WHILE WE HAVE NOT YET SEEN THIS REPORT, WE UNDERSTAND HIS FINDINGS ARE TO THE EFFECT THAT THE KATANGESE POLICE WRONGFULLY REFUSED TO TRANSFER THE 2 TUNISIANS THEY HAD SEIZED INTO THE CUSTODY OF THE TUNISIAN SERGEANT AND SOLDIER WHO SUBSEQUENTLY CAME TO THE SCENE, THAT THE KATANGESE POLICE WRONGFULLY ATTACKED AND ATTEMPTED TO ARREST THE TUNISIAN SERGEANT AND THE SOLDIER WHO ACCOMPANIED HIM, THAT THE KATANGESE POLICE ATTEMPTED TO SEIZE THE SUB-MACHINE GUN THE TUNISIAN SERGEANT WAS CARRYING, THAT THE TUNISIAN SERGEANT FIRST FIRED INTO THE AIR AND THAT ONLY AS A LAST MEASURE IN SELF-DEFENSE DID THE TUNISIAN SERGEANT FIRE ON THE KATANGESE POLICE. 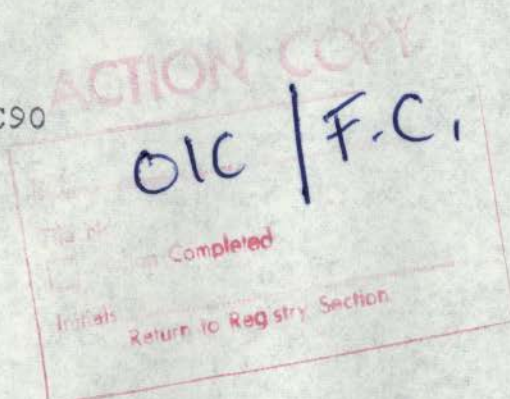

HIS GOVERNMENT HAD SUPPORTED HIM IN A PREVIOUS VIEW THAT THE YOUNG MAN BE SENT TO LEO TO BE TRIED AS A MERCENARY. TO THIS I HAVE REFUSED AND I AM TAKING ACTION AS I HAVE INDICATED ABOVE.
