DRAFT RESOLUTION OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL RELATING  
TO ALTERNATE MEMBERS ON THE COMMISSIONS OF THE COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Economic and Social Council considers that it would facilitate the work of its Commissions if provision were made for alternate members of the Commissions, and

WHEREAS such alternates should be selected in accordance with the same procedure as that adopted by the Council for the selection of members of the Commissions

THEREFORE the Economic and Social Council resolves

1. that alternates may be designated by the Governments represented on the Commissions, subject to confirmation by the Council
2. that with a view to securing a balanced representation in the various fields covered by the Commissions, the Secretary-General shall consult with the respective Governments before the alternates are finally designated by them and submitted to the Council for confirmation.
