1. SITUATION: CALM AND QUIET

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

a. POLITICAL: IT WAS DECIDED BY THE GOVERNMENT TO ORGANISE A REMEMBRANCE DAY CEREMONY FOR THOSE WHO DIED DURING THE WAR ON 7 APR 95 IN KIGALI AT THE REBERO L'HORIZON HOTEL.

b. MILITARY: NTR

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES:

a. KM-2 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KACYIRU COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. PTL VISITED THE BROADCASTING CENTRE OF THE GERMAN SHORTWAVE STATION IN RWANDA. THEY WERE GIVEN AGUIDED TOUR THROUGH THE AREA WHICH COVERS ABOUT 2-3 SQKM. THE CHIEF IS MR RAVEN FROM GERMANY. HE EMPLOYS AN OTHER 3 GERMANS AND ABOUT 45 LOCALS WHICH IS ONLY ONE THIRD OF THE STRENGTH BEFORE THE WAR. THIS STATION ALSO TAKES CARE OF THE SHORT WAVE SERVICE OF RWANDA. THEY SEND PROGRAMMES IN GERMAN, FRENCH, ENGLISH, SPANISH AND IN SWAHILI TO AFRICA SOUTH AMERICA, CARIBICS, INDIA, MIDDLE EAST. IN THE AREA OF THE RADIO BROADCASTING STATION GR 125885 THERE ARE SEVERAL EOD. MANAGER REQUESTS CLEARING SO THEY CAN CUT THE GRASS AROUND THE ANTENNAS AND BUILDING TO REDUCE THE FIRE HAZARD IN THE DRY PERIODS.

PTL WENT TO SEE HEALTH CENTER OF KINYINYA GR 124882 WHICH HAS ONE MED ASSISTANT AND 3 NURSES EMPLOYED .THEY EARN 30000 RFR/MONTH. SALARY WAS PROVIDED BY MSF UNTIL FEBRUARY 95. NOW

THIS HAS BECOME A GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBILITY. PATIENTS HAVE TO PAY FOR TREATMENT 50 RPF. THAT HAS REDUCED THE FLOW OF PATIENTS FROM ABOUT 100 PATIENTS TO 30 PATIENTS A DAY. THE CENTRE HAS 50 BEDS. MOST COMMON DECEASES ARE MALARIA AND LUNG INFECTIONS. THERE IS NO PROBLEM WITH ELECTRICITY AND WATER. MR ALFRED THE MANAGER COMPLAINS ABOUT NO TELEPHONE AND NO RADIO FOR THE HOSPITAL.

- b. KM-3 DID A ROUTINE PTL IN BUTAMWA COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. THE PTL HEARD A RUMOUR FROM DIFFERENT LOCAL SOURCES THAT THE HUTUS FEAR THAT RPA AND FANATIC TUTSIS MIGHT CELEBRATE THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT ON THE 6/7 APRIL 95 WITH HARASSMENT AND MURDER OF HUTUS AND THAT NEW RIOTS AND FIGHTS MIGHT BREAK OUT. IT IS A FACT THAT THIS RUMOURS CREATE UNCERTAINTY AMONG THE HUTUS RESIDING IN KIGALI. SOME FAMILIES HAVE DECIDED TO MOVE ABROAD OR TO MOVE TO HUTU DOMINATED AREAS THROUGH OUT THIS SENSITIVE PERIOD. UNAMIR HQ SHOULD BE PREPARED FOR INCREASED ACTIVITY DURING THIS PERIOD.

ADDITIONALLY THE PTL ASSISTED THE INDIAN MINE CLEARING TEAM.

1. SITUATION: CALM AND QUIET

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES:

a. KM-1 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN GIKOMERO COMMUNE. THEY FOUND NEW INFO ABOUT PRISONS. THE AREA IS QUIET AND CLAM. THE PTL WENT AGAIN TO GISHAKA PRISON GR 167955 WERE THEY FOUND THE NO OF PRISONERS HAD INCREASED WITHIN A WEEK FROM 108 TO 140. THEY COULD TALK TO PRISONERS WHO STAYED OUTSIDE THE PRISON ROOM UNGUARDED. THEY SAID THAT THE DURATION OF ARRESTS OF THE INMATES IS BETWEEN 2 WEEKS AND 2 MONTHS. THE PRISON IS ONLY GUARDED BY NIGHT. THE PRISONERS SAID THAT THE SANITARY SITUATION IS NOT TOO BAD AS THEY CAN USE THE TOILETS OUTSIDE THEIR PRISON. THEIR CONDITION SEEMS TO BE GOOD. THE ONLY PROBLEM IS LACK OF SPACE AT NIGHT AND THAT THEY HAVE TO SLEEP ON THE FLOOR. MOST OF THEM ARE ACCUSED OF TAKING PART IN THE GENOCIDE AND THEFT OF LIVE STOCK. INVESTIGATION IS CARRIED OUT BY LOCALS AND GENDARMERIE. THOSE WHO ARE FOUND GUILTY ARE TO BE TRANSFERRED TO KIGALI PRISON. OTHERS ARE RELEASED.

ANOTHER PRISON WAS FOUND IN SHANGO GR 150954 NEXT TO THE SCHOOL BUILDING. 9 PRISONERS ARE HELD THERE SINCE THREE DAYS. PRISONERS SHARE THE TOILETS WITH THE PUPILS. IT WAS ALSO SAID THAT PRISONERS ARE BEATEN AND TORTURED WHILE UNDER INTERROGATION. PRISON IS GUARDED BY GENDARMERIE ONLY AT NIGHT.

IN NDUBA PRISON GR 125952 THE PTL REPORTED 11 INMATES LAST WEEK, BUT FOUND ONLY 9 TODAY. 2 MEN HAVE BEEN RELEASED.

PEOPLE ARE AFRAID OF BEING ARRESTED BY RPA.

c. KM-5 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KANOMBE COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. THEY CONTACTED RPA CAMP IN KAGASA CHURCH GR 774121 WHERE 80 SOLDIERS AND 1 2ND LT ARE POSTED. AT THE NEAR BY CHECKPOINT VEH AND PERSONS ARE CHECKED STRICTLY . THE SENTRIES ARE NOT ARMED.



THE OTHER PRISON IS LOCATED IN SHA GR 119977 AND CONTAINS 16 MALE PRISONERS AND 2 FEMALE PRISONERS. ALL OF THEM ARE ACCUSED TO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THE MASSACRERS. PTL WAS NOT ON THE SPOT THIS TIME BUT WILL INVESTIGATE MORE CLOSELY.

b. KM-5 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KONOMBE COMMUNE SECTURE BUSANZA GR 1779. THE AREA IS A PURELY RURAL AREA. ALTHOUGH THEY HAD THE TRANSLATOR WITH THEM FARMERS DIDN'T GIVE ANY INFO AS THEY DO NOT KNOW WHAT IS GOING ON. PEOPLE WERE FRIENDLY AND WORK HARD IN THE FIELDS. AT GR 176816 THERE IS A RPA CAMP WHICH IS ESTIMATED TO CONTAIN A BATTALION. IN THE SURROUNDING OF THE CAMP THERE IS ALSO A ROAD BLOCK. AT GR 167816 THERE IS A WELL GUARDED RADIO STATION WHICH IS REVERED TO AS A RADAR STATION BUT PTL BELIEVES IT IS ONLY A TRANSMITTER OF RADIO RWANDA. IN BUSANZA PRIMARY SCHOOL 22 TEACHERS TAKE CARE OF 2000 PUPILS.

a. KM-1 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL TO GIKOMERO COMMUNE. THEY INVESTIGATED 4 PRISONS. THE MAIN PRISON IS IN GISHAKA GR 1695 WHERE 108 PRISONERS ARE HELD. IN RUTUNGA GR 1999 THEY FOUND 40 - 50 PRISONERS WITHIN THE SECTURE OFFICE BUILDING. IN KAYANGA GR 2196 IN A MUD HOUSE NEXT TO SECTURE OFFICE BUILDING 15 MEN AND 4 WOMEN ARE HELD. IN GIKOMERO OFFICE BUILDING GR 2392 10 PRISONERS ARE LOCATED. IT WAS STATED BY LOCALS THAT PEOPLE ARE ARRESTED FOR NO REASON AND TORTURED THERE. LOCALS FEEL FRIGHTENED. ELECTRICITY AND WATER ARE BEING SUPPLIED WITH FREQUENT INTERRUPTIONS.

NGOS ARE WORKING IN THE AREA FROM TIME AS ACCORDING TO THE SECTOR'S OFFICIALS IRC DISTRIBUTED CORN, RISE BEANS AND C/OIL TO 6,600 PEOPLE RESIDING IN THE AREA IN LAST SEPTEMBER. AFTER SOME TIME SUCH NGOS AS LIBYA, ADRA SAW, PAM AND SOS ALSO DISTRIBUTED SOAP, BEANS, RICE AND C/OIL COVERING ALMOST THE WHOLE AREA.

THERE ARE NO MINES OR UNEXPLODED MUNITIONS IN THE AREA.

THERE IS NO GENDARMERIE UNIT ENSURING SECURITY DEPLOYED IN THE AREA AND SECURITY IS NOT ENSURED AT ALL, THOUGH KACYIRU GENDARMERIE TRAINING CAMP IS LOCATED THERE.

b. KM 4 PATROLLED MASACA SECTOR OF KANOMBE COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE MILOBS REPORTED THE FOLLOWING :

THEY MET MRS. MUKANZAMIZE THALIONO WHO INFORMED THE MILOBS

THAT THE AUTHORITIES DO NOT POSSESS INFO ABOUT THE NUMBER OF THE POPULATION OF THE AREA AS A BIG NUMBER OF RETURNEES ARRIVED AND SETTLED IN THE AREA.

THE TWO MAIN PROBLEMS IN THE AREA ARE : FIRST - CLEAN DRINKING WATER, AS WATER SOURCES ARE NOT CLEAN, AND SECOND - A SHORTAGE OF AGRICULTURAL LAND AS, THE NUMBER OF THOSE WHO WANT TO CULTIVATE IT IS EXCEEDING THE LOTS AVAILABLE IN THE AREA.

THE PRIMARY SCHOOL AVAILABLE IN THE AREA IS STILL CLOSED.

THERE IS ONLY SMALL DISPENSARY WHICH IS FUNCTIONING IN THE AREA.

THERE ARE ABOUT 360 ORPHANS IN THE SECTOR, 300 OF THEM ARE STAYING AT MASACA ORPHANAGE CENTRE. THE MILOBS MET THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF THE CENTRE MR. UDAHEMUKA ADOLPHE WHO INFORMED THEM THAT THE CENTRE IS BEING SUPPORTED BY INTERNATIONAL COMPASSION. THERE ARE 42 STAFF WORKING IN THE CENTER. THE MAIN PROBLEMS ARE ELECTRICITY AND WATER SUPPLY.

NGOS AND UN ORGANIZATIONS ARE NOT ACTIVE IN THE AREA. THE MILOBS WERE TOLD BY THE RESIDENTS THAT THEY HAD SEEN ONLY CARE ONCE WHEN IT DISTRIBUTED HOES AND SEEDS, BUT THOSE THINGS DIDN'T RECEIVE FOR EVERYONE.

SECTOR COORDINATOR INFORMED THE PATROL THAT SECURITY SITUATION IS NOT SO CALM IN THE AREA AS SOMETIMES PEOPLE IN UNIFORM AND WITH WEAPONS ARE SAID TO COME AND ROB THE LOCAL RESIDENTS.

THE MILOBS MET SOME RPA SOLDIERS PATROLLING THE AREA BUT THEY REFUSED TO TESTIFY THE FACTS OF ROBBERY WHEN ASKED BY THE PATROL.

c. KM 5 WAS DETAILED TO ESCORT 8 B & R TRUCKS TO CYANGUGU. THE MILOBS LEFT KIGALI FOR CYANGUGU AT 0930 HRS. THEY ARE EXPECTED TO BE BACK ON 03 FEB 95.

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES.

a. KM 1 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL GIKOMERO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS VISITED BUMBOGO ( 157 922 ), NDUBA ( 124 948 ) AND SHA ( 118 978 ) SECTORS. AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE TEAM REPORTED AS FOLLOWS :

THE PATROL VISITED THE PRIMARY SCHOOL IN BUMBOGO WHERE THE TEACHERS INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THE SCHOOL NEEDS TO BE SUPPLIED WITH CHAIRS, TABLES, BLACK BOARDS EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL AND SO ON. THE TEACHERS OF THE SCHOOL HAVEN'T BEEN PAID SINCE LAST OCTOBER.

THEY ALSO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THERE ARE NO MASS GRAVES IN THE AREA.

AT NDUBA AND SHA THE PATROL OBSERVED BIG NUMBERS OF PEOPLE AND FOUND OUT THAT THERE IS A VACCINATION CAMPAIGN BEING CARRIED BY THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE CHILDREN FROM 6 MONTHS OF

AGE TILL 12 YEARS.

b. KM 2 PATROLLED SECTOR REMERA OF KACYIRU COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF THE PATROL THE TEAM REPORTED THE FOLLOWING :

THE MILOBS MANAGED TO MEET SECTOR COORDINATOR MR. MUKABU GONZAQUE AND HIS DEPUTY MR. MGAYIRA PARL WHO INFORMED THEM THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF RESIDENTS IN THAT AREA AMOUNTS TO 25,000 PEOPLE.

THERE IS STILL A PROBLEM WITH ACCOMMODATION IN THE SECTOR AS NEW COMERS HAVE NO WILL TO LEAVE OCCUPIED HOUSES. THE MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT THESE DAYS COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE HAVE ISSUED A DIRECTIVE OBLIGING SUCH OCCUPANTS TO LEAVE THE HOUSES WITHIN 2 WEEKS.

THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS ARE OPEN IN THE AREA BUT SECONDARY ARE STILL CLOSED.

MSF IS RUNNING A MEDICAL CENTRE IN SAINT CHRIST'S, BUT THAT AREA IS BELIEVED TO BE MINED. THIS SECTOR HQ REPORTED ABOUT THE MATTER IN THE DAILY SITREP FOR 16 NOV 94 BUT IT SEEMS THAT THE SITUATION HASN'T BEEN CHANGED SINCE THAT TIME ( ENGINEERING SECTION OF FHQ OPS BRANCH WAS ALSO INFORMED ).

THERE ARE MANY ORPHANS AND WIDOWS WITH THE CHILDREN IN THE AREA. THE MILOBS WERE TOLD THAT A BIG PART OF THE POPULATION IS FACING FOOD PROBLEM AND WERE ASKED FOR ASSISTANCE IN THIS REGARD. THEY WERE INFORMED THAT IN SEPTEMBER 94 IRC DISTRIBUTED FOOD FOR 300 RESIDENTS. EACH PERSON RECEIVED THAT TIME :

- CORN - 3 KG,
- RICE - 4 KG,
- BEANS - 2 KG,
- C/OIL - 1 LTR.

THE AUTHORITIES ALSO COMPLAINED THAT THEY NEED COMMUNAL POLICE UNIT AS GENDARMERIE UNIT AVAILABLE IN THE AREA DOESN'T MEET ALL REQUIREMENTS.

c. KM 5 WAS TASKED TO PATROL SECTOR GASOGI ( 88 83 ) OF RUBUNGO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS MET THE COORDINATOR OF THE SECTOR BUT HE SHOWED A COMPLETE RELUCTANCE FOR COOPERATION. SO THE MILOBS INTERROGATED THE LOCAL PEOPLE ABOUT THE SITUATION IN THE AREA AND THEIR VITAL NEEDS.

THE POPULATION OF THE AREA IS ABOUT 5,000 RESIDENTS.

THERE IS ONLY ONE PRIMARY SCHOOL WITH 450 PUPILS AND 14 TEACHERS IN IT. THE SCHOOL IS SUPPORTED BY UNICEF.

DUE TO THE LACK OF ANY MEDICAL CENTRE PEOPLE GO TO NDERA TO SEE THE DOCTOR.

THERE IS AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLY LINE BUT NO ELECTRICITY GIVEN TO THE AREA.

THERE ARE SOME WATER POINTS WHERE PEOPLE CAN GET DRINKING WATER FROM.

PEOPLE ARE TRYING TO EXPAND THEIR AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA AS 95 % OF THE POPULATION DEPENDS ON THE LAND,



THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND ITS SUBURBS REMAINED CALM.

THE CHIEF OF GENDARMERIE OF THE REPUBLIC ISSUED A DIRECTIVE SAYING THAT ALL DRIVES MUST POSSESS DRIVER'S LICENCE. THOSE WHO WILL FAIL TO DECLARE IF STOPPED WILL TO BE PUNISHED SEVERELY.

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES.

a. KM 1 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL [REDACTED] COMMUNE. THE TEAM VISITED TWO SCHOOLS ; ONE IN BUMBOGO ( 157 922 ) SECTOR AND ANOTHER IN KAYANGA ( 217 965 ) SECTOR.

IN BUMBOGO THE PATROL TALKED TO ASSISTANT TO ADMINISTRATOR MR. PURGAENBA THELEPHONE WHO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THE SCHOOL NEEDS TO BE SUPPLIED AS IT DOESN'T HAVE BENCHES AND DESKS AS WELL AS EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL. IT ALSO NEEDS ANY HYGIENIC FACILITIES FOR THE CHILDREN. TODAY THE SCHOOL WAS CLOSED AS ALL THE POPULATION OF THAT AREA WAS BEING VACCINATED IN GISHAKA MEDICAL CENTRE. THE MILOBS LATER OBSERVED A BIG CROWD IN GISHAKA.

IN KAYANGA THE MILOBS TALKED TO THE HEADMASTER WHO

INFORMED THEM THAT THE SCHOOL IS ATTENDED BY 900 PUPILS UNDER THE CHARGE OF 4 TEACHERS WHO HAVEN'T BEEN PAID SINCE THE END OF THE WAR. IT HAS THE SAME PROBLEMS : NO CHAIRS , TABLES, BLACKBOARDS AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL. THERE ARE 14 CLASSES IN THE SCHOOL. UNICEF AND UNESCO SPORADICALLY SUPPORT THE SCHOOL BUT THEIR HELP IS ABSOLUTELY INSUFFICIENT. FOR INSTANCE TODAY THEY BROUGHT 240 COPYBOOKS, 200 PERSONAL BLACKBOARDS ( 40 FOR 30 CM ), 80 PENCILS AND 80 RUBBERS, AND SOME BROCHURES ON MINE THREATS AS AN EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL .

b. AT 1755 HRS KM 3 RETURNED FROM CYANGUGU ON COMPLETION OF TWO DAYS ESCORT MSN OF B & R CONVOY.

c. KM 4 VISITED MEDICINE DU MOND CENTRE IN GIKONDO AND MET DR. MUNYAKAZI ALPHONSE WHO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THE CENTRE OPENED ITS DOORS FOR THE PUBLIC AFTER THE WAR IN AUGUST 1995. THERE ARE 2 LOCAL DOCTORS AND 33 MEDICAL ASSISTANTS AND NURSES WORKING IN IT. THEY TREAT UP TO 115 PATIENTS PER DAY THOUGH BEFORE THE WAR THEY COULD TREAT UP TO 300 PATIENTS. THE CENTRE DOESN'T HAVE PROBLEMS WITH THE MEDICINE. THE BIGGEST PROBLEM OF IT IS SAID TO BE A LACK OF AMBULANCE.

THE MILOBS ALSO INFORMED ENGINEERING SECTION OF FHQ'S OPS BRANCH ABOUT THE LOCATION OF MINES DETECTED YESTERDAY AND REPORTED IN THE SITREP FOR 30 JAN 95.

d. KM 5 CARRIED OUT PATROL IN [REDACTED] ( 215 752 ) SECTOR OF [REDACTED] COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE MILOBS REPORTED AS FOLLOWS :

THEY MET SECTOR COORDINATOR MR. AHIMANA PASCAL WHO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT MOST OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE AREA ARE VERY POOR.

THERE IS ONE PRIMARY SCHOOL IN THE SECTOR. THE SCHOOL IS OPEN BUT ITS OVERCROWDED. UNICEF SOMETIMES APPEAR PROVIDING SOME EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL.

THERE IS NO ELECTRICITY IN THE SECTOR. WATER IS TAKEN BY PEOPLE FROM NVARAYES RIVER WHICH IS NOT DRINKING AT ALL. DUE TO THAT FACT PEOPLE SUFFER FROM MANY INFECTIOUS DISEASES.

THERE IS NO MEDICAL CENTRE IN THE AREA PEOPLE HAVE TO WALK TO KANOMBE OR MASACA CENTRES TO BE TREATED.

AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES DO NOT COVER ALL THE LANDS AVAILABLE IN THE AREA AS PEOPLE DON'T HAVE IMPLEMENTS AND SEEDS. THE MILOBS WERE TOLD THAT CARE PROVIDED THE POPULATION WITH ONE HOE, SORGHUM AND BEAN SEEDS PER FAMILY ONCE IN LAST DECEMBER, BUT THE HELP WAS INSIGNIFICANT.

SECURITY SITUATION IS NOT STABLE IN THE AREA AS RPA AND GENDARMERIE DON'T ENSURE IT DUE TO THIS THE RESIDENTS SCARED OF LEAVING THE HOUSES IN THE EVENING AND RUSH HOME BEFORE THE DUSK. THE MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT CASES OF VIOLATION AND ROBBERY ENLARGE IN NUMBER IN THE AREA.
