1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. NTR.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) THE RPA AIR UNIT COMMANDER HAS BEEN APPOINTED COMMANDER OF THE RWANDA AIRFORCE. HE HAS BEEN TASKED TO RECOMMEND TO THE GOVERNMENT WAYS OF BUILDING/RESTRUCTURING OF THE FORCE.

(b) IN SECTOR 2, RPA TROOPS STOPPED MILOBS AT THEIR CHECK-POINT AT IDAGAZA ( GR 5739 ) AND MUGOGO ( GR 5737 ). AFTER SOME PERSISTENCE, THE MILOB PATROL WAS ALLOWED TO CONTINUE.

(2) FRGF. NTR

(3) OTHER MILITARY ACTIVITY. NTR

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED FROM BYUMBA TO GATUNA ( GR 0142 ), CYUMBA ( GR 0133 ) AND KIBALI. THE SITUATION IN AREAS PATROLLED WAS REPORTED CALM.

(3) PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED FROM RWAMAGANA TO GAHINI, KIZIGURO, MATIMBA AND NGARAMA. SITUATION IN THOSE AREAS WAS REPORTED CALM.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

- (1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.
- (2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR AOR. THE SECURITY SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

- (1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.
- (2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN MURAMA, MASANGO (GR 6254) AND NDORA ( GR 8112 ) COMMUNES. LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN MURAMA AND MASANGO TOLD MILOBS THEY WERE EXPECTING MORE IDPS TO RETURN TO THEIR COMMUNES. THEY WERE HOWEVER WORRIED OVER SHORTAGE OF FOOD AND THE ANNOUNCED CESSATION OF FOOD DISTRIBUTION BY ICRC.
- (3) MILOBS WERE INFORMED OF NUMEROUS ARBITRARY ARRESTS BY RPA AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES. MOST OF THE VICTIMS WERE SAID TO BE MEN AND ARE USUALLY PICKED AT NIGHT. ONE PARTICULAR CASE INVOLVING ONE MR SEYANGA SAMUEL, WHO IS BEING HELD INCOMMUNICADO IN THE TAMBWE (GR 7653 ) COMMUNE JAIL, IS TO BE INVESTIGATED. IN NDORA COMMUNE, SIMILAR CASES WERE PRESENTED TO MILOBS WITH A LIST OF THOSE RECENTLY ARRESTED. THE MATTER WILL BE TAKEN UP WITH RPA LIAISON OFFICER AND HUMAN RIGHTS.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

- (1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT MOBILE PATROLS IN RWAMIKO, GISUNZU, KAMANA, MUNINI AND REMERA BP. FOOT PATROLS WERE ALSO CARRIED OUT IN GIKONGORO. MILOBS LIAISED WITH THE RPA COMMANDER IN GIKONGORO. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS HELD A MEETING WITH THE SECURITY OFFICER FOR KIBUYE PREFECTURE REGARDING THE WITHDRAWAL OF FRAFBATT.

(3) DUE TO PROBLEM OF VEHICLES, FOOT PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN KIBUYE TOWN.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. MILOBS REPORTED AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN RPA AND BANDITS IN THE AREA OF KIREHE ( GR 0547 0 IN THE NIGHT OF 19/20 FEB 95. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES/ARREST REPORTED. ETHIOBATT ALSO EXCHANGED FIRE WITH SUSPECTED BANDITS IN TWO BOATS IN AREA OF GASAYO ( GR 9941 ) AT ABOUT 2300 HRS SAME NIGHT. ONE PERSON IN CIVILIAN CLOTHES WAS ARRESTED.

(2) MILOBS TOGETHER WITH COY COMMANDER OF ETHIOBATT INVESTIGATED THE KILLING OF 18 FEB 95 IN NAYAMATEME ( GR 052423 ). THE ATTACK WAS CARRIED OUT BY BANDITS, POSSIBLY RGF. ONE PERSON WAS SHOT DEAD AND TWO WOUNDED.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT SPECIAL PATROLS IN GISENYI TO MONITOR THE SECURITY SITUATION FOLLOWING THE INCIDENTS OF THE LAST TWO DAYS. THEY LIAISED WITH THE COMMANDER OF THE GENDARMERIE FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY AROUND THE WAREHOUSES IN GISENYI.

(3) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN THE AOR. THE SITUATION IN THOSE AREAS WAS REPORTED CALM.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO NYARUGENGE AND KANOMBE COMMUNES. MILOBS MET WITH THE COORDINATOR OF NYARUGENGE COMMUNE AND AFTER A LONG DISCUSSION, HE PROVIDED THEM WITH A LETTER AUTHORIZING THEIR FURTHER ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS OF HIS COMMUNE. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

(3) SECTOR COMMANDER WAS INTRODUCED TO KANOMBE COMMUNE.

k. AIR OPS.

(1) THE SITUATION AT KIA REMAINED CALM.

(2) A DELEGATION OF INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL ARRIVED WITH SABENA AIRLINES TODAY.

(3) A TOTAL NUMBER OF 18 FLIGHTS WERE CARRIED OUT TODAY. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) UNAMIR - 12

- (c) COMMERCIAL - 4

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

UN RESTRICTED

a. SECTOR 5 MILOBS REPORTED THAT THERE WAS AN ORGANIZED MOVE OF 503 RETURNEES FORM KIBUMBA CAMP IN ZAIRE TO THE BORDER. REGISTRATION WAS IN PROGRESS.

b. SECTOR 1 MILOBS REPORTED THAT CARITAS WAS PROVIDING FOOD FOR DISABLED PERSONS IN KIBALI COMMUNE.

c. SECTOR 3 MILOBS HAVE OBSERVED THAT HUMANITARIAN EFFORTS IN THE COMMUNES IN THEIR SECTOR DID NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE POPULACE AND THEREFORE SUGGESTED MORE HELP IN THE PROVISION OF FOOD, ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE WHO WILL ARRIVE IN THE MIDDLE OF OR AFTER THE FARMING SEASON.

d. A TOTAL OF 744 DPS WERE EVACUATED FROM DPCS IN SECTORS 3 AND 4A DURING THE PERIOD. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

a. SECTOR 1 MILOBS REPORTED A LARGE CROWD INFRONT OF THE COMMUNE OFFICES IN CYUMBA DEMANDING SALARIES FOR THE PAST FOUR MONTHS.



1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNU AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. NTR.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA. NTR.

(2) FRGF. NTR

(3) OTHER MILITARY ACTIVITY. NTR

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN BYUMBA, GATUNA, NAGARAMA AND RWAMAGANA. THE SITUATION WAS NORMAL IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PROVIDED ESCORTS FOR NIGERIAN DELEGATION TO NYARUBUYE. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN VARIOUS PARTS OF THE SECTOR AOR. SITUATION WAS NORMAL.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN MURAMA, MASANGO (GR 6254) AND MUKINGI (GR 7160) COMMUNES. IN THE MURAMA COMMUNE MILOBS OBSERVED A LARGE GATHERING OF THE LOCALS.

THEY WERE INFORMED BY THE LOCAL RPA COMD THAT THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO PLAN A COMMUNAL CULTURAL PROGRAMME AS A MEANS OF RAISING FUNDS TO HELP DISTRESSED PERSONS IN THE COMMUNE.

(3) MILOBS ALSO WENT TO SECTOR 4B HQ (KIBUYE) TO LIAISE WITH MILOBS IN THAT SECTOR ON OPERATIONS ALONG THE INTER-SECTOR BDRY.

(4) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED TO THE BORDER CROSSING POINT AT KANYARU-HAUTE (GR 9163). SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) THE MAIN ACTIVITY BY MILOBS DURING THE PERIOD WAS THE FAMILIARISATION OF NEWLY-POSTED MILOBS TO THE BORDER CROSSING POINTS AND THE DPCS IN THE SECTOR. ALL AREAS PATROLLED WERE REPORTED QUIET.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) SECTOR COMD AND HQ STAFF HELD A COORDINATING CONFERENCE WITH COMD AND MILOBS FROM SECTOR 3 HQ. ISSUES DISCUSSED INCLUDED THE SHORTAGE OF VEHICLES, IMPROVEMENT IN THE METHODS OF PATROLLING AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE RELATIONSHIP WITH NGOS AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. MILOBS REPORTED THE CONTINUED INTERFERENCE WITH COMMUNICATIONS ON CHANNEL 12. IT WAS REQUESTED THAT THE PROBLEM BE TACKLED AS A MATTER OF URGENCY.

(2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN SEVERAL AREAS OF THE AO. IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE CURFEW IN THE NORTHERN PART OF THE SECTOR WAS STILL IN FORCE. THE SECURITY SITUATION REMAINED UNCHANGED.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS REPORTED ANOTHER INCIDENT OF LOOTING OF WFP AND ICRC TRUCKS IN GISENYI DURING THE PERIOD. AT 0700 HRS CROWDS WERE OBSERVED CONVERGING ON THE RPA CHECK POINT WHERE THE TRUCKS HAD BEEN HALTED. MILOBS NEGOTIATED WITH RPA FOR THE RELEASE OF THE TRUCKS AND THEIR MOVEMENT TO TUNBATT AROUND 0830 HRS. TUNBATT WAS ALSO CONTACTED TO PROVIDE ARMED ESCORT FOR THE TRUCKS. THE CROWD HOWEVER HALTED THE CONVOY AND LOOTED IT. BY THE TIME TUNBATT TROOPS ARRIVED THE TRUCKS HAD BEEN ALMOST COMPLETELY LOOTED. THE CROWD CONTINUED TO FOLLOW THE CONVOY EVEN AFTER THE ARRIVAL OF TUNBATT TROOPS. THE TRUCKS WERE THEREFORE REDIRECTED TO KIGALI. MILOBS ASSESS THAT THE LOOTING WAS AN ORGANISED AFFAIR. THE PERSONS OR GROUP RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS PLANNING IS YET UNKNOWN. DETAILED REPORT TO FOLLOW.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO THE GATSASA SECTOR. 4 MEN ACCUSED OF STEALING GOATS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN DETAINED IN THE SECTEUR OFFICE. THE REPORT STATED THAT THE ACCUSED WERE WHIPPED ANYTIME THEY CHANGED THEIR POSITION IN THE ROOM. IT WAS ALSO REPORTED THAT THEY HAD NOT BEEN FED FOR 4 DAYS. ONE OF THE ACCUSED WAS A UGANDAN CITIZEN.

k. AIR OPS. NTR

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

a. SECTOR 4B MILOBS REPORTED THAT THERE WERE MANY DPS IN GISENYI WHO WERE TO BE EVACUATED TO KIBUYE. THE PREFECT OF GISENYI HAD HOWEVER REFUSED TO RELEASE THEM BECAUSE HE WAS OF THE OPINION THAT THE SECURITY SITUATION IN KIBUYE WAS POOR. THERE WAS A CONFERENCE BETWEEN THE TWO PREFECTS IN GISENYI DURING THE PERIOD TO DISCUSS THE ISSUE. THE CONFERENCE WAS ATTENDED BY THE KIBUYE SECURITY OFFICER AND THE CHIEF OF GENDARMES. IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE DPS WOULD RETURN TO KIBUYE BY 1800 HRS ON 20 FEB 95.



(1) MATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) SECTOR 4B MILOBS ON HELI AND VEHICLE PATROLS LOCATED 2 RPA TRAINING CAMPS AT GR 275732 AND IN GISHIVU (GR 2852).

(b) MILOBS OF THE AIR OPS BRANCH AT KIA REPORTED THAT THE AIR UNIT OF THE RPA IS GRADUALLY BEING ESTABLISHED. THE FORMER HANGAR BEING USED BY UNHCR WAS BEING PREPARED FOR THIS PURPOSE DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) FRGF. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED JOINT PATROLS TO WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES OF THE BYUMBA PREFECTURE TO GATHER DATA IN THE BYUMBA AND CYUMBA (GR 0133).

(3) MILOBS HELD A COORDINATING CONFERENCE WITH RPA LOCAL COMMANDERS TO COMMENCE JOINT NICOT/RPA PATROLS. THE CONFERENCE WAS ALSO TO EXCHANGE MINE INFO.

(4) MILOB AND HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS VISITED THE KIYANZA JAIL. THERE WERE REPORTED TO BE 70 MALES AND 4 FEMALES ALL IMPRISONED IN ONE ROOM. VISITORS WERE ALLOWED AND

FAMILIES OF THE INMATES PROVIDED FOOD. MED TREATMENT WAS ALSO PROVIDED ON A REGULAR BASIS.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN RILIMA (GR 2561), GASHORA (GR 2655), RUTETE (GR 2742) AND SAKI (GR 4354). THE EXISTENCE OF A PRISON IN THE PREMISES OF THE SAKI BOURGEMESTRE'S OFFICE WAS CONFIRMED. REPORTS FROM LOCALS INDICATED THAT THERE WERE ABOUT 10 PRISONERS IN THAT LOCATION. DETAILED REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.

(3) MILOBS MONITORED THE HANDING OVER OF AN FRGF SOLDIER TO THE PROSECUTOR OF BARRE. THE SOLDIER HAD ESCAPED FROM RPA CUSTODY AND SOUGHT PROTECTION WITH GHANBATT TROOPS. IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE FRGF SOLDIER WAS PLACED IN KIBUNGO PRISON AFTER BEING HANDED OVER.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) SECTOR COMD HELD MEETING WITH RPA BDE COMD GITARAMA TO DISCUSS MARKING AND SAFETY OF ROAD BLOCKS AT NIGHT, COOPERATION BETWEEN RPA AND UNAMIR, ILLEGAL ARRESTS OF LOCALS BY RPA AND A PROPOSED JOINT PATROL SCHEDULED FOR MON 20 FEB 95. RPA BDE COMD APPEARED COOPERATIVE AND ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT ALL POINTS DISCUSSED. DETAILED REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.

(3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE (GR 8374). THE BOURGEMESTRE INFORMED MILOBS THAT HE REQUIRED ASSISTANCE TO REPAIR 2615 HOUSES DESTROYED DURING THE WAR. HE ALSO COMPLAINED THAT VERY FEW DPS HAD

RETURNED TO HIS COMMUNE. SEEDS AND HOES WERE ALSO REPORTED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY.

(4) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN RUTOBWE (GR 7681) AND KAYENZI (GR 8338) COMMUNES TO FAMILIARISE THEMSELVES WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND TO INVESTIGATE RUMORS OF HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES. THE PATROL ALSO LOCATED ONE OF THE SEVERAL CHILDREN REPORTED TO BE MISSING IN KAYENZI AND RETURNED HIM TO A RELATIVE IN GITARAMA.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED MBUGA (GR 4224), NYAMIGYANA (GR 4523), MURAMBI (GR 5128) AND KARAMABI (GR 5622) AS PART OF OF RETOUR. DPS WERE EVACUATED FORM THE CAMP AT MBUGA BY UNHCR. DESTINATIONS OF THE DPS WERE TO KIGALI, GITSARAMA, BUTARE AND KIBUNGO. ZAMBATT TROOPS PROVIDED SECURITY AND AUSMED PROVIDED MEDICAL COVER FOR THE EVACUATION.

(3) PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN NDAGO (GR 5102), MUNINI (GR 4800) KAMANA (GR 5197) AND REMERA (GR 4192). DPS WERE EVACUATED FROM SEVERAL CAMPS IN THE SECTOR. SOME DPS OF THE NDAGO CAMP INFORMED MILOBS THAT OTHER DPS WHO HAD RETURNED HOME HAD REPORTED THAT THEY HAD BEEN ARRESTED AND GIVEN INHUMAN TREATMENT BY RPA TROOPS IN THEIR HOME COMMUNES.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED HELI RECCE FROM KIVUMU (GR 5573) TO BWAKIRA (GR 4981). THE RECCE ALSO COVERED THE BWIZA (GR 3694) - MURUNDA ROAD AND THE NATURAL FOREST IN THE AREA OF GISHWAT (GR 3694). THE KIVUMU-BWAKIRA ROAD AND THE BWIZA- MURUNDA ROAD HAD BOTH BEEN RENDERED IMPASSABLE BY LANSLIDES, HEAVY RAINS AND NEGLECT. TWO CAMPS WERE LOCATED IN THE GWISHAT FOREST AT GR 3298 (29 24'E/1 48'S). THE CAMPS WERE ABOUT 100 M APART AND APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN RECENTLY VACATED.

(3) MILOBS PATROLLED TO GISOVU AND GISHYITA TO COLLECT INFO ON THE VACANCY RATES. THE PATROL TO GISOVU WAS INFORMED OF AN INCIDENT ON THE NIGHT OF 7/8 FEB 95 IN WHICH 9 BOATS WHICH ATTEMPTED TO LAND IN GOMA (GR 2159) WERE ATTACKED. THE ATTACKERS ESCAPED IN TWO OF THE BOATS. RPA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE ARRESTED TWO LOCALS SUSPECTED OF HAVING COLLABORATED WITH THE BANDITS. THE TWO SUSPECTS ARE PRESENTLY IN THE KIBUYE PRISON.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE LOCAL POPULATION WAS REPORTED TO BE STILL UNEASY ABOUT THE RECENT SPATE OF RPA ARRESTS.

(2) MILOB PATROLS TO KAGANO AND FAMBIRA (GR 0144) CONFIRMED THAT THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND OTHER PERSONS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED BY THE RPA HAVE BEEN TRANSFERRED TO KIGALI. (SITREP OF 13 FEB REFERS) THE EXACT NUMBER OF PERSONS ARRESTED COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO THE UNCOOPERATIVE ATTITUDE OF LOCALS ARISING FROM FEAR OF RPA REPRISALS.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED INVESTIGATIONS INTO TWO SEPARATE REPORTS OF MURDER IN BATUKA (GR 3129) AND KABATWE. PRELIMINARY FINDINGS INDICATE THAT THE RPA WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE KILLING OF ONE MAN IN BATUKA. LOCAL EYE WITNESSES ATTRIBUTED THE MURDER OF A COUPLE IN KABATWE TO THE ARMED CIVILIANS FROM ZAIRE WHO WERE SUSPECTED TO BE INTERAHAMWE.

(3) MILOBS ALSO PATROLLED GISENYI, MUKAMIRA (GR 4521), KARAGO (GR 4516), GICEYE (GR 5111) AND GASEKE (4904) TO MONITOR THE WELL-BEING OF RETURNEES SINCE THEIR RETURN. IT WAS REPORTED THAT RETURNEES WERE GENERALLY WELL TAKEN CARE OF BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THEY WERE HOWEVER LOW ON FOOD SUPPLY. MILOBS INTEND TO LIAISE WIT UNHCR TO ASSIST.

(4) SECTOR COMD PAID FIRST COURTESY CALL ON COMD OF THE RPA BDE LOCATED IN RUHENGARI. IT WAS AGREED THAT THERE SHOULD BE CLOSE COOPERATION BETWEEN TO ENSURE A GOOD WORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RPA TROOPS AND UNAMIR.

j. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN BYTAMWA AND KANOMBE COMMUNES DURING THE PERIOD. THE SITUATION WAS CALM IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED.



(a) MILOBS IN SECTOR 4C REPORTED THAT RPA ARRESTED THE BOURGEMESTRE, THE SECRETARY AND THE INSPECTOR OF SCHOOLS IN THE KAGANO COMMUNE. 5 MORE PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FROM THE FAMBIRA AREA (GR 0144). ONE OF THOSE ARRESTED WAS A LOCAL EMPLOYEE OF UNHCR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

THE NGO MEMISA HAD EMBARKED ON A VACCINATION EXERCISE.

(3) MILOB PATROL TO KIGOMA COMMUNE (GR 7750) WERE INFORMED BY THE BOURGEMESTRE OF THE LARGE NUMBER OF UNOCCUPIED HOUSES IN THE COMMUNE. HE SAID THERE WAS NO NEED FOR EXTRA CONSTRUCTION TO ACCOMMODATE RETURNEES. HE ALSO EXPRESSED HIS SATISFACTION WITH THE RECENT CURRENCY EXCHANGE EXERCISE. HOSPITAL AUTHORITIES REPORTED THAT MOST LOCALS WERE TOO POOR TO PAY THE FEES. 

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN BYUMBA, GATUNA (GR 0142), RUSHAKI (GR 1093) MURAMBI (GR 4601 NYAGATARE (GR 3550), KIZIGURO (GR 4205) AND RWMAGANA. REFUGEE TRUST IRELAND WHICH RUNS THE HEALTH CENTRE AT RWESERO, WAS REPORTED TO BE IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE TO CONSTRUCT A SOAKAGE PIT AND SEPTIC TANK FOR THE CENTRE. THE ACCESS ROAD LEADING TO THE HEALTH CENTRE AT KIYANZA (GR 0605) IS REPORTED TO BE IN A BAD STATE AND VEHICLES PLYING THE

ROUTE ARE IN DANGER OF SLIDING DOWN WHERE LANDSLIDES HAVE TAKEN PLACE. THE PREFECT OF BYUMBA WAS ALSO REPORTED TO BE FACING PROBLEMS WITH FINDING SUITABLE GRAZING AREAS FOR ABOUT 400,000 COWS WHICH HAVE CROSSED THE BORDER INTO THE SECTOR. IT WAS INDICATED THAT THE CATTLE WERE GRAZING IN THE AKAGERA NATIONAL PARK.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIBUNGO, MUGESERA (GR 4764), AND MUGATARE (GR 4466) TO INVESTIGATE THE REPORTED MURDER OF TWO WOMEN CLOSE TO BARE. THE ONLY LOCAL INTERVIEWED WAS TOO FRIGHTENED OF BEING SEEN TALKING TO MILOBS. INVESTIGATION IS STILL IN PROGRESS.

(3) MILOBS ALSO INVESTIGATED REPORTS OF THE EXISTENCE OF CLANDESTINE PRISONS IN MUGESERA (GR 4764), BIRENGA (GR 5958) AND SAKE (GR 4354). PRELIMINARY REPORT INDICATED THAT THERE WERE 10 PRISONERS IN THE SAKE PRISON AND 20 IN THE MUGESERA PRISON. HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS HAVE BEEN REFUSED ACCESS TO THE THREE AREAS. FULL REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED ON COMPLETION ON INVESTIGATION.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN RUNYINYA COMMUNE AND TO THE BORDER POST AT KANYARU-HAUTE. MILOBS OBSERVED THAT LOCALS HAD BEEN ADVISED TO LIVE CLOSE TO EACH OTHER DUE TO FREQUENT INCIDENTS OF ARMED ROBBERY.



e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE SECTOR COMD AND HQ STAFF MET AND BRIEFED A VISITING UN DELEGATION AT KIBEHO FROM 1400 HRS TO 1430 HRS. THE DELEGATION WAS LED BY THE POLITICAL ASSISTANT TO THE SECRETARY GENERAL.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED REMERA (GR 4192) AND AKABUGA (GR 5089) BORDER POSTS AS PART OF OP RUBY DURING THE PERIOD. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN SEVERAL PARTS OF THE SECTOR. THE SITUATION WAS NORMAL IN ALL AREA PATROLLED.

(2) MILOBS TEAMS WERE ON STAND BY FOR ANY TASK DURING THE PERIOD. ROUTINE ADMIN DUTIES WERE ALSO PERFORMED.

k. AIR OPS.

(1) A SPECIAL REPORT SUBMITTED BY UNAMIR AIR OPS INDICATED THAT A SECURITY STAFF MEMBER DEMANDED THAT AIR OPS MILOBS AT THE AIRPORT RETURN THEIR AIRPORT VEHICLE PASS TO HIM. HIS DEMAND WAS TURNED DOWN BY THE MILOBS. THE AIRPORT SECURITY STAFF WAS INFORMED TO ROUTE HIS DEMAND THROUGH UNAMIR HQ. AIR OPS PERSONNEL AT THE AIRPORT WERE SUBJECTED TO REPEATED SEARCHES ON EACH ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT. THE REPORT INDICATED THAT THERE SEEMED TO BE A DELIBERATE ATTEMPT TO PREVENT MILOBS AT THE AIRPORT FROM PERFORMING THEIR DUTIES. FURTHER DETAILS TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.

(1) TOTAL OF 21 FLIGHTS WERE UNDERTAKEN AT THE KIGALI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT DURING THE PERIOD. BREAKDOWN IS AS FOLLOWS:

c. TOTAL OF 208 RETURNEES WERE REPATRIATED TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES IN KABAYA (GR 4906) AND SATINSYI (GR 5900) IN SECTOR 5. IN THE SAME SECTOR, AN ORGANISED CONVOY OF 250 RETURNEES WAS RECEIVED FROM THE KIBUMBA CAMP IN ZAIRE. REGISTRATION OF THE LATTER GROUP BY UNHCR OFFICIALS IS STILL IN PROGRESS.







9. CIVIL POPULATION

THE TEAM MET COORDINATOR OF KICUKIRO COMMUNE MR. KAYRA PAUL WHO INFORMED THE MILOBS THAT THERE ARE 70 -75,000 RESIDENTS IN THE AREA.

THE MAIN PROBLEMS OF THE POPULATION ARE SHORTAGE OF FOOD AS MOST OF THE PEOPLE ARE POOR AND JOBLESS. THERE ARE ALSO MANY WIDOWS WITH CHILDREN AND ORPHANS IN THE AREA. DUE TO THE LACK OF AGRICULTURAL LAND, SEEDS AND IMPLEMENTS PEOPLE CAN NOT PROVIDE THEMSELVES WITH ENOUGH FOOD.

ELECTRICITY ARE GIVEN ONLY TO SOME PARTS OF THE COMMUNE ON A VERY IRREGULAR BASIS. THERE IS A GREAT DEMAND OF DRINKING WATER AND EVEN WATER FOR HOUSEKEEPING NEEDS IN THE WHOLE COMMUNE. HA

THERE IS NO MEDICAL FACILITIES IN 3 OF 5 SECTORS OF THE AREA NAMELY : KIMISANGE, GATENGA, KAGARAMA. IN ADDITION THERE IS NO GOVERNMENTAL OR CITY TRANSPORT SERVICE AND PEOPLE HAVE TO WALK MANY MILES TO SEE A DOCTOR IN KIGALI CITY.

MOST OF THE SCHOOLS WERE DAMAGED AND LACKS DOORS, WINDOWS AND SOMETIMES EVEN ROOF. GATENGA SECTOR DOESN'T HAVE PRIMARY SCHOOL AT ALL.

THE COORDINATOR COMPLAINED THAT HIS OFFICE NEED TO BE REPAIRED AND HE DOESN'T HAVE ANY TRANSPORT MEANS TO COORDINATE THE ACTIVITIES IN DIFFERENT SECTORS OF THE COMMUNE.



THEY HOWEVER REFUSED TO ALLOW MILOBS ASSESS TO THE BUILDING SUSPECTED TO BE HOUSING THE PRISON. MILOBS ALSO REFUSED TO PROVIDE THE RPA OFFICER IN CHARGE WITH THE NAMES OF THE WITNESSES. THE RPA OFFICER PROMISED MORE INFO TO THE MILOBS IN TWO DAYS. INVESTIGATION CONTINUES.

(3) MILOBS ALSO CONDUCTED PATROLS IN TABA, RUTOBWE AND KAYENZI COMMUNE TO COLLECT INFO FOR COMMUNE FILES. SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREAS PATROLLED WAS GOOD.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN RUKONDO AND KIRARO AS PART OF OP RETOUR. IT WAS ESTIMATED THAT THERE WERE 600 PS IN THE RUKONDO DPC. SITUATION IN THE CAMPS WAS NORMAL.

(3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN MURUNDA (GR 3008), RUTSIRO (GR 3138), NYABIRANGA (GR 4860) TO ASSES THE PERFORMANCE OF SCHOOLS, MEDICAL FACILITIES AND ESSENTIAL SERVICES. IT WAS OBSERVED THAT THE SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE AREA WERE GENERALLY RUN DOWN AND SHORT OF TEXTBOOKS, STATIONERY AND OFFICE EQUIPMENT. THE SOUS PREFECT OF BIRAMBO COMPLAINED OF SEVERE CROWDING AND SHORTAGE OF FOOD FOR THE INMATES OF THE PRISON IN HIS COMMUNE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KICUKURO COMMUNE DURING THE PERIOD. THE SITUATION IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED WAS NORMAL.

a. TOTAL OF 788 DPS WERE EVACUATED FROM DPCS IN SECTOR 4A DURING THE PERIOD. BREAKDOWN IS AS FOLLOWS:



3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN RWMAGANA, GATUNA, GAHINI, KIZIGURO, MATIMBA AND KAGITUMBA. 

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS. THE DFC/CMO CONDUCTED ROUTINE TOURS OF FORMED TROOP LOCATIONS IN SECTORS 4A AND 4B DURING THE PERIOD.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN RWMAGANA, KIYANMZA (GR (0705), KIVUYE, BUNGWE, GAKUBO, KAYANZA AND KAGITUMBA. INVESTIGATIONS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED INTO A MURDER OF ONE LOCAL IN KIYANZA SECTOR. IT WAS CONFIRMED THAT FIVE PERSONS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE MURDER AND ARE PRESENTLY BEING DETAINED IN KIGALI PENDING INVESTIGATIONS.

(3) MILOB PATROLS ALSO MET THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUGAMBAZI COMMUNE (GR 0903) WHO REQUESTED AN EOD TEAM TO CLEAR MINES ON THE ROAD FROM KIYANZA (GR 0705) TO MUGAMBAZI (GR 0903) AND TABA (GR 0113). TOTAL DISTANCE TO BE CLEARED IS 11 KM. THE SECURITY SITUATION IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED WAS HOWEVER REPORTED NORMAL.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN SEVERAL AREAS INCLUDING BORDER POSTS WITHIN THE SECTOR. IT WAS REPORTED THAT 120 DPS WERE EVACUATED TO THE ORC AT RILIMA. AN UNSPECIFIED NUMBER OF RETURNEES WERE ALSO SEEN ARRIVING INTO NYAMATA. TOTAL FIGURE WILL BE SUBMITTED ON FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

IN MUGINA, IT WAS REPORTED THAT LOCATIONS HAVE BEEN SITED FOR RE-BURIAL OF CORPSES OF SHALLOW MASS GRAVES. DATE FOR RE-BURIAL IS YET TO BE ASCERTAINED.

(3) INVESTIGATIONS WERE CONDUCTED INTO ALLEGED KILLING OF A LOCAL BY RPA IN THE NTYAZO COMMUNE ON THE NIGHT 03/04 FEB 95. THE INCIDENT IS STILL UNDER INVESTIGATION. DETAILED REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED ON COMPLETION.

(4) MILOBS ALSO CONDUCTED INVESTIGATIONS INTO A FIRING INCIDENT WHICH OCCURRED ON NIGHT 02/03 FEB 95 IN THE KALIBANA (GR 7012). INFO GATHERED INDICATES THAT A DRUNK RPA SOLDIER FIRED 3 ROUNDS INTO THE AIR. THE SOLDIER WAS REPORTED TO BE UNDER ARREST.



e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) NEWLY-POSTED MILOBS WERE CONDUCTED ON A FAMILIARISATION TOUR OF VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND DPCS IN THE SECTOR. MILOBS ALSO CONDUCTED PATROLS AT THE BORDER POSTS AS PART OF OP RETOUR AND OP RUBY. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS CALM. THE EVACUATION OF DPS FROM THE VARIOUS CAMPS WAS ALSO MONITORED.

IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE LOCAL RPA TROOPS ARE AWARE OF THESE BANDITS BUT ARE PREVENTED FROM ACTING DUE TO THE LIMITED STRENGTH OF THEIR DETACHMENT IN THE AREA.

(3) PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN THE GENERAL AREA OF NYABITARA (GR 6822). LOCALS COMPLAINED OF FREQUENT INCIDENTS OF BANDITRY. INCIDENTS HAVE SO FAR BEEN CONFINED TO THE THEFT OF LIVESTOCK AND CROPS. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES FROM BANDITRY REPORTED.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLS DURING THE PERIOD WERE AIMED AT FAMILIARISING NEWLY-POSTED MILOBS WITH THE SECTOR AOR. AREAS PATROLLED WERE REPORTED NORMAL. NO INCIDENT WAS

REPORTED.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED RUHENGARI, CYANIKA, (GR 7152) CYERU, KIDAHU (GR 7247), BUTARO (GR 8243), AND BUSHOKO (GR 7223). THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL IN AREAS PATROLLED, HOWEVER MEDICAL AUTHORITIES REPORTED AN OUTBREAK OF MEASLES AMONG CHILDREN IN CYERU.

(3) MILOBS CONDUCTED A JOINT PATROL WITH THE UNHCR REP AND CIVPOL IN GISENYI, KAMANA (GR 2712), KIVUMU (GR 2303), MUTURA (GR 3123) AND RWERERE (GR 2772). THE PATROL LIAISED WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND ACQUIRED A LIST OF PERSONS WHO URGENTLY REQUIRED AID IN THE VARIOUS LOCATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ARRANGING HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE FOR THEM AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY. THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREAS PATROLLED WAS NORMAL.

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE VARIOUS SECTORS IN GIKOMERO COMMUNE (GR 9416) TO FAMILIARISE NEWLY-POSTED MILOBS TO THE SECTOR. RPA WAS REPORTED BY LOCALS TO BE CARRYING OUT INTENSIVE FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS IN THE AREA BY DAY AND BY NIGHT. THE SECURITY SITUATION WAS THEREFORE CONSIDERED GOOD.

(3) PATROLS ALSO CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN KACYIRU COMMUNE. THERE WAS NO INCIDENT TO REPORT. THE SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE WAS NORMAL.



1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATU A AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL.

(1) THE PRIME MINISTER OF RWANDA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE MET THE BRITISH AMBASSADOR AND COMMONWEALTH REPRESENTATIVE DURING THE PERIOD. IT WAS ANNOUNCED DURING THE MEETING THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF US\$3 BILLION TO THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) THE FOREIGN MINISTER MET THE FRENCH AMBASSADOR ON 02 FEB 95. THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF GOOD RELATIONS BETWEEN RWANDA AND FRANCE WAS DISCUSSED. IT WAS DECIDED TO RE-OPEN THE FRENCH CULTURAL CENTRE. IT WAS ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT HAD ALREADY GIVEN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF 35 MILLION FFR TO THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA

(a) RPA TROOPS ON CHECK POINT DUTY AT GASHORA IN SECTOR 2 DENIED PASSAGE TO A MILOB PATROL. THEY INSISTED THAT THE PATROL SHOULD HAVE AN AUTHORITY LETTER FROM THEIR LOCAL COMMANDER AT NGENDA

(b) RPA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE INCREASED THE STRENGTH OF ITS TROOPS ALONG THE SHORES OF LAKE KIVU IN THE AREA OF RWMATAMU (GR 5715) IN SECTOR 1B.

(c) RPA REPORTEDLY CARRIED OUT A CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION IN KAGANO COMMUNE IN SECTOR 4C ON 31 JAN 95. FIVE PERSONS, SUSPECTED TO BE BANDITS WERE ARRESTED DURING THE OPERATION. IN THE SAME SECTOR AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE WAS REPORTED TO HAVE TAKEN PLACE BETWEEN RPA TROOPS AND BANDITS ON KIREHE PENINSULA AROUND 022000B. NO CASUALTIES OR ARRESTS WERE REPORTED.

(d) ONE MAN, LATER IDENTIFIED TO BE A FORMER MILITIA WAS SHOT DEAD BY TROOPS AT RWESERO MARKET AROUND MIDNIGHT ON 02 FEB 95. BODY OF THE DECEASED HAS BEEN HANDED OVER TO HIS FAMILY IN GISHARA FOR BURIAL.

(2) FRGF.

(a) FRGF TROOPS MANNING THE CROSSING POINT AT UVIRA (GR 8900) WERE REPORTED BY SECTOR 4C MILOBS TO HAVE BEEN REPLACED BY GENDARMERIE. IT IS THOUGHT THAT REASON WAS BECAUSE THE FRGF TROOPS HAD A TRG DAY. SECTOR 4C MILOBS INVESTIGATING.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN RWMAGANA, SHONGA (GR 8653), UKOMO (GR 9146) AND NYAGATARE TO LIAISE WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND NGOS AND TO IDENTIFY THE MINE FIELDS IN THE AREAS. FARMERS IN THE NORTH-EASTERN PART OF THE SECTOR ARE BEING ENCOURAGED TO CULTIVATE TOBACCO AND BEANS. IT WAS ALSO REPORTED THAT CARITAS IS PLANNING TO LAUNCH A SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAMME FOR WIDOWS, ORPHANS AND HANDICAPPED PEOPLE IN THE NORTHERN PART OF THE SECTOR. THE PATROL TO LOCATE MINEFIELDS WAS HOWEVER RESCHEDULED FOR 6 FEB 95 DUE TO THE ABSENCE OF THE AUSTRALIAN RELIEF PROGRAMME WHO WAS TO POINT OUT THE KNOWN MINEFIELDS.

(3) DEPUTY SECTOR COMD AND SOO MILOB GP HQ HELD CONFERENCE WITH LOCAL RPA BN COMD TO LOCATE NEW AREAS FOR THE DEPLOYMENT OF MILOBS IN THE NYAGATARE SUB SECTOR. SUITABLE AREAS OF DEPLOYMENT WERE HOWEVER NOT WITHIN THE AOR OF THE LOCAL RPA BN COMD. THE RPA COMD IS TO LIAISE WITH THE RESPONSIBLE COMD AND COORDINATE ARRANGEMENTS FOR A HELI RECCE OF HE PREFERRED AREAS.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN SEVERAL AREAS INCLUDING BORDER POSTS WITHIN THE SECTOR. NO INCIDENT WAS REPORTED AND THE SITUATION WAS NORMAL IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED. A PATROL OF GASHORA WAS HOWEVER HALTED BY RPA CHECK POINT TROOPS.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONTINUED INVESTIGATIONS AT SHYOGWE AND RULLI SECTORS OF NYAMABUYE COMMUNE TO GATHER LISTS OF PERSONS WHO HAD ALLEGEDLY DISAPPEARED. THE LIST PROVIDED WAS MUCH SHORTER THAN MILOBS ANTICIPATED. IT WAS SUSPECTED THAT THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES WERE EITHER RELUCTANT TO SPEAK TO NEW MILOBS OR HAD BEEN THREATENED BY AN UNKNOWN AUTHORITY. MILOBS TO CONTINUE SUBTLE INVESTIGATIONS.

(3) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ANOTHER INVESTIGATION OF AN INCIDENT IN RUNYINYA COMMUNE IN WHICH AN ELDERLY WOMAN WAS MACHETED ON THE NIGHT 02/03 FEB 95. THE VICTIM IS CURRENTLY UNDER TREATMENT AT MSF HOSPITAL IN BUTARE. IN ANOTHER REPORTED INCIDENT AT BUHORO (GR 5710) ON THE NIGHT 01/02 FEB 95, 4 PERSONS WERE INJURED IN A SIMILAR INCIDENT. BOTH ATTACKS WERE SUSPECTED TO HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT BY BANDITS FROM THE GIKONGORO AREA.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) NEWLY-POSTED MILOBS WERE CONDUCTED ON A FAMILIARISATION TOUR OF VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND DPCS IN

THE SECTOR. PATROLS ALSO MONITORED THE EVACUATION OF  
DPS FROM THE RUKONDO AND KIRARO DPCS.

(3) MILOBS PATROLLED REMERA, AKABUGA, KAMANA (GR  
5197), MUNINI (GR 4800), AND SHORORO (GR 4385) AS PART  
OF OP RUBY. THERE WERE REPORTED TO BE ABOUT 35,000 990  
DPS AT THE KAMANA CAMP. THE INCREASE WAS ATTRIBUTED TO  
NEW ARRIVALS FROM THE RUKONDO DPC.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE  
PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT INVESTIGATIONS OF A REPORT OF  
AN INCIDENT OF BANDITRY WHICH OCCURRED AT RWABISINDU  
(GR 596514) AROUND 0200 HRS ON 01 FEB 95. 8 BANDITS  
ATTACKED A FAMILY IN THAT LOCATION. ONE MAN WAS KILLED  
IN THE RAID, 4 OTHERS, INCLUDING A 6-MONTH OLD BABY  
WERE ALSO INJURED. THREE OF THE WOUNDED ARE ON  
ADMISSION AT GOMA HOSPITAL AND ONE IS ON ADMISSION AT  
KARENGERA HEALTH CENTRE (GR 5013). BANDITS LOOTED  
LIVESTOCK AND SOME BEANS. INVESTIGATIONS STILL IN  
PROGRESS.

(3) MILOBS PATROLS TO RWABISINDU ALSO RECEIVED  
REPORTS OF OTHER INCIDENTS OF BANDITRY. TOTAL OF 17  
COWS HAVE BEEN RUSTLED OVER THE PAST WEEK. LOCALS IN  
THE AREA BELIEVE BANDITS MAY HAVE SOME COLLABORATORS  
AMONG THE LOCAL INHABITANTS SINCE THE BANDITS SEEM TO  
KNOW EXACTLY WHERE TO GO AND ARE ABLE TO AVOID RPA  
PATROLS. THE PREFECT ADDRESSED A GATHERING OF WORRIED  
LOCALS TO CALM THEIR FEARS ABOUT THE DETERIORATING  
SECURITY SITUATION.

(4) A PATROL TO BWAKIRA COMMUNE WAS ABORTED DUE TO  
THE POOR STATE OF THE ROUTE.

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KAGANO COMMUNE RWESERO AND KARENGERA COMMUNE. IN KAGANO COMMUNE, THE SECRETARY TO THE BOURGEMESTRE HAS BEEN REPORTED MISSING SINCE 28 JAN 95. LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN KARENGERA WERE REPORTED TO BE CARRYING OUT CENSUS OF THE ORPHANS AND UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN IN THE COMMUNE. A GERMAN NGO, PAM, IS TO IMPLEMENT A "FOOD FOR WORK" PROGRAMME IN THE COMMUNE. GENERAL SITUATION WAS ALSO REPORTED NORMAL.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED RUHENGERI (NYANIKI, (GR 7152) NYAMUTERA (GR 5819), NYABIKENKE (GR 7392) AND RUTOBWE (GR 7880) TO LIAISE WITH NGOS, LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND TO GATHER INFORMATION ON MINES. THE PATROL STRONGLY RECOMMEND ENGINEER ATTENTION TO THE BRIDGE AT GR 661081.

(3) MILOBS CONDUCTED A JOINT PATROL WITH THE UNHCR REP IN GISENYI, KAMANA GR 2712, KIVUMU (GR 2303) AND KAYOVE (GR 2792). THE PATROL LIAISED WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND ACQUIRED A LIST OF PERSONS WHO URGENTLY REQUIRED AID IN THE VARIOUS LOCATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ARRANGING HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE FOR THEM AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY. THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREAS PATROLLED WAS NORMAL.

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN KACYIRU COMMUNE. THERE IS REPORTED TO BE FREQUENT NGO ASSISTANCE TO THE COMMUNE ESPECIALLY IN THE AREA OF FOOD ASSISTANCE TO THE FAMILIES. THE GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREA IS REPORTED AS GOOD. MILOBS WOULD HOWEVER RECOMMEND A STRONGER PRESENCE OF GENDARMES IN THE AREA.

a. THE AUSTRALIAN RELIEF PROGRAMME IN SECTOR 1 IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WFP IS REPORTED BE CONSIDERING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A FOOD FOR WORK PROGRAMME FOR THE COMMUNITY GARDEN AT NGARAMA (GR 2629).



1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL.

(1) PREFECT OF KIBUYE HELD MEETING WITH LOCALS OF RWAMATAMU DURING THE PERIOD TO CALM THEIR FEARS ABOUT RECENT WATER-BORNE INCURSIONS INTO THE AREA.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA

(a) RPA CURFEW IN CYANGUGU (SECTOR 4C) IS REPORTED TO BE STILL IN FORCE. DURING THE PERIOD, A CONFERENCE WAS HELD FOR ALL RPA OFFERS IN CYANGUGU (GR 7824). THE MAIN DISCUSSION WAS ON HOW TO PREVENT ILLEGAL BORDER CROSSING AND INCIDENTS OF BANDITRY AND LOOTING.

(2) FRGF. NTR.

(3) OTHER MILITARY ACTIVITY. MILOBS IN SECTOR 4C REPORTED THAT THE HARASSMENT OF REFUGEES CROSSING THE BORDER BY ZAIREAN TROOPS STILL CONTINUES. IT WAS CONSIDERED THAT THE RECENT PROPOSAL FOR ZAIREAN TROOPS TO PROVIDE SECURITY IN THE CAMPS MAY BE COUNTER-PRODUCTIVE IN VIEW OF THE POOR DISCIPLINARY RECORD OF ZAIREAN BORDER TROOPS.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS. SECTOR COMDS' CONFERENCE WAS HELD IN SECTOR 3 HQ (GITARAMA) DURING THE PERIOD.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN BYUMBA, RWMAGANA, GITINGURO, GATUNA AND NYAGATARE TO LIAISE WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND TO COLLECT INFO ON MINES IN THE AREAS PATROLLED. INFO WAS COLLECTED ON MINEFIELDS IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

(a) SHONGA (GR 8653).

(b) RUKOMO (GR 9146).

(c) RWEMPASIA (GR 9965).

(d) KABARO (GR 0563).

(e) AIRPORT STRIP EAST OF NYAGATARE.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED INVESTIGATIONS OF AN ALLEGED KILLING OF A WOMAN AND HER CHILDREN IN KAYONZA. INVESTIGATIONS STILL IN PROGRESS. INVESTIGATIONS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED INTO THE ALLEGED ARRESTS OF 2 IDPS IN MUGESERA AND SAKÉ BY THE RPA FOR THEIR ALLEGED PARTICIPATION IN MASSACRES DURING THE WAR. THE BOURGEMESTRE OF SAKÉ CONFIRMED THAT THE TWO PEOPLE WERE STILL IN DETENTION.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE SECTOR HOSTED THE SECTOR COMDS' CONFERENCE AT THE SECTOR HQ DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONTINUED THE INVESTIGATION OF THE BANDIT ATTACK IN THE NYARUBANGWE SECTOR (GR 7332) OF THE NYAKI COMMUNE ON THE NIGHT 30/31 JAN 95 IN WHICH 2 WERE KILLED AND ONE WAS INJURED. (SITREP OF 01 FEB 95 REFERS) IT WAS CONFIRMED THAT THE CRIMES WERE COMMITTED BY BANDITS. INVESTIGATION IS CONSIDERED CLOSED.

(3) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED TO THE BORDER CROSSING POINT AT KANYARU-HAUTE. NO BORDER CROSSING FIGURES WERE AVAILABLE.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) NEWLY-POSTED MILOBS WERE CONDUCTED ON A FAMILIARISATION TOUR OF VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND DPCS IN THE SECTOR. PATROLS ALSO MONITORED THE EVACUATION OF DPS FROM THE DPCS IN THE SECTOR. VEHICLES FROM UNHCR, ZAMBATT AND NIBATT WERE USED FOR THE EVACUATION. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL IN ALL THE DPCS.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN RWMATAMU COMMUNE. THEY WERE HINTED OF WATER-BORNE INCURSIONS INTO THE AREA BY UNSPECIFIED FORCES. PATROLS COULD HOWEVER NOT BE COMPLETED DUE TO THEIR INVOLVEMENT IN A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT. AT THE TIME OF SUBMISSION OF SITREP PATROL AND NOT RETURNED. RECOVERY WAS ARRANGED FOR THE VEHICLES. FULL REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

(3) MILOBS ALSO CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIVUME COMMUNE. THE BOURGEMESTRE COMPLAINED THAT MILOB PATROLS ALWAYS ASK THE SAME QUESTIONS BUT HE NEVER RECEIVED ANY RESULTS OR FEED BACK. SECTOR OPS OFFR TO DISCUSS THE PROBLEM WITH HAC AND UNREO.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE GENERAL AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY. THE SITUATION IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED



WAS GENERALLY NORMAL.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED RUHENGARI, CYANIKA, (GR 7152) KIDAHU GR (7247) BUTARO (GR 8243), KIRAMBO (GR 8335) AND BUSHORA (GR 7223) TO LIAISE WITH NGOS, LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND TO GATHER INFORMATION ON THE STATE OF MEDICAL FACILITIES IN THE VARIOUS COMMUNES VISITED. SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL. THERE ARE HOWEVER REPORTED TO BE GENERAL SHORTAGES OF DRUGS AND HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT AT THE VARIOUS MEDICAL CENTRES IN THE PREFECTURE.

(3) MILOBS CONDUCTED A JOINT HELI RECCE WITH THE SECTOR POLITICAL TEAM, UNHCR REP, HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM AND TUNBATT ESCORT OVER THE AREAS OF KIDAHU (GR 7047), BUTARO (GR 8144) AND CYERU (GR 8034). PATROL REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.

(4) NEWLY-POSTED CIVPOL PERSONNEL TO THE SECTOR WERE BRIEFED ON ACTIVITIES AND OPERATIONS IN THE SECTOR DURING THE PERIOD.

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN KANOMBE COMMUNE TO MONITOR THE SECURITY SITUATION AND THE STATE OF EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES. MILOBS WERE BRIEFED BY VARIOUS LOCAL AUTHORITIES. LOCALS COMPLAINED ABOUT OCCASIONAL ROBBERIES BY ARMED UNIFORMED MEN BUT DECLINED TO GIVE DETAILS WHEN PRESSED BY MILOBS. THE ONLY PRIMARY SCHOOL IN THE AREA IS STILL CLOSED AND POTABLE WATER IS IN SHORT SUPPLY. MILOBS WERE ALSO INFORMED THAT

THERE WAS INFREQUENT ASSISTANCE FROM NGOS TO THE COMMUNE.

(3) ESCORTS WERE PROVIDED FOR BROWN AND ROOTS COMPANY TRUCKS TO CYANGUGU. THE ESCORT TASK WILL LAST FOR TWO DAYS.


