**Note to Ms. Malcorra**

1. During the session of the Third Committee of the General Assembly, from 15 October to 14 November, a number of Special Procedures (of the Human Rights Council) mandate-holders will travel to New York to present their latest reports before the Committee. For the very first time, all Chairs of the Human Rights Treaty Bodies have also been invited to speak before the General Assembly.
2. Five Treaty Body Chairs will be in New York on 23 October 2012, and would like to have a joint meeting with the S-G in order to discuss the treaty body strengthening process as well as the impact of the international human rights system and the treaty body recommendations.
3. Several Special Procedures mandate-holders have also expressed interest in meeting the S-G or the DSG during their stay in New York.
4. A list of those who have requested meetings with the S-G or the DSG is attached to this note.
5. I very much hope that the Secretary-General will be able to meet with the Treaty Body Chairs and with Special Procedures mandate-holders, to the extent his agenda allows.
