

On 9 November 1994, at around 4,15 p.m., I was driving alone from work in Gikongoro to Butare in the UN vehicle (l.p.# UNAMIR 1107), when I was stopped at the RPA check-point (approximately 10 km from Butare). Two RPA soldiers approached and demanded to search the vehicle. Initially I refused and explained to them that they have no right to search UN vehicles (the vehicle was marked clearly and I was wearing my UNAMIR I.D. card). Nevertheless, they wouldn't let me go through and insisted on searching the vehicle. One of them started to knock on the back window with the gun-shaft. At that point, I decided to allow them to search the vehicle in order to avoid further confrontation and material damage. After searching the vehicle, including my brief bag and travel bag, they let me pass the check-point. Upon arrival in Butare I reported the incident to the duty officer in the UNAMIR Tactical HQ, Capt.Kweifio Okai.

A booby trap comprising of 5 rifle grenades, mines and plastic explosive charges tied together with det cord was also discovered. This booby trap is yet to be cleared.

c. MILOB Gp HQ reported that locals in Sector 4C complained of the arrest of 2 pers at KEMEMBE (GR 8031) by the RPA. The RPA took them to NYUNGWE forest and returned without them. They were suspected to have been killed. A MILOB investigation is in progress.
