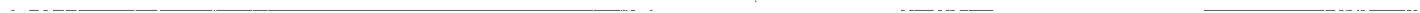



1. There has been considerable change in the UNAMIR Military Component over the past three months and I thought it might be of interest to all UNAMIR personnel to know the details of the medal and ribbon we earn during our tour in RWANDA.
2. **The UNAMIR Medal.** There is one standard medallion for all peacekeeping operations except KOREA and UNEF 1. It is a bronze medallion which bears the UN Symbol on the obverse surmounted by the letters UN and on the reverse the words "IN THE SERVICE OF PEACE".
3. **The UNAMIR Ribbon.** The standard ribbon measures 35 mm in width with at the centre the UN blue supported by white trim. To either side are three distinctive stripes representing the black of the world famous Rwandan gorillas and volcanic lava, the green of the local forest vegetation, and the red of the African soil.

3. **Ribbon.** The standard ribbon measures 35mm in width with at the centre the UN blue supported by white. To either side there is then the black of the world famous Rwandan gorillas and volcanic lava, the green of the local bush vegetation and the red of African soil.

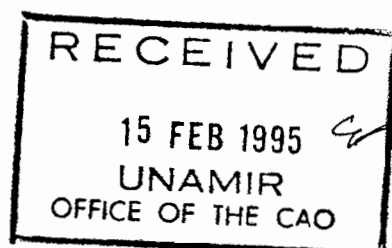

Reference:

A. Conversation DFC/DCOS (Sp) 1 Feb 95.

1. I have investigated the current regulations for the issue of UNAMIR medals and in particular the qualifying time for military observers and civilian police.

2. The UN Regulations were amended on 16 Nov 94 giving a common qualifying period of 90 days for all military and civilian police personnel regardless of the UN's organ they belong to, as long as the tasks they are performing fall within a mandate given by the Security Council or the general assembly.

3. The qualifying period for numerals shall be 180 days from the qualification of the medal or previous numeral, with only periods of at least 90 consecutive days counted towards the total qualifying period

4. The full amended regulation is attached.

UNITED NATIONS MEDAL

Reference: Regulations for the United Nations Medal.
(ST/SGB/119/Rev.1, dated 16 February 1966).

GENERAL

1. The Secretary-General has established the UN Medal for award, subject to the Regulations for the United Nations Medal, to military personnel who are or have been in the service of the United Nations.

2. The aim of the present document is to clarify the policy on the award of the UN Medal. It supersedes all previous documents on the same subject.

3. The policy will apply to personnel deployed in all existing missions at the date of the promulgation of the present policy and to all new missions established for that date on.

ELIGIBILITY.

3. The UN Medal should be awarded for service in a UN Mission to military and civilian police personnel regardless of the UN's organ they belong to, as long as the tasks they are performing fall within a mandate given by the Security Council or the General Assembly.

4. The personnel must be under operational or tactical control of the United Nations.

5. The qualifying service period shall be a minimum period of 90 days consecutively in the service of the United Nations.

6. The qualifying period for numerals shall be 180 days from the date of qualification of the medal, or previous numeral. Only periods of at least 90 consecutive days can be counted towards the total qualifying period (C)
