



(2) EM-2. Team went to sector 1B in connection of transferring a 9 years old boy named SINDATIGAYA to his home commune Muyira. Team briefed the Sector Cdr of 1B regarding the boy's father location and situation. The case has been taken over by UNHCR, GITARAMA. Three days back Rwandian authority moved the boys from the NTONGWE cachot to the juveniel center of detention in GITAGARA. Team has given the particulars of boy's father, henceforth UNHCR will make necessary contact with the boy's father and arrange necessary transportation for the father to visit his son. Team will inform the Bourguemaster of MUYIRA of the above action.

(3) EM-3. Team patrolled NGOMA (GR 7112) commune and reported the situation to be calm. Following refugees were arrived in the commune as per the date given:

- (a) 74 On 12 Oct 95
- (b) 84 On 13 Oct 95

(1) EM-1. Team patrolled NYSABISINDU (GR 7138) commune and reported the situation to be calm. The team reported that so far 200 refugees of 1959 case and 175 of 1994 had reported back to the commune these are without shelter and much of support.

(2) EM-2. Team patrolled NDORA (GR 8112) commune and reported the situation to be calm. Team visited all the sectors of the commune and reported new houses being constructed using local material and locals were seen cultivating fields in groups as cooperatives.

Team was informed by the Bourgemastre that there were 250 prisoners in the commune cachot of which 240 were males and 10 females. 160 of these were genocide cases. The Bourgemastre requested for transport to transfer 10 female prisoners to Karubanda prison. The commune needs assistance in the provision of seeds and hoes for the farming season.

(4) EM-4. Team patrolled GISHAMVU (GR 6575) commune and the Kanyaru-Haute border check post and reported the situation to be calm. Team reported that a delegation comprising of 13 members from BURUNDI crossed the Kanyaru-Haute check post to assess the security situation in the MUGANZA commune.



2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

a. POLITICAL. The president of Ireland accompanied by her husband and minister for development visited Butare today. A large number of dignitaries were present including the Prefect of Butare to receive her at the helipad. The Sector Cdr of Milob Sector, Butare along with the Ops Officer also attended. From the helipad, the President was taken to the National University where she addressed the students. The address mostly emphasised on the good relationship between Ireland and Rwanda. From the university she was taken to the Nyanza prison. The whole visit lasted from about 1130h to 1400h.

- (1) RPA. Continued with patrol tasks and manning of check points at all the important places. They provided security and escort coverage to the entire visit of the president of Ireland.

12/10/95

report on the subject forwarded to your HQ dated 31 Aug 95). The three persons were arrested within a week of the incident and they all belong to GATUKI sector of the commune. The three are now in Kigali jail. The Bourgemastre also explained that the judge was suspected to be involved in the 1994 genocide. The matter is being further investigated. The Milob team also accompanied a truck from Mali Coy which delivered its service in carrying the remains of the victims of genocide. The reburial ceremony will be held on 05 Nov 95.

(2) EM-2. NTR.

(3) EM-3. Team patrolled RUNYINYA (GR 6012) commune and reported the situation to be calm. The name of the new Bourgemastre of the commune is Mr SEMUSHI FRANCOIS.

(4) EM-4. Team patrolled KIGEMBE (GR 7093) commune and assisted the transfer of prisoners from the commune to Nyanza prison. The truck for the task was organised from Mali Coy. Representatives of Human Rights, Gendarmerie and civil court were also present. A total of 35 prisoners were transferred. There are still 74 prisoners left in the commune.

(5) CIVPOL. The Civpol team patrolled NYARUHENGARI (GR 7607) commune and reported situation to be calm. The Bourgemastre of the commune requested to transport some prisoners to Nyanza prison. Team reported that there were 156 detainees in the commune all for genocide.




