TRUST TERRITORIES IN EAST AFRICA IN 1960

Note by the Secretary-General

TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE UNITED NATIONS VISITING MISSION TO TRUST TERRITORIES IN EAST AFRICA, 1960

Bolivia: draft resolution

The Trusteeship Council,

Having decided to dispatch a periodic Visiting Mission to the Trust
Territories in East Africa,

Having decided that the Visiting Mission should be composed of,
as chairman and, assisted
by members of the Secretariat and also by members of the local administration
as may be appointed by the latter,

Having decided that the Visiting Mission should depart in mid-February 1960,
that it should visit the Trust Territories of Ruanda-Urundi and of Tanganyika
in that order and that the duration of its visit should be approximately two
months,

1. Directs the Visiting Mission to investigate and report as fully as possible
on the steps taken in the above-mentioned Trust Territories towards the
realization of the objectives set forth in Article 76 b of the Charter of the
United Nations, taking into account the terms of General Assembly
resolution 321 (IV) of 15 November 1949 and other relevant Assembly resolutions,
in particular General Assembly resolutions 1413 (XIV) on the attainment
of self-government or independence and 1419 (XIV) on plans for political
reforms for the Trust Territory of Ruanda-Urundi;
2. Directs the Visiting Mission to give attention, as may be appropriate in
the light of discussions in the Trusteeship Council and in the General Assembly
and of resolutions adopted by them, to issues in connexion with the annual

reports on the administration of the Trust Territories concerned, in petitions received by the Council relating to these Territories, in the reports of the previous periodic Visiting Mission to these Territories and in the observations of the Administering Authorities on these reports;

3. Directs the Visiting Mission to make a special investigation on the conditions and causes of the recent disturbances in Ruanda-Urundi;

4. Directs the Visiting Mission to receive petitions without prejudice to its acting in accordance with the rules of procedure of the Trusteeship Council, and to investigate on the spot, in consultation with the local representative of the Administering Authority concerned, such of the petitions received as, in its opinion, warrant special investigation;

5. Requests the Visiting Mission to submit to the Council in time for consideration by it at its twenty-sixth session a report on each of the Territories visited containing its findings, with such observations, conclusions and recommendations as it may wish to make.
