SITREP:

REF: OPERATION OVERTURE.

AT APPROX. 2300 HRS ON 13/12/94 UNAMIR CONTINGENT UNDER THE COMMAND OF DFC LEFT BUTARE FOR KIBEHO AND NDAGO REFUGEE CAMPS THROUGH THE RED AND GREEN ROUTES.

THE CONVOY OF VEHICLES NUMBERED ABOUT 125 TRUCKS INCLUDING APC'S (ARMoured PERSONNEL CARRIERS) AND ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY TWO (1552) FORMED TROOPS FROM GHANBATT, TUNBATT, ETHIOBATT, ZAMBATT, NICOY, MALAWI COY AND ABOUT 20 TEAMS OF MILOBS.

CONVOY ARRIVED AT THE REFUGEE CAMPS AT 0430 HRS ON 14/12/94 AND DEPLOYMENT OF THE TROOPS COMMENCED AT 0445 HRS AND AT 0600 HRS. THE EXERCISE BEGAN.

THE REFUGEES APPLAUDED WHEN INFORMED BEFORE THE EXERCISE COMMENCED THAT THE OPERATION WAS MEANT TO FLUSH OUT CRIMINAL ELEMENTS WITHIN THEIR RANKS.

THE SEARCHING WAS CONDUCTED WITHOUT ANY HINDRANCE AND NO MOLESTATION WAS OBSERVED. FORTY FIVE (45) SUSPECTS WERE ARRESTED, SOME WITH DEADLY LOCAL WEAPONS LIKE SPEARS, DAGGERS, MATCHETS, CUTLASSES AND CLUBS. OTHERS WERE SUSPECTED TO BE EITHER INTERAHWE OF RGF MEMBERS.

AT 1100 HRS ON 14/12/94 FOUR (4) OF THE SUSPECTS WERE TAKEN TO GIKONGORO BY THE MILITARY POLICE AND CIVPOL.

AFTER SCREENING BY THE MILITARY POLICE ACCOMPANIED BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE I.C.R.C. TO BE HANDED OVER TO THE PUBLIC PROSECUTOR. UNFORTUNATELY NEITHER THE PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, THE PREFECT NOR ANY GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL WAS SEEN AFTER MORE THAN THREE HOURS SEARCH FOR THEM.

SUSPECTS THEREFORE WERE RETURNED TO KIBEHO.

ALL FORTY FIVE (45) MALE SUSPECTS DETAINED OVERNIGHT UNDER GUARD OF MILITARY POLICE.

OPERATION CAME TO A SUCCESSFUL END AT 0800 HRS ON 15/12/94.

DEPUTY FORCE COMMANDER AND DCMO WERE WITH THE TROOPS THROUGHOUT THE OPERATION. DFC NOT HAPPY WITH THE STRENGTH OF THREE MAN CIVPOL TEAM ON THE OPERATION.

NO INCIDENT OR CASUALTY REPORT.

THE SUSPECTS ~~WERE TAKEN~~ TAKEN TO KIGALI FOR FUTHER ACTION.

Objet:

1. After studying these sitreps, I could get the following conclusions:

a. Crimes are increasing slowly which dictates:

- i. Quick deployment of CIVPOL, especially in Sector 2 and full deployment at CMT in Cyangugu.
- ii. Quick support of CPMTs with needed serviceable vehicles and communication sets.
- iii. Sets that CPMTs to become the responsible of investigating crimes that MILOBs carry out investigation this time.
- iv. To incite CPMTs to quickly complete submit their investigations as soon as possible.

b. MILOBs are carrying out investigation though investigation is one of the tasks that CIVPOL is more qualified to do.

c. Investigation carried out by CIVPOL are going very slowly.

2. Returnees:

a. Gisenyi border post is closed and that participates in hindering their settlement and the settlement of the general situation in Rwanda.

b. The same day closure of camps without prior efforts paid to persuade people to go back to their original homes (in Rwanda) and without building new house for refugees coming from Burundi & Uganda (.... their for along time before the war), and that will ignite new conflicts & problems if not preconsidered and planned and well prepared in early.

c. Camps are some how scattered, and made in small sizes which hinders the deployment of CPMTs in these location for providing efficient police and local gendarmerie service to them, and that plays role a

frequent crimes committed their.

- d. Borders are not controlled sufficiently to prevent criminals from using them for covering purposed.

3. RPA:

- a. RPA is misusing the indirect support he gets from UN and NGO agencies including:

- i. misusing substantial aids granted to prisoners;
- ii. misusing the efforts offered by UNAMIR to provide stability to the area;
- iii. misusing the tolerance of UNAMIR and its agencies and different components.

- b. Escalating the tension:

- i. in camps through and street;
- ii. banditry committed by uncontrolled recruits;
- iii. murder and genocide committed in the ground of revenge, proclaimed trials and punishments;
- iv. rumours and propaganda against UNAMIR and on the ground at racial conflicts;

- c. with UNAMIR components:

- i. harassments on UNAMIR personnel on/off duty CHR, Milobs);
- ii. Hindering the functioning agencies from doing its jobs;
- iii. accusing profitable witnesses of alleged crimes to prevent them from helping the justice and UNAMIR.
