KIGOMBE COMMUNE: REPRESENTATIVE OF MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION INFORMED THE TEAM THAT FROM JULY TO DATE 513 RETURNEES HAVE ARRIVED IN THE COMMUNE. FURTHER MORE, HE SAID THE TOTAL NUMBER OF RETURNEES STOOD AT 36,647 AND SINCE DEC ONLY 39 RETURNEES HAVE BEEN REGISTERED. THE ABOVE FIGURES ARE ON 1994 RETURNEES. HOUSING PROJECT BEING UNDER TAKEN BY AUSTRIAN RELIEF PROGRAMME FOR THE 1959 RETURNEES HAS STOPPED DUE TO THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE NGO FROM RWANDA.





(3) OTHERS: MSF RUHENGERI (FROM HOLLAND) GAVE A TELEPHONE CALL ON 07 DEC AT 2030 HOURS AND INFORMED DUTY OFFICER THAT ONE OF THEIR CAR WAS FIRED UPON FROM THE DIRECTION OF BANANA GARDEN (GR 585335) WHEN THE VEHICLE WAS MOVING FROM ONE HOUSE TO ANOTHER WITHIN RUHENGERI TOWN. IMMEDIATELY RPA BN COMD WAS CONTACTED WHO SAID THAT FEW ROUNDS WERE FIRED INCLUDING TRACER AMMUNITION FROM THE DIRECTION OF THAT BANANA GARDEN BY SOME ONE. THERE WAS A GENDARMERIE NIGHT PATROL NEAR BY WHO HEARD THE FIRING AND IMMEDIATELY THEY WERE REINFORCED TO INVESTIGATE THE INCIDENT. FINALLY IT COULD NOT BE REVEALED WHO ACTUALLY FIRED BUT RPA AND GENDARMERIE SAID THAT FIRING WAS NOT INTENDED TOWARDS THE VEHICLE OF MSF. HOWEVER, MSF STILL THINKS THAT FIRING WAS DIRECTED WITH THE INTENTION TO HIT THEIR VEHICLE.

- (3) OTHERS: IN KABARE-I SECTOR (5528) OF NYAKINAMA (5827) COMMUNE ON 061900 DEC, SEVERAL PEOPLE WENT TO A HOUSE AND SHOT AT ONE MAN NAMED WAGIYESU. THEY WERE WEARING BOTH UNIFORM AND CIVIL CLOTHS BUT ALL OF THEM HAD GUNS WITH THEM. LATER THEY WENT TO ANOTHER HOUSE VERY NEAR TO FORMER AND SHOT AT ANOTHER PERSON NAMED GAHAMANI. THESE TWO INJURED PERSONS ARE NOW UNDERGOING TREATMENT IN RUHENGIRI HOSPITAL. ACCORDING TO THEM AND THE LOCALS OF THE AREA, IT WAS VERY DIFFICULT FOR THEM TO IDENTIFY THOSE ATTACKERS. FURTHER DETAILS ON THE ISSUE IF OBTAINED WILL BE INTIMATED TO YOU IN TIME.

BUT LOCALS EXPRESSED THEIR CONCERN ABOUT THE WITHDRAWAL OF UNAMIR. ACCORDING TO THEM, STILL COMPLETE PEACE IS NOT PREVAILING IN RWANDA. ON THE OTHER HAND A LARGE NUMBER OF REFUGEES ARE YET TO RETURN FROM THE NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES. THEREFORE, UNAMIR MUST STAY TO ENSURE ALL THIS. THEY HAVE ALSO CONFIRMED THAT RESTRICTION HAS BEEN IMPOSED ON THEM ON INTER PREFECTURE / COMMUNE MOVEMENT. OF COURSE, ONE CAN GO WITH THE LEGAL PERMISSION OF COMMUNE AUTHORITIES. BUT MOST OF THEM DO NOT WANT TO MOVE FROM THEIR PRESENT LOCATIONS BECAUSE OF SECURITY REASON.

(A) COUNCILLOR OF RWAJA (6529) SECTOR NAMELY HITIMANA INFORMED THE TEAM THAT FEW RPA SOLDIERS ASKED HIM TO PROVIDE THE PISTOL OF HIS BROTHER WHO FLED TO ZAIRE LONG BACK. HE INFORMED THE RPA THAT THE PISTOL WAS TAKEN BY RPA IN MAR 94 AND FORMER COUNCILLOR WROTE A LETTER TO COMMUNE AUTHORITIES WITH THE LIST WHICH WAS TAKEN BY RPA IN MAR 94 INCLUDING THE PISTOL. DESPITE THAT, THE COUNCILLOR WAS BEATEN AND RPA TOOK HIM TO RUHONDO MILITARY CAMP WHERE HE RECEIVED MORE BEATING. ONE DAY LATER ON 22 NOV RPA OFFICERS FROM RUHENGERI INTERVENED INTO THE MATTER AND FINALLY ON 23 NOV HE WAS RELEASED. NOW HE IS BACK AT WORK BUT STILL UNDERGOING TREATMENT IN LOCAL HEALTH CENTER AS AN OUT PATIENT.

(B) SITUATION IS CALM BUT IT WAS REVEALED FROM THE LOCALS THAT MANY OF THEM WILL FEEL INSECURE IF UNAMIR LEAVES ON 08 DEC 95. SOME WERE HAPPY THAT THE MANDATE WAS EXTENDED FOR THREE MONTHS AS PER THE NEWS.

THEY ARE SUFFERING FROM HUNGER AS THEY DO NOT FIND ANY WORK IN THE SECTORS. THEY WANT TO GO TO KIGALI FOR JOB/WORK BUT AUTHORITIES DO NOT ISSUE PROPER DOCUMENTS IN THIS REGARD. THE MATER WAS ALSO CONFIRMED BY THE ASSISTANT BOURGMESTER OF NYAMUGALI COMMUNE. HE SAID THAT THEY NORMALLY DO NOT GIVE ANY PAPER TO THE LOCALS TO WORK OUT SIDE THE COMMUNE AREA BECAUSE IF THESE PEOPLE DO ANY UNTOWARD ACTIVITIES IN KIGALI/OTHER PLACES THEN THE WHOLE BLAME WILL ROLL DOWN TO THEM. 

OUT OF THEM, 03 ARE CHARGED WITH GENOCIDE AND 04 HAVE BEEN ARRESTED AS THEY DID NOT COME THROUGH OFFICIAL BORDER POST AND ALSO DID NOT REGISTER THEMSELVES IN THE COMMUNE.

NDUSU COMMUNE: THERE ARE 13 PRISONERS IN COMMUNE JAIL AND ONLY ONE OF THEM IS CHARGED WITH GENOCIDE. IT WAS ALSO INFORMED BY THE BOURGMESTER OF NYAKINAMA (5827) COMMUNE THAT DUE TO HEAVY RAIN ON 02 DEC 95, 11 HOUSES HAVE BEEN DESTROYED COMPLETELY AND 29 HOUSES WERE DAMAGED PARTIALLY. MANY DOMESTIC ANIMALS ALSO DIED AND COMMUNE AUTHORITIES ARE YET TO ESTIMATE THE TOTAL DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE RAIN.

FOR THIS REASON IN MANY SECTORS PATROLLING AT NIGHT BY THE LOCALS HAVE BEEN STOPPED. THIS COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED FROM COMMUNAL STAFF AS THE OFFICES WERE CLOSED.

THREE LOCALS IN KABARE -2 SECTOR LOST THEIR VALUABLE ITEMS DURING THE OPERATION.





IN RUTARE SECTOR (6127) ON 18 NOV AT NIGHT SOME UNKNOWN PERSONS WEARING MILITARY UNIFORM CAME TO ONE OF THE HOUSE OF LOCALS FOR STEALING. NEIGHBOURS WERE ALERT AND WHEN THEY STARTED SHOUTING, THIEVES ESCAPED BUT NEXT MORNING RPA FOUND ONE ANTI PERSONNEL GRENADE LEFT BY THE THIEVES ON THEIR WAY OF WITHDRAWAL.

BUTARO COMMUNE: THE BOURGMESTER HOLD A SECURITY MEETING WITH ALL SECTOR COUNCILLORS ON 15100 NOV 95. IT WAS DECIDED IN THE MEETING TO MAKE 3 PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURITY OUT OF EVERY 10 HOUSES. THOSE 3 WILL DO PATROLLING WITH THE SOLDIERS AT NIGHT. IN ADDITION, TO CREATE MINE AWARENESS AMONG THE LOCALS, THE COMMUNE IS SUPPLYING LEAFLETS CONTAINING THE PICTURE OF MINES TO THE LOCALS. TOTAL 8 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE JAIL AND 3 OF THEM WERE ARRESTED RECENTLY TO VISIT ZAIRE WITH IN FEW DAYS AFTER THEIR ARRIVAL IN RWANDA. SECOND TIME WHEN THEY CAME BACK TO COMMUNE THEY WERE ARRESTED AS THEY ARE SUSPECTED TO PASS VALUABLE INFORMATION TO THE FRGF. OVERALL SECURITY SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE IS CALM BUT PEOPLE ARE AT PANIC ABOUT THE MINE INCIDENTS IN OTHER COMMUNES.

NYAKINAMA COMMUNE: IPS OF THE COMMUNE INFORMED THE TEAM THAT MANY CASES OF ROBBERY HAVE BEEN REPORTED, IN MOST OF THEM THIEVES / BANDITS WERE ARMED WITH FIRE WEAPONS, GRENADES AND MACHETES. IN THIS MONTH 15 PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED IN NUKO SECTOR (5828), ONE ESCAPED WHEN DETAINED, BEING IN POSSESSION OF HAND GRENADE. PRESENTLY ONLY 3 DETAINEES IN THE SECTOR DETENTION CENTER. SECURITY SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE IS CALM.
