Clothing for Tolumat.

Following on from my letter of July, this is to let you know that Camps Division U.N.R.R.A. have appointed a special officer, Capt. Hart, to deal with clothing problems in the camps.

He has assured me that plans have been made for the provision of adequate clothing in Tolumat children's camp in the winter, and that any deficiencies now in their clothing are, I am afraid, unavoidable, owing to shipping delays caused by present military operations.
