THE PRESIDENT OF RWANDA MR BIZIMUNGU VISITED KIBUYE WHERE HE ATTENDED THE REBURIAL OF LAST YEARS VICTIMS OF GENOCIDE. IN HIS SPEECH HE REGRETTED THE MASSACRE WHICH CLAIMED THOUSANDS OF LIVES BOTH IN KIBUYE AND THE REST OF RWANDA. HE ALSO COMMENDED THE ROLE BEING PLAYED BY UNAMIR AND OTHER NGOS IN RESETTLING THE IDPs. THE FUNCTION TOOK PLACE AT GATWARO STADIUM IN KIBUYE GR 2772.



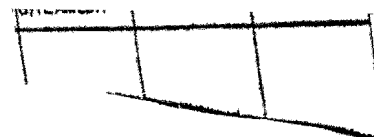



THIS UNKNOWN GROUP IS BELIEVED TO BE THE FORMER HOUSE HOLDERS IN THE AREA ANOTHER PATROL WENT NGOZI BOARDER GR 6989 WITH RPA PL COMDR KIGEMBE FOR FAMILIARISATION. CONTINUE PROVIDING SECURITY IN AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY.
