Programme: Comprises following principal items:

I N T R O D U C T I O N

The Danish Board of International Development Co-operation presents, in this booklet, a list of courses and seminars to be held in 1977.

These activities form part of Denmark's participation in the international Co-operation for social, economic and cultural development.

MULTI-BI training courses and seminars (chapter I) are sponsored by the Government of Denmark and organized together with the Specialized Agencies, the United Nations' Office of Technical Co-operation or other International Organizations. The Courses and Seminars are mainly intended for senior officials, technicians, scientists, teachers, etc. from public, as well as private institutions in developing countries.

Participants are selected by the Specialized Agencies, the United Nations' Office of Technical Co-operation or International Organizations from candidates nominated by Member Governments. In case of most of the arrangements mentioned, this selection will already have taken place when this booklet is being issued. Further information about these and similar coming arrangements may be obtained through the international bodies concerned.

Courses and Seminars are also organized by the Danish Board of International Development Co-operation itself as so-called BILATERAL activities (chapter II), often in co-operation with a Danish government - or other national - institution. Information about future courses and seminars, as well as application forms for participation are channeled through the Danish International Development Agency (DANIDA) and the Danish diplomatic or consular missions to the Governments invited to nominate candidates.

The purpose of this Training Course is thus to contribute to improvements in the methods of handling slaughter animals, and of teaching slaughter technique, and to raise the level of sanitation with regard to handling carcasses, meat and by-products, and the storage of those products in developing countries by imparting practical and theoretical knowledge to the personnel concerned through the demonstration and training to modern methods of slaughtering cattle and sheep.

The subject of the research work is proposed by the participant and submitted together with his/her application. The research work will be dealt with in 3 seminars and the results recorded in a written thesis.
