



- A. AT ABOUT 2036 HRS ON 28 AUGUST 1995 WHEN TWO ARMED MEN WENT TO A WFP HOUSE/OFFICE AND DEMAND ACCESS TO THE HOUSE.
- B. WFP OFFICIALS TELEPHONED HUMAN RIGHTS OFFICES WHO LATER CONTACTED MILOBS BUTARE. MILOBS AND MILITARY POLICE REACTED AND WERE AT THE SCENE WITHIN TEN (10) MINUTES. ON ARRIVAL THE MILOBS AND THE MPs FOUND THAT THE ARMED MEN HAD ABSCONDED AND THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL AND UNDER CONTROL.

(3) **WATER.** OUT OF 310 PIPELINES ONLY 99 ARE FUNCTIONAL. RUNNING WATER IS AVAILABLE ONLY IN TWO SECTORS OF MARABA AND KIBAGU. 3 SECTORS HAVE PARTIAL RUNNING WATER, GASASA, MOYA AND YAMAMBA. PRESENTLY AICF IS WORKING ON THE REPAIR WORK.

(4) **HEALTH.** OUT OF THREE DESPENSARIES ONLY ONE IS FUNCTIONAL. THE CLINIC IS ASSISTED BY MSF.

(5) **ORPHANS.** THERE ARE 1124 ORPHANS ADOPTED BY FAMILIES WHILE 68 ARE BEING CENTRALLY LOOKED AFTER. FEED THE CHILDREN IS ASSISTING.






