1. SITUATION: CALM AND QUIET

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES:

a. KM-1 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN GIKOMERO COMMUNE. THEY FOUND NEW INFO ABOUT PRISONS. THE AREA IS QUIET AND CLAM. THE PTL WENT AGAIN TO GISHAKA PRISON GR 167955 WERE THEY FOUND THE NO OF PRISONERS HAD INCREASED WITHIN A WEEK FROM 108 TO 140. THEY COULD TALK TO PRISONERS WHO STAYED OUTSIDE THE PRISON ROOM UNGUARDED. THEY SAID THAT THE DURATION OF ARRESTS OF THE INMATES IS BETWEEN 2 WEEKS AND 2 MONTHS. THE PRISON IS ONLY GUARDED BY NIGHT. THE PRISONERS SAID THAT THE SANITARY SITUATION IS NOT TOO BAD AS THEY CAN USE THE TOILETS OUTSIDE THEIR PRISON. THEIR CONDITION SEEMS TO BE GOOD. THE ONLY PROBLEM IS LACK OF SPACE AT NIGHT AND THAT THEY HAVE TO SLEEP ON THE FLOOR. MOST OF THEM ARE ACCUSED OF TAKING PART IN THE GENOCIDE AND THEFT OF LIVE STOCK. INVESTIGATION IS CARRIED OUT BY LOCALS AND GENDARMERIE. THOSE WHO ARE FOUND GUILTY ARE TO BE TRANSFERRED TO KIGALI PRISON. OTHERS ARE RELEASED.

ANOTHER PRISON WAS FOUND IN SHANGO GR 150954 NEXT TO THE SCHOOL BUILDING. 9 PRISONERS ARE HELD THERE SINCE THREE DAYS. PRISONERS SHARE THE TOILETS WITH THE PUPILS. IT WAS ALSO SAID THAT PRISONERS ARE BEATEN AND TORTURED WHILE UNDER INTERROGATION. PRISON IS GUARDED BY GENDARMERIE ONLY AT NIGHT.

IN NDUBA PRISON GR 125952 THE PTL REPORTED 11 INMATES LAST WEEK, BUT FOUND ONLY 9 TODAY. 2 MEN HAVE BEEN RELEASED.

PEOPLE ARE AFRAID OF BEING ARRESTED BY RPA.

b. KM-3 DID A ROUTINE PTL IN BUTAMWA COMMUNE. THE AREA IS CALM AND QUIET. THEY WERE SHOWN A BROKEN DOWN WATER PUMP AT GR 7603 WHICH NEEDS URGENT REPLACEMENT.

c. KM-5 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KANOMBE COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. THEY CONTACTED RPA CAMP IN KAGASA CHURCH GR 774121 WHERE 80 SOLDIERS AND 1 2ND LT ARE POSTED. AT THE NEAR BY CHECKPOINT VEH AND PERSONS ARE CHECKED STRICTLY . THE SENTRIES ARE NOT ARMED.



a. KM-1 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN GIKOMERO COMMUNE. BY TALKING WITH LOCALS THEY GOT INFORMATION ABOUT 2 MORE SMALLER PRISONS IN NDUMBA GR 125948 WHERE 11 MALE PRISONERS ARE HELD. THE OTHER PRISON IS LOCATED IN SHA GR 119977 AND CONTAINS 16 MALE PRISONERS AND 2 FEMALE PRISONERS. ALL OF THEM ARE ACCUSED TO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THE MASSACRERS. PTL WAS NOT ON THE SPOT THIS TIME BUT WILL INVESTIGATE MORE CLOSELY.

b. KM-5 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KONOMBE COMMUNE SECTURE BUSANZA GR 1779. THE AREA IS A PURELY RURAL AREA. ALTHOUGH THEY HAD THE TRANSLATOR WITH THEM FARMERS DIDN'T GIVE ANY INFO AS THEY DO NOT KNOW WHAT IS GOING ON. PEOPLE WERE FRIENDLY AND WORK HARD IN THE FIELDS. AT GR 176816 THERE IS A RPA CAMP WHICH IS ESTIMATED TO CONTAIN A BATTALION. IN THE SURROUNDING OF THE CAMP THERE IS ALSO A ROAD BLOCK. AT GR 167816 THERE IS A WELL GUARDED RADIO STATION WHICH IS REVERED TO AS A RADAR STATION BUT PTL BELIEVES IT IS ONLY A TRANSMITTER OF RADIO RWANDA. IN BUSANZA PRIMARY SCHOOL 22 TEACHERS TAKE CARE OF 2000 PUPILS.

IN RUTUNGA GR 1999 THEY FOUND 40 - 50 PRISONERS WITHIN THE SECTURE OFFICE BUILDING. IN KAYANGA GR 2196 IN A MUD HOUSE NEXT TO SECTURE OFFICE BUILDING 15 MEN AND 4 WOMEN ARE HELD. IN GIKOMERO OFFICE BUILDING GR 2392 10 PRISONERS ARE LOCATED. IT WAS STATED BY LOCALS THAT PEOPLE ARE ARRESTED FOR NO REASON AND TORTURED THERE. LOCALS FEEL FRIGHTENED. ICRC CONTINUES TO REPAIR MED CENTER IN GISHAKA GR 1695.

b. KM-3 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN NYARUGENGE COMMUNE. THEY VISITED GITEGA PRIMARY SCHOOL AND FOUND OUT THAT 11 TEACHERS EDUCATE 850 PUPILS. AT THE SCHOOL 2 NEW CLASS ROOMS ARE UNDER CONSTRUCTION AND 90 % OF THE PUPILS ARE TUTSIS. AT THE MASS GRAVE AT KIGALI CENTRAL WORK CONTINUES AND IT WAS SEEN THAT BODIES WERE LOADED ON TO TIPPER TRUCK.

THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND ITS SUBURBS REMAINED CALM.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

THE ANNUAL SESSION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS STILL GOING ON. THESE DAYS THE DEPUTIES HAVE BEEN DISCUSSING THE LAW GIVING THEM SOME FINANCIAL PRIVILEGES.

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES.

a. KM 1 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL GIKOMERO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS VISITED BUMBOGO ( 157 922 ), NDUBA ( 124 948 ) AND SHA ( 118 978 ) SECTORS. AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE TEAM REPORTED AS FOLLOWS :

THE PATROL VISITED THE PRIMARY SCHOOL IN BUMBOGO WHERE THE TEACHERS INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THE SCHOOL NEEDS TO BE SUPPLIED WITH CHAIRS, TABLES, BLACK BOARDS EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL AND SO ON. THE TEACHERS OF THE SCHOOL HAVEN'T BEEN PAID SINCE LAST OCTOBER.

THEY ALSO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THERE ARE NO MASS GRAVES IN THE AREA.

AT NDUBA AND SHA THE PATROL OBSERVED BIG NUMBERS OF PEOPLE AND FOUND OUT THAT THERE IS A VACCINATION CAMPAIGN BEING CARRIED BY THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE CHILDREN FROM 6 MONTHS OF

AGE TILL 12 YEARS.

b. KM 2 PATROLLED SECTOR REMERA OF KACYIRU COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF THE PATROL THE TEAM REPORTED THE FOLLOWING :

THE MILOBS MANAGED TO MEET SECTOR COORDINATOR MR. MUKABU GONZAQUE AND HIS DEPUTY MR. MGAYIRA PARL WHO INFORMED THEM THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF RESIDENTS IN THAT AREA AMOUNTS TO 25,000 PEOPLE.

THERE IS STILL A PROBLEM WITH ACCOMMODATION IN THE SECTOR AS NEW COMERS HAVE NO WILL TO LEAVE OCCUPIED HOUSES. THE MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT THESE DAYS COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE HAVE ISSUED A DIRECTIVE OBLIGING SUCH OCCUPANTS TO LEAVE THE HOUSES WITHIN 2 WEEKS.

THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS ARE OPEN IN THE AREA BUT SECONDARY ARE STILL CLOSED.

MSF IS RUNNING A MEDICAL CENTRE IN SAINT CHRIST'S, BUT THAT AREA IS BELIEVED TO BE MINED. THIS SECTOR HQ REPORTED ABOUT THE MATTER IN THE DAILY SITREP FOR 16 NOV 94 BUT IT SEEMS THAT THE SITUATION HASN'T BEEN CHANGED SINCE THAT TIME ( ENGINEERING SECTION OF FHQ OPS BRANCH WAS ALSO INFORMED ).

THERE ARE MANY ORPHANS AND WIDOWS WITH THE CHILDREN IN THE AREA. THE MILOBS WERE TOLD THAT A BIG PART OF THE POPULATION IS FACING FOOD PROBLEM AND WERE ASKED FOR ASSISTANCE IN THIS REGARD. THEY WERE INFORMED THAT IN SEPTEMBER 94 IRC DISTRIBUTED FOOD FOR 300 RESIDENTS. EACH PERSON RECEIVED THAT TIME :

- CORN - 3 KG,
- RICE - 4 KG,
- BEANS - 2 KG,
- C/OIL - 1 LTR.

THE AUTHORITIES ALSO COMPLAINED THAT THEY NEED COMMUNAL POLICE UNIT AS GENDARMERIE UNIT AVAILABLE IN THE AREA DOESN'T MEET ALL REQUIREMENTS.

c. KM 5 WAS TASKED TO PATROL SECTOR GASOGI ( 88 83 ) OF RUBUNGO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS MET THE COORDINATOR OF THE SECTOR BUT HE SHOWED A COMPLETE RELUCTANCE FOR COOPERATION. SO THE MILOBS INTERROGATED THE LOCAL PEOPLE ABOUT THE SITUATION IN THE AREA AND THEIR VITAL NEEDS.

THE POPULATION OF THE AREA IS ABOUT 5,000 RESIDENTS.

THERE IS ONLY ONE PRIMARY SCHOOL WITH 450 PUPILS AND 14 TEACHERS IN IT. THE SCHOOL IS SUPPORTED BY UNICEF.

DUE TO THE LACK OF ANY MEDICAL CENTRE PEOPLE GO TO NDERA TO SEE THE DOCTOR.

THERE IS AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLY LINE BUT NO ELECTRICITY GIVEN TO THE AREA.

THERE ARE SOME WATER POINTS WHERE PEOPLE CAN GET DRINKING WATER FROM.

PEOPLE ARE TRYING TO EXPAND THEIR AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA AS 95 % OF THE POPULATION DEPENDS ON THE LAND,



1. SITUATION.

a. GENERAL

THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND ITS SUBURBS REMAINED CALM.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

a. POLITICAL.

PRESIDENT BIZIMUNGU PASTEUR ATTENDED AN OFFICIAL MEETING HELD DURING THE BURIAL CEREMONY OF THE REMNANTS OF THE GENOCIDE VICTIMS AT NYABISUNDU IN BUTARE ON 29 JAN 95.

b. MILITARY.

3. MILOB ACTIVITIES.

a. KM 2 WAS DETAILED TO CARRY OUT PATROL OF RUBUNGO COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE MILOBS REPORTED THE FOLLOWING :

THE PATROL MANAGED TO MEET COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE MR. NIYIVUGA PATRICE WHO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT BEFORE THE WAR THE POPULATION OF THAT AREA WAS EQUAL TO 49,000 PEOPLE, BUT TODAY IT AMOUNTS TO ONLY 30,100 RESIDENTS.

THERE ARE SOME PROBLEMS WITH ACCOMMODATION IN THE AREA AS PEOPLE, WHO ESCAPED GENOCIDE AND LEFT THEIR HOUSES, ARE COMING BACK AND FIND THEM OCCUPIED BY THE STRANGERS. COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE ISSUED A DIRECTIVE TO LEAVE SUCH HOUSES FREE WITHIN A TWO WEEKS PERIOD.

THERE ARE ONLY TWO PLACES WHERE PEOPLE CAN GET MEDICAL ASSISTANCE : ONE IN NDERA AND ANOTHER CENTRE IN KIMIYINYA. A NEUROPSYCHIATRIC CENTRE IN NDERA IS STILL CLOSED FOR THE

PATIENTS.

THE RESIDENTS COMPLAINED TO THE MILOBS THAT THEY RECEIVED BAD HARVEST OF BEANS AND VERY BAD OF CORNS AS THE SEEDS, WHICH WERE DISTRIBUTED BY CARE IN SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER 1994 FOR THEM WERE OF LOW QUALITY.

THERE ARE ONLY TWO NGOS OPERATING IN THE AREA : MSF AND TROCAIRE ( BOTH ARE RUNNING MEDICAL CENTRES ).

THE PATROL ARRANGED A MEETING WITH SOME SECTOR COORDINATORS ON 02 FEB 95 AT 0900 HRS.

b. KM 3 WENT WITH A TWO DAYS MSN TO CYANGUGU AT 0900 HRS. THE MILOBS ARE ESCORTING B & R CONVOY THROUGH GITARAMA AND GICONGORO.

c. KM 4 PATROLLED KICKIRO AND GIKONDO SECTORS OF KICKIRO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION REMAINED CALM DURING THEIR PATROLLING OF BOTH AREAS.

THE COORDINATOR OF KICKIRO SECTOR SHOWED THE MILOBS TWO UNEXPLODED MORTAR BOMBS JUTTING FROM THE WALL OF A HOUSE AT SQUARE ( 111 830 ).

THEN THE MILOBS VISITED THE PRIMARY SCHOOL IN GIKONDO AND TALKED TO ONE OF ITS STAFF MRS. KAMSAYISA FATUNALA WHO INFORMED THEM THAT THERE ARE 12 CLASSROOMS IN THE SCHOOL AND 13 TEACHERS WORK THERE THOUGH SHE FAILED TO INDICATE THE NUMBER OF PUPILS.

SHE ALSO LISTED THE PROBLEMS WHICH THE SCHOOL HAS BEEN FACING SINCE THE END OF THE WAR, THEY ARE COMMON TO ANY OTHER SCHOOL'S PROBLEM. IT DOESN'T HAS WINDOWS AND DOORS, ROOF IS BADLY LEAKING DURING THE RAIN, NO BENCHES OR DESKS. THE SCHOOL IS RUN BOTH BY THE GOVERNMENT AND A CHURCH IN KINUNGA BUT THE TEACHERS RECEIVED THEIR LAST SALARY IN SEPTEMBER 1994.

d. KM 5 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL KANOMBE COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF THE PATROL THE TEAM REPORTED AS FOLLOWS.

THE MILOBS MT COMMUNE COORDINATOR WHO INFORMED THEM ABOUT THE VITAL, PROBLEMS OF THE COMMUNE.

THE FIRST PROBLEM IS THE SITUATION IN AGRICULTURAL SECTOR. MOST OF THE RESIDENTS LOST THEIR CATTLE AND HARVEST DURING THE WAR. NOW THEY DON'T HAVE MONEY TO RESUME THEIR AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES IN THE FULL SCALE. THEY NEED SEEDS, FERTILIZERS AND IMPLEMENTS LIKE HOES. THE NEW COMERS (SO CALLED RETURNEES) ARE NOT RELUCTANT TO CULTIVATE THE LAND AT ALL AS PER GOVERNMENT POLICY THEY WILL HAVE TO HANDOVER THE LAND TO THE OWNER WHEN HE RETURNS.

MANY SHOPS AND A TRADING CENTRE ARE STILL CLOSED.

A GREAT NUMBER OF PEOPLE REMAIN JOBLESS. MANY EMPLOYEES ARE NOT RECEIVING THE FULL SALARY.

THERE ARE MANY ORPHANS AND WIDOWS IN THE AREA. THE MILOBS WERE TOLD THAT 3 ORGANIZATIONS ARE TAKING CARE OF A CERTAIN NUMBER OF ORPHANS BUT THEIR EFFORTS CAN'T MEET THE DEMAND. THE

FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS ARE WORKING WITH THE ORPHANS :

- COMPASSION INTERNATIONAL ( IN MASAKA ),
- SUMARI INTERNATIONAL ( IN RUBIRIZI ),
- CARE INTERNATIONAL ( IN UMUSHUMBA MURZA ).

THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE ARE OPEN BUT ALL SECONDARY ARE STILL CLOSED. THE MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT MOST OF THE SCHOOLS ARE OVERCROWDED. UNICEF IS TRYING TO SUPPORT THE TEACHERS WORKING AT SCHOOLS BY ALLOTING US 30 \$ FOR EVERY TEACHER PER MONTH. BUT THIS MONEY IS TOO LITTLE. UNICEF IS ALSO PROVIDING SOME SCHOOLS WITH EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL BUT IT MAKES IT IN A VERY SMALL SCALE.

THERE ARE THREE MEDICAL CENTRES IN THE COMMUNE : KANOMBE MILITARY HOSPITAL, GAHANGA HOSPITAL AND MASACA CLINIC BUT THEIR FACILITIES DO NOT MEET THE DEMAND OF THE POPULATION. THE MOST COMMON DISEASES ARE MALARIA AND DIARRHOEA.

THERE IS NO PURE DRINKING WATER IN THE AREA. ELECTRICITY SUPPLY IS AVAILABLE ONLY IN THE AREAS LOCATED CLOSE TO THE AIRPORT.

SECURITY IN THE AREA IS ENSURED BY RPA UNITS DEPLOYED THERE BUT PEOPLE ARE REPORTED TO BE SCARED TO LEAVE THEIR HOUSES AFTER 2100 HRS AS IT WAS SAID THERE ARE STILL SOME PEOPLE WHO ARE TRYING TO TAKE REVENGE FOR THE PAST MASSACRE.





b. KM 3 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL IN RUBUNGO COMMUNE. TODAY THE MILOBS VISITED KINUNGA CELLULE OF NDERA SECTOR AND SECTORS GASOZI AND RUSORORO. AS A RESULT OFF PATROL THE MILOBS REPORTED THE FOLLOWING :

THE PATROL MET HEAD OF KINUNGA CELLULE MR. BALINGANA DONAZIANI WHO LED THEM TO THE MASS GRAVES HAVING THE FOLLOWING GR :

- SQUARE ( 196 836 ) - MORE THEN 15 PERSONS ( 2 FAMILIES ) WHO ARE REPORTED BEING KILLED BY 3 OR 4 GRENADES THROWN INSIDE THE HOUSE WHERE THEY HAD HID THEMSELVES. THERE ARE 3 ORPHANS OF THOSE FAMILIES WHO SURVIVED AND ONE OF THEM IS SAID TO HAVE WITNESSED THE TRAGEDY.

- SQUARE ( 192 832 ) - 2 PERSONS WHO WERE KILLED IN THE NEIGHBOURING HOUSE AND BURIED NEAR-BY.

- SQUARE ( 195 828 ) - A GRAVE 10 MEETERS FOR 1 MEETER. A FAMILY IS REPORTED TO HAVE TRIED TO ESCAPE LEAVING THE HOUSE. ALL MEMBERS WERE TURNED BACK MASSACRED AND BURIED ( ABOUT 30 PERSONS ).

THEN THE MILOBS VISITED SECTOR COORDINATOR OF GASOZI SECTOR. THEY ARRANGED MEETING WITH HIM ON MONDAY 30 JAN 95 AT 0830 HRS. THE NAMES OF THE CELLULES OF THE SECTOR ARE AS FOLLOWS :

- CYARUZINGI,
- RUDASHYA,
- BWIZA,
- GASHORE,
- NYAKWIBEREKA.

IN THE END OF PATROL THE MILOBS VISITED ONE OF THE OFFICIAL IN RUSORORO SECTOR OFFICE. THEY HANDED OVER HIM A LETTER AUTHORIZING THEIR ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA AND ARRANGED MEETING ON THURSDAY 02 FEB 95 AT 0930 HRS. THE REPRESENTATIVE INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAVE ALREADY STARTED GATHERING INFO ON MATTERS INTERESTING MILOBS.

c. KM 4 WAS DETAILED TO ESCORT B & R CONVOY TO KIBUYE. THE MILOBS WENT AT 0730 HRS FOR A TWO DAYS MSN.

d. KM 5 WAS TASKED TO PATROL KANOMBE COMMUNE. THE MILOBS VISITED MASAKA, KANOMBE AND NYARUGUNDA SECTORS. AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE TEAM REPORTED AS FOLLOWS :

THEY TRIED TO MEET WITH THE COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE BUT THE LATTER HAD A MEETING SO THE MILOBS TALKED ONLY TO THE LOCAL INHABITANTS ABOUT THE GENERAL SITUATION AND ITS NEEDS.

95 % OF THE POPULATION IN ALL THREE AREAS ARE WORKING ON THE LAND. THEY HAVE STARTED FULL SCALE AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES.

THERE IS A MILITARY HOSPITAL IN KANOMBE CAMP, BUT IN GENERAL MEDICAL FACILITIES DO NOT MEET DEMAND OF THE POPULATION OF THOSE AREAS.

DRINKING WATER IS ALSO ONE OF THE PROBLEMS AS PEOPLE HAVE TO BRING IT FROM REMOTE WATER POINTS.

THERE IS SOME SHORTAGE OF FOOD IN THE SECTORS. PEOPLE ARE REPORTED TO RECEIVE SOME FOOD AID FROM CARE ON A MONTHLY BASIS.

SECURITY IS ENSURED BY RPA UNITS DEPLOYED IN THE AREAS BUT PEOPLE INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THEY PREFER TO STAY AT HOME AFTER THE SUNSET BEING SCARED OF LEAVING THE HOUSES AT NIGHT.



THE MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT THE MAIN PROBLEM OF THE PEOPLE RESIDING IN THE AREA IS LACK OF SEEDS AND AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS WHICH AFFECTS THE SCALE OF AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES



FIRST MILOBS WENT ALONG WITH A TEAM OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO SEE

IN GISOZI THEY VISITED 3 PLACES :

- A HUT AT A SQUARE ( 061 878 ) WHICH BELIEVED TO CONTAIN THE

KILLED BY GRENADES. BONES ARE STILL SCATTERED AROUND THE YARD  
AND THEY HAVEN'T BEEN PROPERLY BURIED YET.

- A PLACE CALLED KASAVE ( 088 897 ) WITH A MASS GRAVE  
CONTAINING 20 - 35 BODIES OF THE PEOPLE WHO ARE ALSO BELIEVED  
TO HAVE BEEN KILLED BY GRENADES.

- A PLACE AT A SQUARE ( 077 870 ) WITH SOME 3 TO 10 BODIES.

IN KAGUGU THE COORDINATOR OF THE SECTOR MR. RUDASIGWA JEAN  
BATISTE LED THEM TO A MASS GRAVE ( 095 899 ) BELIEVED TO  
CONTAIN FROM 500 TO 1000 DEAD BODIES OF THE PEOPLE WHO SAID TO  
BE KILLED BY GRENADES AS WELL.

THEN THE MILOBS VISITED SOS VILLAGE IN KACYIRU SECTOR AND  
ITS DIRECTOR MR. MURYENTWARI ALFRED WHO INFORMED THE PATROL  
ABOUT THE PROBLEMS OF THE CENTRE, WHICH ARE AS FOLLOWS :

- FREQUENT ELECTRICITY AND WATER CUTS. THE DIRECTOR ASKED FOR  
ASSISTANCE IN ERECTING WATER PILLAR OR TANK.

- THE CHILDREN DON'T HAVE ENOUGH CLOTHES. THERE IS BIG  
SHORTAGE OF KITCHEN UTENSILS, MILK AND SUGAR FOR THEM.

- THE STAFF WORKING AT THE CENTRE ALSO ENCOUNTERS WITH THE  
SHORTAGE OF ACCOMMODATION, FOOD, KITCHEN UTENSILS, MEANWHILE  
THEY ARE TAKING CARE OF 200 CHILDREN STAYING THERE.

THE MILOBS ALSO VISITED EMERGENCY UNIT OF SOS IN KACYIRU  
WHERE THEY TALKED TO ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT MR. ELIZAPHAN  
NKUNINZIZA. HE INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT SOS HAS 2 CENTRES FOR  
RWANDA EMERGENCY PROGRAMME : ONE IN KIGALI TAKING CARE OF 105  
ORPHANS, AND ANOTHER ONE IN NGARAMA WITH 148 ORPHANS. BOTH  
THESE CENTRES FACE ACCOMMODATION PROBLEM. THE CENTRE IN

BOTH OFFICIALS INFORMED THAT CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES,



COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE MR. KABANDANA LIONIDAS SHOWED

THE MILOBS TWO UNEXPLODED 60 MM MORTAR BOMBS IN SQUARE ( 113 820 ) : ONE JETTING OUT OF THE PILLAR OF THE SHOP, BELONGING TO MR. KAGABO, AND LOCATED AT SONATUBES CENTRE, AND THE OTHER JETTING OUT OF THE PAVEMENT CLOSE TO THE SAME SHOP. THOUGH THE SHOP IS ENCIRCLED BY THE BARS IT IS LOCATED ON A VERY BUSY PLACE NEAR SERVICE STATION.

IT IS URGENTLY REQUIRED TO EXECUTE MINE CLEANING EXERCISE IN THAT PLACE.

b. KM 3 PATROLLED RUBUNGO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS MET COORDINATOR AND ASKED HIM TO GIVE THEM ANY STAFF TO GUIDE TO THE LOCATION OF THE MASS GRAVES IN THAT AREA. INSTEAD OF IT THE COORDINATOR GAVE THE MILOBS LETTERS AUTHORISING THEM TO MEET WITH THE SECTOR COORDINATORS AND TO ACCOMPLISH THE TASK.

THE MILOBS WENT TO THE SECTORS BUT THEIR OFFICES WERE EMPTY AGAIN.

AT NDERA ROAD JUNCTION THE MILOBS OBSERVED 3 UNHCR CONVOYS BEING SEARCHED BY RPA SOLDIERS. DESTINATIONS OF THE CONVOYS AND THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE BEING CARRIED ARE AS FOLLOWS :

- GASHORA - 188,
- NGENDA - 649,
- RVENGHERY - 39.

THE CONVOYS WERE NOT BEING ESCORTED BY THE MILOBS. THE SOLDIERS INFORMED THE PATROL THAT SOMETIMES THEY ASK MINISTRY FOR REHABILITATION TO PROVIDE A REPRESENTATIVE FOR SUCH A MISSION AND THE REQUEST IS SATISFIED AS A RULE.

c. KM 4 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL KAGUGU AND GISOZI SECTORS. THE MILOBS VISITED THE DIRECTOR OF REGION SANITAIRE DE KIGALI DR. NYIRIKWANYA JEAN AT HIS OFFICE.

THE DIRECTOR INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THE CENTRE SUPERVISES 5 MAIN HOSPITALS AND SOME HEALTH CENTRES IN KIGALI.

THE CENTRE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MANNING THE MENTIONED ABOVE CENTRES BY THE STAFF, REHABILITATING THEM AS A HEALTH CENTRES, WORKING OUT A PROGRAMME FOR SUPERVISION AND FOR SUPPLYING DRUGS.

SINCE 26 JAN 95 THE CENTRE LAUNCHES A COUNTRY WIDE CAMPAIGN OF VACCINATING PEOPLE FOR MEASLES. THE DIRECTOR STRESSED THAT THE CENTRE ENCOUNTERS WITH THE PROBLEM OF SHORTAGE OF SYRINGES. TODAY HE VISITED SOME UN OFFICIALS LOOKING FOR ASSISTANCE ON THE MATTER.

BESIDES THE MENTIONED PROBLEM THE CENTRE FACES SOME OTHER LISTED BELOW :

- THERE IS A BIG SHORTAGE OF SPECIALISTS IN THE HOSPITALS AND HEALTH CENTRES INCLUDING SURGEONS. THOSE WHO ARE WORKING HAVE NOT BEEN PAYED SINCE THE END OF THE WAR.
- THEY DON'T HAVE AMBULANCES TO SERVE THE HOSPITALS.
- TPT CENTRE HAS ONLY TWO VEHICLES WHICH ARE ALLOTTED 30 LTRS OF FUEL PER WEEK.
- THERE IS NO SPECIALISTS ON COMPUTERS.



THE PATROL SPOKE WITH THE DIRECTOR OF BUREMA SCHOOL. HE INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THE CLASSES ARE BEING HELD IN 6 ROOMS ( BEFORE THE WAR THERE WERE 14 CLASSROOMS ). AS ON TODAY THERE ARE ONLY 6 TEACHERS AND SOME 300 PUPILS INCLUDING 75 ORPHANS. BEFORE THE WAR THESE FIGURES WERE 12 AND 800 ACCORDINGLY.

THE SCHOOL WAS LOOTED DURING THE WAR. NOW THERE IS NO FURNITURE THERE AND THE CHILDREN SIT ON THE GROUND DURING THE LESSONS.

THERE IS NO DRINKING WATER IN THE SCHOOL AND THE CHILDREN GET WATER FROM THE NEAREST RIVER.

THERE IS ONLY ONE CLINIC IN THAT AREA IN GASHANGA ( 749 100 ) AND IT TAKES ONE 2 HRS TO REACH IT.

THE LOCAL RESIDENTS INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT IN JULY 1994 RPA EXECUTED SOME MASSACRES IN THE AREA. PEOPLE WAS CALLED TO THE MEETING FROM WHERE SOLDIERS SEPARATED SMALL GROUPS OF THE ATTENDERS, BROUGHT THEM TO THE HOUSES, LOCKED AND SET THE HOUSES ON FIRE. LATER THEY DEMOLISHED THE HOUSES AND DESTROYED ALL THE EVIDENCE OF IT.

THE LOCALS ARE AFRAID TO SHOW SUCH PLACES TO THE MILOBS BECAUSE THEY ARE SCARED OF BEING VICTIMISED.

MORE INFO ON THE ABOVE TO FOLLOW IF GATHERED.

b. KM 3 WAS DETAILED TO PATROL RUBUNGO COMMUNE. THE MILOBS FAILED TO MEET THE COORDINATOR OF THE COMMUNE AS THE LATTER WAS ATTENDING A TWO DAYS MEETING BEING HELD IN THE SAME COMMUNE. THE MILOBS ARRANGED THE MEETING ON 25 JAN 95 AT 1000 HRS. THEN THEY CONTINUED WITH THE MSN AND IN ALL SECTORS THEY WERE TOLD THAT THE PEOPLE IN CHARGE WERE ATTENDING THE SAME MEETING.

c. KM 5 WAS DETAILED TO ESCORT 3 B & R TRUCKS TO BUSOGO. THE MILOBS LEFT KIGALI FOR BUSOGO AT 0720 HRS AND RETURNED AT 1500 HRS.





AREA.

THE MILOBS WERE ALSO INFORMED THAT THERE IS NO MASS GRAVE IN THE SECTOR, HOWEVER THE BODIES OF THE PEOPLE MASSACRED DURING MASS KILLING WERE THROWN INTO NYABARONGO RIVER. THAT MOSTLY HAPPENED IN CELLULES KAMASHASHI ( 774 210 ), KANYETABI ( 758 215 ) AND CYANKONGI ( 733 225 ). THE MILOBS VISITED ALL THREE PLACES AND INSPECTED THE PART OF THE RIVER BETWEEN THE SQS ( 85 75 ) AND ( 91 70 ). THEY HAVEN'T FOUND ANY FACTS TESTIFYING THE MATTER. BUT THEY MEASURED THE SPEED OF THE WATER FLOW WHICH IS ABOUT 10 KM/HR AND JUDGING THIS FACT AND TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION THE INFO SAYING THAT THE KILLING HAD BEEN EXECUTED SINCE APRIL TILL JUNE, ONE CAN CONCLUDE THAT THE CORPSES WERE FLOWN AWAY BY THE WATER STREAM.

IN AYABARAYA SECTOR ( 760 243 ) THE MILOBS MET ONLY ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECTOR HQ WHO WAS RATHER DRUNK. HE SHOWED THE MILOBS A BIG HOLE IN THE GROUND CLOSE TO THE SECTOR'S OFFICE AND SAID THAT IT WAS MADE BY THE FOREIGNERS WHO HAD BEEN CARRYING OUT SOME RESEARCHES FOR MINERALS IN THAT AREA BEFORE THE WAR. LATER HE INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THERE WAS NO MASS GRAVE IN THE SECTOR.

b. KM 5 WAS TASKED TO CARRY OUT PATROL IN RUBUNGO COMMUNE AND IN NDERA SECTOR OF THE SAME COMMUNE.

AS A RESULT OF PATROL THE MILOBS REPORTED THE FOLLOWING :

IN RUBUNGO THE MILOBS TALKED TO SOME LOCAL PEOPLE ABOUT THE GENERAL SITUATION AND THEIR VITAL NEEDS. THE RESIDENTS INFORMED THE PATROL THAT THEY DON'T HAVE ENOUGH WATER NOT ONLY FOR DRINK BUT ALSO FOR THEIR AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES THAT AFFECTS THE SITUATION WITH FOOD IN THAT AREA.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE PEOPLE IS PROVIDED BY TROCAIRE.

THE PRIMARY SCHOOL, AVAILABLE IN THE AREA IS OPEN HOWEVER THE SECONDARY SCHOOL IS STILL CLOSED.

IN NDERA THE MILOBS VISITED NDERA RECEPTION CENTRE FOR REFUGEES. THE CENTRE IS BEING RUN BY IOM, SAVE THE CHILDREN AND SWISS DISASTER.

THE PATROL TALKED TO ONE OF THE STAFF WORKING IN THE CENTRE WHO SAID THAT AROUND 200 REFUGEES ARE ARRIVING EVERY DAY TO THE CENTRE. EVERYBODY OF THE NEW COMERS IS PROVIDED BY THE FOOD FOR 10 DAYS AND SOME ITEMS WHICH ARE AS FOLLOWS :

- MAIZE - 4 KG,
- BEANS - 1 KG,
- COOKING OIL - 250 GR,
- JERYCAN - 1,
- BLANKET - 1.



THE POPULATION OF COMMUNE BEFORE THE WAR WAS 40000 INHABITANTS BUT PRESENTLY THE FIGURE HAS DROPPED DOWN TO 11000.

THE BUGAMASTER SAID THAT THERE WERE NO NEW COMERS BUT HOWEVER WHEN THE TEAM VISITED THE BUTAMWA PRIMARY SCHOOL THE HEADMASTER OF THE SCHOOL INFORMED THAT THERE WERE BETWEEN 40-50 NEW PUPILS IN THE SCHOOL. THAT MEANS THAT THE BUGAMASTER HAS NO EXACT INFORMATION ABOUT NEW PEOPLE COMING TO SETTLE IN HIS AREA. THE COMMUNE CANNOT EMPLOY MANY PEOPLE BECAUSE THERE IS NO ENOUGH MONEY. THEY ARE UNDER STAFFED.

THE AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITY IN THE COMMUNE IS VERY LOW. HOWEVER THE LOCALS WERE GIVEN SEEDS AND HOES BY CARE INTERNATIONAL LAST YEAR.

THERE ARE 8 PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE ( EACH SECTOR

HAS ONE SCHOOL) WITH THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PUPILS ABOUT 1800 (BEFORE THE WAR - 6000). THE COMMUNE HAS ALSO ONE TECHNICAL SCHOOL AND ONE SECONDARY. THE GENERAL PROBLEM OF ALL SCHOOLS IS A SHORTAGE OF BOOKS, FURNITURE AND THE SHORTAGE OF TRAINED TEACHERS. THE WHOLE COMMUNE HAS 59 TEACHERS 26 OF WHOM ARE NOT TRAINED AS A TEACHERS AT ALL. THE BUTAMWA PRIMARY SCHOOL HAS 18 CLASSROOMS BUT ONLY 8 OF THEM ARE BEING USED. THERE ARE 370 PUPILS IN THE SCHOOL 40-50 OF THEM ARE NEWCOMERS AND 100 ARE ORPHANS. THE SCHOOL'S EQUIPMENT IS COMPLETELY DESTROYED DURING THE WAR BECAUSE THERE WAS A REFUGEE RECEPTION CENTER. THE WATER TANK IS DESTROYED.

THE TEACHERS HAVE TO WALK 10-15 KM EVERY DAY FROM KIGALI TO THE SCHOOL BECAUSE THERE IS NO ACCOMMODATION IN THIS AREA. THE ORPHANS WHO ATTEND THE SCHOOL HAVE A BIG PROBLEM OF FOOD, CLOTHES, BOOKS. HOWEVER THEY ARE BEING LOOKED AFTER BY RELATIVES. THERE IS NO ORPHANS REHABILITATION PROGRAMME IN THE COMMUNE. LAST YEAR THE SCHOOL WAS PROVIDED WITH SOME MATERIALS BY UNICEF BUT IT WAS ENOUGH FOR TWO CLASSES ONLY.

THERE IS ONLY ONE SMALL HOSPITAL RUN BY MEDICINE DE MONDE IN THE COMMUNE SO THE PEOPLE HAVE TO MOVE LONG DISTANCES TO REACH THE PLACE.

THE TEAM WAS TOLD BY THE BURGOMASTER THAT THERE WERE ABOUT 200 ORPHANS IN THE WHOLE COMMUNE BUT THE REAL FIGURE MUST BE 5 OR 6 TIMES MORE.

b. KM 2 ESCORTED THE B & R CONVOY TO GISENYI.

c. KM 3 PATROLLED SECTORS AYABARAYA AND RUSORORO INSIDE KANOMBE COMMUNE.

THE TEAM MET MR BIDERY FIDELE - THE AYABARAYA SECTOR COORDINATOR AND WAS INFORMED THAT THE POPULATION OF THE SECTOR WAS 3489 PERSONS 88 OF THEM WERE DP AND 80 WERE REFUGEES WHICH RETURNED HOME.

THE SECTOR ADMINISTRATION CONSISTS OF:

- THE HEAD OF THE SECTOR (PAID BY THE GOVERNMENT);
- ASSISTANT FOR AGRICULTURE;
- ASSISTANT.

THE LAST TWO PERSONS ARE VOLUNTEERS.

THE LAW AND ORDER IS PROVIDED BY ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF SECTOR POLICE. THE JUSTICE RUN BY SECTOR ADMINISTRATION. THEY HAVE A DETENTION CENTER (ONLY ONE ROOM ) CLOSE TO THE SECTOR OFFICE. AT REQUEST THEY GET SUPPORT FROM GENDARMERIE BRIGADE LOCATED AT KABUGA.

THERE ARE 625 HOUSES 20 OF WHICH ARE ILLEGALLY OCCUPIED AND 20 ARE TEMPORARY OCCUPIED. A LOT OF HOUSES ARE STILL NOT REPAIRED.

THERE IS A GOVERNMENT PRIMARY SCHOOL WITH 800 PUPILS AND 13 TEACHERS WHICH NEEDS TO BE RECONSTRUCTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE (DOORS, WINDOWS, ROOF). LAST TIME THE TEACHERS WERE PAYED BY THE GOVERNMENT IN OCTOBER 94.

THERE IS NO ELECTRICITY IN THE SECTOR.


