SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING PERIOD FROM 011800 TO 021800 JULY 95.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION OF INSECURITY PREVAILS AMONG THE LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE AS BEFORE.

A. ONE MILOB TEAM CONDUCTED A FOOT PATROL IN KIBUYE GR (2772) IN GITESI COMMUNE, SITUATION IS CALM . THE TEAM VISITED KIBUYE HOSPITAL , HOSPITAL STAFF TOLD THE TEAM THAT THE HOSPITAL IS FUNCTIONING WELL . THE TEAM FOUND A WOMAN NAMED NYIRAMEZA FROM KAGANA CELLUE , SHE IS NURSING A GUN SHOT WOUND . IT IS ALLEGED THAT LAST WEEK , RPA IN NGOMA GR (2159) SECTOR WHILE SEARCHING FOR INTAHAMWE AND MISTAKENLY OPENED FIRE AT HER . ANOTHER PATIENT NAMED GASIGWA FROM KIBINGO CELLUE IN BWAKIRA COMMUNE WAS BEATEN BY COMMUNE POLICE TWO WEEKS AGO . HE WAS ACCUSED OF PARTICIPATION IN LAST YEAR'S GENOCIDE , HE IS NURSING WOUNDS ON THE BUTTOCKS AND LEGS . THE MILOB TEAM COULD NOT MEET ANY LOCAL OFFICIALS SINCE IT IS A WEEKEND .

KM-3 WAS ASKED BY COUNSELLOR OF NYAMIRAMBO SECTURE TO REHABILITATE THE OFFICE BUILDING WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF UNAMIR. THE COSTS ARE ESTIMATED TO A TOTAL OF 243000 RF. THEY ALSO ASKED FOR A MOTOR BIKE TO SOLVE TRANSPORT PROBLEMS WITHIN THE SECTURE.

BOURGHMESTRE OF GIKOMERO COMMUNE REQUESTS PLASTIC (ABOUT 6000 SQM) TO COVER 3000 DEAD BODIES.
