SUBJECT : DAILY SITREP COVERING 090600B DEC - 092200B DEC 941. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE KAGANO AND NYAMASHEKE (9841) AREAS (SECT 4C - CYANGUGU) WERE REPORTED TENSE DURING THE PERIOD. RPA TROOPS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN FIRING SHOTS AT NI ALONG THE BORDER AREAS.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA, TABAGWE AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPENED TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIESa. POLITICAL

(1) MABANZA COMMUNES AUTHORITIES (KIBUYE PREFECTURE SECT 4B) COMPLAINED OF NOT HAVING REPS FORM THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE.

(2) MILOBS ASSISTED PREFECT OF RUHENGERI WITH TPT TO INVEST ALLEGED ATROCITIES COMMITTED BY THE MILITIA AT MIKINGO (5130). (SECT 5)

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA

(a) RPA CONDUCTED ROUTINE DAY AND NIGHT FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS AND MOUNTED SNAP ROAD BLOCKS IN MAJOR TOWNS AND VILLAGES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

(b) RPA CONTINUED TO TRAIN RECRUITS IN KIBUYE CAMP.

(c) RPA LOCAL AUTHORITIES AT CYANGUGU ARRESTED 39 LOCALS FOR ILLEGAL FISHING AND THE LEADER FINED 500 FRW AND THE REST 200FRW EACH. THE AUTHORITIES WANTED ALL FISHERMEN TO BE REGISTERED.

(d) RPA TROOPS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN FIRING AT NI ALONG THE BORDER AREAS OF KAGANO AND NYAMASHEKE (9841). (SECT 4C)

(e) ABOUT 400 POTENTIAL GENDARMES ASSEMBLED AT RUHENGARI FOR A THREE-WEEK TRAINING PROGRAMME STARTING 12 DEC 94.

(f) RAP BDE HQ EXPECTED TO BE RE-LOCATED AT MUKAMIRA (4621) 9 DEC 94.

(2) MILITIA. ONE PERSON WAS REPORTED KILLED DURING AN ARMED ROBBERY ON NI OF 8/9 DEC 94 IN MUTURA COMMUNE. INVEST IN PROGRESS.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) SECTOR MILOBS PATROLLED TO RWAMANGANA, BYUMBA, RUKOMO, MUREHE, GATUNA, GABIRO AND NGARAMA. PATROLS VISITED NGARAMA HOSP WHICH WAS OPERATIONAL DURING THE PERIOD. MILOBS ALSO MET THE SOUS-PREFECT AND THE BOURGEMESTRE OF RWAMAGANA. BOTH PROMISED TO COOPERATE WITH MILOBS.

(3) MILOBS ESCORTED FUEL TANKER FROM KIGALI TO BYUMBA DURING THE PERIOD.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE SPECIAL REP OF THE UNSG VISITED THE SECTOR DURING THE PERIOD. HE VISITED BUGESERA, GISHITA AND KIBUNGO. HE ADDRESSED NGOS IN THE SECTOR AND MADE CONTACTS WITH LOCAL OFFICIALS.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED THE SPECIAL REP OF THE UNSG TO AREAS WITHIN THE SECTOR.

(3) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO SAKE, KIGARAMA, RUKIRA AND KIREHE.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. 2 MILOB TEAMS FROM SECT 3 WERE DEPLOYED AT KIBEHO 9 DEC 94. TEAMS TO RTU LAST LI AND RETURN 10 DEC 94. SECT COMD ALSO RECCE THE AREA.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED 207 DPs FROM NDAGO AND KIBEHO DPs' CAMPS TO CARE STATION.

(3) MILOBS INVESTIGATED 4 MURDER CASES DURING THE PERIOD.

(4) MALICOY PATROLLED NYAKONGO (6255) AND MUTINA (9064) AND LOCALS REQUESTED FOR FOOD AND FARM IMPLEMENTS.

(5) MALAWICOY PATROLLED KIBAYI (8498), NYARUHENGARI (7607), GAHORORO (6014) AND BUNGORO 5710) GEN SIT CALM. LOCALS EXPERIENCING DRUGS SHORTAGE. RETURNEES WERE REPORTED TO BE INCREASING IN THE AREA. (SECT 3).

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED BORDER AREAS AND DPs CAMPS AT MUGANZA, KIVU, NSHILI AND SHORORO. PATROLS REPORTED THAT CAMPS WERE VACATED. NUMBER OF DPs IN MUNINI (4800) CAMP WAS 22,000.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD RAINS CONTINUE TO RENDER ROADS IMPASSABLE IN SECTOR.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO KIBUYE, RUGABANO (4266), BWAKIRA (5061), MABANZA (3373), MUSHUBATI (3278), GITESI. TEAMS HELD DISCUSSION WITH BOURGEMESTRE OF GITESI.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED CYABINGO (7720), MILIBIZI (8315) CYATO (7618), RUSIZI-2 (7422) KAGANO (9840), KIRAMNBO (0444), KAGINKOGORO (8316) AND GATARE (1345). THE SIT IN AREAS WERE REPORTED RELATIVELY NORMAL.

e. LOCALS IN THE AREAS PATROLLED IN SECT 4B (KIBUYE PREFECTURE) COMPLAINED OF MALARIA AND INSUFFICIENT FOOD SUPPLY.

f. PRISON AT MABANZA BELIEVED TO BE HOLDING ABOUT 45 PRISONERS.



(2) MILOB ESCORTED 12 DPs FROM NDERA CAMP TO MUVUMBA.

(3) SECTOR MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS TO BYUMBA, RUKOMO, MUREHE, GIKOMO AND GATUNA AND REPORTED THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THESE AREAS CALM. AT GATUNA BORDER, 21 PERS CROSSED INTO RWANDA.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED 35 DPs FROM KIGALI TO GASHORA.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED MUGINA (9367), MUSANBIRA (8374), RUNDA, RUHANGO (7754), MUKINGI (7161), SHYEMBE (6217) AND MUGOMBA (8404). MILOB PATROLS REPORTED THAT MANY LOCALS NOW SETTLED IN THEIR HOMES BECAUSE OF UNAMIR PRESENCE IN THE AREA.

(3) MALICOY PATROLLED MASANGO (6254), NYABINYEGA (6444) AND RUKINGO (7345) AND REPORTED POPULATION NEED FOOD AND MEDICINE.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM TO NBOGO CAMP TO CONTINUE INVESTIGATION.

(3) MILOBS PATROLLED BORDER AREAS, REFUGEE CAMPS AT BUSANSE (4690) AND KAMANA (5197) AND REPORTED SITUATION CALM. MILOBS ALSO PATROLLED MUGANO, NYAMIGINA, KARAMBI, RWAMIKO AND BOHORO CAMPS. MILOBS REPORTED INCREASE IN NUMBER OF DPs IN THESE CAMPS. DPs ENTERING THESE CAMPS ARE BELIEVED TO HAVE COME FROM MUKO AND MUSANGE CAMPS.

(4) AS A RESULT OF THREATS ISSUED BY BOURGMESTRE OF GIKONGORO ON 01 DEC GIVING DEADLINE OF 05 DEC BY WHICH DPs MUST VACATE MUKO CAMP, DPs VACATED THE CAMP NI 3/4 AND 4/5 DEC 94. 166 DPs LEFT IN CAMP WERE EVACUATED BY UNAMIR 05 DEC 94 TO KIGALI. 169 DPs WERE ALSO EVACUATED FROM KADUHA AND 293 FROM KIBEHO CAMPS WERE ALSO EVACUATED TO KIGALI. DPs WHO VACATED MUKO CAMP WERE BELIEVED TO HAVE MOVED TO KADUHA GITARAMA AND KIGALI.

(5) MILOBS AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM CONTINUED INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED MOLESTATION AND MASSACRES BY RPA IN GITARAMA AREAS WHICH FORCED DPs TO RETURN TO CAMPS AT MBOGO.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED RELATIVELY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED PATROLS TO KIBUYE, MABANZA, RUTSIRO (3183), NIRUNDA (3088), NDABA (4173) AND KIBUMU (5573). SIT IN AREAS REPORTED CALM.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS INVESTIGATED THE KILLING OF 10 REFUGEES BY RPA AT MWITO AREA (8534). THE INCIDENT ALLEGEDLY OCCURRED ON 27 NOV 94 AND WAS INITIALLY INVESTIGATED BY ETHIOBATT. IN ALL A TOTAL OF 40 REFUGEES WERE TRYING TO CROSS TO ZAIRE WHEN RPA TROOPS FIRE AT THEM FROM THE SHORES OF LAKE KIVU. 5 BODIES WERE ALREADY RECOVERED AND BURIED. RPA REPORTED TO BE IN POSSESSION OF 4 BOATS AND THE BELONGINGS OF THE REFUGEES. MILOBS ALSO INVESTIGATED A CASE OF REPORTED KILLING AT NYAMASHEKE (9841) RELATED TO PEOPLE CROSSING TO ZAIRE. 4 PERS WERE ALLEGEDLY BEATEN AND TORTURED TO DEATH. INVESTIGATION CONTINUES.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED GISENYI AND BORDER POSTS, RUHENGARI AND CYANIKA (7153), KINIGI (5440), GISASABISATE (4639), NYAMULIMIRWA (4834), NYARUTOVU (7517) TARE (8910) AND SHYRONGI (8994). MILOBS ALSO LIAISED WITH AMERICARE AT MUKAKA (7522) AND AFRICA HUM ACTION AT TARE.
