

OPERATION "LEO-LULU"
ONUC OPERATION ORDER
REF MAP: CONGO 1,300,000

1. SITUATION

- a. GHANA Brigade, with under command the following Unit/Sub Units, is located in LEOPOLDVILLE. :-
 - (1) SUDANESE Battalion
 - (2) TUNISIAN Company
- b. TUNISIAN Brigade, with under command LIBERIAN Battalion, is located in KASAI Province.
- c. MALAYAN Battalion is arriving on 1 Nov 60 at MATADI and will move by train to LEOPOLDVILLE. This Battalion is designed for duties in KASAI Province.

2. MISSION

GHANA Brigade less under command SUDANESE Battalion and TUNISIAN Company and TUNISIAN Brigade less LIBERIAN Battalion will relieve each other in LEOPOLDVILLE and KASAI Provinces respectively.

3. EXECUTION

a. GHANA BRIGADE

- (1) Tentative Deployment. Same as TUNISIAN Brigade. Any changes/modifications in disposition will be at the discretion of the Brigade Commander. Such changes/modifications if any will be intimated to HQ, ONUC, LEOPOLDVILLE.
- (2) MALAYAN Battalion which will come under command GHANA Brigade on reaching PORT FRANQUI will be deployed in KASAI Province at the discretion of the Brigade Commander.
- (3) Task.
 - (a) Will take over the duties from TUNISIAN Brigade and will peacefully occupy the areas now occupied by TUNISIAN Brigade.
 - (b) Will remain under command HQ, ONUC, LEOPOLDVILLE.

b. TUNISIAN BRIGADE

- (1) Deployment: Same as GHANA Brigade at LEOPOLDVILLE.
- (2) Task
 - (a) Will take over the duties from GHANA Brigade.
 - (b) Will remain under command HQ, ONUC, LEOPOLDVILLE.

c. CO-ORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) GHANA Brigade. The following Unit/Sub Unit under command GHANA Brigade will remain "in situ" and will come under command TUNISIAN Brigade on its arrival at LEOPOLDVILLE :-
 - (a) SUDANESE Battalion
 - (b) TUNISIAN Company.
- (2) TUNISIAN Brigade. Liberian Battalion will remain "in situ" and will come under command of the GHANA Brigade on its arrival at LULUABOURG.
- (3) D - Day for the move will be 28 OCTOBER 1960.

S E C R E T

- (4) Advance Parties. The strength of the advance parties will not exceed one DC-4 load, i.e. 55 passengers.

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS

a. Movement Plan

- (1) POLICY. GHANA Brigade will relieve TUNISIAN Brigade. Consequently, the first movement will commence from LEOPOLDVILLE to LULUABOURG. The returning transport will lift equal number of relieved TUNISIANS from LULUABOURG and surrounding areas to LEOPOLDVILLE.

b. Tentative Movement Plan is as follows :-

- (1) PHASE 1. - 5 Company, 9 Battalion TUNISIAN Brigade (Strength 210 in all ranks) will be air lifted from LULUABOURG in C-119s returning empty to LEOPOLDVILLE.
(Air Move)
- (2) PHASE 2. - Move of advance parties of both the Brigades.
(Air Move)
- (3) PHASE 3. - Move of 350 GHANIAN Troops to TSHIKAPA. The returning Aircrafts will lift equal number of TUNISIAN Troops to LEOPOLDVILLE. DC-3s will shuttle between TSHIKAPA and LULUABOURG and DC-4s will shuttle between LULUABOURG and LEOPOLDVILLE.
(Air Move)
- (4) PHASE 4. - Move of GHANA Brigade Troops/Stores/Vehicles by rivercraft to PORT FRANQUI and the return move of TUNISIAN Troops/Stores/Vehicles by the same rivercraft to LEOPOLDVILLE.
(Move by River Craft)

c. Detailed Movement Tables will be issued separately by the Logistics Branch (Chief Movement Control) this Headquarters.

d. Movement Control Arrangements. A transit area/camp will be established at PORT FRANQUI by Movement Control of this HQ. A movement control detachment will be located there for the duration of the move.

e. Administrative Policy

f. Supplies

g. Accommodation

h. Transportation

j. P.O.L.

k. Medical

l. Repairs and Recoveries

m. Postal

Separate detailed orders are being issued by Logistics Branch of this Headquarters.

5. COMMAND AND SIGNALS.

a. Existing Communication facilities in KASAI and LEOPOLDVILLE Provinces will function as hitherto.

b. Communications within the Brigades will be under Brigade arrangements. Any additional demands will be placed on this Headquarters.



NERAL

1. This order pertains to the move of and logistics support for the Indonesian Battalion. Instructions for move of the Moroccan Para Coy and Infantry Platoon are being issued separately.






