RPA CONTINUES TO CONDUCT VEH AND FOOT PATROLS IN THE AOR BOTH BY DAY AND NIGHT.

4. **HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES**

a. **TUMBA COMMUNE.** UNICEF, REDCROSS & PAM ARE WORKING IN THIS COMMUNE. THE TUMBA HEALTH CENTRE IS SUPPORTED BY REDCROSS WITH MEDICINE AND OTHER ESSENTIAL ITEMS. ~~RUN BY THE REDCROSS~~ .HOWEVER, THERE IS ACUTE SHORTAGE OF DRINKING WATER AROUND 3 Km OF THE MENTIONED HEALTH CENTRE. THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS OF THE COMMUNE ARE PROVIDED WITH LIMITED EDUCATIONAL ITEMS BY UNICEF. PRESENTLY PAM IS DISTRIBUTING BEANS, MAIZE AND COOKING OIL TO THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS TEACHERS. ON LAST 18 AUG 95 THESE ITEMS WERE DISTRIBUTED AMONGST 79 TEACHERS. LOCAL POPULATION IS BEING ENGAGED VOLUNTEERILY IN FARMING, BUT THEY ARE IN DIRE NEED OF SEEDS OF BEANS AND INSECTICIDES. FROM 25 AUG TO 30 AUG 95 TOTAL 19 REFUGEES ARE RETURNED HOME FROM ZAIRE. ALTHOUGH NO NGO IS INVOLVED IN REHEBLITATING THESE REFUGEES , LOCAL PEOPLE AND THIER RELATIVES ARE HELPING TO GET THEM SETTLED.

b. **RUTARE COMMUNE.** AFVP, ARAMET AND ICRC ARE WORKING IN THIS COMMUNE COVERRING WIDE RANGE OF HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. AFVP AND ARAMET ARE CO-ORDINATING ARRANGEMENT OF FRESH WATER SUPPLY AND RECONSTRUCTION OF COMMUNE INFRASTRUCTURES RESPECTIVELY. ICRC IS SUPPORTING THE RUTARE HEALTH CENTRE WITH MEDICINES AND OTHER ESSENTIALS. THE PATROL TEAM REPORTED ABOUT THE OUTBREAK OF DIARRHOEA AND MALARIA IN THE COMMUNE. FURTHERMORE, NGANGE, NABIHU, MUKO AND BUSHWAGANA SECTORS ARE REPORTED TO BE FACING ACUTE SHORTAGE OF DRINKING WATER.

c. **KINYAMI COMMUNE.** MAINLY THREE NGOS , NAMELY WORLD VISION, SAD, PUM ARE WORKING IN THE MENTIONED COMMUNE. TWO HEALTH CENTRES AT GISLJA AND KINYAMI ARE BEING BACKED UP BY WORLD VISION AND SAD . THE WORLD VISION IS ON THE VERGE OF TERMINATION OF THIER MISSION .HENCE SAD IS GRADUALLY ASSUMING THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF WORLD VISION . PREVAILING DISEASES OF THE AREA ARE DIHOREA AND MALARIA. PUM IS CO-ORDINATING INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES AND FOOD DISTRIBUTION AMONGST THE NEEDYS. IT IS WORTH MENTIONING THAT PUM IS PRESENTLY HANDICAPPED WITH THIER NON-OPERATIONAL VEHICLES. ABOUT 6 TONS OF FOOD STUFFS ARE LYING STOCKPILLED IN THE BYUMBA PREFECTURE DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORTATION FACILITY. SINCE LAST WEEK 4 RETURNEES ARE REPORTED TO BE BACK FROM ZAIRE AND THEY HAVE JOINED THIER FAMILY.

5. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS.**

a. PATROL TEAM - TWO VISITED THE THE PRISION OF RUTARE COMMUNE. TOTAL 7 INMATES ARE LIVING THERE IN A DEPLORABLE CONDITION. THERE IS NO SUPPLY OF FOOD OR FRESH WATER AND

THEY HAVE TO RELY ON THIER RELATIVES .MOREOVER THERE IS NO BED AND BLANKET FOR THE INMATES. OUT OF THESE INMATES ONLY ONE IS CHARGED FOR MAJOR CRIME, NAMELY , INVOLVING HIMSELF IN THE GENOCIDE. THE REST ARE CHARGED WITH MINOR OFFENSES. ALL OF THE INMATES ARE AWAITING TRIAL.

b. 75 RETURNEES HAVE REPORTED IN BYUMBA PREFECTURE FROM ZAIRE. OUT OF THESE 68 HAVE BEEN SETTLED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE COMMUNES AND THE BALANCE ARE AWAITING TO BE TRANSPORTED TO THEIR HOMES.



4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

a. MUKARANGE COMMUNE. THERE ARE TWO NGOS OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE ie GOAL IRELAND AND BUFMAR (GERMANY). THEY ARE BOTH PROVIDING MEDICINES TO THE MUKONO AND RUSHAKI HEALTH CENTRES. GOAL IRELAND ALSO CONDUCTING HEALTH AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS TO THE LOCALS.

b. KIYOMBE COMMUNE. THERE IS ONLY ONE NGO , GOAL IRELAND WHICH OPERATES IN THE COMMUNE. THEY RUN A HEALTH CENTRE AT MULINDI (GR 707376). THE NGO SUPPLIES MEDICINES BUT AT THE TIME OF THE MILOBS' VISIT IT WAS REPORTED THAT DRUGS FOR MALARIA WAS IN SHORT SUPPLY. THE CENTRE ATTENDS TO BETWEEN 100 - 150 PATIENTS PER DAY. THE SAME NGO SUPPLIED THE CENTRE WITH A WATER PUMP TO ENSURE CONSTANT WATER SUPPLY. THECOMMON DISEASES IN THE AREA ARE MALARIA, WORMS AND DIARRHOEA.

c. BYUMBA PREFECTURE. THERE ARE 03 CHILDREN WHO WERE BROUGHT FROM BUKAVU REFUGEE CAMP IN ZAIRE BY ICRC THROUGH SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) AND RE - UNITED WITH THEIR PARENTS IN BYUMBA PREFECTURE ON 30/08/95. ICRC IS CONTINUING WITH THEIR PARENTS TRACE PROGRAMME WITHIN AND OUTSIDE RWANDA. THE 68 RETURNEES WHO CAME FROM ZAIRE ON 29/08/95 HAVE ALL BEEN TRANSPORTED TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES IN UNHCR TRUCKS TODAY. WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME HAVE ISSUED FOOD FOR THESE RETURNEES BUT THERE IS NO TRANSPORT TO SEND THE FOOD THE VARIOUS COMMUNES THE RETURNEES HAVE BEEN SENT TO. THE FOOD THAT WAS ISSUED IWS BEANS, MAIZE AND COOKING OIL AND SHOULD BE DISTRIBUTED TO 05 COMMUNES AS FOLLOWS:

(i)	KIYOMBE	2300 KGS
(ii)	TUMBA	700KGS
(iii)	CYUMBA	3000 KGS
(iv)	KINYAMI	7000 KGS
(v)	BUYOGA	600 KGS

THE PREFECT OF BYUMBA IS REQUESTING FOR URGENT TRANSPORT TO UP LIFT THE ABOVE SAID FOOD STOCKS TO THE RETURNEES BEFORE THEY COULD STARVE. THERE ARE ALSO AN ADDITIONAL 75 RETURNEES WHO ARRIVED FROM ZAIRE TODAY 30/08/95. THEY HAVE TO UNDERGO REGISTRATION PROCEES BEFORE THEY COULD BE SENT TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES.



b. CYUMBA COMMUNE. AMREF IS THE ONLY NGO WHICH IS OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE. THE NGO DOES THE FOLLOWING:

- (i) REHABILITATING RUGASA HEALTH CENTRE (CR 013318)
- (ii) PROVIDING MEDICINE TO THE SAME CENTRE.
- (iii) PAYING THE RWANDAISE HEALTH CENTRE WORKERS.
- (iv) PROVIDES TRANSPORT FOR REFERRED MEDICAL CASES TO BYUMBA HOSPITAL.

C. KIBALI COMMUNE. THE MILOB TEAM VISITED URUMULI ORPHANAGE WHICH IS RUN BY ICRC, SAVE THE CHILDREN FOUNDATION AND WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME WHO ARE THE SOLE SUPPLIERS OF FOOD TO THE ORPHANAGE. ICRC IS CONTINUING WITH THEIR PARENTS TRACE FOR THE ORPHANS AND SO FAR THERE ARE 86 ORPHANS OUT OF 90 THAT WERE REPORTED LAST WEEK.

S. CIVIL AFFAIRS

9. RETURNEES. IN KIVUVE COMMUNE, THERE ARE 24 RETURNEES WHO REPORTED BACK FROM ZAIRE UNDER THE FORCED REPATRIATION PROGRAMME. THE RETURNEES WENT DIRECT TO THEIR ORIGINAL HOMES AND WERE PEACEFULLY SETTLED. THESE RETURNEES HAVE A COMMON PROBLEM OF FOOD SHORTAGE. IN CYUMBA COMMUNE THERE ARE THREE FAMILIES WHO ALSO REPORTED DIRECT TO THEIR ORIGINAL HOMES ON 25 AUG 95 AND WERE PEACE FULLY SETTLED. IN KIBALI COMMUNE THERE ARE 68 RETURNEES WHO REPORTED TO PREFECTURE HEAD OFFICE FROM ZAIRE TODAY, 29 AUG 95. THEY WERE TRANSPORTED IN UNHCR TRUCKS. THE RETURNEES HAVE TO UNDERGO REGISTRATION PROCESS BEFORE THEY CAN BE RESETTLED, WE WILL CONTINUE TO MONITOR THEIR RESETTLEMENT PROCESS.

b. EDUCATION. IN CYUMBA COMMUNE THERE ARE 10 PRIMARY SCHOOLS WITH A TOTAL ENROLMENT OF 7382 PUPILS AND 103 TEACHERS. THERE IS NO SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE COMMUNE. IN KIVUYE COMMUNE THERE ARE 6 PRIMARY SCHOOLS WITH A TOTAL ENROLMENT OF 2180 PUPILS AND 32 TEACHERS.

c. LAW AND ORDER. THE VICE BOUGHMESTRE OF KIVUYE COMMUNE, MR EMMANUEL BIZIMANA WAS YESTERDAY ARRESTED AND DETAINED BY LOCAL RPA MEMBERS FOR DRUNKENNESS AND DISORDERLY BEHAVIOUR. HE WAS ^RARRESTED TOGETHER WITH TWO OTHER LOCALS WHO WERE LATER RELEASED AFTER PAYING FINE OF 10 000 FRW EACH BUT THE VICE BOUGHMESTRE WAS, AT THE TIME OF THE MILOBS' VISIT STILL DETAINED.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

a. CYUNGO COMMUNE. PAM, AN NGO IS OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE. THEY ARE REPAIRING ROADS IN THE AREA UNDER THE FOOD FOR WORK PROGRAMME. THEY AT THE MOMENT ENGAGED ABOUT 100 WORKERS UNDER THE SAME PROGRAMME. THE LOCALS ARE GIVEN FOOD AT THE FOLLOWING SCALES PER PERSON:

CARITAS IS PROVIDING MEDICINES TO RUKOZO HEALTH CENTRE WHICH IS COLLOCATED WITH THE COMMUNE OFFICES. AMREF PROVIDES MEDICINE TO MIYOVE DISPENSARY AND THEY ARE AT PRESENT ON AN IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME AGAINST THE SIX KILLER DISEASES.

b. BWISIGE COMMUNE. ICRC IS OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE. THEY ARE PROVIDING MEDICAL FACILITIES/DRUGS TO NYAGAHANGA HEALTH CENTRE (GR853280). THE SALARIES OF THE RWANDESE WORKERS ARE PAID BY THEIR OWN GOVERNMENT. THESE SALARIES ARE HOWEVER SUPPLEMENTED BY ICRC THROUGH BONUSES. THERE IS IN THE COMMUNE A DISPENSARY WHICH IS OPERATED BY WORLD VISION AT (GR 828257). ACCORDING TO THE DOCTOR AT THE DISPENSARY, THERE HAD BEEN AN OUTBREAK OF DIARRHOEA IN THE COMMUNE SINCE MARCH. THE DOCTOR INTIMATED THAT ABOUT 50 CASES OF THE DISEASE ARE REPORTED EVERY WEEK AND TWO DEATHS HAVE SO FAR BEEN RECORDED. HE BELIEVES THAT MORE PEOPLE DIE IN THEIR HOMES DUE TO UNAVAILABILITY OF TRANSPORT. HE ALSO SAID EXPLAINED THAT THE SITUATION GETS EVEN WORSE WHEN HE REFERS A PATIENT TO BYUMBA HOSPITAL AND THE PATIENT IS LEFT WITH NO OPTION BUT TO GO HOME AS THERE IS TOTALLY NO TRANSPORT TO FERRY HIM TO BYUMBA.

c. BYUMBA PREFECTURE. THERE ARE TWO GROUPS OF RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE. THE FIRST GROUP ARRIVED AT THE BYUMBA ON 21/08/95 UNDER THE VOLUNTARY REPATRIATION PROGRAMME WITH THE SECOND GROUP ARRIVING ON 24/08/95 UNDER THE FORCED REPATRIATION PROGRAMME. THE FIRST GROUP WHICH CONSISTS OF 41 PEOPLE HAD LEFT RWANDA BETWEEN 1959 AND 1960 AND AS SUCH DO NOT HAVE ANYWHERE TO SETTLE. THE PREFECT OF BYUMBA HAS ARRANGED THAT THEY BE SETTLED IN KIVUYE COMMUNE BUT DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORT THEY ARE STILL SITTING AT THE PREFECTURE HEAD OFFICES COMPLEX. WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME HAS GIVEN THEM FOOD BUT THEY DO NOT HAVE BLANKETS. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ARE APPEALING FOR ANY DONORS TO ASSIST THESE RETURNEES. THEY ARE ALSO REQUESTING FOR TRANSPORT TO FERRY THEM TO THE ALLOCATED AREA OF RESETTLEMENT. THE SECOND GROUP WHICH CONSISTS OF 35 PEOPLE IS DUE TO BE TRANSPORTED TO THEIR HOME

COMMUNES BUT THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORT. SEVENTEEN OF THEM HAVE SO FAR BEEN TRANSPORTED TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES IN KIBALI AND CYUMBA BY THE LIMITED TRANSPORT RESOURCES AVAILABLE. THIS PROGRAMME NEEDS TO BE SPEEDED UP BECAUSE THESE RETURNEES DO NOT HAVE ANY FOOD.

b. MUHURA COMMUNE. ON 28 JUL 95, WFP DISTRIBUTED FOOD TO TEACHERS IN THE COMMUNE TO SUPPLEMENT THEIR MEAGRE SALARIES. THE RATION SCALE WAS 25 KG OF MAIZE, 15 KG OF PEAS AND 5 LTS COOKING OIL.

c. GITI COMMUNE. THREE NGOS OPERATE IN THIS COMMUNE. THEY ARE MALTESER, RHENANIE PALANTINA AND REFUGEE TRUST. MALTESER PROVIDES MEDICAL SUPPORT TO GITI AND RUZIZI (GR 2800) HEALTH CENTRES. b. BYUMBA PRISON. THE NUMBER OF INMATES OF THE BYUMBA PRISON HAVE REDUCED FROM 310 TO 295, 260 OF WHOM ARE ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE. FIFTEEN WERE RELEASED. THE PROBLEMS FACING THE PRISON INCLUDE LACK OF TRANSPORT, OFFICE ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD FOR THE INMATES. A REPORT INDICATES THAT THE AUTHORITIES ARE RENOVATING BUILDINGS CAPABLE OF ACCOMMODATING 600 PRISONERS IN ORDER TO DECONGEST OTHERS LIKE THE KIGALI PRISON WHICH ARE SO CONGESTED. WORK IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED IN A WEEK'S TIME.





THE AREAS AFFECTED ARE GITUZA (GR3122), MURAMBI (GR4601), NGARAMA (GR2628) AND MUVUMBA (GR2646). IT IS ALLEGED TO HAVE KILLED 2000 COWS. **BLATHRAX** VACCINE IS NEEDED TO CURE INFECTED CATTLE.

(2) CONTAGIOUS BOVINE PLEURAL PNEUMONIA (CBPP). THIS AFFECTS THE LUNGS OF THE ANIMAL. THIS IS THE SECOND MOST DANGEROUS DISEASE.

(3) TRYPANOSOMIASIS. THIS IS TRANSMITTED THROUGH TSE-TSE FLY. IT HAS HOWEVER NOT REACHED AN ALARMING SITUATION.






