Given that the exclusively Sinhalese security apparatus is still intact, as well as the intense militarization of the northeast of the country where Tamil victims and potential witnesses live, Tamils will rightly be fearful of participating in any in-country process. The DRACONIAN Prevention of Terrorism Act, which provides immunity for security force is not repealed.

Sri Lanka's corrupt judiciary would have been removed; its ethnic chauvinist politicians deterred; the mentality of racial and religious superiority ended; the false pretensions of past mythical glory terminated; Triumphalism that attended victory in battle terminated. The UN High Commissioner must demand for a Time Frame from Sri Lankan Government for the implementation of the his Recommendations and set up a
