REFERENCE

A. OUR INCREP DATED 09 FEB 95.

1. AT ABOUT 091830 HRS FEB 95, ZAMBATT TRUCK, UNAMIR 3424 DRIVEN BY SGT F. CHISOWA KNOCKED DOWN 2 RPA SOLDIERS IN MUFTI IN BUTARE. AT THE TIME, THE DRIVER WAS GOING TO FUEL UP AFTER RETURNING FROM KIGALI ON OPERATION RETOUR. ONE OF THE VICTIMS LATER DIED WHILE THE OTHER ONE WAS EVACUATED TO KIGALI WITH MALAWI COMPANY AMBULANCE.
2. AN AUSTMED TEAM THAT ARRIVED AT THE SCENE OF THE ACCIDENT RESCUED THE DRIVER, OTHERWISE HE WOULD HAVE BEEN SERIOUSLY MANHANDLED.
3. LATER ABOUT ONE COMPANY OF RPA SOLDIERS SURROUNDED THE TAC HQ TO DEMAND FOR THE RELEASE OF THE DRIVER TO THEM. THE SEIGE CONTINUED UNTIL RPA ACTING BRIGADE COMMANDER WAS INVITED WHO APPARENTLY PERSUADED THE SOLDIERS TO WITHDRAW. HOWEVER, HE DEMANDED THAT THE DRIVER BE PRODUCED THE FOLLOWING DAY TO MAKE A STATEMENT TO THE LOCAL POLICE. THE DRIVER HAD SINCE MADE STATEMENT AND ASKED TO REPORT WHENEVER THEY NEED HIM.
4. THERE HAVE BEEN MUCH FUSE BY THE LOCAL RPA SOLDIERS ABOUT THE AUSTMED TEAM WHO RESCUED THE DRIVER. RPA SOLDIERS WERE APPARENTLY AGGRIEVED ABOUT THE METHOD ADOPTED TO RESCUE THE DRIVER, WHICH HINGE ON THE THREAT OF USE OF FORCE.
5. RPA SOLDIERS FAILED TO RELEASE THE VEHICLE INVOLVED IN THE ACCIDENT DESPITE ALL ENTREATIES MADE TO THAT EFFECT.

C. OTHER PATROL WERE SENT TO NTYAZO (8631), MPUNGWE (8414) RUKARA (8512) AND RUSINGA (8113) AND REPORTED THE GENERAL SITUATION TO BE CALM IN ALL THE AREAS. IN MPUNGWE AND RUKARA RETURNEES REPORTED THAT SOME OF THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS WERE RECENTLY ARRESTED BY RPA AND TAKEN TO BUTARE PRISON FOR NO APPARENT REASONS.

A. RPA: CONTINUE GUARDING THE UNAMIR VEHICLE WHICH WAS INVOLVED AN ACCIDENT ON 9 FEB 95. THEY HAVE REFUSED TO RELEASE THE VEHICLE DESPITE SERIOUS NEGOTIATIONS. THE GENDARMERIE TOOK STATEMENTS FROM THE DRIVER. THE SITUATION WAS TENSE BECAUSE THE GENDERMERIE WANTED TO OUT THE DRIVER IN CUSTODY. RPA FURTHER REQUESTED TO MEET THE AUSTRALIAN TROOPS WHO RETRIEVED THE DRIVER ON THE SCENE OF THE ACCIDENT. THEY HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT ONE AUSTRALIAN REP WILL VISIT THEM, SOME RPA AND GENDERMERIE OFFICERS OVER REACTED ON THE SITUATION QUITE CONVIABABLE. EVENTUALLY, SOME RPA OFFICERS APOLOGISED FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR OFFICERS.

A. ONE TEAM ESCORTED THE CIVPOL AND DRIVER TO GENDERMERIE FOR POLICE PROCEDURES AS OUTLINED IN PARA 3A.

B. ONE TEAM VISITED NDORA AND NGOMA COMMUNES.

(i) IN NDORA COMMUNE THE TEAM INTERVIEWED THE BOURGMESTRE WHO INFORMED THE TEAM THAT THE SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE WAS CALM. POPULATION BEFORE THE WAR WAS 33,000 AND PRESENTLY IT IS 20,000. 100 DPs HAVE RETURNED FROM GIKONGORO THROUGH UNAMIR MEANS. 6 SCHOOLS ARE OPERATING WITH 31 TEACHERS. THE TEAM OBSERVED THAT THE RPA WERE GUARDING A BUILDING WHICH THE LOCALS CONFIRMED THAT IT IS A PRISON. HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WILL BE CONTACTED TO INVESTIGATE. THE FOLLOWING NGOS COVER THIS COMMUNE FOR HUMANITARIAN ASSDISTANCE: FEED THE CHILDREN, WFP, CRS AND CARTAS (OPERATING CLINC) PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED ARE : LACK OF SUFFICIENT FOOD, INADEQUATE MEDICAL CARE AND AGRICULTURE IMPLEMENTS. ROAD CONDITION FROM GD 7511 TO 7811 GETS QUITE BAD DURING RAINY TIMES. (ii) IN NGOMA COMMUNE THE TEAM COULD NOT MEET THE BOURGMESTRE BUT PROMISED ARRANGE TIME AT ALATER DATE. TEAM VISITED BUTARE HOSPITAL AND OBSERVED A UNAMIR VEHICLE BEING USED IN ASSISTING THE RPA DELIVER THE DECEASED SOLDIER WHO WAS RUN DOWN BY UNAMIR VEHICLE ON 09 FEB 95 AT HIS HOME.
