A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO KAYENZI COMMUNE 8389 AND REPORTED THAT THERE ARE 346 WIDOWS IN WHOLE COMMUNE, THESE WIDOWS ARE SAID TO BE LIVING WITH THEIR RELATIVES. THESE PEOPLE ARE IN NEED OF ALL THE BASIC HUMAN NEEDS. IT IS REPORTED THAT, SALVATION ARMY HAS GIVEN THEM FOOD AND BLANKETS SOME TWO MONTHS AGO. IT IS FURTHER REPORTED THAT, THIS SAME NGO HAS COMMENCED RECONSTRUCTING HOUSES FOR THE WIDOWS AT A RATE OF 5 PER SECTOR. FIGURES FOR ORPHANS COULD NOT BE OBTAINED SINCE THE AUTHORITIES DID NOT HAVE THE INFORMATION HAND.

ii) A CIVPOL TEAM TODAY WENT TO GITARAMA PRISON ON A FURTHER INVESTIGATION, FOLLOWING THE SHOOTING INCIDENT THAT TOOK PLACE THE NIGHT OF 28/29 JUN95. THE TEAM DID NOT GET ANYTHING NEW SINCE THE PRISON DIRECTOR CORROBORATED THE ALLEGATION WITH THE RPA GUARDS THAT THE PRISONERS WHO SHOT WERE ATTEMPTING TO ESCAPE. A DETAILED REPORT TO FOLLOW.



1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM. THE ROAD COMMUNICATION IN HINTERLANDS OF THE COMMUNE HAS SUFFERED GREATLY DUE TO THE HEAVY RAINS ON 13 MAY. MOST OF THE CELLULES REMAIN UNAPPROACHABLE. MILOBS PATROLS ARE NOW BEING ACCOMPANIED BY ARMED ESCORTS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
  - A. GITARAMA TEAM
    - i) ONE PATROL TO KIGOMA AND TAMBWE COMMUNE. SITUATION CALM. 1036 IDPS RETURNED FROM KIBEHO IN KIGOMA COMMUNE AND 984 IN TAMBWE COMMUNE. ICRC HAS STARTED ITS AID PROGRAM IN KIGOMA COMMUNE.
    - ii) ONE PATROL WENT ON GITARAMA - NYABISINDHU ROAD, TO MAP OUT THE WRECKAGE LITTERING THE ROAD, UPTO GITARAMA - BUTARE PREFECTURE BORDER. THE RECOVERY OF THESE VEHICLES WILL COMMENCE IN A COUPLE OF DAYS.
    - iii) ONE PATROL TO NYABEKENKE COMMUNE. SIT CALM.
  - B. KIBUYE TEAM
    - i) ONE PATROL TO RUTSIRO 3183 TO INVESTIGATE THE RUMOURS OF A SHOOTING AND BEATING CARRIED OUT BY THE RPA. THE TEAM FOUND OUT THAT THESE EVENTS DID TAKE PLACE AND THE DETAILS ARE AS

FOLLOWS :

ON 7 MAY ONE MAN WAS SHOT WHILE FLEEING THE RPA. HE WAS ADMITTED IN THE HOSPITAL AT MURUNDA 3088 FOR SURGERY. THE DOCTORS FEEL THAT THE PATIENT WOULD LOSE HIS LIMBS.

THE OTHER INCIDENT INVOLVED A WOMEN WHO WAS APPARENTLY MARRIED TO A HUTU WHO FLED TO ZAIRE. THE RPA SAID THAT SHE HAD TO DIVIDE HER BELONGINGS BETWEEN HER AND THE MAN'S GIRLFRIEND/ SECON WIFE (UNCLEAR). SHE REFUSED AND WAS BEATEN. SHE IS NOW IN THE MURUNDA HOSPITAL AND HER BELONGINGS HAVE SUBSEQUENTLY BEEN DIVIDED.

ii) ONE PATROL TO RWAMATAMU COMMUNE. ROADS IN VERY BAD CONDITION. SIT CALM.

iii) THERE WAS A BREAK IN IN THE FORMER ACCOMODATION IN ETO (WHERE THE HELIPAD IS). SOME MILOBS WERE STORING THEIR BELONGINGS THERE. CIVPOL INVESTIGATING DETAILED REPORT FOLLOWS TOMORROW.

i) ONE PATROL TO MUNINI SECTOR 9463 SIT. CALM. SECURITY SIT. GOOD. SECTOR CONSEILLER SAID THAT HE IS GOING TO ADDRESS THE LOCALS IN FUTURE TO BE MORE COOPERATIVE WITH UNAMIR PERSONNEL.

ii) ONE PATROL TO MBUYE 8365. SIT. CALM. POPULATION NOT VERY RESPONSIVE TO UNAMIR.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.

i) THE KIBUYE PREFET HELD A MEETING WITH NGOS AND MILOBS REGARDING STEALING OF VEHs. THE PREFET TOLD THE PARTICIPANTS IN ORDER TO AVOID THE STEALING OF VEHs ALL VEHs SHOULD BE PARKED BY 2200 HRS. HE FURTHER STATED THAT, THE THIEVES WHO STOLE THE SWISS DISASTER RELIEF PROGRAM VEH WERE ARRESTED ONE WEEK AGO.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM JOINED THE FORCE ENGR CDR WHO HAD VISITED THE SECTOR TO CHECK ON THE FOLLOWINGS BRIDGES 7271985, 727975, 704882 OVER KIBAYE IN NYABIKENGE COMMUNES 7292, THE TEAM HAD COME TO ASSES THE AMOUNT OF ENGR EFFORT REQUIRED ON THESE BRIDGES.

ii) TODAY THE FORCE CDR VISITED SECTOR 3B AND MALI COY. THE FC WAS ACCOMPANIED BY SECTOR CDR AND MALI COY CDR PLUS STAFF. THE FC WAS GIVEN A BRIEF BY THE SECTOR CDR AT GITARAMA SECTOR HQ. THE FC AND PARTY LATER VISITED RUHANGO PLATOON LOCATION 7653 AND NTONGWE PLATOON LOCATION 9057, HE LEFT NTONGWE AT 1445 HRS. MOST OF THE SECTOR ACTIVITIES WERE CONFINED TO THE FC'S VISIT.

**B. KIBUYE TEAM**

i) ONE MILOB TEAM ACCOMPANIED BY MALAWI ESCORTS WENT TO NYARUTUDURA SECTOR 3289, TO VERIFY RUMORS THAT FRGF ELEMENTS HAD INFILTRATED THE SECTOR. THE TEAM MET THE COUNSELLOR WHO TOLD THEM THAT HE HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF SUCH RUMORS. THE TEAM FURTHER INQUIRED FROM SEVERAL LOCALS WHO ALSO DENIED THE RUMORS.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO RUGARAGARA 1749 IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE 1557 AND VISITED KABULIRO PRIMARY SCHOOL 1650 AND WAS BRIEFED BY THE TEACHERS THAT, PUPILS ARE STARVING BECAUSE WFP IS GIVING FOOD TO THE ADJACENT COMMUNE AND LEAVING THEM OUT SAYING THAT THEY ARE IN CYANGUGU PREFECTURE, THIS ISSUE WAS BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER. TEAM WAS ALSO TOLD THAT THE SCHOOL AND THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY DO NOT HAVE POTABLE WATER.

iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO RUGABANO 4367 AND MUGUDA 4468, TO CHECK ON THE RETURNEES WHO ARE RESETTLING IN THESE SECTORS. THE TEAM ESTABLISHED THAT THE RETURNEES DO NOT A FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS AND POTABLE WATER.

**C. MALICOY.**

i) ALL COY ACTIVITIES WERE CONFINED TO THE FORCE COMMANDER'S VISIT. HE VISITED GITARAMA COY HQ, RUHANGO PLATOON LOCATION 7653, NTONGWE PLATOON LOCATION 9057 AND FINAL LEFT AT 1445 HRS.

ii) MALI COY CDR DENIED THIS EVENING TO BRING ESCORT TO THE HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM THAT REQUESTED IT AT THE END OF THEIR NORMAL ACTIVITY. A COMPLETE REPORT REGARDING THIS MATTER WILL BE SENT ASAP.

**D. MALAWI COY.**

i) MALAWI COY PROVIDED ESCORTS TO MILOBS FROM KIBUYE 2772 TO NYARUTUNDURA 3183.

**5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.**

i) MALAWI COY TRANSPORTED 82 IDPs FROM NYAMISHABA 2671 TO THEIR VARIOUS HOME COMMUNE.

ii) THE KIBUYE HUMANITARIAN TEAM AND NGOS ATTENDED A MEETING AT THE PREFECTURE THAT WAS PRESIDED BY THE PREFET. THE MAIN SUBJECT OF DISCUSSION WAS RETURNEES WHO ARE STRANDED AT THE RUTSIRO COMMUNE SECTOR 3183. UNHCR AND WFP TOLD THE PARTICIPANTS THAT EACH REFUGEE WAS PROVIDED WITH ONE MONTH FOOD PACKAGE AND IN ADDITION, WHILE THE RETURNEES WERE IN GISENYI, EACH FAMILY WAS ISSUED WITH LARGE PLASTIC SHEET TO BE

USED AS TEMPORARY SHELTER, COOKING UTENSILS AND BLANKETS. THE MEETING WAS INFORMED THAT THESE RETURNEES WILL BE RESETTLED IN BWIZA SECTOR 3694.



1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIESA. RPA.

B. FRGF. IT IS RUMORED THAT SOME FRGF ELEMENTS HAVE INFILTRATED IN KAYOVE (2792) AND TWO WERE CAPTURED YESTERDAY AT AROUND 261730 JUN 95.

C. MILITIA. NTR4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO NYAKABANDA (6597) ON A HUMANITARIAN TASK TO COLLECT FROM THE COMMUNE AN ELECTRICAL ENGINE FOR REPAIR. THIS WAS DONE AFTER THE BOURGMESTRE HAD REQUESTED UNAMIR TO ASSIST HIM REGARDING THIS MATTER. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY THE BOURGMESTRE THAT EVERYTHING WAS UNDER CONTROL BUT AS USUAL, THE GENERAL COMPLAINT OF HUNGER AND DEMOLISHED HOUSES WHICH REQUIRE UNAMIR ASSISTANCE WAS PUT FORWARD.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIGOMA COMMUNE (7750) AND VISITED NGWA (7248) AND GAHOMBO (7949) SECTORS. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY THE BOURGMESTRE THAT, THERE ARE 1641 ORPHANS AND 1550 WIDOWS IN HIS COMMUNE. THESE PEOPLE COULD NOT BE PUT INTO CATEGORY. THE BOURGMESTRE PROMISED TO FORWARD THIS REQUIRED INFORMATION BY THE END OF THE MONTH (JUNE). IT WAS FURTHER SAID THAT THESE PEOPLE ARE LIVING WITH THEIR EXTENDED FAMILIES THROUGHOUT THE COMMUNE AND THE GENERAL PROBLEMS COMPOUNDING THEM ARE ITEMS LIKE FOOD, CLOTHING AND PROPER HEALTH CARE. ALSO WIDOWS DO NOT HAVE SHELTER. THE TEAM LATER VISITED HOME DE LA VIERGE DES PAUVRES IN NGWA SECTOR. THE TEAM COULD NOT SPEAK TO THE AUTHORITIES SINCE THEY WERE SAID TO BE OUT ON BUSINESS. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY OTHER STAFF MEMBERS THAT SAID, THE CENTER HAS 125 PEOPLE WHO DO NOT HAVE HANDS OR LEGS AND 60 PEOPLE WHO

ARE BLIND. THESE PEOPLE ARE BEING LOOKED AFTER BY 80 STAFF MEMBERS. THE STAFF DID PUT FORWARD THEIR REQUEST OF LEATHER TO MAKE ARTIFICIAL LEGS. AVIS (NGO) IS SAID TO BE PROVIDING THE BASIC NECESSITIES AT THIS CENTER.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO RUGARAGARA (1749) IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE AND WAS STOPPED AT RPA CHECK POINT AT NGOMA (2059). THE TEAM WAS DENIED ACCESS TO PROCEED TO RWAMATAMU. THE MILOBS DEMANDED TO SEE THE RPA CDR, AFTER A LENGTH TALK, MANAGED TO SEE A SECOND LIEUTENANT APPEARED BUT REFUSED TO DISCLOSE HIS IDENTITY, HOWEVER HE TOLD THE TEAM THAT RPA HAVE RECEIVED ORDERS FROM THE BN CDR IN KIBUYE NOT TO ALLOW UNAMIR VEHICLES TO GO BEYOND NGOMA WITHOUT A WRITTEN PERMIT FROM HIM. ALL DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS FAILED AND THE TEAM RETURNED TO KIBUYE. THE SUB SECTOR CDR SORT AUDIENCE WITH THE RPA BN CDR TO CLARIFY THE REASON FOR RPA SOLDIER'S ACTION AT NGOMA CHECK POINT. THE RPA BN CDR DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF SUCH ORDERS. HE HOWEVER PROMISED THE SUB SECTOR CDR THAT, HE WILL TALK TO HIS SOLDIERS SO THAT A SIMILAR SITUATION WILL NOT OCCUR.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIBINGO SECTOR (3080) IN MABANZA COMMUNE(3473) AND REPORTED THAT SITUATION IS CALM BUT, THERE IS FEAR AND APPREHENSION AMONG THE LOCALS. LOCALS AT RUHINGO CELLULE (2979) REFUSED TO TALK TO THE TEAM FOR FEAR OF REPRISALS FROM RPA SOLDIERS. HOWEVER ONE LOCAL TALKED TO, TOLD THE TEAM THAT RPA SOLDIERS IN THE AREA ARE CONDUCTING WEEKLY ARRESTS AT NIGHT AND THAT THOSE ARRESTED ARE TAKEN TO NYAGATOVU SECTOR CACHOT (3077). HE FURTHER TOLD THE TEAM THAT ONE WOMAN NAMED MUKANKUSI WAS ARRESTED ON 21 JUNE 95 FOR ALLEGED AIDING INTERHAMWE DURING THE WAR. SHE IS CURRENTLY DETAINED AT MABANZA PRISON. THE TEAM MET 40 REFUGEES TREKKING FROM MABANZA TO RUTSIRO COMMUNE (3183).

iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIVUMU COMMUNE (5573) AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS WERE NOT PREPARED TO TALK TO THEM. THE TEAM WENT TO THE BOURGEMESTRE AND EXPLAINED TO HIM WHY HELI FLIGHTS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE COMMUNE LAST WEEK. THIS WAS BECAUSE HE HAD SEND A MESSAGE TO THE MILOBS THAT EACH TIME THE HELI IS TO FLY IN HIS COMMUNE HE MUST BE INFORMED IN ADVANCE. THE MATTER HAS BEEN RESOLVED, HOWEVER HE REFUSED TO BRIEF THE TEAM ON SECURITY MATTERS IN HIS COMMUNE.

iv) THE KIBUYE HUMANITARIAN TEAM COORDINATED THE DELIVERY OF 10 METRIC TONNES OF FOOD BY MALAWI COY TO GISOVU. A MILOB TEAM CASEVAC A FEMALE PATIENT NAMED ENCOMIA FROM NYANGE HOSPITAL TO KIBUYE HOSPITAL.



1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIESA. RPA.

B. FRGF. IT IS RUMORED THAT SOME FRGF ELEMENTS HAVE INFILTRATED IN KAYOVE (2792) AND TWO WERE CAPTURED YESTERDAY AT AROUND 261730 JUN 95.

C. MILITIA. NTR4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO NYAKABANDA (6597) ON A HUMANITARIAN TASK TO COLLECT FROM THE COMMUNE AN ELECTRICAL ENGINE FOR REPAIR. THIS WAS DONE AFTER THE BOURGMESTRE HAD REQUESTED UNAMIR TO ASSIST HIM REGARDING THIS MATTER. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY THE BOURGMESTRE THAT EVERYTHING WAS UNDER CONTROL BUT AS USUAL, THE GENERAL COMPLAINT OF HUNGER AND DEMOLISHED HOUSES WHICH REQUIRE UNAMIR ASSISTANCE WAS PUT FORWARD.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIGOMA COMMUNE (7750) AND VISITED NGWA (7248) AND GAHOMBO (7949) SECTORS. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY THE BOURGMESTRE THAT, THERE ARE 1641 ORPHANS AND 1550 WIDOWS IN HIS COMMUNE. THESE PEOPLE COULD NOT BE PUT INTO CATEGORY. THE BOURGMESTRE PROMISED TO FORWARD THIS REQUIRED INFORMATION BY THE END OF THE MONTH (JUNE). IT WAS FURTHER SAID THAT THESE PEOPLE ARE LIVING WITH THEIR EXTENDED FAMILIES THROUGHOUT THE COMMUNE AND THE GENERAL PROBLEMS COMPOUNDING THEM ARE ITEMS LIKE FOOD, CLOTHING AND PROPER HEALTH CARE. ALSO WIDOWS DO NOT HAVE SHELTER. THE TEAM LATER VISITED HOME DE LA VIERGE DES PAUVERES IN NGWA SECTOR. THE TEAM COULD NOT SPEAK TO THE AUTHORITIES SINCE THEY WERE SAID TO BE OUT ON BUSINESS. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY OTHER STAFF MEMBERS THAT SAID, THE CENTER HAS 125 PEOPLE WHO DO NOT HAVE HANDS OR LEGS AND 60 PEOPLE WHO

ARE BLIND. THESE PEOPLE ARE BEING LOOKED AFTER BY 80 STAFF MEMBERS. THE STAFF DID PUT FORWARD THEIR REQUEST OF LEATHER TO MAKE ARTIFICIAL LEGS. AVIS (NGO) IS SAID TO BE PROVIDING THE BASIC NECESSITIES AT THIS CENTER.

**B. KIBUYE TEAM**

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO RUGARAGARA (1749) IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE AND WAS STOPPED AT RPA CHECK POINT AT NGOMA (2059). THE TEAM WAS DENIED ACCESS TO PROCEED TO RWAMATAMU. THE MILOBS DEMANDED TO SEE THE RPA CDR, AFTER A LENGTH TALK, MANAGED TO SEE A SECOND LIEUTENANT APPEARED BUT REFUSED TO DISCLOSE HIS IDENTITY, HOWEVER HE TOLD THE TEAM THAT RPA HAVE RECEIVED ORDERS FROM THE BN CDR IN KIBUYE NOT TO ALLOW UNAMIR VEHICLES TO GO BEYOND NGOMA WITHOUT A WRITTEN PERMIT FROM HIM. ALL DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS FAILED AND THE TEAM RETURNED TO KIBUYE. THE SUB SECTOR CDR SORT AUDIENCE WITH THE RPA BN CDR TO CLARIFY THE REASON FOR RPA SOLDIER'S ACTION AT NGOMA CHECK POINT. THE RPA BN CDR DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF SUCH ORDERS. HE HOWEVER PROMISED THE SUB SECTOR CDR THAT, HE WILL TALK TO HIS SOLDIERS SO THAT A SIMILAR SITUATION WILL NOT OCCUR.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIBINGO SECTOR (3080) IN MABANZA COMMUNE (3473) AND REPORTED THAT SITUATION IS CALM BUT, THERE IS FEAR AND APPREHENSION AMONG THE LOCALS. LOCALS AT RUHINGO CELLULE (2979) REFUSED TO TALK TO THE TEAM FOR FEAR OF REPRISALS FROM RPA SOLDIERS. HOWEVER ONE LOCAL TALKED TO, TOLD THE TEAM THAT RPA SOLDIERS IN THE AREA ARE CONDUCTING WEEKLY ARRESTS AT NIGHT AND THAT THOSE ARRESTED ARE TAKEN TO NYAGATOVU SECTOR CACHOT (3077). HE FURTHER TOLD THE TEAM THAT ONE WOMAN NAMED MUKANKUSI WAS ARRESTED ON 21 JUNE 95 FOR ALLEGED AIDING INTERHAMWE DURING THE WAR. SHE IS CURRENTLY DETAINED AT MABANZA PRISON. THE TEAM MET 40 REFUGEES TREKKING FROM MABANZA TO RUTSIRO COMMUNE (3183).

iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIVUMU COMMUNE (5573) AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS WERE NOT PREPARED TO TALK TO THEM. THE TEAM WENT TO THE BOURGMESTRE AND EXPLAINED TO HIM WHY HELI FLIGHTS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE COMMUNE LAST WEEK. THIS WAS BECAUSE HE HAD SEND A MESSAGE TO THE MILOBS THAT EACH TIME THE HELI IS TO FLY IN HIS COMMUNE HE MUST BE INFORMED IN ADVANCE. THE MATTER HAS BEEN RESOLVED, HOWEVER HE REFUSED TO BRIEF THE TEAM ON SECURITY MATTERS IN HIS COMMUNE.



1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR CDR VISITED GITARAMA PREFET AND INFORMED HIM AROUND EXTORTIONS BY RPA SOLDIERS AND ROBBERIES SUFFERED BY COFFEE HARVESTERS, AND ABOUT THE LACK OF FOOD IN THE SOUTHERN COMMUNES.

B. SECTOR CDR CONFIRMED BY HIMSELF THAT THE PHOTOCOPY MACHINE AND THE GENERATOR PROVIDED BY UNAMIR TO BE USED FOR 3 WEEKS IN THE ACCELERATION OF THE PROCESS OF THE PRISONERS IN GITARAMA'S PRISON, THAT WAS OBTAINED THROUGH LETTERS OF THE MINISTER OF INTERIOR, IS BEING USED AT THE PREFET'S OFFICE FOR OTHER PURPOSES (THE COPY MACHINE) AND THE GENERATOR IS STILL LAYING UNDER A STAIR. WHEN THE SECTOR CDR, TOLD HIM THAT SOME HOSPITAL IN THE SECTOR NEEDS SOME AID ABOUT ELECTRICITY FOR SOME TIME BECAUSE THEIR OWN WAS OUT OF ORDER AND THE ABOVE MENTIONED WAS NOT BEEN USED; HE ANSWERED THAT THE HOSPITAL STAFF COULD ASK FOR A GENERATOR BY THEMSELVES AND THAT HE MADE A LOT OF WORK TO GET IT FOR THE PREFECTURE.

COMMENTS : IT IS RECOMMENDED TO SEND THOSE DEVICES TO THE CORRECT PLACE, IF IT IS NECESSARY FOR THE ALLEGED PURPOSE, AND IF NOT TO RECUPERATE THEM FOR UNAMIR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIESA. RPA.

1. BDE CDR LT COL CHARLES KAYONGA PAID AN ANNOUNCED VISIT TO THE SECTOR CDR. THE SECTOR CDR EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN ABOUT THE PROBLEM OF THE STOLEN CARS AND THE RPA CHIEF AGREED THAT THIS ISSUE CAUSED DAMAGES IN THE RPA'S PRESTIGE AND SAID THAT HE ARRESTED SOME MEMBERS OF HIS ARMY TRYING TO FIND A RACQUET OF THIEVES THAT SEEMS TO BE OPERATING COMBINING ELEMENTS OF THE RPA AND SOME CAPITALISTS THAT PAID SOME AMOUNT OF MONEY FOR EACH CAR. THE VISITOR ALSO EXPRESSED THAT IN EACH COMMUNE THERE ARE SOME ARMED ELEMENTS OF INTERAHAMWE AND THAT IS FOR THE LEGAL AUTHORITIES VERY DIFFICULT TO DETECT AND CHASE THEM. THE CONVERSATION WAS FLUENT AND FRIENDLY, EVEN WHEN THE SECTOR CDR TOLD THAT IS SO DIFFICULT BRING CONFIDENCE WHEN INCIDENTS

LIKE THE ABOVE MENTIONED HAPPENED.

2. FORMER BDE CDR COL CHARLES NGOGA VISITED THE SECTOR CDR THIS AFTERNOON AND ALSO RECEIVED THE EXPRESSION OF CONCERN ABOUT THE CARS AND THE ANSWER WAS SIMILAR TO THE LT COL KAYONGA'S ANSWER. THE AIM OF THIS VISIT WAS PROTOCOL.

3. RPA BROUGHT A VEHICLE BELONGING TO SWISS DISASTER RELIEF PROGRAM WHICH WAS STOLEN LAST WEEK IN KIBUYE. THE VEHICLE HAS OFFICIALLY BEEN HANDED OVER TO THE SWISS DISASTER RELIEF PERSONNEL TODAY. ACCORDING TO RPA'S STATEMENT THE VEHICLE WAS FOUND IN THE FOREST NEAR GITARAMA BY RPA SOLDIERS

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) GITARAMA TEAM HAD HELI RECCE PATROL WITHIN BOUNDARIES. THE RECCE WAS EXTENDED TO ALL THE 17 COMMUNES OF SECTOR 3B. THE TEAM NOTICE THAT, ALL ALONG THE EASTERN BOUNDARY WITH KIBUYE SUB SECTOR 3A IN THE FOLLOWING AREA, KIRWA (7787), NYARIBUYE (9882), GISHARU (9891), NDAGO (9697), KIVUMO (9798), NYABINONI (9804) BUNDUNDI (0403) AND GITOVU (0004) ARE QUITE DESERTED. LIVE COULD BE SEEN 3 KM FROM NYABARONGO RIVER. CULTIVATION IS TAKING PLACE ALONG THE MAIN ROADS AND ALONG THE STREAMS AS USUAL. IN THE SOUTH AND WESTERN PART OF THE SECTOR, THE AREAS ARE HARD HIT, THERE IS VERY LITTLE THAT IS TAKING PLACE IN TERMS OF AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES. IN THE AREAS OF RUVUZO (9443), GASHIRU (9345), GITEGA (9047) MUNAMIRA (8957) RUNYINYA (9052 AND KAVUMU (8957) WITH VERY LITTLE GOING ON IN TERMS OF CULTIVATION. MOST OF THE HOUSES COULD BE SEEN EMPTY.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) ONE TEAM CONDUCTED A HELI PATROL TO KIVUMU SECTOR 5573 AND VISITED VOGANYANA PRIMARY SCHOOL, THE TEAM CONDUCTED ROUTE RECCE ON THE ROAD TO KIBANDA SECTOR 5278 WHICH IS NOT BEEN ACCESSIBLE BECAUSE OF BRIDGES HAVING BEEN WASHED AWAY BY THE HEAVY RAINS AT 5072 AND 5497. THE TEAM CONFIRMED THAT THE ROAD IS STILL NOT PASSABLE. TEACHERS AT THE SCHOOL TOLD THE TEAM THAT THEY DO NOT KNOW THE WHEREABOUTS OF MR NKAKA CALLISTE A TEACHER WHO WAS ARRESTED IN MARCH. LOCALS CLAIMED THAT BANDITS USED TO COME AND STEAL COWS ARE COMING FROM MUKURA FOREST NORTHWEST OF KIVUMU SECTOR.

ii) ONE TEAM PATROLLED GACUMBI 1050 IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE 1557 AND WAS TOLD THAT 4 WEEKS AGO ONE PERSON NAMED GARAMBE WAS ARRESTED UPON ARRIVAL FROM ZAIRE, HE IS ALLEGED TO HAVE TAKEN

PART IN GENOCIDE.

- v) THE KIBUYE HUMANITARIAN TEAM HELD A DISCUSSION WITH THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE OF THE ORPHANAGE OF NGOMA. THE TEAM TOLD THAT FOOD STOCKS ARE RUNNING LOW AND THERE IS NEED FOR RESUPPLY. THE TEAM WILL VISIT THE ORPHANAGE CENTER TOMORROW TO VERIFY THE FOOD SITUATION.
- vi) UNHCR MANAGED TO TRANSPORT A TOTAL OF 1824 REFUGEES (1959/60 FROM GISENYI AND GOT THEM RESETTLED VIA THE TRANSIT CAMP AT NYABIYABA. THE MOVEMENT TOOK PLACE SINCE 15 JUN AND ENDED AT 23 JUN 95. THE NEW RESETTLED ARE CONFRONTED WITH PROBLEMS OF ACCOMMODATION AND FARMING IN GITESI COMMUNE.



THE TEAM NOTICE THAT, ALL ALONG THE EASTERN BOUNDARY WITH KIBUYE SUB SECTOR 3A IN THE FOLLOWING AREA, KIRWA (7787), NYARIBUYE (9882), GISHARU (9891), NDAGO (9697), KIVUMO (9798), NYABINONI (9804) BUNDUNDI (0403) AND GITOVU (0004) ARE QUITE DESERTED. LIVE COULD BE SEEN 3 KM FROM NYABARONGO RIVER. CULTIVATION IS TAKING PLACE ALONG THE MAIN ROADS AND ALONG THE STREAMS AS USUAL. MOST OF THE HOUSES COULD BE SEEN EMPTY.

ii) ONE TEAM PATROLLED GACUMBI 1050 IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE 1557 AND WAS TOLD THAT 4 WEEKS AGO ONE PERSON NAMED GARAMBE WAS ARRESTED UPON ARRIVAL FROM ZAIRE, HE IS ALLEGED TO HAVE TAKEN



THE TEAM LATER VISITED KILINDA HOSPITAL AND WERE TOLD BY THE HOSPITAL STAFF THAT THE HOSPITAL IS FUNCTIONING EFFECTIVELY APART FROM THE MILK OF THE UNDER NOURISHED CHILDREN WHICH HAS RUN OUT. ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WITH WFP TO RESUPPLY.

ii) ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED NABINGA SECTOR 1451 IUN THE RWAMATAMU COMMUNE 1557 AND ESTABLISHED 05 LOCALS WERE ARRESTED LAST WEEK NAMELY UWIMANA, NTAKARIMARA, JERINE, RWAMIHIGO AND BUCYANA FOR ALLEGEDLY HAVING PARTICIPATED IN THE LAST YEAR GENOCIDE. AMONG THOSE ARRESTED WAS ONE PERSON WHO HAD JUST ARRIVED FROM ZAIRE BUT THEIR WHEREABOUTS IS NOT KNOWN TO THE LOCALS. THE TEAM LATER VISITED THE KARENGERA HOSPITAL AND WERE TOLD THAT THE HOSPITAL IS OPERATING WITHOUT A DOCTOR AND IT IS BEING MANAGED BY ONE MEDICAL ASSISTANT. THE HOSPITAL STAFF REQUESTED UNAMIR FOR TRANSPORT ASSISTANCE TO TRANSPORT DRUGS FROM KIBUYE TO THE HOSPITAL.

iii) ONE TEAM PATROLLED RUTSIRO COMMUNE 3183 AND GATHERED THAT THEY ARE 700 REFUGEES AT THE COMMUNE CENTER WHO CAME FROM GISENYI TWO WEEKS AGO, THE REFUGEES HAVE NO FOOD, WATER AND ACCOMMODATION. THE BOURGMESTRE OF RUTSIRO COMMUNE IS REQUESTING FOR TRANSPORT TO TRANSPORT THESE REFUGEES TO BWIZA 3694 WHERE THEY ARE TO BE RESETTLED.





2. Milob Sector 3A has now 6 handset radios ( 2 sets were stolen when RPA soldiers took Veh UNAMIR 1069 near Gitarama on 15 May 95). According to the organization list Milob Sector 5C will consist of 7 teams and 4 officers in HQ team.

With the above mentioned subject we need 8 Motorola handsets more for everyday use and at least 2 spare with spare batteries and 5 single unit battery chargers.


3. Usually all Milobs' vehicles are equipped with radios but last month we got two vehicles (UNAMIR 1069 and 1080) without radios. And now during patrolling teams are to communicate with Sector HQ by handhold MOTOROLAs over the distance of 30-40 km. I ask you to help us to install radios on all our vehicles.

4. 1 computer set is available in Sector HQ. This is not enough for the ops and log/pers matters. Sector needs two more computer sets (1 notebook type). The reason of it is the increasing volume of reports and returns submitted to Kigali and future increase of humanitarian activities according to the new UN Mandate.

5. After shifting to Eden Rock Hotel Sector HQ will require more powerful generators (15 KVA).

6. Sector has 7 vehicles at its disposal and 4 of them are now at Kigali workshop awaiting maintenance/repair. In future we need 10 vehicles ( 2 per each patrolling team).

IT IS BELIEVED THAT ARRESTS ARE STILL GOING ON THOUGH THE BOURGHESTRE DENIED IT, THIS IS DUE TO THE RAISE IN FIGURES OF THE INMATES BECAUSE LAST WEEK THE SAME TEAM VISITED THE SAME CACHOT AND SAW 35 INMATES. THE TEAM THEN FURTHER PROCEEDED TO GATINZI SECTOR 7474 AND MET WITH THE COUNCILLOR WHO BRIEFED THE TEAM THAT, THERE ARE 78 FAMILIES WHO ARE BADLY IN NEED OF FOOD, AND ALSO AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT. HE ALSO SAID THAT HE RECEIVED 38 REFUGEES FROM BURUNDI AND 6 FROM ZAIRE. ACTS OF BANDITRY ARE PREVALENT IN THIS SECTOR. IN GIHUMA SECTOR 6972, THE TEAM VISITED KAVUMU ORPHANAGE CENTER AND REPORTED THAT, THERE ARE 110 ORPHANS WHO ARE BEING LOOKED AFTER BY 20 STAFF MEMBERS. IT WAS LEARNT THAT THE CENTER IS IN NEED OF MOSQUITO NETS, SPORTING EQUIPMENT AND MEDICINES.

**B. KIBUYE TEAM**

i) THE ACTING SUB SECTOR CDR HELD A SECURITY MEETING WITH THE RPA BN CDR TODAY AND DISCUSSED THE BANDITRY ACTIVITIES ALONG THE EASTERN BOUNDARIES OF THE SUB SECTOR AND SECTOR 3B. THE RPA CDR ACKNOWLEDGE THE REPORTS OF ARMED BANDITRY ALONG THIS FRONT AND ADDED THAT PATROLS WERE SENT TO THIS AREA TWO DAYS AGO. HOWEVER NOTHING OF VALUE WAS OBTAINED. HE FURTHER PROMISED TO CONTINUE MOUNTING PATROLS IN THIS SAME AREA, LIAISING WITH GITARAMA RPA BN CDR.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MARA SECTOR 6821 AND REPORTED THAT ON 17 JUN 95, 04 PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED WHILE RETURNING FROM ZAIRE BY BOAT THEY WERE TAKEN TO COXA VILLAGE IN KAGABIRO SECTOR 6625 BY RPA SOLDIERS. THE TEAM WAS TOLD THAT REFUGEES OF OLD CASE LOAD ARE BEING SETTLED THIS SECTOR.

iii) ONE TEAM CONDUCTED A HELI PATROL IN NYARUTAGARA SECTOR 3354 AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS ARE LIVING IN FEAR BECAUSE OF RUMORS OF THE IMPENDING ATTACK BY FORMER GOVT SOLDIERS. TEACHERS OF A LOCAL SCHOOL IN THIS SECTOR INFORMED THE TEAM THAT THEY WERE LAST PAID IN THE MONTH OF APR 95.



i) A JOINT MILOBS AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE (8274), BIMOMWE (8271) AND NYARUBAKA (8268) AND REPORTED THAT CARITAS IS STILL HANDING OUT FOOD TO THE POOREST PEOPLE ONCE A MONTH BUT LOCALS ARE SAYING THE FOOD IS NOT ENOUGH. THE TEAM ALSO RECEIVED REPORT FROM THE LOCALS THAT ACTS OF BANDITRY IS STILL GOING ON IN THESE SECTORS. IT IS SAID THE BANDITS ARE ROBBING THEM DURING THE NIGHT ESPECIALLY WHEN LOCALS HAVE MONEY BECAUSE THEY SOLD THEIR COFFEE CROP AND BEATING THEM AFTER STEALING. THE TEAM MET WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF HAGURUKA ASSOCIATION, NIRAMA FRANCOISE, WHO BRIEFED THEM THAT THE ORGANIZATION IS HELPING WIDOWS IN BUILDING THEIR DESTROYED HOUSES AND IT IS ALSO PROMOTING HUMAN RIGHTS OF WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN THE COMMUNE. THE TEAM MET A PRIEST IN THE COMMUNE WHO TOLD THEM THAT LOCALS ARE STILL BEING ARRESTED FOR GENOCIDE CASES BUT NO CURRENT FIGURES WERE OBTAINED. IN KAMBYEYI SECTOR, THE TEAM VISITED A LOCAL SCHOOL AND ESTABLISHED THAT THE SCHOOL HAVE 461 STUDENTS AND 11 TEACHERS OUT OF WHICH 4 ARE QUALIFIED. THE TEACHERS ARE GETTING THEIR SALARIES THOUGH THEY COMPLAINED THAT IT IS TOO LITTLE. AS USUAL, THE SCHOOL LACKS ALL BASIC SCHOOLS NEEDS AND IS REQUESTING UNAMIR ASSISTANCE.

ii) A JOINT CIV POL AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO NYABIKENKE COMMUNE (7292) ON A FOLLOW UP TASK OF ALLEGED KILLINGS IN THE

COMMUNE. THE TEAM WAS INFORMED BY EMMANUEL NMITEGEKU THAT, THE BOURGMESTRE AND RPA OFFICIALS HAD A MEETING WITH THE POPULATION ON 14 JUN 95. IT IS SAID THAT THE BOURGMESTRE WARNED LOCALS TO DESIST FROM SPEAKING WITH UNAMIR PERSONNEL WHO COME TO ENQUIRE IN THE COMMUNE. HE ALSO DISCLOSED THAT LOCALS WHO WERE SEEN TALKING TO UNAMIR PERSONNEL TWO WEEKS AGO WERE INTERROGATED BY RPA SOLDIERS. AT THE COMMUNE HQ THE BOURGMESTRE CONFIRMED THAT BANDITRY ACTIVITIES ARE ON AN INCREASE. THE TEAM VISITED THE CACHOT AND SPOKE TO THE INMATES WHO TOLD THEM THAT THEY WERE NOT INTERROGATED BY THE PROSECUTOR, HOWEVER THE TEAM COULD NOT CONTINUE THEIR TALK BECAUSE THE RPA SECURITY OFFICER INCHARGE OF THE CACHOT CAME AND ORDERED THE TEAM TO STOP THE INTERVIEW AND HAND OVER THEIR NOTES TO HIM. THE TEAM DID NOT OBLIGE TO THE REQUEST AND AFTER ABOUT AN HOUR AND HALF OF DELIBERATIONS, THE TEAM WAS ALLOWED TO GO. THE RPA OFFICER ACCUSED UNAMIR OF SPREADING FALSEHOOD ABOUT THE COMMUNE AUTHORITIES TO THEIR SUPERIORS.

COMMENTS :

A WRITTEN COMPLAIN WILL BE SENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE SINCE THIS OFFICER INTERFERED WITH THE SPECIFIC MANDATE OF BOTH PARTS OF THE TEAM AND THEIR WORK.

(iii) A JOINT HUMAN RIGHTS /CIV POL TEAM VISITED TAMBWE COMMUNE (7653) AND SPOKE THE BOURGMESTRE WHO TOLD THEM THAT, THERE ARE 3500 WIDOWS AND 388 ORPHANS IN HIS COMMUNE. HE ALSO TOLD THEM THAT HE RECEIVED 67 REFUGEES FROM TANZANIA, THESE ARE OLD CASES. HE INFORMED THEM THAT THESE PEOPLE DO NOT HAVE ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

(i) ONE TEAM WENT TO BWAKIRA COMMUNE (4666) AND REPORTED THAT IDPS OF OLD CASES ARE SETTLING IN THE COMMUNE, BUT THEY HAVE PROBLEMS OF FOOD, HOUSING AND AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT. THE SITUATION IS CALM.

ii) ONE TEAM CONDUCTED A FOOT PATROL IN THE KIBUYE TOWN CENTER (3772) AND SPOKE WITH LOCAL HOSPITAL STAFF WHO TOLD THEM THAT THEY LACK QUALIFIED STAFF AND MEDICAL FACILITIES.

C. MALICOY.

i) ONE PATROL FROM NTONGWE (9057) WENT TO GITWA (9555) AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS LAST RECEIVED FOOD IN MAY 95. THEY SAID LOCALS LACK POTABLE WATER AND MEDICINES.

D. MALAWI COY.

(i) MALAWI COY TRANSPORTED 700 IDPS FROM NYAMISYABA (2671) TO VARIOUS COMMUNES WITHIN KIBUYE PREFECTURE.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

(i) MALI COY PROVIDED ONE TRUCK TO GITARAMA PREFECTURE FOR TRANSPORTING ROAD CONSTRUCTING MATERIALS.

ii) MALI COY TREATED 16 LOCALS.

(iii) MALAWI COY TRANSPORTED 700 IDPS FROM NYAMISYABA (2671) TO VARIOUS COMMUNES WITHIN KIBUYE PREFECTURE.

(iv) MALAWI COY TRANSPORTED ONE PATIENT FROM KIBUYE TO RUBERENGERA DISPENSARY.

(v) THE KIBUYE SUB SECTOR HUMANITARIAN OFFICER INTERVIEWED MR NZABAMWITA ARDEREDATUS THE INSPECTOR OF BWAKIRA SCHOOL AND OBTAINED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: IN BWAKIRA COMMUNE THERE WERE 28 SCHOOLS, 214 TEACHERS (96% QUALIFIED) AND 9000 STUDENTS BEFORE THE WAR. NOW THERE ARE 22 SCHOOLS OPERATING WITH 140 TEACHERS (50 % QUALIFIED) AND 7000 STUDENTS. MOST OF THE TEACHERS HAVE NOT BEEN PAID SINCE FEBRUARY AND THE MAJORITY ARE LEAVING FOR GREENER PASTURES. HE IS APPEALING FOR SCHOOLING MATERIALS FROM UNAMIR.



A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) THE SECTOR CDR TOGETHER WITH KIBUYE SUB SECTOR CDR HAD A HELICOPTER RECCE PATROL ALONG THE COASTAL LINE AND WITHIN KIBUYE SUB SECTOR BOUNDARIES. IT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED THAT, ALONG THE KIBUYE LAKE KIVU SHORES IS NOT INHABITED LIFE COULD ONLY BE SEEN 2 TO 3 KM FROM THE SHORES AND ALSO THE LITTLE ISLANDS WHICH WERE INHABITED ARE NOW DESERTED.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MASANGO COMMUNE 6254 AND VISITED MUYUNZWE 6260 AND GITINDA 5959 SECTORS. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT IN THE GITINDA SECTOR, LOCALS ARE STILL SUFFERING THE NIGHTMARE OF THE ARMED BANDITS WHO ARE BELIEVED TO BECOMING FROM KIBUYE PREFECTURE. IT IS ALSO BELIEVED THAT THE BANDITS ARE USING NYABARONGO RIVER AS THEIR HIDEOUT DURING DAY LIGHT. IN MUYUNZWE, IT IS SAID THE ONLY DISPENSARY WHICH CATERS FOR ALMOST 5 SECTORS HAVE 3 QUALIFIED STAFF OUT OF 18 STAFF MEMBERS. THE DISPENSARY STAFF GETS PAID FROM CARITAS AND THE GOVERNMENT. THE HOSPITAL IS IN NEED OF BEDS AND THE STAFF IS APPEALING TO UNAMIR TO PROVIDE ABOUT 20, IT HAS NO AMBULANCE AND CLEAN WATER. THE TEAM VISITED MUYUNZWE SECONDARY SCHOOL AND REPORTED THAT, MUYUNZWE IS A PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL WHICH HAS 132 STUDENTS HOUSED IN 8 CLASSES. IT HAS 13 TEACHERS OUT OF WHICH 03 ARE QUALIFIED. THE DIRECTOR OF THE SCHOOL TOLD THE TEAM THAT, THE SCHOOL LACKS SPORTING, TEACHING AIDS AND ELECTRICITY WHICH HE SAID HE IS SEEKING OUR ASSISTANCE. HE

FURTHER MENTIONED THAT THEY ARE 38 ORPHANS STUDENTS WHOM THE GOVERNMENT HAD PROMISED TO MEET THEIR SCHOOLING EXPENSES BUT UP TO NOW THERE IS NOTHING THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAS DONE ABOUT IT.

iii) A JOINT HUMAN RIGHTS AND MILOBS TEAM WENT TO RUHANGO 7653 AND NTONGWE 9057 COMMUNES. THE TEAM WAS ON A FOLLOW UP TASK OF AN ALLEGED ARRESTS BY RPA IN THE RUHANGO COMMUNE, IT WAS ESTABLISHED FROM RUHANGO BOURGMESTRE THAT MR. ELIAS MBARUSUKYE AGED 58 YEARS WAS ARRESTED BUT DATE NOT GIVEN AND SEND TO GITARAMA PRISON. IT IS BELIEVED THAT HIS SON WHO IS STUDYING IN USA ADDRESSED A PRESS CONFERENCE IN USA AND MADE SOME SUBVERSIVE STATEMENTS THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA IS VIOLATING HUMAN RIGHTS. THE TEAM LATER VISITED MUKINDO CELLULE 8551 AND NYARURAMA SECTOR 8751 AND REPORTED THAT, LOCALS ARE LIVING FEAR DUE TO RUMORS OF THE FRGF IMPENDING INCURSION. IN NYARURAMA SECTOR, THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY THE SCHOOL HEADMASTER OF THEIR PROBLEMS AMONG WHICH HE SAID TEACHERS WERE LAST PAID THEIR SALARIES IN APRIL 1995 AND THAT THE SCHOOL LACKS STATIONERY, SCHOOL FURNITURE AND SPORTING ITEMS. HE ALSO INFORMED THE TEAM THAT UNICEF HAD PROMISED TO GIVE THE THEIR REQUIRED ASSISTANCE THUS IN MUCH BUT UP TO NOW UNICEF IS NOT SHOWN UP.

COMMENTS : IN THE LAST MEETING WITH PREFET OF GITARAMA THE SECTOR CDR CONSULTED HIM ABOUT THE REASONS OF THE IRREGULAR PAYMENT OF THE TEACHERS IN THE JURISDICTION AND THE ANSWER WAS THAT SOME OF THE TEACHERS DO NOT HAVE THEIR FILES COMPLETED IN THE MINISTRY AND THE ARE RECEIVING SOME MONEY BUT NOT THE COMPLETE SALARY AND THIS CIRCUMSTANCES ARE DUE THE ARRIVAL OF SOME TEACHERS FROM THE NEIGHBORING COUNTRIES AND THE BUREAUCRATIC STEPS THAT TAKE A LONG TIME TO SOLVE THE PROBLEM.

**B. KIBUYE TEAM**

i) THE SUB SECTOR CDR HELD A MEETING YESTERDAY WITH THE PREFET REGARDING THE SECURITY PREVAILING IN THE PREFECTURE, AND ABOUT THE THEFT OF A SWISS DISASTER RELIEF FUND VEHICLE. THE MEETING WAS ATTENDED BY THE PREFECTURE SECURITY CHIEF, THE RPA BN SECURITY OFFICER AND THE HEAD OF THE LOCAL GENDARMERIE. THE FOLLOWING MEASURES WERE INSTITUTED :

a) RPA PATROLS IN THE CITY OF KIBUYE WILL BE INCREASED AND REINFORCED.

b) RPA CHECK POINTS IN THE PREFECTURE WILL BE INCREASED AND REINFORCED.

c) ALL NGOS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL WILL LIMIT THEIR MOVEMENTS PAST MIDNIGHT TO ONLY THOSE FOR REASONS OF DUTY.

d) AS SOON AS A SECURITY INCIDENT OCCURS, THE ABOVE MENTIONED SECURITY OFFICERS ARE TO BE CONTACTED SOONEST.

e) A SECURITY MEETING PRESIDED BY THE PREFET WILL TAKE PLACE ONCE A MONTH.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIVUME COMMUNE 5573 AND VISITED RUKOKU SECTOR 4772, AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IS CALM. THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT RPA SOLDIERS STOLE 4 SHEEP AND 3 COWS IN THIS SECTOR. THE TEAM FURTHER LEARNED THAT FOUR TEACHERS WHO WERE ARRESTED SIX WEEKS AGO ARE STILL IN CUSTODY.

iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MBOGO SECTOR 1555 AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IS CALM, HOWEVER LOCALS ARE COMPLAINING OF HARASSMENT BY RPA SOLDIERS IN THE AREA. THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT THE TUTSIS IN THE AREA ARE COLLABORATING WITH RPA SOLDIERS IN STEALING LIVESTOCK FROM THE HUTUS. THE TEAM WAS FURTHER INFORMED THAT BANDITS FROM ZAIRE LOOTED UNDISCLOSED AMOUNT OF MONEY AND RADIO SETS FROM THE LOCALS LAST WEEK.

**C. MALI COY.**

i) ONE PATROL WENT TO BEMBA 9454 CELLULE AND RUTABO SECTOR 9455 AND REPORTED SITUATION IS CALM. ANOTHER TEAM WENT TO NYAKOGO 6295 AND WAS TOLD BY THE LOCALS THAT THEY ARE HAPPY ABOUT THE RENEWAL OF THE UN MANDATE. GENERAL SITUATION IS CALM.

**D. MALAWI COY.**

i) ONE PATROL WENT TO MBOGO SECTOR 1555 AND REPORTED THAT A GROUP OF BANDITS USUALLY COME DURING NIGHT AND ROB LOCALS OF MONEY. THESE UNKNOWN BANDITS COME FROM ZAIRE AND BEACH-LAND IN THE AREA. IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT LOCALS LIVE IN FEAR DUE TO WIDELY SPREAD RUMORS THAT RGF IS REGROUPING IN ZAIRE WITH AN AIM OF OVERTHROWING THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT.



A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO RUGALIKA SECTOR (9574) ON A FOLLOW UP OF HOMELESS ORPHANS IN THIS SECTOR. THE TEAM ESTABLISHED THAT, THERE ARE APPROX 200 ORPHANS WHO ARE STAYING IN DESTROYED HOMES. THIS WAS ALSO CONFIRMED BY LOCAL TEACHERS WHO FURTHER MENTIONED THAT, IN MUSAVE CELLULE( 9472) AND KINYANI SECTOR (9177) THERE IS A SIMILAR PROBLEM OF ORPHANS. THE TEAM RECEIVED A REPORT FROM THE PRINCIPLE OF KINYANI SCHOOL THAT IN SHELI SECTOR OF RUNDA COMMUNE (9379) AND KAMONYI SECTOR OF TABA COMMUNE (8978) ,THERE ARE A LOT OF THESE ORPHANS .A FOLLOW UP OF THIS INFORMATION IS UNDER WAY.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO NYAKABANDA COMMUNE AND VISITED GASOVU (6688), KIRWA (6387) AND KAGOGWE (6490) SECTORS AND ESTABLISHED THAT,THE ONLY DISPENSARY IN THE THREE SECTORS DO NOT HAVE A DOCTOR AND ALSO LACKS MEDICAL EQUIPMENT.THE DISPENSARY HAS NO AMBULANCE AND ENOUGH QUALIFIED PERSONNEL.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO RWAMATAMA (2063) IN THE RWAMATAMU AND SPOKE TO RPA SOLDIERS WHO INFORMED THEM THAT,THE SECURITY SITUATION IS A BIT TENSE AND THEY ARE EXPECTING AN ATTACK FROM ZAIRE. THE SOLDIERS SAID THEY DO NOT KNOWN THE MAIN THRUST POINT THAT THE FRGF FORCES WILL USE TO ATTACK, BUT THEY RPA SOLDIERS REMAIN VIGILANT AND READY TO REPELANY ATTACK.LOCALS WERE AFRAID TO SPEAK WITH MILOBS IN FEAR OF RPA.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KIBONGO (2980) AND NYAGATOVU (3078) SECTORS IN THE MABANZA COMMUNE (3473) AND REPORTED THAT NYAGATOVU PRIMARY SCHOOL HAVE 465 STUDENTS HOUSED IN TEN CLASSES. THE SCHOOL IS OPERATING WITH MERGE RESOURCES. TEACHERS HAVE NOT BEEN PAID SINCE APRIL. THIS WAS THE FIRST DAY OF MILOBS TO VISIT THE TWO SECTORS BECAUSE OF BAD ROAD CONDITION. THE LOCAL RPA SECURITY OFFICER HAD DENIED THE PATROL ACCESS IN TO THE SECTORS AND LATER ACCEPTED THEM ENTRY AFTER SOME DELIBERATIONS. LOCALS WERE UNCERTAIN ABOUT THEIR FREEDOM TO SPEAK WITH THE MILOBS, HOWEVER THEY SPOKE FREELY AFTER THE TEAM CLEARED WITH THE RPA DETACHMENT COMMANDER.

i) THE COY DEPUTY COMMANDER ATTENDED THE OPERATIONS OFFICER CONFERENCE WHICH WAS HELD AT THE FORCES HQ TODAY.

ii) ONE PATROL FROM NTONGWE (9057) WENT TO BUHANIKA (8761) CELLULE AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION WAS CALM BUT THERE IS AN OUT BREAK OF MALARIA DISEASE. ONE PATROL FROM MASANGO (6254) WENT TO GWARAMANA (6555) AND REPORTED THAT THERE ARE A LOT OF IDPS FROM KIBEHO CAMP WHO ARE NOT REGISTERED WITH THE COMMUNE.



A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) MILOBS/HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIVPOL TEAMS JOINED THE NTONGWE COMMUNE 9057 POPULATION IN THE REBURIAL OF THE LAST YEAR GENOCIDE VICTIMS, WHICH TOOK PLACE TODAY IN THE RUTABO SECTOR 9455. THE CEREMONY WAS ATTENDED BY HIGH RANKING MILITARY AND PARLIAMENTARY OFFICIALS. THE MINISTER OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION LED THE OFFICIALS. THE UNAMIR PERSONNEL WHO ATTENDED THE CEREMONY WERE ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE SPEAKERS AND THE LOCALS. HOWEVER, THE TEAM COULD NOT UNDERSTAND THE SPEECHS WHICH WERE GIVEN DURING THE CEREMONY BECAUSE ALL WAS SAID IN KINYARUWANDA. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT 12000 OR MORE BODIES WERE REBURIED TODAY. THE CEREMONY WAS MARKED BY BOTH CHRISTIAN AND TRADITIONAL RITUALS.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) THE SUB SECTOR HQ AND TEAMS CONDUCTED LOCAL PATROLS JOINED BY THE PREFET, PREFECTURE SECURITY, LOCAL GENDARMERIE, AND RPA SECURITY OFFICERS ON THE FOLLOWING EVENT THAT TOOK PLACE ON 172330B JUN 95, IN KIBUYE 269722, WHEN A SWISS DISASTER RELIEF BRIGHT RED TWO DOOR LATE MODEL TOYOTA LAND CRUISER FITTED WITH A RADIO, PLATE NUMBER 6464, THAT WAS STOPPED AND STOLEN ON GUNPOINT. THIS EVENT OCCURED APPROX 200 METRES FROM THE RESIDENCE OF THE VICTIMS INVOLVED WHO WERE ON THEIR WAY TO A LOCAL DISCO.

THE TWO EMPLOYEES, A MAN AND A WOMAN WERE FORCED FROM THEIR VEHICLE BY THREE MEN (TWO MEN ARMED WITH AN AUTOMATIC RIFLE, AND ONE MAN UNARMED) IN CIVILIAN CLOTHING. THEY FORCED THEM TO HAND OVER THE VEHICLE AND 160,000 FRANCS. THEY ALSO ROBBED A GERMAN PASSPORT #31422005438 AND INTERNATIONAL VACCINATION CERTIFICATE THAT BELONGED TO ONE OF THE VICTIMS.

THE UNARMED MAN, DROVE THE VEHICLE TOWARDS THE KIBUYE TOWN CENTRE. THE TWO GUNMEN AFTER TAKING PERSONAL MONEY (BUT NO BELONGINGS) FROM THE VICTIMS, TOLD THEM TO GO AWAY AND NOT TO LOOK BACK OR OTHERWISE THEY GET SHOT. THE TWO GUNMEN THEN CASUALLY WALKED AWAY ACCORDING TO THE VICTIMS. THE ENTIRE EVENT IS SAID TO HAVE LASTED APPROX 10 MINUTES.

ON ARRIVAL AT THEIR RESIDENCE, THE VICTIMS THEN INFORMED ALL CONCERNED. MALAWI COY ALERTED THEIR OUTLYING PLATOONS TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES, THE COY AND LOCAL RPA CONDUCTED AN IMMEDIATE SEARCH OF THE AREA AND SET UP HASTY ROAD BLOCKS, BUT NOTHING WAS FOUND.

FOLLOWING THIS EVENTS, THE SUB SECTOR TOGETHER WITH NGOS HAVE INFORCED THEIR PERSONNEL AND VEHICLE SECURITY.

COMMENTS : IT IS OBVIOUS THAT IT IS ANOTHER TYPICAL RPA'S ACTION SINCE THEY COVERED THE FLED OF THE ROBBERS WITH THE ROAD BLOCKS AND ALSO THEY ARE CHOSING UNPROTECTED VEHICLES LIKE TARGETS FOR THIS KIND OF FACTS.

i) ONE TEAM FROM NTONGWE 9057 JOINED THE LOCAL POPULACE OF NTONGWE ON THE REBURRIAL THAT TOOK PLACE IN THE RUTABA SECTOR (9455).

i) ONE TEAM VISITED REMERA (9879), MUSENYI 9778 AND MUSANGE 9378 SECTORS IN THE BULINGA COMMUNE 6679 AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS IN THE MUSANGE SECTOR ARE LIVING IN FEAR OF LOCAL BANDITS WHO ARE STEALING THEIRS FOOD AND LIVESTOCK DURING THE NIGHT. ALSO IN THE THREE SECTORS VISITED, THEY LACK POTABLE WATER, AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS AND THERE IS AN ACUTE SHORTAGE OF FOOD. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTED THAT THERE ARE SOME ORPHANS WHO WE BEING LOOKED AFTER BY LOCAL VOLUNTEERS AND THEY RECEIVE FOOD FROM CARITAS AND ICRC, THE ORPHANS ARE IN NEED OF BLANKETS AND CLOTHING. IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT THE SECTORS FORMED A COOPERATIVE WHICH IS RECONSTRUCTING HOUSES OF WIDOWS.

ii) A TEAM FROM KABGAYI MSF HOSPITAL LED BY MR RICHARD AND THE MSF FIELD OFFICER MISS JOSEPHINE AND MR JOSEPH BRADY, THE REGIONAL SECURITY OFFICER OF UNHCR, VISITED SECTOR HQ TO BE BRIEFED ON SECURITY MATTERS. COMMENT" IT WOULD APPEAR A LOT OF THESE NGOS ARE AFRAID OF THEIR PERSONNEL AFTER THE THINNING OUT OF THE FORMED TROOPS, BECAUSE MOST OF THEIR QUESTIONS WERE BASED ON HOW WILL THEY OPERATE WHEN THE FORMED TROOPS ARE THINNED OUT AND THE EVACUATION PROCEDURE SUPPOSE THE SITUATION TURNS SOUR".

**B. KIBUYE TEAM**

i) ONE TEAM TOGETHER WITH A MALAWI PATROL WENT TO MARA(2161) IN THE MWENDO COMMUNE, THE TEAM COULD NOT REACH ITS DESTINATION DUE TO BAD WEATHER. THE TEAM THEN PROCEEDED TO RWARAMBA (2063) TO CONTINUE WITH INVESTIGATION OF THE KILLINGS THAT OCCURRED THE NIGHT OF 11/12 JUN 95. THE TEAM CONFIRMED THE KILLINGS BUT COULD NOT GET ENOUGH DETAIL DUE TO THE LACK OF INTERPRETERS.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MUSASA (4565) IN THE BWAKIRA COMMUNE AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION WAS CALM. THE ROAD CONDITION IS QUITE BAD.

**C. MALICOY.**

i) ONE PATROL FROM NTONGWE (9057) WENT TO KINAZI SECTOR AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION WAS CALM.

CAPT ALCAIN AND LT COL FOX FOUNDED A NISSAN PATROL PLATE 1967 HR OF HCHR PARKED NEAR CHECK POINT'S CABIN. THAT CHECK POINT WAS AN RPA 'S ONE AND A SOLDIER WHEN BOTH MILOBS STOPPED BECAUSE IT WAS ANOTHER CAR IN FRONT OF THEM CAME AND TOLD THE MILOBS THAT THE CAR WAS STOLEN AND THE ROBBERS WERE PRISONERS INSIDE THE CABIN. SECTOR CDR ASKED ABOUT ONE UNAMIR ID THAT ONE OF THE SOLDIERS HAD HOLDING IN HIS HAND AND THE NAME OF THE DRIVER CHECKED IN IT WAS READ, IT IS MUSA AHMED. AFTER THAT THE SECTOR CDR ASKED TO SEE THE PRISONERS AND POUNDED TWO AFRICAN MEN WITHOUT SHIRTS, TIED AND KNEELING ON THE GROUND AND ASKED TO ONE OF THEM (SIMILAR FACE OF ID'S PHOTO) IF HE WAS AHMED AND THE MAN ANSWERED THAT HE WAS.

DUE THE LACK OF COMMUNICATION WITH RPA SOLDIERS IT WAS NOT CLARIFIED THE SITUATION FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN HALF AN HOUR, BUT IN THE MEAN TIME THE PLACE WAS VISITED BY LT COL PATRICK OF RPA THAT DID NOT EXPLAIN ANYTHING ABOUT THE SITUATION AND LEFT THE PLACE; AND SOME MINUTES BEFORE THE ARRIVAL OF MILITARY POLICE THAT MILOBS CALLED THROUGH CBO AND CKO, A TEAM OF HUMAN RIGHTS WAS STOPPED AT THE PLACE AND INTERESTED IN THE MATTER BY MILOBS.

AT THE ARRIVAL OF MILITARY POLICE (ON CHARGE CPL POIRIER G.) THE SITUATION REMAINED LIKE IS REPORTED AND AN NON IDENTIFIED MALE OF ABOUT 50 YEARS OLD, AFRICAN, PROBABLY UGANDAN, ENGLISH SPEAKER REMAINED AT THE PLACE DETAINED BUT NOT TIED. THIS MAN TOLD SECTOR CDR AND HR PEOPLE THAT HE WAS THE BUYER OF THE CAR AND THAT HE PAID FOR IT ONE MILLION RWANDESE FRANCS.

FINALLY WITH THE SITUATION UNDER MILITARY POLICE'S CONTROL MILOBS DROVE TO SECTOR 3 LOCATION.



i) A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO GIHARA SECTOR 9585 ON A FOLLOW UP OF MRS NYABUSHISHI AGNES'S CASE WHO WAS RAPED AND SEVERELY BEATEN IN THE RUNDA CACHOT 9882. THE TEAM COULD NOT LOCATE THE SUBJECT BECAUSE SHE WAS TRANSFERRED TO KIGALI HOSPITAL FOR FURTHER TREATMENT. IT WAS FURTHER ESTABLISHED THAT, RPA SOLDIERS ARE ARRESTING LOCALS AND ASKING FOR BRIBES TO RELEASE THE SUBJECTS. THIS WAS CONFIRMED BY A MR MARTIN BIZIMANDA OF KIGESE SECTOR 9880, WHO WAS ARRESTED ON 21 MAY 95. THE SUBJECT STATED THAT, HE WAS BEATEN SEVERELY AND ASKED TO PAY 2000 FRANCS IN ORDER FOR HIM TO BE RELEASED. THE SUBJECT IS STILL IN THE LOCAL COMMUNE HOSPITAL SUFFERING FROM THE BEATINGS.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) THE SUB SECTOR CDR, UNHCR, ICRC AND SOME MILOBS ATTENDED THE CHILDREN DAY. THE OCCASION WAS PRESIDED BY THE KIBUYE PREFECT. THE FUNCTION WAS ATTENDED BY SEVERAL THOUSANDS OF CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS. THE EVENT WAS VIDEO TAPED BY THE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER WHO SHALL PRESENT IT TO THE PREFET AND OTHER NGOS. THE PREFET WAS ALSO PRESENTED WITH 75000 FRANCS.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO GASHALI 4462 IN THE MWENDO COMMUNE AND

REPORTED THAT, THE COMMUNE WAS ATTENDING THE CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATIONS AND ALL WAS WELL. THE LOCALS ARE HOWEVER OF THE FEELING THAT THE CONTINUED PRESENCE OF UNAMIR IS AVERTING A CIVIL WAR. LOCALS WERE NOT FREE TO SPEAK TO THE MILOBS IN FEAR OF ARRESTS.

iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO GISOVU SECTOR 2952 WHICH IS IN THE GISOVU COMMUNE AND JOINED THE COMMUNITY IN ATTENDING THE CHILDREN CELEBRATION DAY. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY THE REHABILITATION OFFICER THAT, THE COMMUNE PRISON IS HOLDING 25 INMATES AND UNKNOWN NUMBERS OF LOCALS ARE BEING DETAINED IN THE RPA GARRISON FOR UNKNOWN REASON.

C. MALICOY.

i) ONE PATROL FROM NTONGWE 9057 WENT TO MUHINDO 9551 AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS WERE SEEN MOVING TOWARDS THE COMMUNE CENTER TO MARK THE CHILDREN'S DAY AND THE SITUATION WAS CALM.

D. MALAWI COY.

i) ONE PATROL WENT TO RUVUMBA 1554 AND REPORTED THAT GEN SITUATION WAS CALM AND ALSO REPORTED THAT THERE IS AN OUT-BREAK OF DIARRHOEA.

ii) ONE PATROL WENT TO KINKUMBA 4972 AND REPORTED THAT, THE DIRECTOR OF SCHOOLS IN THE KIVUMU COMMUNE DUSABIYEZU BONIFACE AND THE FOLLOWING TEACHERS FROM BITEGA SCHOOL WERE ARRESTED EARLY THIS MONTH, NZABIDA BONFACE, HABIMANA KASIPARE AND SIMUBA ALIFONSO. DATE NOT KNOWN. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE VICTIMS WERE TAKEN TO MURUBZINIRO PRISON. THE CHIEF POLICEMAN IN THE AREA AND RPA SOLDIERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS ARREST.

iii) APPROX 600 RETURNEES OF THE 1959/60 CASELOAD FROM ZAIRE ARRIVED YESTERDAY IN THE KIBUYE PREFECTURE. SINCE THERE IS INSUFFICIENT HOUSING IN THE CITY, THESE PEOPLE WERE DISTRIBUTED RELATIVELY THROUGHOUT THE KIBUYE'S NINE COMMUNES. UNHCR ALONG WITH REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE PREFECTURE SUPERVISED THE DISTRIBUTION.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
  - A. GITARAMA TEAM

(i) A JOINT TEAM HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIVPOL PATROL WENT TO BULINGA COMMUNE (6679) AND REPORTED THAT, THE BOURGMESTER COMPLAINED THAT, THERE ARE ABOUT 1700 RETURNEES IN THE COMMUNE AND MOST OF THEM FOUND THEIR HOUSES DESTROYED . HE REQUESTED FOR BUILDING MATERIALS TO ASSIST THESE PEOPLE . HE ALSO COMPLAINED OF LACK OF POTABLE WATER AND A MATERNITY HOME IN THE COMMUNE. HE FINALLY REQUESTED THAT EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE 8 PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE, WHICH ARE IN DIRE NEED OF THESE MATERIALS . HE PRAISED THE EFFORTS OF ICRC WHO GIVE MEDICAL CARE TO LOCALS IN

THE COMMUNE TWICE A WEEK . OTHER NGOS OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE INCLUDE CARITAS AND LWF . AT THE COMMUNE CEUS , THE TEAM SAW 46 PERSONS ONLY 4 OF THEM WERE NOT GENOCIDE CASES. SOME INMATES COMPLAINED THAT THEY HAVE NOT BEEN INTERVIEWED BY THE PROSECUTOR , AND THE HUMAN RIGHTS MONITOR PROMISED TO BRING IT TO THE NOTICE OF THE OFFICIAL CONCERNED . THEY ALSO COMPLAINED OF BEING BEATEN BY SOLDIERS DURING INTERROGATION.

(ii) ONE TEAM VISITED CHIRWA, WIMANA, AND GITANDA SECTORS AND MASANGO COMMUNE (6254). THE TEAM ESTABLISHED THAT PEOPLE DO NOT HAVE ENOUGH FOOD AND THE LAST RECEIVED FOOD IN FEBRUARY 95 FROM ICRC AND CRS. THE LOCALS ARE APPEALING FOR HELP IN FORM OF IRON SHEETS/ TILES AND CEMENT TO RECONSTRUCTION THEIR DEMOLITION HOUSES. THEY ARE ALSO REQUESTING FOR SOME ASSISTANCE IN FORM OF BLANKETS, CLOTHING AND COOKING UTENSILS TO BE GIVEN TO THE LESS FORTUNATE PEOPLE IN THE ORPHANS. IN GITINDA SECTOR, LOCALS COMPLAINED OF INSECURITY WHICH THEY SAY ITS BEING CAUSED BY SOME BANDITS WHO THEY SAID TO BE ARMED WITH GRENADES. THESE BANDITS ARE BELIEVE TO BECOMING FROM THE BOUNDARIES OF SUB SECTOR 3A AND 3B, AND \* ROBBING LOCALS OF THEIR PROPERTIES.

(ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO KINAZI AND RUBONA SECTEURS UNDER NTONGWE COMMUNE (9057) AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION WAS CALM. THE LOCALS ARE COMPLAINING OF LONG DISTANCES THAT THEY TRAVEL TO OBTAIN MEDICAL TREATMENTS AND ALSO THEY DO NOT HAVE POTABLE WATER.

(iii) A HUMAN RIGHT VISITED GITARAMA PRISON AND REPORTED THAT THERE ARE 6840 INMATES BROKEN DOWN AS FOLLOWS: 6514 MEN, 218 WOMEN AND 102 CHILDREN, OUT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER 22 INMATES ARE HOSPITALIZED IN KABGAYI MSF HOSPITAL. THE MORTALITY RATE IS STILL VERY HIGH THUS 28 PER WEEK. NO RELEASES HAVE BEEN DONE OF LATE. THERE IS FOOT INFECTION DISEASES WHICH HAS MADE SOME INMATES TO BE AMPUTATED THEIR LEGS AND EAR INFECTIONS WHICH ALSO CAUSED SOME INMATES TO LOSE THEIR EARS. IT WOULD APPEAR THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ARE GIVING A DEAF EAR TO THIS SITUATION. THE PRISON EXTENSION IS AT AN ADVANCED STAGE.

#### B. KIBUYE TEAM

(i) A TEAM WENT TO MUSHUBATI SECTOR (3279) IN THE MABANZA COMMUNE. THEY TO VISITED THE HEALTH CENTER AND A LOCAL SCHOOL

AND ESTABLISHED THAT THE SCHOOL LACKS ALL NECESSARY AIDS AND THE TEACHERS HAVE NOT BEEN PAID FOR THE LAST THREE MONTHS. DUE TO THE NON SERVICEABILITY OF RUNNING WATER AND ELECTRICITY AT THE HEALTH CENTER MOST OF THE ESSENTIAL DRUGS ARE GETTING SPOILED . THE HEALTH CENTER AUTHORITIES ARE REQUESTING FOR SOME ASSISTANCE TO ALLEVIATE THE PROBLEM.

(ii) FURTHER TO OUR SITREP DATED 12 JUN 95 . IT HAS BEEN

ESTABLISHED THAT THE 5 PEOPLE WHICH WE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN KILLED IN THE MAHAMBE SECTOR (1854) WERE KILLED ON 5 JUN 95 . IT HAS BEEN CONFIRMED BY A LOCAL TEACHER NAMED MUHINDAZIGA THAT , THE FIVE WERE A HUTU FAMILY , A MOTHER AND HER 4 CHILDREN WHO HAPPENED TO BE RETURNEES. THIS FAMILY WAS KILLED BY AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF TUTSI LOCALS, WHO ARE ALSO BELIEVED

TO BE RETURNEES NOT RPA SOLDIERS OR CROSS BORDER RAIDER AS WAS REPORTED BY OUR SITREP . THE HUSBAND IS REPORTED TO BE AT LARGE SINCE THE DATE OF THIS OCCURRENCE .

(iii) REFERENCE TO OUR SITREP DATED 12 JUN 95, THE MISSING TEACHER AND HIS 7 STUDENTS COULD NOT BE LOCATED IN THE GITARAMA PRISON . A HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM VISITED THE PRISON IN A BID TO ESTABLISH THE TRUTH BUT THEY COULD NOT LOCATE THEM . IT IS ASSUMED THAT THESE PUPIL AND THEIR TEACHER COULD BE IN ONE OF THE COMMUNE CACHOTS .  
MORE INFO TO FOLLOW IF ANY.

C. MALICOY.

(i) THE NTONGWE PLATOON REPORTED THAT TWO RPA SOLDIERS EXCHANGED GUN FIRE RESULTING ONE SOLDIER DYING. IT IS ALLEGED THAT THE TWO SOLDIERS WERE FIGHTING OVER A RUSTLED CATTLE.

D. MALAWI COY.

(i) ONE TEAM WENT TO NYAKAHINGA (3468) AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS LIVE IN FEAR OF ARRESTS. THE FOLLOWING WERE ARRESTED BY RPA SOME THREE MONTH AGO , DONALD BIZIMUNGU , SEWERA AND MUSABINA, AND LOCKED IN KIBUYE PRISON .

CIRCUMSTANCE SURROUNDING THE INCIDENT IS AS FOLLOWS ; THE VEH WAS FROM GITARAMA PROCEEDING TO NTONGWE 9057 PL LOC, WHEN A CIVILIAN VEH PEUGEOT BLOCKED THE ROAD AT GR 8153 AND STOPPED THE VEH. SUDDEN 11 MEN ARMED WITH AK RIFLES, WHO ARE BELIEVED TO BE RPA SOLDIERS APPEARED FROM THE BUSH DEMANDING UNAMIR TROOPS TO HAND OVER THE VEH. THE DRIVER GAPPED IT WITH THE KEY TO RUHANGO 7653 PL HQ AND MADE A REPORT. A QUICK REACTION TEAM WAS DESPATCHED TO THE SCENE, BUT ONLY TO FIND THE VEH GONE. THE VEH HAD 01 LT AND 03 SOLDIERS. THE SECTOR CDR AND TWO MILOB TEAMS WERE DEPLOYED IN THE GEN AREA AROUND 1800 HRS, BUT ALL WAS INVAIN. THE QUICK REACTION TEAM FROM MALI COY, TRACKED THE SPOOR AND LOST IT AFTER BUSORO BRIDGE 9647.

(ii) THE SECTOR HQ INSTITUTED AN INVESTIGATION LAST NIGHT. THE MILITARY POLICE ARE ALSO CARRYING OUT INVESTIGATIONS.

B. FRGE. NTR.C. MILITIA. NTR

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

(1) ONE PATROL WENT TO NYABIKENKE COMMUNE 7292 AND VISITED THE FOLLOWING SECTORS, BURAMBA, KIBYIMBA AND KARACUZI AND

ESTABLISHED THAT PEOPLE ARE IN NEED OF FOOD DUE TO HEAVY RAINS THAT DESTROYED THEIR CROPS. SCHOOL TEACHERS HAVE NOT BEEN PAID SINCE MARCH 95. THEY ALSO IN NEED OF SCHOOL EQUIPMENT IN FORM OF CHAIRS, BENCHES, BLACK BOARDS AND NOT TO MENTION SCHOOL BOOKS. THE BRIDGE OVER GATARE RIVER 7186 WAS WASHED OUT BY THE HEAVY RAINS, THEREFORE THEY REQUIRE CEMENT AND QUARRY STONES TO RECONSTRUCT IT. LOCALS HAVE FORMED CONSTRUCTING GROUPS TO RECONSTRUCT DESTROYED HOUSES IN THE THREE SECTORS AND THEY HAVE SINCE CONSTRUCTED QUITE REASONABLE NUMBER OF THEM WITHOUT ANY ASSISTANCE FROM ANY ORGANIZATION.

(ii) A JOINT CIVPOL AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM VISITED MUGINA 9267 AND RUNDA 9882 COMMUNES TO MONITOR THE COMMUNE CACHOTS. THEY REPORTED THE FOLLOWING, AT MUGINA COMMUNE THERE ARE 107 MEN, 07 WOMEN WITH 02 CHILDREN AGED 06 MONTHS. ALL ACCUSED OF PARTICIPATING IN LAST YEAR'S GENOCIDE. THE INMATES COMPLAINED OF LACK OF PORTABLE WATER. SOME CLAIMED THAT THEY HAD NOT HAVE A BATH FOR MORE THAN 03 MONTHS. THEY WERE SEEN LYING ON BARE FLOOR IN THE CELL. THE SUSPECTS FURTHER COMPLAINED THAT THEY WERE INDIVIDUALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR FEEDING AND MEDICAL PROBLEMS. AT RUNDA COMMUNE, THE TEAM COUNTED 135 INMATES IN 06 CELLS. ONLY 03 WERE COMMON CRIME CASES, WHILE THE REST WERE GENOCIDE SUSPECTS. THE TEAM OBSERVED THAT MOST OF THE SUSPECTS IN BOTH COMMUNE'S CELLS HAD BODILY INJURIES, THE PRISONERS CLAIMED THAT THEY WERE BEATEN UP DURING THE INTERROGATION PERIOD BY THE RPA. THE TEAM BROUGHT THIS COMPLAINT TO THE NOTICE OF RPA OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE COMMUNE CELLS AND HE PROMISED THAT NO FURTHER HARASSMENT WILL OCCUR.

**B. KIRUYE TEAM**

(i) ONE TEAM WENT TO MUGOZI 1858 AND ESTABLISHED THAT, ON 24 MAY 95 RPA SOLDIERS HARASSED, BEATEN UP SOME LOCALS AND EXTORTED MONEY AND PROPERTY FROM THEM. AT MAHEMBE 1854, 05 PEOPLE KILLED BY RPA SOLDIERS, REASON UNKNOWN. MARIECLAIRE OF UNHCR CONFIRMED HAVING RECEIVED THE SAME REPORT. IT IS ALLEGED THAT THE KILLINGS WERE COMMITTED BY RAIDERS FROM ZAIRE.

(ii) AT BUTIMBU 1254 LAST WEEK DATE AND TIME NOT GIVEN, AN RPA SOLDIER TOOK ONE CATTLE FROM IT'S OWNER CLAIMING IT TO BE FINE FOR THE LOCAL. ANOTHER TEAM WENT TO KINANIRA 1660 AND ESTABLISHED THAT LAST WEEK DATE NOT GIVEN, ONE TEACHER AND 07 STUDENTS WERE ARRESTED AND TAKEN TO GITARAMA PRISON. THE MOTIVE APPEARS TO BE FOR NOT ANSWERING A SATISFACTORY TO THE RPA SOLDIERS DURING QUESTIONING. HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIVPOL (GITARAMA) WILL CONDUCT A FOLLOW UP TOMORROW.

(iii) THE LACK OF INTERPRETERS IS HAMPERING COLLECTION AND GATHERING OF INFORMATION IN THE SUB SECTOR AREA







(i) A MILOB TEAM FROM GITARAMA TOGETHER WITH A TEAM FROM HUMANITARIAN CELL HQ VISITED KIGOMA COMMUNE 7649 TO ASSESS THE AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE REQUIRED BY THE WIDOWS AND ORPHANS IN THE COMMUNE. THE TEAMS ESTABLISHED THAT THEY ARE 494 ORPHANS SOME OF WHOM ATTENDING PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL. THIS ORPHANS REQUIRE ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF BOOKS, BLANKETS, CLOTHING AND FOOD IT WAS ALSO LEARNT THAT THEY ARE 1550 WIDOWS IN THE SAME COMMUNE WHO ALSO REQUIRE FOOD, CLOTHING, COOKING UTENCILS AND SHELTER SINCE THEIR HOUSES WERE DESTROYED DURING THE WAR.

(ii) MALI COY TREATED 18 LOCALS PATIENTS AND SENT ONE MED TEAM TO CYEZA ORPHANAGE.

(iii) MALI COY PROVIDED 2 TRUCKS TO LWF FOR TRANSPORTING BUILDING MATERIALS FROM RUHANGO 7653 TO MUGINA 9267.

(iv) ONE TEAM FROM THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE VISITED KIBUYE SUB SEC HQ AND WAS BRIEFED OF THE SITUATION IN THE PREFECTURE.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE PREFECT OF KIBUYE HELD A MEETING WITH BOURGMESTRE OF KIBUYE PREFECTURE DETAILS OF THE MEETING COULD NOT BE OBTAINED AS MILOBS WERE NOT ALLOWED ENTRY.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

A. RPA. THE RPA CHECK POINT AT MUSHUBATI 6970 STOPPED THE VEHICLE OF THE LOGISTIC OFFICER OF SECTOR 3A. THE RPA SOLDIERS WANTED TO SEARCH THE VEHICLE. THE MILOBS REFUSED TO BE SEARCHED. AFTER SOME LENGTH DISCUSSION THE VEHICLE WAS ALLOWED TO PASS WITHOUT SEARCH. THE ISSUE WAS THEN REPORTED TO RPA LOCAL COMMANDER WHO THEN AGREED TO MEET THE SECTOR COMMANDER ON 08 JUNE 95 TO RESOLVE THIS ISSUE ONCE AND FOR ALL.

B. FRGE. NTR.C. MILITIA. NTR4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES. A.GITARAMA TEAM

(i) ONE TEAM WENT TO MUKINGI (7160) AND MUSHUBATI (6970). THEY VISITED THE CACHOT AND ESTABLISHED THAT THERE ARE 48 PRISONERS ALL OF THEM ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE. IN MUSHUBATI CACHOT THERE ARE 35 PRISONERS, 24 ARE ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE AND 11 ARE BEING CHARGED OF PETTY CRIMINAL CASES.

(ii) THE SAME TEAM TOGETHER WITH HUMAN RIGHTS, AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL AND SECTOR CDR VISITED MUKINGI AND LATER VISITED RUGOGWE SECTOR, WHERE THEY ATTENDED A PUBLIC GATHERING WITH THE POPULATION AND THE LOCAL CONSEILLER, MANAGED BY MUKINGI'S BOURGMESTRE. THE AIM OF THE MEETING WAS SECURITY MATTERS.

(iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MUGINA (9267) AND MUSAMBIRA (8274). THE PATROL ESTABLISHED THAT THERE IS A LOT OF BANDITRY ACTIVITIES TAKING PLACE IN FORM OF CATTLE RUSTING. IT IS ALSO ESTABLISHED THAT THERE ARE 23 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CELL, THERE ARE CHARGED OF GENOCIDE. IN MUGINA THERE

ARE 19 RETURNRES FAMILIES FROM UGANDA WHO CAME ON 06 JUN 95. THEY HAVE BEEN SETTLED IN THE COMMUNE. 176 FAMILIES ARE STILL WAITING RESETTLEMENT IN THE AREA OF CYERU SECTOR. THE RESETTLEMENT IS BEEN PLANNED BY THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

(i) A HUMANITARIAN TEAM VISITED ICRC AND GATHERED THAT 344 UNREGISTERED IDPS FROM KIBKHO CAMP WERE SAID TO HAVE SETTLED OWN THEIR IN THE PREFECTURE IN THE MONTH OF MAY 95. BESIDES THE ICRC REGISTERED 56 OTHERS BRINGING THE TOTAL OF IDPS TO 400.

(ii) IN THE SAME MONTH THE ICRC REGISTERED 200 IDPS WHO LEFT THE COUNTRY IN 1959/60. OUT THIS FIGURES THE ICRC TRANSPORTED 120 REFUGEES TO THEIRS COMMUNES OF ORIGIN. HOWEVER, 40 OF THOSE REMAINING REFUSED TO SETTLE AT GISOVU COMMUNE (2952) FOR REASONS THAT THERE IN NOT AVAILABLE LAND FOR CULTIVATION.

C. MALI COY

(i) ONE PATROL WENT KARAMBA 8757 AND REPORTED THAT THE AREA IS DESERTED, VERY FEW LOCALS ARE IN THIS SECTOR. SITUATION IS CALM.

D. MALAWI COY

(i) ONE PATROL WHICH WAS DESTINED FOR GASHARU (4263) COULD NOT REACH DUE TO A BROKEN BRIDGE AT 431666. THE PATROL LATER WENT TO RUBANGO SECTOR 4366 AND ESTABLISHED THAT THE RPA SOLDIERS ARE HARASSING AND ARRESTING LOCALS IN AREA. IT WAS ALSO LEARNT THAT THE CATTLE AND GOATS RUSTLING ACTIVITIES TAKING PLACE IN THE AREA IS BEING CARRIED OUT BY THE RPA SOLDIERS.

(ii) ANOTHER PATROL TEAM WENT TO MURANGA 2267 AND REPORTED THAT THE 09 GIRLS WHO WERE ARRESTED AT MUBUGA COMMUNE ON 31 MAY 95 HAVE BEEN RELEASED.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

(i) THERE WILL BE CELEBRATIONS IN KIBUYE PREFECTURE ON 16 JUN 95 IN COMMEMORATION OF AFRICA'S DAY OF THE CHILDREN. MALAWI COY PROVIDE TRANSPORT FOR 50 ORPHANS FROM NGOMA(2159) TO ATTEND THIS CELEBRATION.

(ii) MALI COY TREATED 23 LOCALS.

(iii) MALI COY SENT A MEDICAL TEAM TO CONCERN ORPHANAGE.

(iv) MALI COY PROVIDED ONE TRUCK FOR LUTHERAN WORLD FEDERATION TO CARRY BUILDING MATERIALS, AND ONE TRUCK TO BULINGA COMMUNE (6679) TO TRANSPORT FOOD.



(i) OUTGOING AND INCOMING SECTOR CDR VISITED MASANGO 6254, MURAMA 6749, RUHANGO 7653 AND NTONEWE 9057 TO BID FAREWELL TO THE MALI TROOPS AND INTRODUCE THE INCOMING SECTOR CDR.

(ii) ONE MILOB TEAM AND CIV POL WENT TO KAYENZI 8389 AND LATER VISITED GIHIRA 8195, BUGARAMA 8985, MUGANZA 8686 AND KIRWA 9185. SITUATION IS REPORTED TO BE CALM DESPITE THE RIFE NIGHT ROBBERIES BY ARMED BANDITS WHO ARE SAID TO BE STEALING GOATS AND COWS. THIS IS MOSTLY HAPPENING IN MUGANZA SECTOR 8686. DUE TO HEAVY RAINS THE CONDITION OF ROADS AND BRIDGES HAS DETERIORATED CONSIDERABLY. CARITAS AND SALVATION ARMY HAVE SINCE COME IN TO HELP THE LESS FORTUNATE TO RECONSTRUCT THEIR DESTROYED HOUSES AND WITH SOME FOOD AID.

(iii) HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIV POL TEAM VISITED GITARAMA PRISON TO ASSESS THE SITUATION. ICRC WAS IN THE PROCESS OF PLACING WOODEN PLANKS ON THE FLOOR. IT IS LEARNT FROM UNCONFIRMED SOURCES THAT THE REASON FOR THIS WAS THE BREAKOUT OF GANGRENE AMONGST AT LEAST 120 PRISONERS DUE TO THE PRESENCE OF STANDING INFECTED WATER AT ONE END OF THE PRISON



(iv) ONE MILOB TEAM AND UNHCR TEAM WENT TO KIGOMA COMMUNE 7649 TO ASSES THE JUDICIAL ASSISTANCE REQUIRED. THE UNHCR TEAM OFFERED TO ASSIST THE COMMUNE TRIBUNAL WITH STATIONERY AND SOME BUILDING MATERIALS TO COMPLETE THE ALREADY STANDING BUILDING.

(v) ONE MILOB AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO TAMBWE COMMUNE 7653. SITUATION IS CALM. THE TEAM WANTED TO VISIT THE CACHOT BUT IT WAS REFUSED ENTRY. THE REASON WAS THAT THE RPA CDR INCHARGE OF THE PRISON HAS SOME DIFFERENCE WITH THE HUMAN RIGHTS MEMBERS. AS A RESULT, THE VISIT WAS ABANDONED.

(vi) THE SAME TEAM PROCEEDED TO NTONGWE COMMUNE 9057. SITUATION CALM. THE TEAM VISITED TO THE CACHOT WHICH IS SAID TO BE HOLDING 142 PEOPLE, 14 FEMALES AND 128 MALES. THEIR PRISON CONDITION IS BAD AND THERE IS A GENERAL LACK OF FOOD AND POOR SANITARY CONDITIONS. THE PRISONERS HAVE BEEN IN THE CACHOT FOR ABOUT 2 AND HALF MONTHS.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

(i) ONE TEAM VISITED PATROLLED GITESI 2871. SITUATION CALM. THE TEAM MET THE NEW BOURGEMESTRE. THE PREVIOUS INCMBENT WAS REMOVED LAST WEEK ON UNKNOWN CHARGES. THE TEAM FOUND TWO PATIENTS IN THE LOCAL HEALTH CENTRE WITH GUN SHOT WOUNDS BUT WERE NOT ALLOWED TO QUESTION THEM. THE SECONDARY

SCHOOL IS FUNCTIONING BUT THERE ARE COMPLAINTS OF LACK OF WATER AND NOW PAYMENT TO TEACHERS.

(i) ONLY ONE MILOB PATROL WAS SENT OUT DUE TO THE VISIT OF THE OUTGOING AND INCOMING SECTOR COM. ONE TEAM PATROLLED NYABUYAGA (1481). LOCAL AUTHORITIES COULD NOT BE CONTACTED AS TODAY WAS BEING OBSERVED AS A HOLIDAY. HOWEVER THE MILOBE LEARNT THAT ON 03 JUN 95 GUN SHOTS WERE HEARD FROM THE COASTAL AREA. THE SITUATION IS CALM BUT LOCALS ARE AFRAID OF CIRCULATING RUMORS THAT UMWARU WILL SOON BE LEAVING THE COUNTRY. THE MILOBE TEAM WAS FURTHER INFORMED THAT TWO WEEKS AGO THREE BOYS WERE ARRESTED BY RPA FOR ALLEGED INVOLVEMENT IN GENOCIDE.



DUE TO THE HEAVY TRAFFIC THE TEAMS COULD NOT FOLLOW THE VEHICLE WHICH PROBABLY WENT TOWARDS KIGALI. THE CEREMONY WAS ATTENDED BY THE PRESIDENT, PRIME MINISTER, DY PRIME MINISTER SEVERAL CABINET MINISTERS AND HIGH OFFICIALS OF THE GOVT AND RPA. THE VICE PRESIDENT DID NOT ATTEND. THE CEREMONY COMMENCED WITH CHURCH SERVICES WHERE THE ACTING BISHOP OF KABGAYI SPOKE OF JUSTICE AND RECONCILIATION. THIS WAS FOLLOWED BY SPEECHES BY DIGNITARIES AT THE KABGAYI SCHOOL WHERE THE SAME MESSAGE WAS REPEATED. THE CEREMONY WAS ATTENDED BY THE MINISTER OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION, OTHER HIGH OFFICIALS INCLUDING LT COL KATUREBA JAMES FROM THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR. MORE THAN 10,000 PEOPLE DIED IN THIS COMMUNE DURING THE GENOCIDE. THE MINISTER SPOKE ON THE OCCASION AND EMPHASISED THAT ARRESTS MUST NOT CEASE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND THE SYSTEM OF JUSTICE MUST BE ESTABLISHED. NO MENTION OF UNAMIR WAS MADE EXCEPT TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE PRESENCE OF OUR TEAM. HE APPEALED TO THE PEOPLE TO ASSIST THE ORPHANS IN

OBTAINING A DECENT UPRISING AND EDUCATION.

(iii) ONE TEAM VISITED KIGOMA COMMUNE 7649 AND OBTAINED DETAILS OF THE PRESENT SITUATION. NO ARRESTS FOR THE PRESENT. 3 WOMEN HELD IN THE CACHOT EARLIER HAVE BEEN RELEASED. OF THE 988 REGISTERED IDPs WHO HAVE RETURNED ONLY 3 HAVE BEEN ARRESTED ON CHARGES OF GENOCIDE. 1641 ORPHANS AND 1550 WIDOWS IN THE COMMUNE, ALL RESIDING IN WITH RELATIVES.

COMMENT: THIS APPEARS TO BE ONE OF THE PRIME REASONS FOR THE FOOD SHORTAGE IN MOST COMMUNES AS THE NUMBER OF WORKING HANDS IS TOO LITTLE COMPARED TO THE NUMBER OF MOUTHS TO BE FED. NO CONCRETE STEPS IN THIS REGARD HAVE BEEN TAKEN BY ANY ORGANISATION.

LOCALS INFORMED THE PATROL OF THE ARREST OF 7 GIRLS ACCUSED OF FRATERNISING WITH UNAMIR TROOPS AND ARE CURRENTLY PLACED IN MUBUGA PRISON. GISHYITA IS NOT THE GIRL'S HOME COMMUNE AND THE LOCALS CLAIMED THAT THEY WERE ACTING CONTRARY TO RWANDESE CUSTOMS. THE GIRLS ARE ACCUSED OF GATHERING INTELLIGENCE FOR UNAMIR. THE SAME REPORT HAS ALSO BEEN RECEIVED FROM MALAWI COY AND IS INCLUDED UNDER CIVIL AFFAIRS IN THIS SITREP. FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS WILL FOLLOW.
