Entretemps, des bureaux gouvernementaux sont en train d'être installés dans des maisons louées à la Forminière dans la région de l'île Tshikapa. Une pénurie de nourriture commencerait à se faire sentir dans cette région (outre une épidémie de variole), et la situation des groupes de Baluba et de Lulua pourrait devenir désespérée à moins que la question ne soit réglée bientôt.

En raison des troubles sérieux provoqués par des émissions ~~radio-phoniques~~ irréfléchies de Radio-Kasaï et par le manque de contrôle, je recommande que le Gouvernement central désigne dès que possible un contrôleur "neutre", qui ne serait responsable que devant Léopoldville.

Lateur, directeur de la BCK, dit que "les délégués du gouvernement d'Eville venant de Kamina" ont informé le représentant de la Safricas à Lubilash que les rails ne pouvaient pas encore être posés sur le pont.
