
Note to the Deputy-Secretary-General

Invitation to address the 13th coordination meeting on international migration

On 12 and 13 February 2015 DESA will be organizing the 13th coordination meeting on international migration. DESA's annual coordination meeting is the principal multi-stakeholder event on migration at the United Nations.
