2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL - NIL

b. MILITARY. RPA CONTINUES TO MOUNT BOTH FOOT
AND MOBILE PATROLS BY DAY AND NIGHT.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE FOLLOWING COMMUNES:

- a. RUTARE COMMUNE (GR B 1903)
- b. KIBALI COMMUNE (GR B 0424)
- c. KIVUJE COMMUNE (GR A 9532)
- d. GATUNA BORDER POST (GR 0143)

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

a. RUTARE COMMUNE. RENANE PALANTINA, AN NGO RECENTLY DONATED A PHOTOCOPIER, TEXT AND EXERCISE BOOKS AND 300 000 FRW TO RUTARE SECONDARY SCHOOL. THE MONEY DONATED WAS TO BE USED FOR SCHOOL FURNITURE REPAIRS.

b. ICRC WHICH USED TO SUPPLY DRUGS TO RUTARE HEALTH CENTRE IS CLOSING DOWN ITS OFFICE AT THE COMMUNE CENTRE AT THE END OF THIS MONTH. IT COULD NOT BE ASCERTAINED WHY ICRC WERE CLOSING DOWN.

b. KIBALI COMMUNE. WORLD VISION IS PROVIDING ITEMS OF FURNITURE TO PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE. ARMREF RUNS A MEDICAL CENTRE AT KIGOGO (GR 0524) THEY PAY ALL THEIR STAFF.

ICRC IS CURRENTLY VISITING PRISONS IN THE COMMUNE TO FIND OUT AND ASSESS LIVING CONDITIONS AND OTHER RELATED PROBLEMS. THEY ARE ALSO TRACING PARENTS OF ORPHANS IN A BID TO ENCOURAGE THEM (PARENTS) TO GET BACK THEIR CHILDREN. WFP HAS STOPPED TEMPORARILY THE DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD SINCE 2 JUL 95 AND THEIR REASON IS THAT THEIR RESIDENT REPRESENTATIVE IS ON LEAVE.

S. CIVIL AFFAIRS

4. IN RUTARE, A TOTAL OF 22 IDPS WHO RETURNED FROM KIBEHO CAMP ARE REPORTED TO HAVE ALL BEEN RESETTLED. THE COMMUNE HAS 564 ORPHANS WHO ARE ALL BEING LOOKED AFTER BY RELATIVES.

5. IN KIBALI COMMUNE THE BOUGMESTRE CONTINUES TO PRESIDE OVER MINOR CASES SUCH AS THEFT AND DOMESTIC DISPUTES AND SENTENCES RANGE FROM FINES TO IMPRISONMENT WITH LABOUR. THERE ARE 715 ORPHANS WHO ARE STAYING WITH FOSTER PARENTS AND 120 ARE AT BYUMBA ORPHANAGE. THERE ARE 10 RETURNEES WHO HAVE COME FROM ZAIRE AND BURUNDI SINCE 2 JUL '95.

6. MISCELLANEOUS.

a. MINES. FIVE ANTI-TANK RIFLE GRENADES WERE FOUND AT KASHINGE VILLAGE IN KICHOYO SECTOR (LR 0122)

b. COMMUNICATIONS. THERE WAS A RADIO REPROGRAMMING EXERCISE FOR ALL RADIO SETS IN THE SECTOR. THE EXERCISE COULD NOT BE COMPLETED DUE TO THAT OTHER SECTOR VEHICLES ARE STILL UNDERGOING REPAIRS IN KICAH.

c. THE WATER AND ELECTRICITY PROBLEM WHICH WAS REPORTED YESTERDAY HAS BEEN RECTIFIED BUT THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY IS VERY ERRATIC AND MORE OFTEN THAN NOT DISRUPTS OUR COMMUNICATIONS.

d. REQUESTS.

(1) THE PROVISIONS OF EOD TEAM TO DISPOSE OF THE GRENADES MENTIONED IN PARA 69 ABOVE.

(2) PROVISION OF A GENERATOR, PREFERABLY OF NOT LESS THAN 35 KVA CAPACITY FOR ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT SUCH AS FAX MACHINE, COMPUTER, PHOTO COPIER, FIELD CHARGERS AND LIGHTING. THAT THE PROVISION OF THE GENERATOR BE TREATED WITH URGENCY TO FACILITATE TIMELY SUBMISSION OF DAILY SITREPS.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS

THERE WAS A PROBLEM OF WATER AND ELECTRICITY SUPPLY IN KIBALI COMMUNE DUE TO BROKEN PIPES AND CABLES THROUGHOUT THE DAY. THE MATTER WAS REPORTED TO ELECTROGAZ PLUMBERS AND HAVE PROMISED TO COMMENCE REPAIR WORKS TOMORROW 17 JULY'95.

6. LOGISTICS


a. AS A CONSEQUENCE OF NIBATT WITHDRAWAL FROM BYUMBA ALL THE SECTOR VEHICLES HAVE TO DRAW FUEL FROM KIGALI ALMOST ON DAILY BASIS WHICH IS VERY INCONVINIENT, PARTICULARLY WHEN PATROLS HAVE TO BE CONDUCTED IN COMMUNES THAT ARE IN OPPOSITE DIRECTION TO KIGALI.

b. MILOBS DO NOT HAVE POTABLE WATER AND HAVE TO DRAW FROM KIGALI OR RISK TAKING WATER FROM LOCAL SOURCES.

c. IT IS REQUESTED THAT DUMPS OF BOTH POTABLE WATER AND FUEL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE SECTOR TO AVOID FUTURE PROBLEMS.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES**a. KIYOMBE COMMUNE. GOAL IRELAND RUNS THE RUSHAKI
HEALTH CENTRE AND CARITAS ARE RENOVATING PRIMARY
SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE. THERE IS ALREADY A COMPLETED
CLASSROOM BLOCK AT KIYOMBE SECTOR (GR 1044).**

b. TUMBA COMMUNE. ICRC ARE RUNNING THE ONLY HEALTH CENTRE. THEY ALSO PROVIDE MEDICINES TO THE CENTRE AND COMMON DISEASES ARE MALARIA AND RESPIRATORY RELATED PROBLEMS.

c. CYUMBA COMMUNE. AMREF IS RUNNING A HEALTH CENTRE AT MANYAGIRO (GR 115320) AND PROVIDE MEDICINES. THEY HAVE STOPPED SALARIES TO THE WORKERS WITH EFFECT FROM JUNE,95 AND THE RWANDESE GOVERNMENT WOULD TAKE-OVER BY THE END OF JULY,95.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS

a. THERE WERE REPORTS OF BANDITRY IN NKANA SECTOR OF KIYOMBE COMMUNE IN JUNE,95 AND INVESTIGATIONS HAVE REVEALED THAT THE BANDITS CAME FROM KAFUNJO, A BORDER TOWN IN UGANDA. THE BOUGMESTRE HAS ARRANGED A MEETING WITH THE POLICE OFFICER -IN-CHARGE OF THE TOWN TO RESOLVE THE ISSUE.

b. THERE IS NO POTABLE WATER IN CYUMBA COMMUNE DUE PIPES WHICH WERE VANDALISED DURING THE WAR. IT IS ALLEGED THAT UNAMIR PERSONNEL WENT TO INSPECT THE PIPES AND THE PUMP SOME TIME IN MAY,95 AND PROMISED TO EFFECT REPAIRS WHICH THEY NEVER DID. *? Nibant?*

7. MISC

a. MINES. THE INDIBATT EOD TEAM VISITED BYUMBA WITH THE INTENTION OF DISPOSING OF SOME MUNITIONS THAT WERE LOCATED AND REPORTED AT THE CONVENT SCHOOL WERE MILOBS WERE STAYING BEFORE MOVING TO THE PRESENT LOCATION. THE TEAM WAS TURNED BACK BY THE DEPUTY PREFECT AND WERE TOLD THAT IT WAS NOT UNAMIR RESPONSIBILITY TO DISPOSE OF SUCH MUNITIONS BUT RPA. THE TEAM WAS FURTHER TOLD THAT THEY WERE SUPPOSED TO GO TO WHERE THERE ARE MINE FIELDS AND START DEMINING AND NOT TO WORRY THEMSELVES WITH SCATTERED BOMBS AND THINGS LIKE THAT. GENERALLY, HIS ATTITUDE WAS VERY NEGATIVE TOWARDS THE TEAM.

b. IN KIYOBE COMMUNE THE MILOB TEAM WHICH VISITED THE COMMUNEE WERE SHOWN AN ISOLATED BUILDING WITH SUSPECTED MINES AND THEY DISCOVERED LARGE QUANTITIES OF OF ROCKETS AND OTHER UNIDENTIFIED ORDNANCE IN THE HOUSE. THE HOUSE HAS BEEN CORDONED OFF PENDING THEARRIVAL OF EOD TEAM TO INSPECT AND DEECIDE ON THE DISPOSAL METHOD THEREAFTER.

b. KINYAMI COMMUNE PAM,AN NGO DISTRIBUTED FOOD TO THE TEACHERS OF THE COMMUNE TODAY AT THE FOLLOWING SCALES:

MAIZE	25 KG PER PERSON
PEAS	15 " " "
COOKING OIL	05 LTRS " "

MELTESER CONTINUES TO SUPPORT THE COMMUNE WITH DRUGS THOUGH NOT TO SUFFICIENT QUANTITIES.THE COMMUNE IS ANTICIPATING A POOR HARVEST THIS SEASON DUE TO HEAVY RAINS.

c. KIVUYE COMMUNE THE HEALTH CENTRE AT BUNGWE WAS CLOSED DOWN AND IT COULD NOT BE ESTABLISHED WHETHER THE CLOSURE WAS A TEMPORARY OR NOT.



a. MURAMBI COMMUNE AS WAS REPORTED IN OUR PREVIOUS REPORTS THERE IS A PROBLEM OF MENINGITIS AT GAKONI ORPHANAGE. THE SAME DISEASE HAS NOW KILLED ONE MORE CHILD, BRINGING THE TOLL TO FOUR AND NO REMEDIAL MEASURE WAS TAKEN, AS WAS REQUESTED IN OUR PREVIOUS SITREP.

b. MUHURA COMMUNE *INTER SOS* ARE RECONSTRUCTING ELEVEN SCHOOLS, A PROJECT WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO FINISH BY THE END OF AUGUST'95, AFTER WHICH THE NGO WOULD WITHDRAW FROM THE COMMUNE. THE NGO ALSO INDICATED THAT THEY HAVE ENOUGH FUNDS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT.

c. GITI COMMUNE *MELTESER*, A GERMAN NGO IS RUNNING A HEALTH CENTRE AT THE COMMUNE CENTRE AND ARE PROVIDING MEDICINES TO THE SAME CENTRE.

d. KIBALI COMMUNE THE INSPECTOR OF SCHOOLS AND THE SECRETARY FOR REHABILITATION, BOTH FOR BYUMBA PREFECTURE HAVE APPROACHED THE MILOBS HQ REQUESTING FOR TRANSPORT TO DISTRIBUTE SCHOLARSTIC (BOOKS AND STATIONERY) TO VARIOUS COMMUNES BEFORE SCHOOLS RE-OPEN ON 21JULY'95. THE OTHER REQUEST ALSO CAME FOR TRANSPORT TO UPLIFT SCHOOL FURNITURE FROM KIGALI TO BYUMBA FOR USE BY PUPILS AT THE SCHOOL THAT WAS VACATED BY MILOBS ON 10 JULY'95. THEY REQUIRE AT LEAST TWO BIG TRUCKS FOR BOTH TASKS.





b. **MUKARANGE COMMUNE.** GOAL IRELAND OPERATES IN THIS COMMUNE. IT RUNS HEALTH CENTRES IN RUSHAKI AND MUKONO. BOURGREMESTRE WAS NOT HAPPY THAT ONLY ONE NGO OPERATES IN THE COMMUNE SINCE OTHER COMMUNES HAVE TWO OR MORE WHICH ASSIST IN THE REHABILITATION OF SCHOOLS AND OFFICES. NOTWITHSTANDING, THE HEALTH CENTRES ARE DOING A GOOD JOB. IT TREATS TB, WHOOPING COUGH, MEASLES, DIPHTHERIA, POLIO AND TETANUS. IT IS ALLEGED THAT, THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH IS INSISTING ON THE PAYMENT OF 250 FRW PER PATIENT AND THAT IS BELIEVED TO BE TOO MUCH FOR THE PEOPLE. HENCE THEIR REFUSAL TO ATTEND CLINIC EVEN WHEN THEY FALL SICK.

c. **MURAMBI COMMUNE.** ADRA HAS DONATED US \$3,000 TO THE GAKONI ORPHANAGE (GR 4698) FOR AN AGRICULTURAL PROJECT TO ASSIST THE INSTITUTION.



b. RUTARE COMMUNE. AIDE D'ACTION IS TRAINING UNTRAINED TEACHERS IN THE RUTARE COMMUNE. IT IS ALSO PROVIDING BOOKS AND TEACHING MATERIALS TO SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE. ICRC SPONSORS THE RUTARE HEALTH CENTRE. IT SUPPLIES DRUGS TO THE CENTRE. IT HAS ALSO RENOVATED THE CENTRE.

c. CYUNGO COMMUNE. AMREF AND CARITAS OPERATE IN THIS COMMUNE. AMREF PROVIDES MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO MYOVE HEALTH CENTRE (GR 9682). IT IS ALSO CARRYING OUT VACCINATION OF CHILDREN. WHILST CARITAS PROVIDES MEDICAL SUPPLIES TO RUKOZO HEALTH CENTRE (GR 9421) AND HIGH-PROTEIN FOOD TO MAL-NOURISHED CHILDREN.


d. BWISIGE COMMUNE. ICRC RUNS THE NYAGAHANGA HEALTH CENTRE (GR 2421). IT PROVIDES DRUGS TO THE CENTRE AND PAYS ALLOWANCES TO THE WORKERS TO SUPPLEMENT WHAT THEY RECEIVE FROM THE GOVERNMENT. b. **KIYOMBE COMMUNE.** GOAL IRELAND SPONSORS THE HEALTH CENTRE AT MULINDI (GR 0437) AND RUSHAKI (GR 1138). IT HAS EQUIPPED THE CENTRES AND SUPPLIES SUFFICIENT DRUGS. IT ALSO PROVIDES BISCUITS AND WEETABIX TO SUPPLEMENT THE FEEDING OF PATIENTS ON ADMISSION. PREVAILING AILMENTS INCLUDE MALARIA AND TUBERCULOSIS.

c. **TUMBA COMMUNE.** ICRC OPERATES IN TUMBA. IT SUPPLIES DRUGS TO THE HEALTH CENTRE. ITS STAFF VISIT THE CENTRE THREE TIMES A WEEK. APPROXIMATELY 60 PATIENTS REPORT SICK DAILY.

a. **NATIONAL HOLIDAY.** TODAY, 04 JUL 95, WAS OBSERVED AS NATIONAL HOLIDAY IN COMMEMORATION OF THE TRIUMPHANT ENTRY OF KIGALI BY THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT FORCES. ALL COMMUNES WITHIN THE PREFECTURE ORGANISED PARADES. IN BYUMBA, THERE WAS A GRAND PARADE CEREMONY WHICH ATTRACTED A LOT OF PEOPLE FROM WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE TOWN. THE BOURGREMESTRE, RPA REPS AND SOME DIGNITARIES GAVE SPEECHES AFTER WHICH THERE WERE CULTURAL DRUMMING AND DANCING TO ENTERTAIN THE CROWD.

SIX PATIENTS WERE FOUND ON ADMISSION. COMMON DISEASES TREATED HERE INCLUDE MALARIA, DIARRHOEA AND BRONCHITIS. THE BOURGREMESTRE HELD A MEETING WITH AMREF OFFICIALS TODAY. DETAILS OF THE MEETING ARE UNKNOWN. CARITAS DISTRIBUTES HIGH PROTEIN FOOD TO MALNOURISHED CHILDREN AND FARMING IMPLEMENTS TO FARMERS.

b. **CYUMBA COMMUNE.** AMREF SPONSORS THE CYUMBA HEALTH CENTRE AND HAS NINE NURSES, THREE OF WHOM ARE QUALIFIED. THREE PATIENTS ON ADMISSION WERE VISITED BY MILOB PATROL. COMMON DISEASES HERE ARE MALARIA, BRONCHITIS, PNEUMONIA, KWASHIORKOR AND RHEUMATISM.

c. **BWISIGE COMMUNE.** THREE NGOS, CARITAS, WORLD VISION AND REMANIE PALANTINA, OPERATE IN THIS COMMUNE. CARITAS DISTRIBUTES SEEDS AND AGRICULTURAL TOOLS TO THE LOCALS. WORLD VISION RUNS THE BWISIGE HEALTH CENTRE AND PROVIDES DRUGS WHILST PALANTINA GIVES TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE NYAGAHANGA SECONDARY SCHOOL.
