- The Fourth Regional Economic Cooperation Conference On Afghanistan (RECCA IV) will be held on 2-3 November 2010 in Istanbul.
- Conference Venue: Meetings of RECCA IV will be held at the Istanbul Ceylan Intercontinental and Conrad Hotels as mentioned below:

DAY ONE:

- Senior Officials Meeting, Working Group III (Trade, Transit, Cross-border Cooperation) and Working Group IV (Human Resources Development) Meetings will begin at 10.00 on 02 November 2010 at the Ceylan Intercontinental Hotel.
- Working Group I (Infrastructure) and Working Group II (Economic Development) Meetings will begin at 10.00 on 02 November 2010 at the Conrad Hotel.
- Buffet lunch will be served at Ceylan Intercontinental and Conrad Hotels.
- Working language of the first day will be English.
- A Business Forum and an Academic Forum, both being non-governmental events, will be held in parallel to RECCA IV on 2 November 2010. Therefore, their administrative arrangements will be executed separately and the related institutions will be informed in due time.

DAY TWO / MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE :

- The Plenary Session will begin at Ceylan Intercontinental Hotel at 10:00. Simultaneous translation
 will be provided in English, Russian, Arabic and Turkish. Limited number of booths may be provided
 for those delegations which would like to have their own translators.
- A luncheon will be arranged for the Heads of Delegations.
- Buffet lunch for other members of the delegations will be served at the Ceylan Intercontinental Hotel
- A Press Conference will be held at the end of the Plenary Session by the Afghan and Turkish Co-Chairs of the Conference.

- The Participating Countries are advised to appoint a Contact Point Officer in their Embassies in Ankara for coordination with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey.
- The participating delegations will cover their international and local travel and accommodation expenses. Transportation between airport and hotels will be arranged by the host country.
- Delegations are advised to note the deadlines for hotel reservations as mentioned in pages 4 and
- <u>Arrivals and Departures:</u> The Participating Countries and International Organizations should provide information concerning the arrivals and departures of the delegations, indicating whether it is a private flight or commercial flight to the Secretariat Contact Point not later than 20 October 2010.

For private flights, resident Embassies in Turkey should contact the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey.

Delegations will be met at Istanbul Atatürk Airport, VIP Lounge.

<u>Transportation</u> of the Delegations between the airport and the hotels at their arrival and departure will be provided by the host country. Ministers and Secretary General (International Organizations) will be provided with a VIP car.

- Vehicle Cards: In case the resident Embassies of the Participating Countries would like to bring
 extra cars in addition to the one VIP car provided by the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, additional
 vehicle cards for access to the restricted areas will be issued. For that purpose, delegations are required
 to fill in the "Additional Vehicle Demand Form" attached and convey it to the Secretariat not later than
 20 October 2010.
- <u>Security:</u> No security officer will be allowed in the Conference Hall and lunch venues. The lists of the Security Personnel accompanying Official Delegations and information concerning the types, calibers and serial numbers of their side arms, the amount of ammunition, types and frequencies of the communication equipment should be forwarded to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs not later than 20 October 2010. The Security Personnel and Communication Equipment Form is attached to this note.



REGIONAL ECONOMIC COOPERATION CONFERENCE ON AFGHANISTAN (RECCA IV)

Introduction

The Regional Economic Cooperation Conference on Afghanistan, RECCA is the only regional forum that puts cooperation with Afghanistan at its centre. It is a process rather than an event, aimed to promote economic cooperation between Afghanistan, regional neighbors, international partners and financial institutions. RECCA provides the opportunity for 26 nations and several regional and international organizations to come together to assess progress on regional economic cooperation initiatives and agree a set of projects, programs and initiatives for delivery. The first RECCA was in Kabul in 2005. It was followed by RECCA II (Delhi, 2006) and RECCA III (Islamabad, 2009). RECCA IV will be hosted by the Republic of Turkey, on 2-3 November 2010.

Background

Regional economic cooperation is now considered the main driving force for individual countries to participate and integrate in the global economy. The Government of Afghanistan attaches significant importance to regional economic cooperation, as the key Afghan enabler for: increasing prosperity; improving the welfare of the people; enhancing the confidence and understanding between governments; and building peace and stability in the region. Economic Cooperation generates income and improves service delivery to millions of people in our region.

After decades of instability, Afghanistan has an opportunity to realize its potential as a central hub and "land bridge" between Central Asia, South Asia and the Middle-Eastern region. Peace and prosperity in this strategically important country has the potential to provide economic opportunities for Afghanistan and

its neighbors. Afghanistan wants its regional and international partners to have a stake in that, share in the benefits of its centrality, and increase regional prosperity and cooperation.

Over the past decade, regional and international partners have confirmed and supported regional cooperation through agreements such as *The Good Neighborly Relations Declaration* of 2002, *The Tokyo Declaration of 2002*, *The Dubai Declaration* of 2003, *The Berlin Agreement* 2003, *The Bishkek Conference Communiqué* of 2004, *The Kabul Declaration* of 2005 (RECCA I), *The Delhi Declaration* of 2006 (RECCA II), and *The Islamabad Declaration* of 2009 (RECCA III), the Paris Declaration of 2008, *The Istanbul Statement of 2010* and Most recently, *The London Conference* of 28th January 2010 and *The Kabul Conference* of 20th July 2010 highlighted the efforts made by Afghanistan and its regional and international partners to strengthen regional cooperation, emphasizing the need for greater economic cooperation, with clear milestones set for progress in the areas of trade, transit, infrastructure, energy, labor migration and border management.

The Afghanistan Compact, 2006 and the Afghanistan National Development Strategy, 2008-13 illustrated the importance of regional economic cooperation as one of the main priorities of the Afghan government, and the benefits of integration for the prosperity of the region. While some progress is being made we recognize that more needs to be done in a shorter timeframe if we are to reach our Afghan National Development Strategy goals by 2013. We want RECCA to be in tune with reaching those goals.

RECCA Outcomes

In the coming weeks, the Government of Afghanistan will report locally to RECCA members on progress made since the Islamabad Declaration, 2009.

At the Kabul Conference, participants agreed to support the Government of Afghanistan to present concrete programs at RECCA IV in the following areas:

- i. sustainable natural resource development and management;
- ii. intra-regional investment in the extraction industries.
- iii. national and regional employment support;
- iv. transfer and access to energy;
- v. creation of a modern transport infrastructure; and
- vi. to facilitate growth of regional trade and transit;

We have been working together with RECCA members to develop such programs. We plan to share them with RECCA members in advance, locally, to reach agreement on a set of recommendations to be presented in four papers at the RECCA Working Group sessions. They will cover:

- Infrastructure (Energy, Transport and Mines)
- . ii. Economic Development (Agriculture, SMEs, Labor Migration)
 - iii. Trade, Transit, Border Management
 - iv. Human Resource Development (Education and Vocational Training)

We will ask participants to agree and support these recommendations. We want to turn these recommendations into deliverables in the final *Istanbul Declaration*, 2010. We will propose a mechanism to monitor and evaluate Declaration deliverables so that the RECCA Secretariat at the Centre for Regional Cooperation, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Afghanistan, can provide a systematic and regular assessment of progress to RECCA members in the future and help address potential bottlenecks at an early stage.

Business to Business and Academic Forum

Representatives of the private sector from participating countries will be invited to a Business Forum which will take place in the margin of the RECCA IV Conference. The Forum will be jointly organized by the Afghanistan Investment Support Agency (AISA), the Union of Chambers and Commodity Exchanges of Turkey (TOBB), the Economic Policy Research Foundation in Turkey (TEPAV), Investment Support and Promotion Agency of Turkey (ISPAT) and Foreign Relation Board (DEIK).

Due to the increasing interest in regional cooperation issues within academic circles, an Academic Forum will be held, for the first time, with the participation of selected academics from the RECCA participating countries.

Both Governments look forward to working closely with RECCA members over the next couple of months towards what we wish will be a successful and productive RECCA Conference.
