

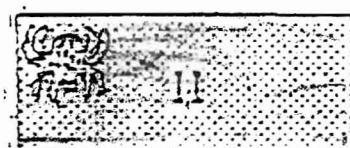
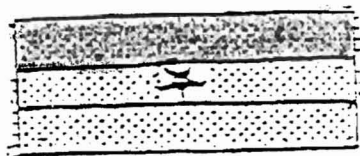

1. SITUATION

a. General

(1) UNAMIR HQ Contingency Plans for security alert, reinforcement and subsequent withdrawal and evacuation provide as follows:

(a) OPS PLAN NIKE. Increased UNAMIR security in the event of deteriorating situation in Rwanda.

(b) OPS PLAN HECTOR. Rft of UNAMIR Units/locs in the event of progressive/increasing deteriorating situation in Rwanda.

(c) OPS PLAN JASON. Wdr and evac of UNAMIR and associated pers in the event of a seriously deteriorating security sit in Rwanda.

(2) The flexible nature of the Plans ensures that UNAMIR Rules of Engagement (ROE) level of readiness/alert states may be applied independently or in conjunction with any of the Contingencies envisaged.

b. Threat. The threat to UNAMIR is likely to be:

(1) Collateral threat caused by attacks on Broadbased Government of National Unity (BBGNU) and RPA.

(2) Direct attack on UNAMIR to achieve Political ends.

c. Protection. In either case the protection of UNAMIR pers is paramount and will incl the protection of the following that UNAMIR has the mandate to protect:

(1) UNREO, UNHCR, UNCIV POL and other UN agency pers.

(2) NGO pers.

(3) Displaced persons, refugees and civilians in sites or posts under the protection of UNAMIR forces.

(4) Any other persons under UN protection.

d. Scenarios. Since it is not possible to anticipate all specific scenarios, CO Ghanbatt, Commander of Sector 2 has sought to:

(1) Simplify all possible progressive deteriorating situations and responses anticipated in Ops Plans NIKE, HECTOR and JASON under a single Contingency Plan for compliance by Ghanbatt troops and all affected agencies in UNAMIR Sector 2.

(2) Suggest appropriate response at each threat level in line with UNAMIR HQ anticipated reaction.

(3) Generate additional formed bodies of troops to enhance the security cover provided in designated sectors.

e. Code Name The simplified Plan for Sector 2 will be Codenamed "DRAGON".

2. MISSION. UNAMIR GHANBATT 3 is to be prepared to enhance security, rft positions in/out of its AOR, offer better protection for or withdraw/evacuate its pers, UNAMIR pers and persons under UNAMIR protection.

3. EXECUTION

a. Gen Outline

(1) Annex A - Ops Plan NIKE Security Alert Measures (SAMs)

(2) Annex B - Ops Plan HECTOR - Rft Loc/Routes.

(3) Annex C - Ops Plan JASON - Safe Areas/Wdr Routes.

(4) It is intended that in the event of:

(a) A general deterioration of the situation, the appropriate SAMs will be activated.

(b) A Sub-Unit being threatened, it will be rft by other Sub-Units using rft routes as rehearsed.

(c) Another UNAMIR Battalion's position being threatened, Ghanbatt will rft that posn with a force of up to a Coy str.

(d) No alternative being feasible, Ghanbatt under HQ UNAMIR supervision will wdr/evac Mission Area.

b. Concept of Operations. Following will be the concept of Operations:

(1) Sub-Units threatened will:

(a) Adopt appropriate SAM under Ops Plan NIKE.

(b) Localise the threat by committing own reserves using routes under Ops Plan HECTOR as per Annex B.

(c) Bn HQ will commit its BMR if local rft proves inadequate to contain the situation.

(d) Bn HQ will request UNAMIR HQ support if unit resources are unable to contain sit.

(2) Bn HQ will make available its BMR of up to Coy Str to rft other UNAMIR Bn/Coy posns threatened.

(3) Bn will provide security to all agencies in the Sector under UNAMIR/UN protection.

(4) Bn will carry out wdr/evac of UNAMIR pers incl self, and pers under UNAMIR/UN protection under Op Plan JASON as per Annex C.

(1) Grouping. Nil.

(2) Tasks

(a) Adopt appropriate SAMs commensurate with security sit in your sub-sector.

1. PLAN NIKE GREEN

- a. Normal Activities. Continue with normal activity.
- b. Recce. Confirmatory recce to be carried out of routes including alternatives to all locations identified for use under NIKE YELLOW and RED.
- c. Protected Pers. All protected pers incl MILOBs are to be briefed on procedures to be followed under NIKE YELLOW and RED.

2. PLAN NIKE YELLOW.

Withdrawal to Safe Areas as follows:

- a. NIKE YELLOW ALFA. Wdr to Platoon Positions. Patrols to be carried out at minimum of section level.
- b. NIKE YELLOW BRAVO. Wdr to Company localities. Patrolling to be carried out at minimum of Platoon level.
- c. NIKE YELLOW CHARLIE. Wdr to Battalion defended area (Safe Area). Patrolling to be carried out at minimum of Platoon levels.
- d. Protected Personnel. May be withdrawn to Safe Areas on a voluntary basis only.
- e. Fixed Installations. Fixed Installations will be listed and the level of security to be accorded each will be indicated.
- f. MILOB Withdrawal. As per Annex D.
- g. Movement.
 - (1) Min number of vehs in a convoy is four.
 - (2) Min protection for a convoy or a packet is one section.
 - (3) Movement off Main Supply Route(MSR) only when absolutely nec.
 - (4) All convoys will have guaranteed comm.

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(5) Night movement may be undertaken only when absolutely necessary.

h. Administration.

(1) Combat Supplies. 7 x days supplies as first line will be maint.

(2) Stockpiling. Further 7 x day at Bn level.

(3) Destr Plans. In accordance with Plans HECTOR/JASON.

(4) Leave. Restricted to compassionate cases only.

(5) Alcohol. No alcohol will be consumed when on NIKE YELLOW or RED.

3. PLAN NIKE RED. When the Unit is NIKE RED the following will prevail:

a. Recce. Further recce of locations/routes for use under plans HECTOR and JASON will be carried out.

b. Protected Personnel. The unit will plan to escort protected personnel to Kigali or neighbouring country as may be ordered by HQ UNAMIR.

c. Movement

(1) Min convoy - 8 x vehicles.

(2) Min protection - 2 Sections per convoy or packet.

(3) No movement off MSR.

(4) All convoys or packets have guaranteed comm.

(5) No movement at night.

d. Administration.

(1) No leave to be granted.

(2) All personnel will wear ballistic protective equipment and headgear when issued.

General

1. MILOBs have Special Status under UN Convention herein they are defined as "experts". Because they are unarmed their security will be safeguarded by the Commanders in whose AOR they are located.

MILOB Withdrawal.

2. MILOBs will adhere to Op NIKE SAMs.

3. Reception and administration for them will be considered by Commanders in whose AOR they are located.

4. They may be given military tasks in the AOR under NIKE YELLOW provided:

a. They are not sent to the site of known or suspected threat.

b. They travel as a minimum party of six in two vehicles.

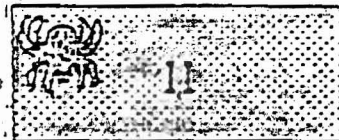
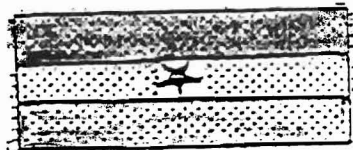
c. They have guaranteed communications.

Time Zone Used Throughout the Order. BRAVO (LT)

1. SITUATION

a. Threat

(1) The Rwandese civil war of April 1994 led to the defeat of the Rwandese Government Forces (RGF) by the Rwandese Patriotic Force (RPF). The former is exiled in neighbouring countries and referred to as Former Rwandese Government Forces (FRGR).

(2) The Rwandese authority's attitude towards the role of UNAMIR can be described as uncooperative. The Rwandese Patriotic Army (RPA), the offspring of the RPF, and other hardline politicians, consider the presence of UNAMIR as illegitimate and a violation of the sovereignty of RWANDA.

(3) Acts of banditry and defiance of the authority of UNAMIR are being perpetuated by some members of the RPA and the Interahamwe militia of the FRGF.

(4) RPA

(a) Identification. 201 Bde deployed as follows:

ii. Bns	Rwamagana	GR 4885

(b) Tactics

- i. Manning of Check Points.
- ii. Cordon and Search of Communes for arms and ammo.
- iii. Arrest and detention of persons, mostly Hutus, suspected of carrying out acts of genocide during the April 1994 Civil War.

(5) FRGF and Interahamwe Militia

(a) Identification. Have been reported to be massing up and trng along the RWANDA - BURUNDI border. Their str is est to be about 20,000.

(b) Tactics.

- i. Acts of banditry, terrorism and intimidation.
- ii. Propaganda against the RPA and even against UNAMIR.
- iii. Convincing refugees in camps in Zaire and in Burundi not to return to Rwanda. At times they use force to achieve this.

(c) Training. They were a well organised Army and therefore well trained except those that were conscripted for the purpose of the war.

(d) Intentions. Is not exactly known following the defeat they have suffered. But it could be suspected that they nurse feelings of reorganising to launch an attack into the country, especially on the part of the hardliners. Some however, are looking forward to a reintegration into the RPA.

(e) Posture. Is very low in terms of aggressiveness; there are great signs of hopelessness in their camps in Zaire.

(f) Dress. OG and boots, black beret with large blue cap badges.

(g) Morale. Very low.

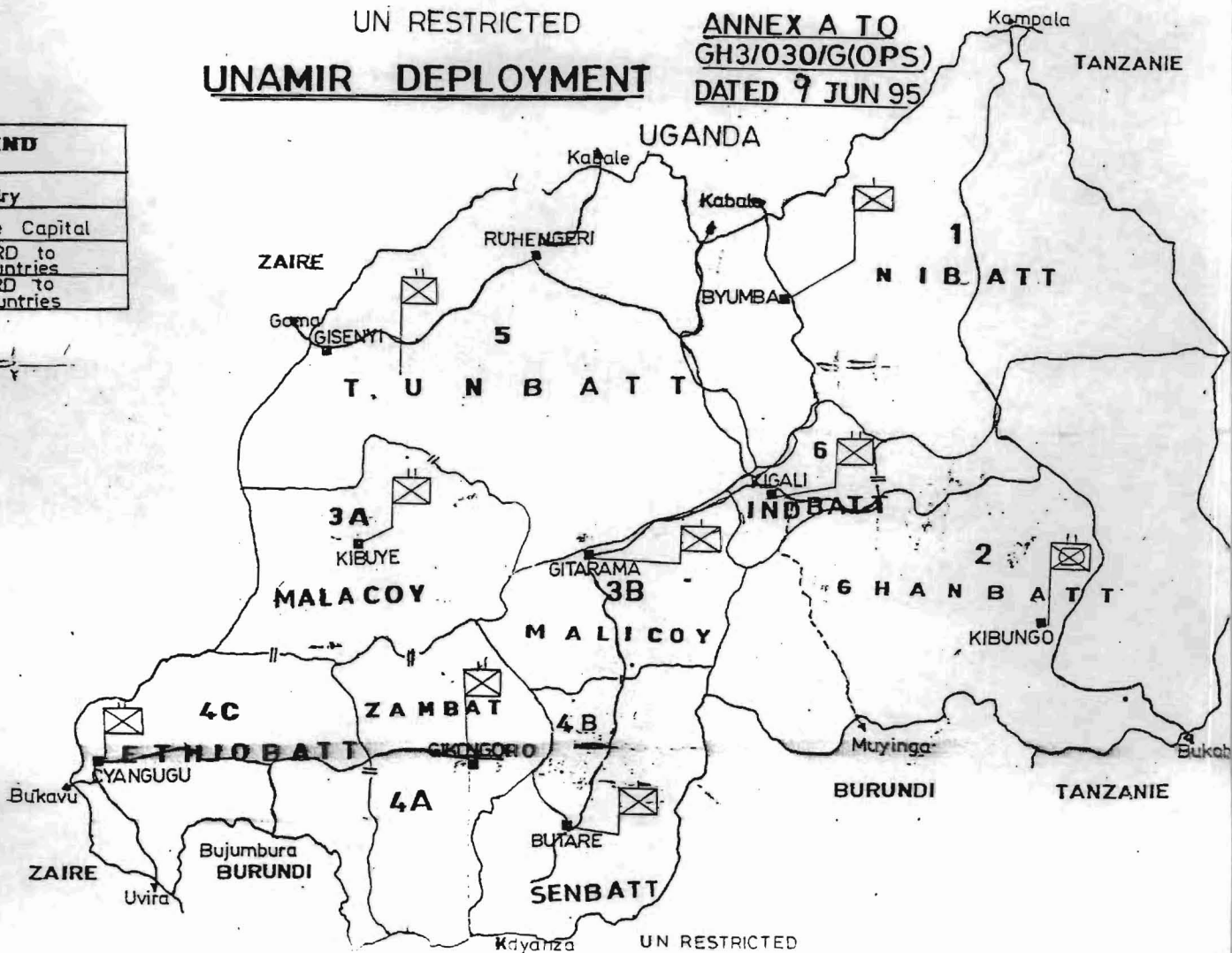
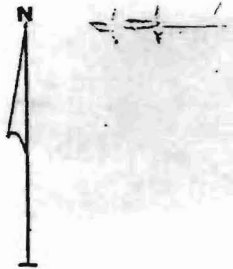
