THE CENTRE HAS RECEIVED AN EXTENSION OF FURTHER ONE MONTH . THE MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION AND ADRA CONTINUE WITH THE SERVICE BUT WITH STRONGER CONTROLS AGAINST MEASLES. THE MONITOR IN CHARGE HOWEVER REQUESTED FOR AN EXTENSION OF TWO MONTHS.

The PMT met the R.P.A commander in Byumba and ask for an explanation of that behaviour



(b) REHABILITATION OF RETURNEES CYUMBA COMMUNE. THERE ARE APPROX 100 RETURNEES PER WEEK SETTLING DOWN IN THE COMMUNE (B 0133). SOME OCCUPY THEIR OWN HOMES AND THOSE WHOSE HOUSES ARE DESTROYED STAY WITH RELATIVES. THEY USUALLY DO WORK FOR FOOD.

(c) TRANSPORTATION OF RETURNEES. 06 RETURNEES ARE STRANDED AT GATUNA BORDER OUTPOST (B 0142) FOR THE PAST ONE WEEK UNHCR MUST BE REQUESTED TO PICK THEM UP FOR ONWARD DESPATCH INTO KIGALI.

(d) CYUMBA HEALTH CENTRE. THE HEALTH CENTRE AT CYUMBA (B 0133) WAS FUNCTIONING SATISFACTORILY AS PER THE LOCALS. THE TWO NURSES THERE REPORTED THE FOLLOWING THAT THEY LACKED WATER THE PUMP IS FUNCTIONAL BUT THE PIPES ARE DESTROYED.



(b) BYUMBA PRISON THERE ARE 148 MALE INMATES IN THE BYUMBA PRISON WHO ARE LIVING IN VERY CROWDED ACCOMODATION . THE BIGGEST PROBLEM IS THAT OF FOOD. THEY ARE BEING PROVIDED ONE MEAL A DAY. WHILE BEANS ARE BEING PROVIDED BY THE MINISTRY OF PRISONS , CARITAS SWISS IS PROVIDING MAIZE MEAL. ICRC ARE VISITING THE PRISON ON EVERY FRIDAY.

5. CIVIL AFFAIRS.

(a) LAW AND ORDER. IN KIBALI COMMUNE (B 0424) ,ALTHOUGH THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED, IT IS NOT FUNCTIONAL. THE AUTHORITIES ARE STILL WORKING ON THE MODALITIES TO START OFF WORK SUCH AS REPAIRING OF BUILDINGS INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICITY AND THE PROVISION OF FURNITURE AND STATIONERY.

(b) MINE NUISANCE. AT 261800 A LOCAL FEMALE ADULT STEPPED ON A ANTIPERS MINE IN NYAKENKE SECTUER (GR - B 012243) WHILE WORKING IN THE FIELD. SHE WAS TAKEN TO AMREF HOSP IN BYUMBA WHERE SHE PASSED AWAY AROUND 270400 DUE TO EXCESSIVE BLEEDING. LOCALS HAVE ALSO REPORTED MINES AT THE FOLLOWING LOCS:-
