MOBUTU ARRIVED LULU MORNING OF 27TH FEB AND STAYED OVERNIGHT WITH BADU COMMANDANT OF ECOLE MILITAIRE, LEAVING FOR KINDU AND ALBERTVILLE WITH MACIOIN 0930 28 FEB. MOBUTU HAS EXPRESSED GREAT ANNOYANCE OVER ALLEGED FAILURE OF AIR CONGO PILOTS TO CARRY HIS TROOPS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHARTER ARRANGEMENTS AND INSTEAD GOING TO ELISABETHVILLE "FOR CIGARETTES". WE INFORMED HIM OUR UNDERSTANDING WAS THAT CHARTERING WAS ON THE BASIS OF FLYING HOURS WITH THE RESULT THAT PILOTS DELAYED FOR LONG PERIODS AWAITING TROOPS OR STORES WOULD TRY TO FIND LOADS ELSEWHERE TO AVOID WASTED FLYING TIME BUT HE SAID HE WAS SURE CHARTERING ARRANGEMENTS WERE ON THE BASIS OF SO MANY DAYS. IN CONSEQUENCE OF A SLIGHT MISUNDERSTANDING RESULTING FROM THIS SITUATION AN AIR CONGO PLANE WHICH HAD NOT IN FACT BEEN CHARTERED WAS HELD OVERNIGHT BUT NO INCIDENT OF ANY CONSEQUENCE HAS OCCURRED. I FEEL HOWEVER I SHOULD LET YOU KNOW THAT AT A DINNER PARTY GIVEN BY PRESIDENT LUBAYA IN HIS HONOR MOBUTU SAID CONTROL OF AIRPORTS BY THE UNITED NATIONS WAS "INTOLERABLE" AND IT SEEMED TO HIM AS THOUGH THE CONGOLESE WERE UNDER "TRUSTEESHIP" OF THE UNITED NATIONS. I REMINDED HIM THAT THE UNITED NATIONS RESPONSIBILITY FOR AIRPORT SECURITY HAD FULL CONCURRENCE OF THE GOVERNMENT, WHEREUPON HE SAID HE WOULD ASK ADOULA TO CHANGE LATTER ARRANGEMENT. THESE REMARKS WERE MADE IN CONVERSATIONAL TONES AND I

THINK WERE CAUSED BY TIREDNESS AND IRRITABILITY. THIS MORNING AT THE AIRPORT MOBUTU APOLOGIZED TO ME FOR THESE REMARKS AND SAID THEY DID NOT REALLY REPRESENT HIS VIEWS BUT WERE CAUSED BY EXTREME FATIGUE. I HAD THE FEELING THAT HE SINCERELY REGRETTED HIS REMARKS AND I ASSURED HIM THAT I FULLY ACCEPTED HIS ASSURANCE

REPORT FOR FEB 27

1. ATTEMPT WAS MADE TO RESCUE BY HELICOPTER 6 FISHERMEN MAROONED ON SMALL ISLAND NEAR KATENDE FALLS ON RIVER LULUA ABOUT 60 KM SOUTH OF LULUA WHO HAD BEEN TRAPPED 3 MONTHS AGO BY SUDDEN RISE IN RIVER AND NOW IN POOR CONDITION AFTER LIVING ON CRABS. AS HELICOPTER UNABLE TO LAND A FURTHER ATTEMPT IS BEING MADE FEB 28 USING ROPES TO TRANSPORT THEM TO RIVER BANK

2. AT DINNER PARTY LAST NIGHT GIVEN BY PRESIDENT LUBAYA IN HONOUR OF MOBUTU, LUBAYA AGAIN INQUIRED WHETHER WE WOULD ASSIST HIS GOVERNMENT IN EFFORTS TO MOVE FOOD FROM AGRICULTURAL REGIONS TO LULUABOURG. I INFORMED HIM MATTER WAS STILL UNDER CONSIDERATION

3. MOBUTU ARRIVED 1000 AND MACEOIN IN AFTERNOON TO STAY OVER-NIGHT BEFORE PROCEEDING TO KINDU AND ALBERTVILLE. WE HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT KATANGA OPERATION HQ WILL BE BASED AT KABALO AND COMMANDED BY LT COL MASIALA. PHASE ONE WILL BE CAPTURE OF KONGOLO AND PHASE 2 WILL BE MOVE TO KAMINA. IT APPEARS THAT NO LOGISTICAL SUPPORT HAS BEEN PLANNED FOR EITHER OPERATIONAL HQ OR THE 4 BATTALIONS. OFFICERS OF NIGERIAN BRIGADE AT MACEOINS REQUEST ARE NOW ASSISTING WITH LOADING OPERATION WHICH HAVE UNTIL NOW BEEN UTTERLY UNSYSTEMATIC AND WITHOUT EITHER LOADING LISTS OR RECORDS OF STORES DESPATCHED

1. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER MR. PODESTA RETURNED TO LULU FROM LEO

3. THIRD COMMANDO BATTALION AND 8 BATTALION ARE NOW BEING SENT DIRECT FROM LULU TO KABALO AND NOT TO ALBERTVILLE. NIGERIAN BRIGADE LIAISON OFFICER HAS NOW BEEN INFORMED THAT 13 BATTALION AND 17 BATTALION WILL MOVE TO NORTH KATANGA AFTER THIRD COMMANDO BATTALION AND 8 BATTALION.
