NOTE FOR THE SRSG

Subject: The Archbishop of Canterbury's visit to Rwanda,
9-13 May 1995

Ref: Letter dated 12 April 1995 from the Rt. Reverend
Jonathan RUHUMULIZA, Bishop Coadjutor of Kigali
Diocese and Chairman of the Visit's Executive
Committee

1. The second meeting on the above-mentioned subject was held
on 19 April 1995 in St. Etienne's Cathedral of Kigali under the
chairmanship of the Rt. Revd. J. RUHUMULIZA. As well as the
representatives of the Rwandese Clergy, Ministers BIHOZAGARA
(Rehabilitation), MAZIMPAKA (Youth and Sports), INYUMBA (Family
and Women's Issues) form part of the Coordinating Commission.
Their representatives attended the meeting. At the request of
the Director of State Protocol (Mr. RUDAHUNGA), present at the
meeting, the Ministers for Foreign Affairs and Works, and Social
Affairs respectively, became members of the said Committee.

2. Among other items on the agenda centred on the preparations
for this visit, and which calls for your attention, is the
request for assistance to UNAMIR, namely :

- Round Trip Air Transportation

For the Archbishop and his Delegation

- Kigali/Gahini/Nyarubuye - Wednesday 10 May 1995
- Kigali/Butare/Kigeme - Vendredi 12 May 1995

It is understood that 14 personalities comprising the
Archbishop and Representatives of Government will make the
trip.

- For the Secretary-General (Canon John Peterson) of the
Anglican Consultative Council

-Kigali/Ruhengeri/Gisenyi/Goma/Bukavu/Yanguu

For this itinerary I indicated to the participants that
UNAMIR helicopters, in keeping with the Mandate of the Mission,
are not authorized to fly over territories of Rwanda's
neighbouring countries. The Rt. Revd. RUHUMULIZA replied that
this point would be reviewed with the Secretary General himself.
However, the dates of 11-12 ~~April~~ ^{May} are to be maintained but
confirmed later.

3. Grading of half a kilometer of the Gahini road and two kilometers of the Ruhanga road:

I indicated that on your instructions I should discuss this item with the competent military unit before giving a response.

4. Vehicles for transport of Delegation

On this point, I intervened to clarify that UNAMIR assists the Government but does not replace it, and that the Commission should firstly solicit an input from the Government on behalf of this distinguished visitor and his delegation to Rwanda before requesting UNAMIR's assistance for transport needs. Here again, the request should specify : type and number of vehicles, dates and times of utilization, as well as the different itineraries to be followed.

The Committee for Transport intends to furnish the relevant particulars as soon as possible.

5. Voice Amplifier

Without giving a precise answer, I suggested that the Committee responsible for Information approach ORINFOR for this equipment.

The Meeting requested UNAMIR (Information Section) to assist in the coverage of the visit by supplying video cassettes - an officer of the Australian Medical Unit present at the Meeting indicated that Major Peter Seaman, Public Relations Officer (Tel. 75216) should be approached with regard to this item.

6. Moreover, the Meeting noted from the draft programme for 11 May 1995 that a "reception/meeting with Aid Agencies and UNAMIR" is foreseen for the Archbishop from 19H00 and 21H00, the place to be specified at a later date.



Your Excellency,

We wish to inform you of the expected visit of the Most Revd. Dr George CAREY, the Archbishop of Canterbury to our country and especially to the Episcopal Church of Rwanda. The Archbishop of Canterbury, who is the Chief Shepherd of the Entire Anglican Communion, will be in Rwanda from 9th to 13th May, 1995.

In this visit he wishes to show his solidarity with the people of Rwanda at this time of rehabilitation and social regeneration, after a time of terrible experiences. He will extend his message to all Rwandans, pray for the survivors of the genocide, and visit some of the sites of the massacres.

The decision of this visit follows the visit of his personal Secretary, the Revd. Andrew Deuchar, and Bishop Jim OTTLEY, the Anglican Observer to the United Nations in January 1995. To this letter we attach a tentative programme of the visit, based on the two saw and heard.

In preparation for this distinguished visit, we kindly request your office to assist us with the following:

1. A helicopter to fly the Archbishop from:
 - Kigali to Gahini, Nyarubuye and back.
 - Kigali to Butare, Kigeme and back.

For the General Secretary of the Anglican Consultative Council who will be part of his delegation:

- from Kigali to Ruhengeri, Gisenyi, Goma, Bukavu, Cyangugu and back.

Please discuss with Military and Administration and propose to SRSO specific areas where we can help. ~~Working in the~~ Thanks. Sd Bus

2. A grader to grade 1/2 a km portion of the road to Gahini and a 2 kms portion of the road to Ruhanga.
3. Some vehicles to help in transporting people.
4. Public address system to amplify the voices.



This note is to inform you of the above-mentioned visit and also the need for UNAMIR assistance, notably with regard to transportation.

It was, through a meeting which took place at "The English Language Church" during the morning of Saturday 2 April 1995, to which I was invited in my capacity as member of the Church, that I learned about this programme (please see the attached draft programme, page 2, of the News Release of 14 March 1995 of the Office of the Archbishop in London).

In the third paragraph of the News Release it is mentioned that the Archbishop hopes to have meetings with authorities of the current Administration as well as with Representatives of the United Nations and other assistance agencies in Rwanda, during the afternoon of 11 May 1995.

His Grace Jonathan RUHUMULIZA, President of the above Meeting, mentioned furthermore that the assistance of UNAMIR is kindly requested for the transport (by helicopter) of the Archbishop to Butaré during the morning of 12 May 1995 in order to visit the displaced persons camp there. To the request made by His Grace, I told him that the authority in UNAMIR to which the request should be made is the Special Representative of the Secretary-General in Rwanda. The latter proposes to contact you officially to inform you of the forthcoming programme.

ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY TO VISIT RWANDA 9-13 MAY 1995

The Archbishop of Canterbury will visit Rwanda between 9 and 13 May 1995.

The Archbishop wishes to visit the people of Rwanda in order to offer his public and prayerful support to them as they try to rebuild their lives following the traumatic events of April last year. He will learn at first-hand of the horrors which they have been through.

It is expected that he will visit a number of sites where massacres took place; he also hopes to visit a camp for internally displaced people. He hopes to meet members of the current administration, other church leaders, representatives of the United Nations and other aid agencies. He will be seeking to encourage Anglican leaders to play a positive and constructive role in the moves towards rebuilding the country.

During the meeting of the Primates of the Anglican Communion, now taking place in Windsor, the proposed visit received strong support and encouragement from the Archbishops of the African Provinces.

The Archbishop will be accompanied by his wife, Eileen, Bishop Ken Barham, who is part-time assistant bishop in Rwanda, and two members of his personal staff.

Canon John Peterson (the Secretary General of the Anglican Communion) will accompany the party for part of the programme, but will also be following a separate programme of his own in his capacity as Secretary General.
