In response to a request by the African Union, NATO has been providing military subject matter experts to assist the African Union's Plans and Operations Unit in staff capacity since June 2008 building upon earlier support to the African Union for their Mission in Somalia (AMISOM).

I would like to inform you that on 09 March 2011, the North Atlantic Council agreed to respond positively to a request from the African Union Commission for a further extension to this mandate, allowing for continued support in the areas of strategic planning, budget/financial/procurement planning and logistics/human resources planning. This lasts from March 2011 for a further six months.

The three NATO Subject Matter Experts, requested by the African Union to cover the six aforementioned areas, will work within the African Union's Plans and Operations Unit at the African Union Headquarters in Addis Ababa.

NATO looks forward to continued co-operation with the United Nations in our respective support to the African Union.
