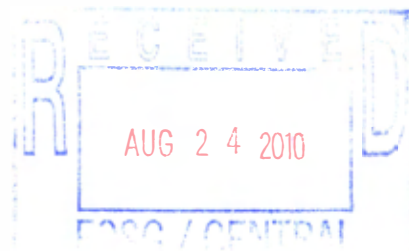

INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS, the Government of the Republic of Zambia signed the African Nuclear- Weapon – Free Zone Treaty (the Treaty of Pelindaba) on 11th April, 1996;

AND WHEREAS, Article 18(1) of the said Treaty provides that it shall be subject to ratification by the parties thereto;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of the Republic of Zambia having considered the Treaty hereby **CONFIRMS** and **RATIFIES** the same for and on behalf of the Republic of Zambia and undertakes to faithfully observe the provisions and carry out the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I Kabinga J. Pande, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Zambia have signed these presents.
