The Chairman recalled that by its decision of June 8, the Steering Committee had referred to Committee III/1 the question of reexamining and redrafting a new text for paragraph 8, Section B, Chapter V concerning the question of the receipt and examination by the General Assembly of reports submitted by the Security Council. The Steering Committee recommended that this task be carried out in consultation by Committees III/1 and II/2 and, if necessary and desirable, with Committee III/3. *text* Subcommittees III/1/C and II/2/B had met in joint session on June 11 and reached agreement on a new ~~draft~~ ^{text} of ~~article~~ paragraph 8, Section B, Chapter V. The joint report of the two subcommittees had been considered on the previous days, June 13, by Committee II/2, which had approved the new text of the paragraph with certain modifications. The Delegate of Greece also expressed the view that the Committee should adopt both the text and the interpretation.

Decision: The Committee unanimously adopted by 34 votes the text of paragraph 8, Section B, Chapter V and the interpretation with respect to that paragraph approved by Committee II/2.

2. Consideration of the Report of the Rapporteur on Section B (WD 313)

Decision: The Committee unanimously approved by 38 votes the report of the Rapporteur, with certain minor modifications.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
