SUMMARY: *DELIVERING ZERO HUNGER* maintains global focus on the Zero Hunger Challenge, providing high-level leaders of member-states, international organizations and civil society with the opportunity to demonstrate their commitment to the Zero Hunger Challenge.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To mobilize high-level engagement and commitment on Zero Hunger.
2. To demonstrate how multi-stakeholder partnerships deliver impact for the Zero Hunger Challenge.

PROPOSED DATE: September 25, 2014.

LEAD AGENCY: World Food Programme

CO-SPONSORS: Ireland, Netherlands

CO-HOSTS: A broad group of co-hosts will anchor the UNSG-led event. The group represents the multi-stakeholder platforms necessary to deliver Zero Hunger.

The World Food Programme, together with the UN High Level Task Force on the Global Food Security Crisis, will be joined by representatives from:

BACKGROUND: The event is the first high-level opportunity, since the launch of the Zero Hunger Challenge Declaration at Davos in January 2014, for leaders to benchmark current and future actions.

OUTCOMES: 1. *DELIVERING ZERO HUNGER* will increase high-level engagement, mobilize support and maintain focus on the Secretary-General's Zero Hunger Challenge.
