDER IN GISHAKA IS 2/LT VCANNEY BUTERA. THE TOTAL FIGURE FOR JUNE 95 FOR NDERA TRANSIT CAMP GR 187843 WAS: ARRIVERS - 2667, DEPARTURES - 3089, STATIONARY - 350. MOST OF RETURNEES CAME FROM IDP CAMPS OUTSIDE RWANDA. THE FIGURE OF RETURNEES IS DECLINING COMPARED TO THE PREVIOUS MONTHS.
- (6) INDBATT MED STAFF TREATED 47 MEDICAL AND 15 DENTAL PATIENTS IN AOR.

- (4) PROVIDED FORK LIFT TO BMS FOR SHIFTING OF STORES.

2. REGARDS

1. OVERVIEW. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS QUIET THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY WITH THE EXCEPTION OF BANDITRY ACTIVITY IN SECTOR 4C AND IMPEDIMENT TO MILOB MOVEMENT IN SECTOR 3A.

2. RPA/GENDARMERIE.

A. IN SECTOR 2: THE RPA PLATOON AT RUKIRA GR 5601 HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN. NEW LOCATION IS UNKNOWN.

B. IN SECTOR 3A: AT NGOMA GR 2159, MILOBs WERE DENIED PASSAGE AT THE RPA CHECKPOINT. THIS IS THE SECOND TIME A MILOB PATROL HAS BEEN DENIED PASSAGE AT THIS CHECKPOINT.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 5: ON 24 JUN, LOCALS AT KINUNU SECTEUR GR 2189 ~~FOUND A BOAT ON THE SHORE OF LAKE KIVU CONTAINING A~~ QUANTITY OF GRENADES AND A MINE. THE RPA WAS INFORMED AND THEY LAID AN AMBUSH. 10 MEN SUSPECTED OF BEING INTERAHAMWE WERE CAUGHT IN THE AMBUSH. TWO OF THE SUSPECTED INTERAHAMWE WERE KILLED IN THE FIREFIGHT AND A LOCAL WHO HAD BEEN TAKEN PRISONER.

B. SECTOR 4C:

(1) IN NGANGE GR 1646 ON 25 JUN AT 1900 HOURS, TWO BANDITS WITH AUTOMATIC WEAPONS AND DRESSED IN UNIFORM ROBBED A BUSINESSMAN. THE MAN ESCAPED DESPITE THE ROBBERS OPENING FIRE.

(2) IN MUTUNGO GR 1247 ON 27 JUN AT 2300 HOURS, A SMALL GROUP OF ARMED BANDITS ROBBED A FAMILY OF MONEY. THE BANDITS FIRED THEIR WEAPONS AS THEY LEFT BUT THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES.

(3) IN CYITA GR 1647 ON 28 JUN AT 0400 HOURS, SIX ARMED MEN IN UNIFORM ATTACKED A TUTSI FAMILY WITH HAND GRENADES. THREE PEOPLE INCLUDING A BABY WERE KILLED. THE BANDITS MADE OFF WITH A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF MONEY.

(4) IN BIREMBO GR 0649 THE RPA INTERCEPTED A BOAT COMING FROM IJWI ISLAND. ONE PERSON WAS KILLED AND THE REMAINDER FLED BACK TO IJWI.

5. POLITICAL. IN SECTOR 3A: THE BOURGERMEISTER OF KARURA COMMUNE GR 2166 ADVISED A MILOB TEAM THAT THE NEW UNAMIR MANDATE DOES NOT ALLOW MILOBs TO PATROL HIS COMMUNE WITHOUT HIS EXPRESSED PERMISSION.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) NIBATT TRANSPORTED 11 IDPs FROM GIKONGORO TO THEIR VARIOUS HOME COMMUNES IN BYUMBA PREFECTURE.

(3) MILOBS AT NGARAMA ON 29 JUN 95 ASSISTED "ACCORD" IN DISTRIBUTING AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS TO PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNE. ALSO, OXFAM IS DRILLING BORE HOLES AT NYABWESHONGWE (4590), KAGITUMBA GR 5093 AND MATIMBA GR 4786. THE PROJECT IS HOWEVER SAID TO HAVE BEEN STOPPED BY THE PREFECT OF BYUMBA.

~~(4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE COMMUNE COURT IN RUTONGO~~

1. OVERVIEW. THERE WAS INCREASED FRGF/MILITIA ACTIVITY IN SECTOR 4C RESULTING IN EXCHANGES OF FIRE WITH THE RPA. THE REMAINDER OF THE COUNTRY HOWEVER WAS QUIET.

2. RPA/GENDARMERIE. SECTOR 4B: TWO TOYOTA LAND CRUISERS WERE OBSERVED HEADING TOWARDS KANYARU BAS BORDER CROSSING GR 6891 PRESUMABLY CARRYING HIGH RANKING RPA OFFICERS.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 4C:

1. OVERVIEW. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINED CALM THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. A SUSPECTED AERIAL RECONNAISSANCE WAS MADE OF THE NYAMESHEKI BORDER AREA OF SECTOR 4C.

(1) THE RPA ARE REPORTED TO BE ARRESTING LOCALS AND THEN DEMANDING BRIBES FOR THEIR RELEASE. ONE WITNESS STATED THAT HE WAS ARRESTED IN KIGESE SECTOR GR 9880 ON 21 MAY, BEATEN WHILE IN JAIL AND THEN ASKED TO PAY 2,000 FRW BEFORE HE WOULD BE RELEASED.

(2) RPA SOLDIERS ARE ALLEGED TO HAVE BEATEN AND RAPED A WOMAN WHILE SHE WAS A PRISONER IN THE RUNDA COMMUNE JAIL GR 9882. THE VICTIM HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO KIGALI FOR TREATMENT AND THE INCIDENT IS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

B. IN SECTOR 5. MILOBS ON A HELICOPTER PATROL TO RUSHASHI GR 8309 AND MUSASA GR 8298 WERE NOT ALLOWED, BY THE RPA, TO CONTACT LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THE RPA CLAIMED THAT THIS ACTION WAS BECAUSE THEY HAD NOT BEEN INFORMED OF THE FLIGHT.

6. REGIONAL. SEVERAL OVERFLIGHTS WERE REPORTED IN THE NYAMESHEKE SUB-SECTOR OF SECTOR 4C BETWEEN 1000 AND 1700 HOURS. THE AIRCRAFT COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED DUE TO ITS ALTITUDE BUT THERE WERE MORE THAN ONE AIRCRAFT INVOLVED. THE LOCAL RPA COMMANDER INQUIRED OF THE MILOBS IF THE AIRCRAFT BELONGED TO THE UN/UNAMIR. THE RPA DID NOT ATTEMPT TO FIRE UPON THE AIRCRAFT.

7. MISC. SMALL GROUPS OF YOUNG HUTU MALES, AGE 18 YEARS AND OLDER, ARE FLEEING THE AREA OF KAMANA, MUNINI AND RUNYIOMBYI, IN SECTOR 4A, FOR BURUNDI AND ZAIRE. IT IS RUMOURED THAT THE YOUTHS ARE FLEEING TO AVOID CONSCRIPTION INTO THE RPA.
