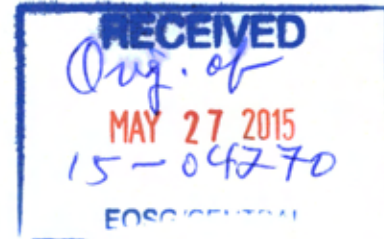

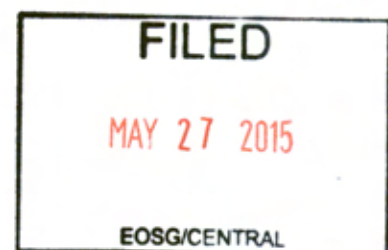
Excellency,

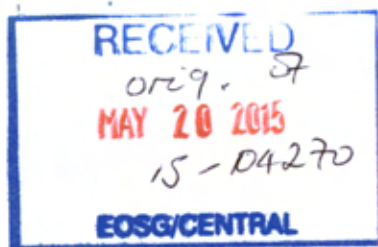

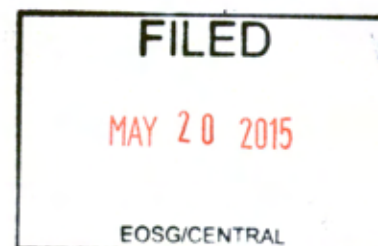
